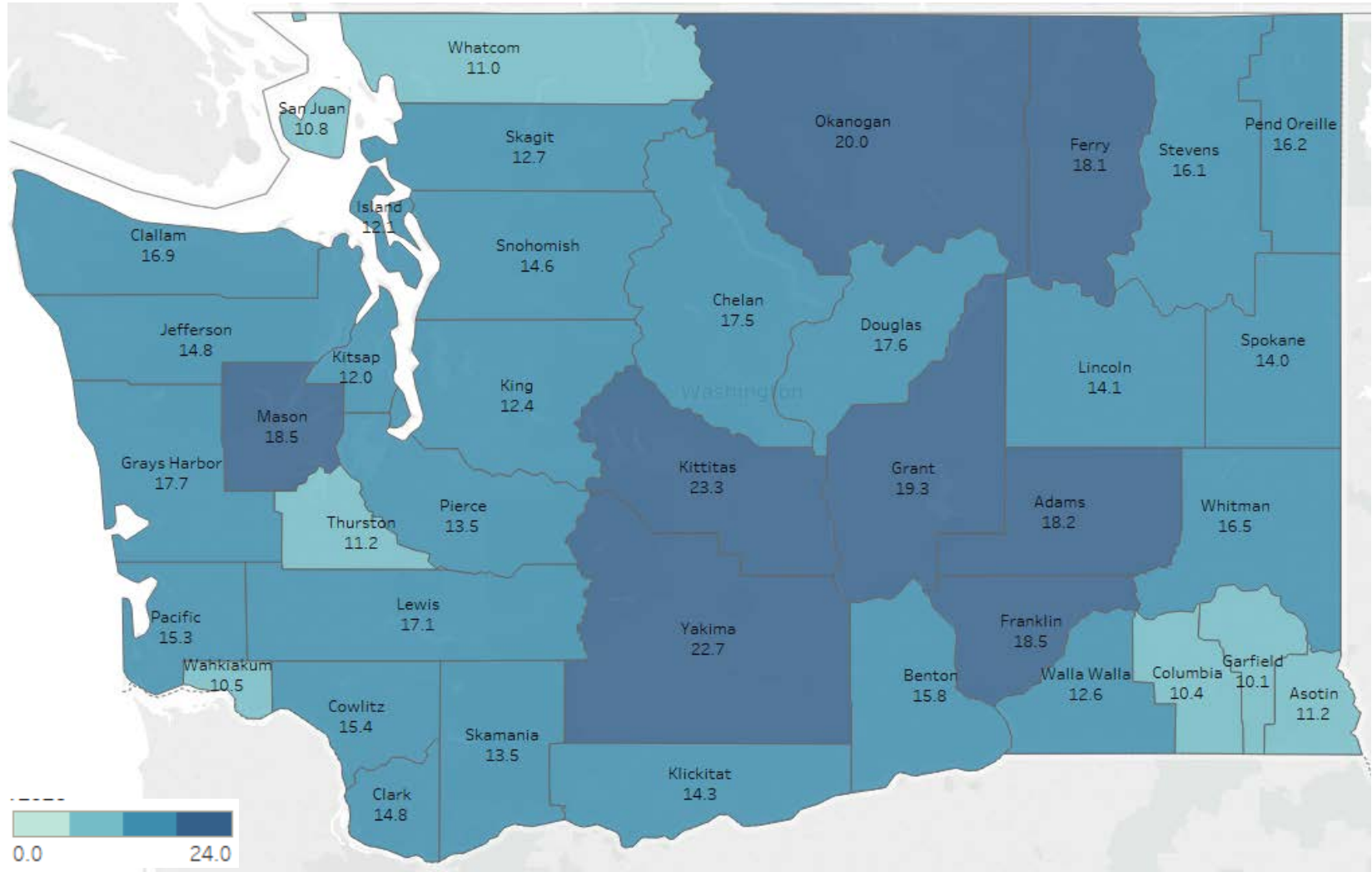

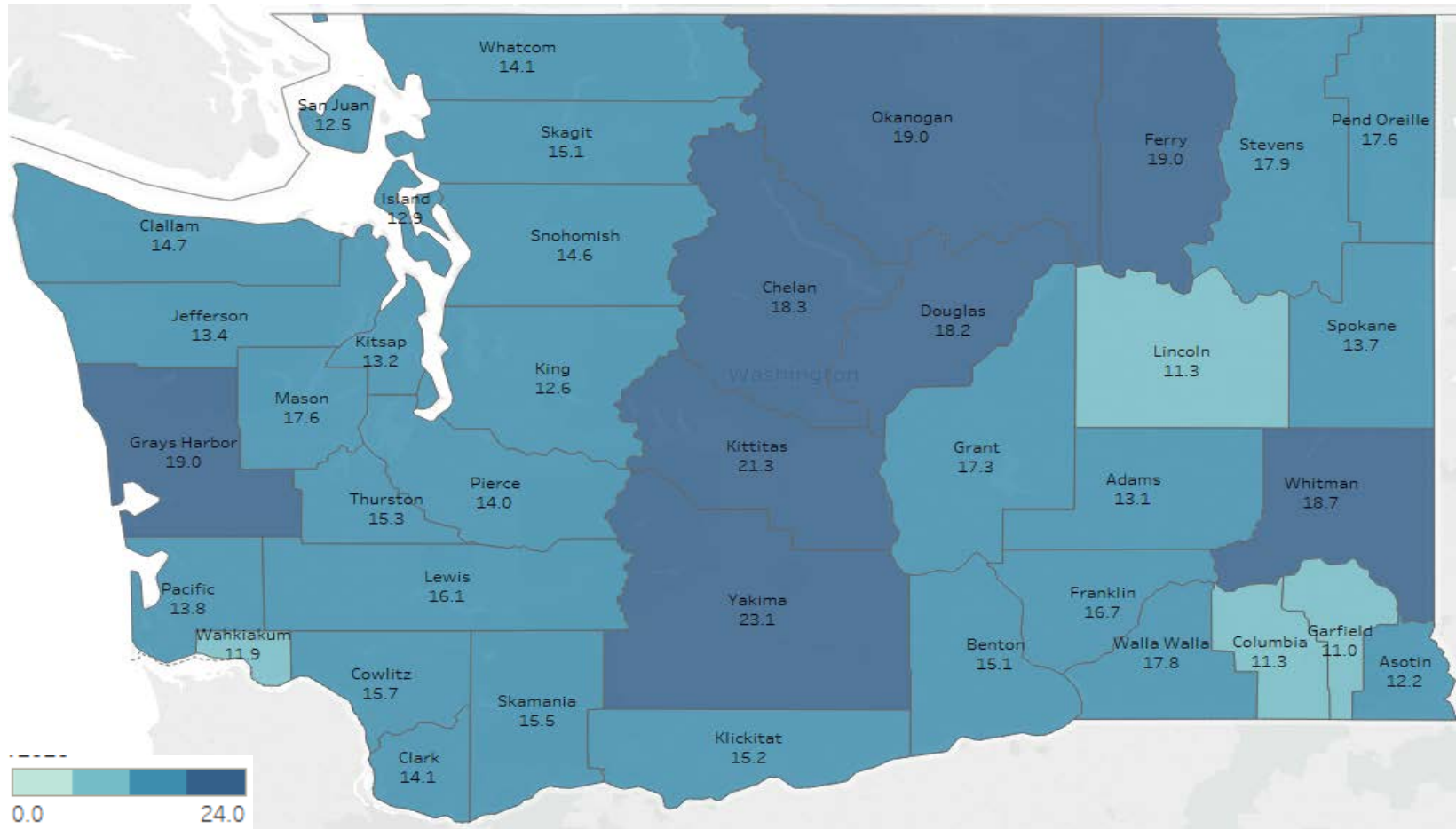

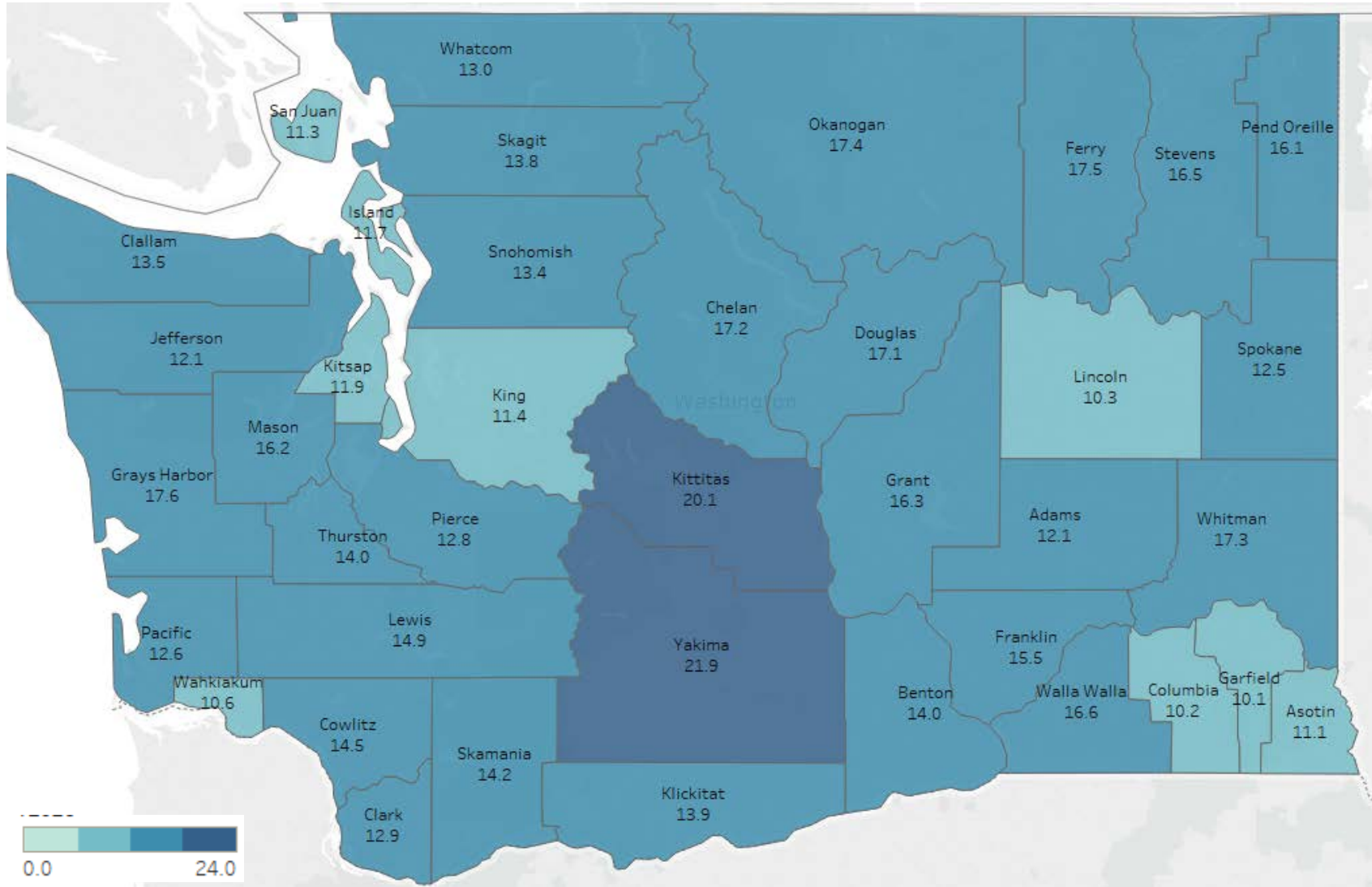

Chart 2. County Uninsured Rates (%), 2012



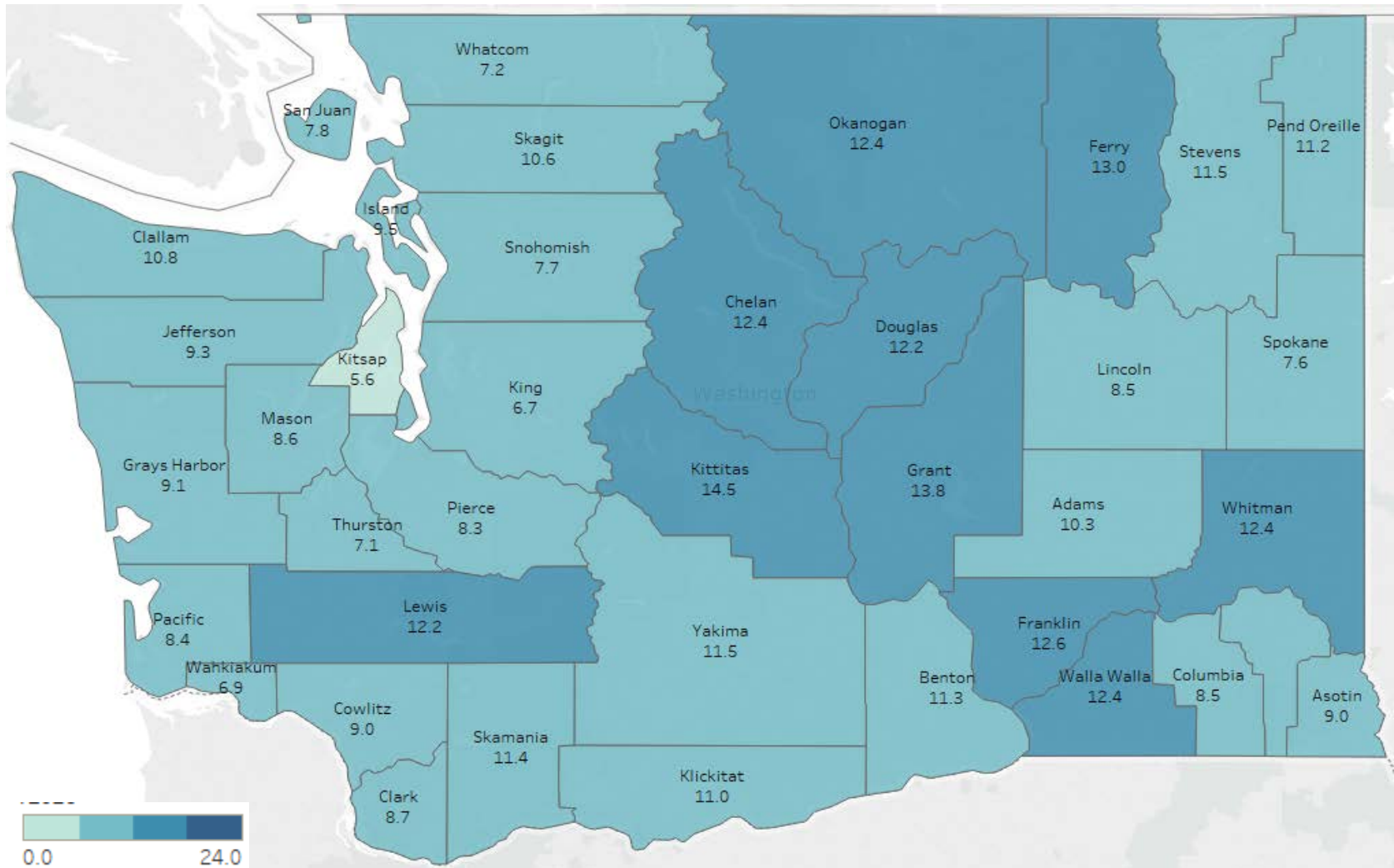

Chart 3. County Uninsured Rates (%), 2013



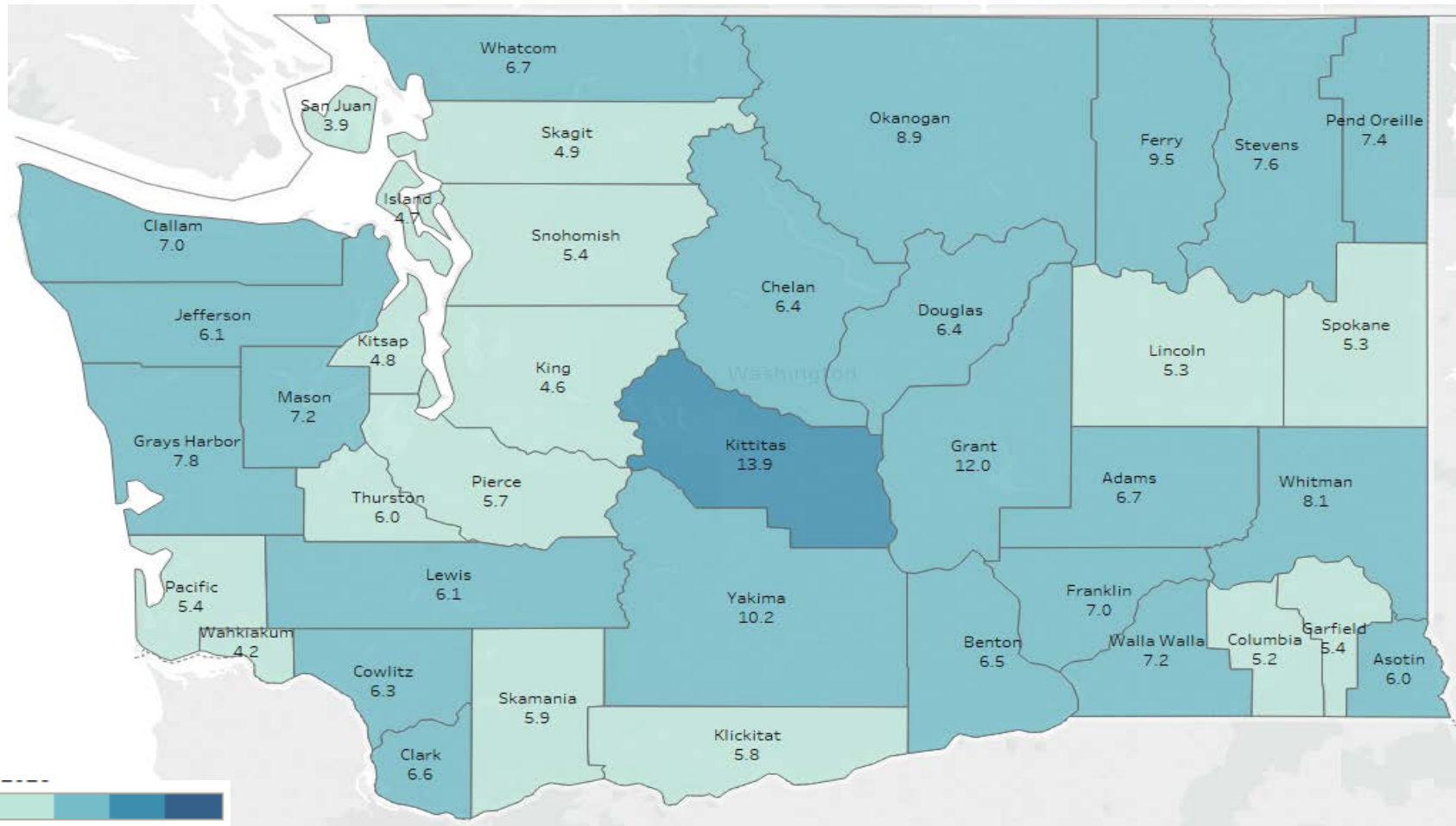

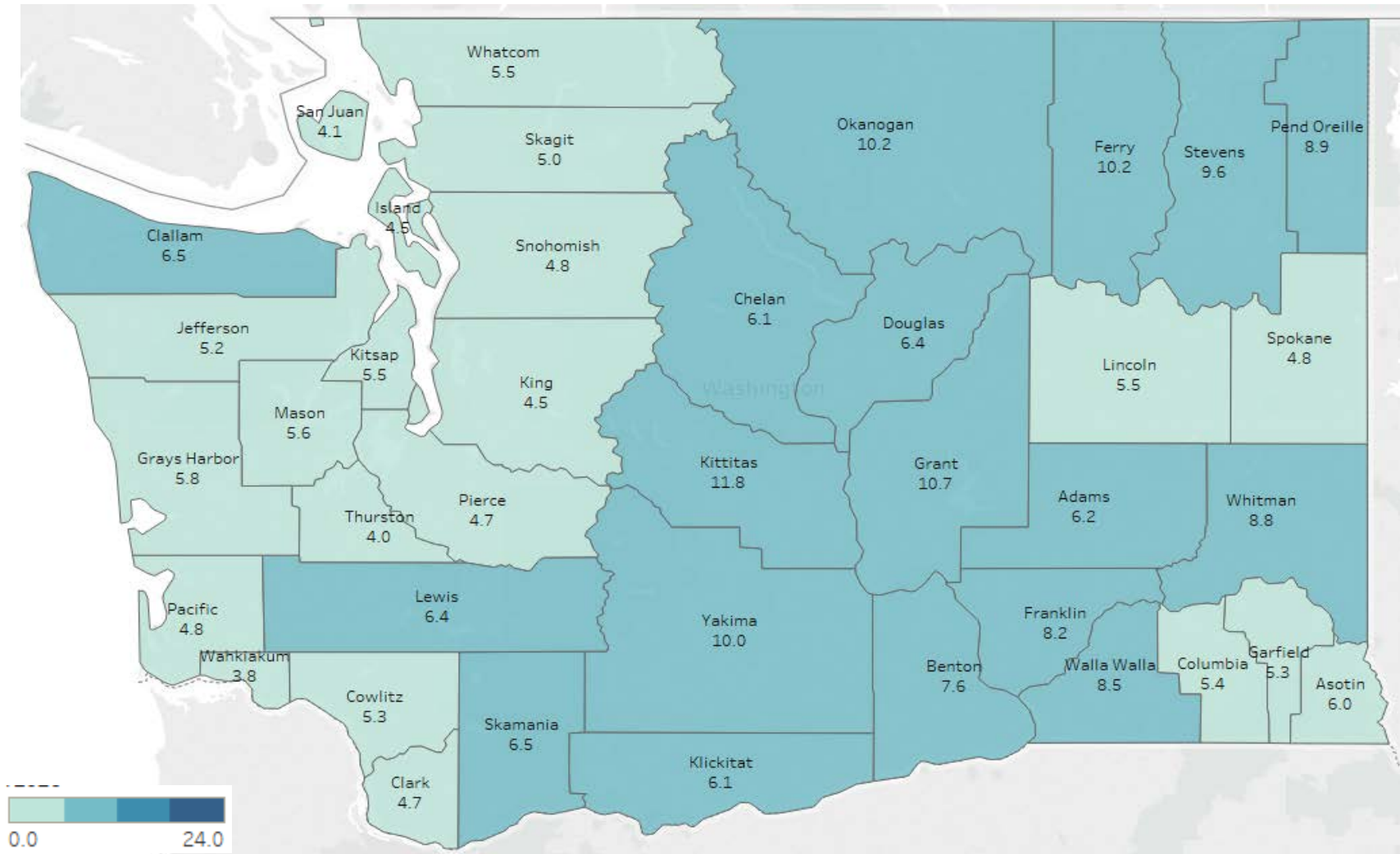

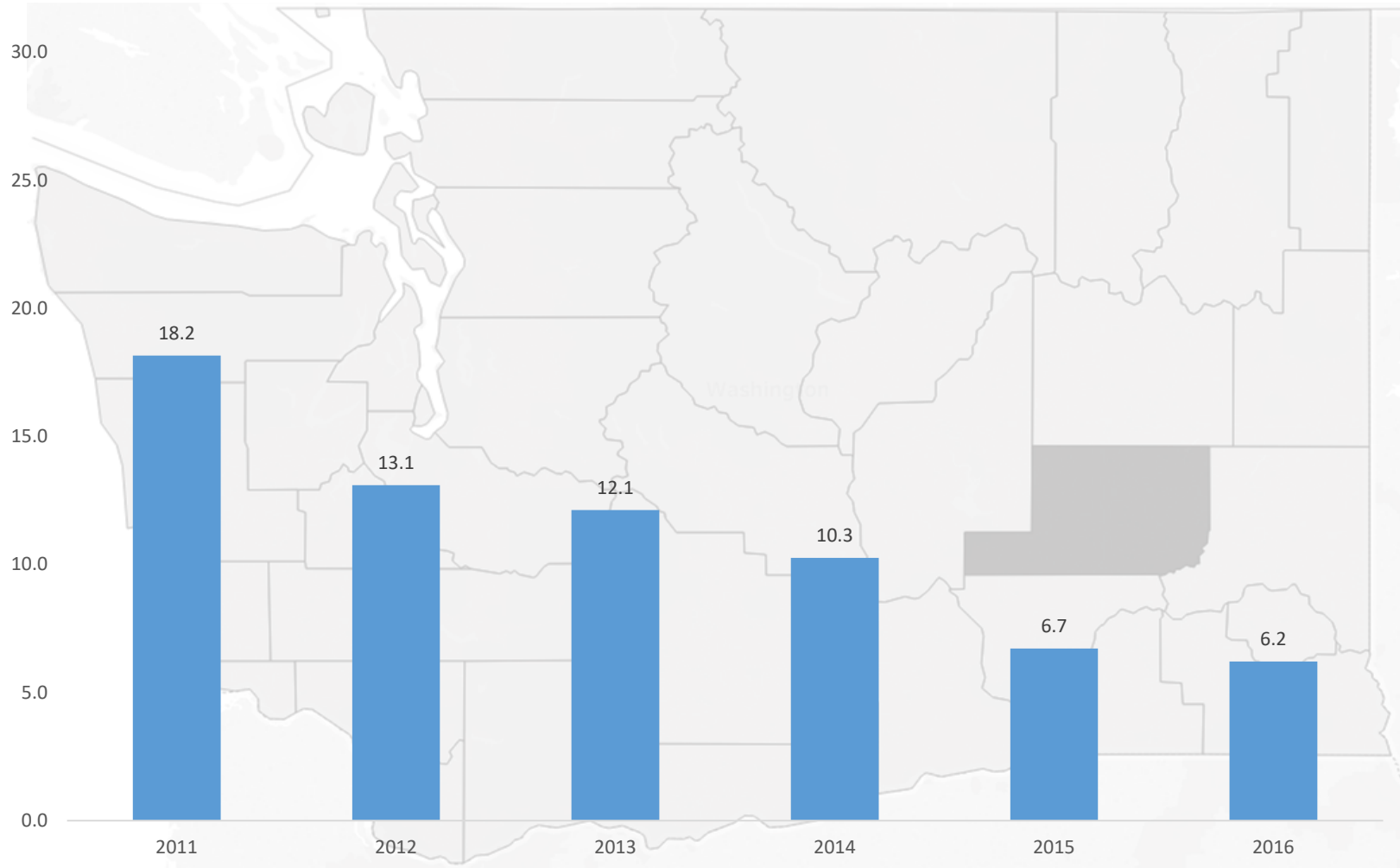

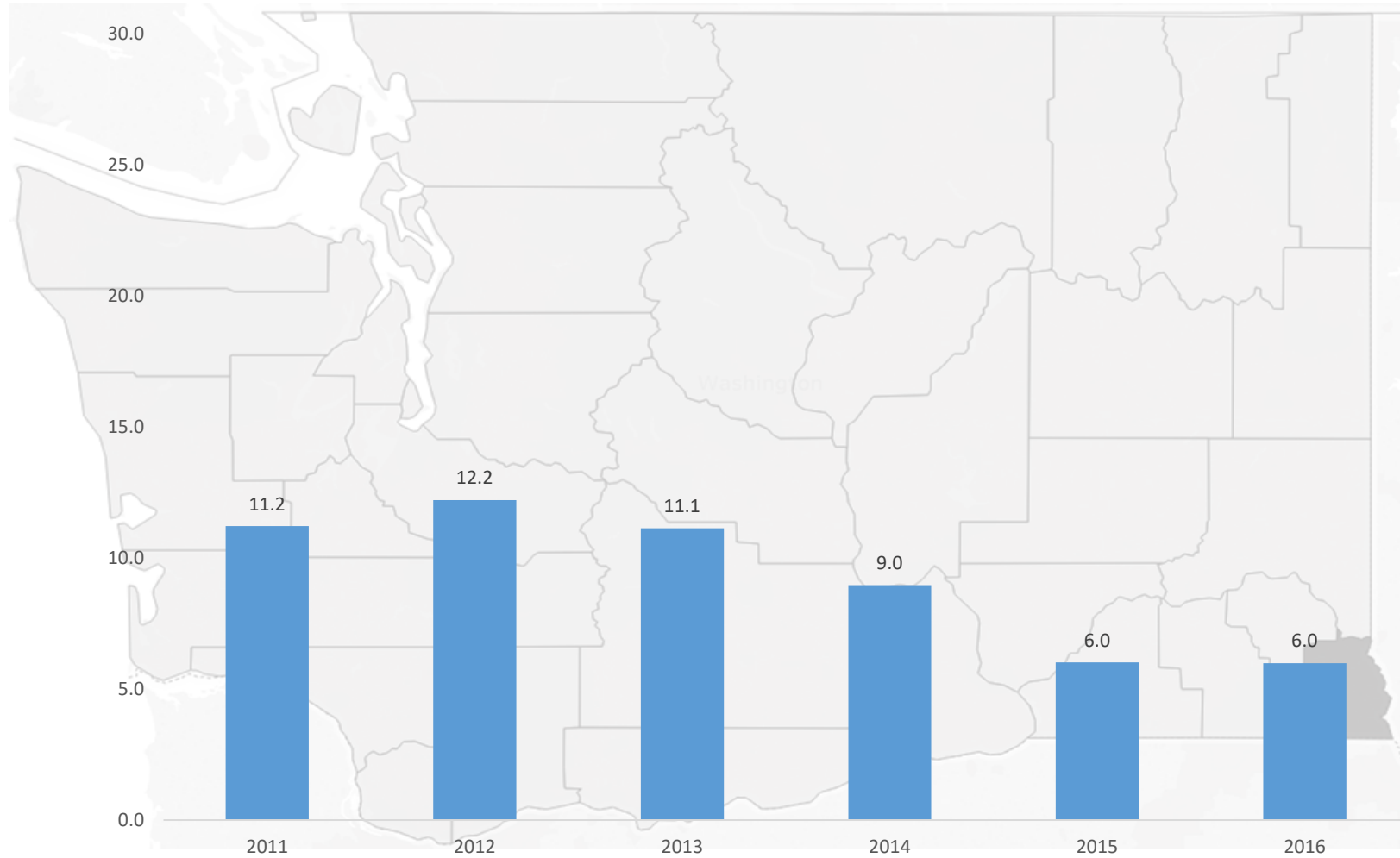
Chart 7. Percent Uninsured, Adams County, 2011-16

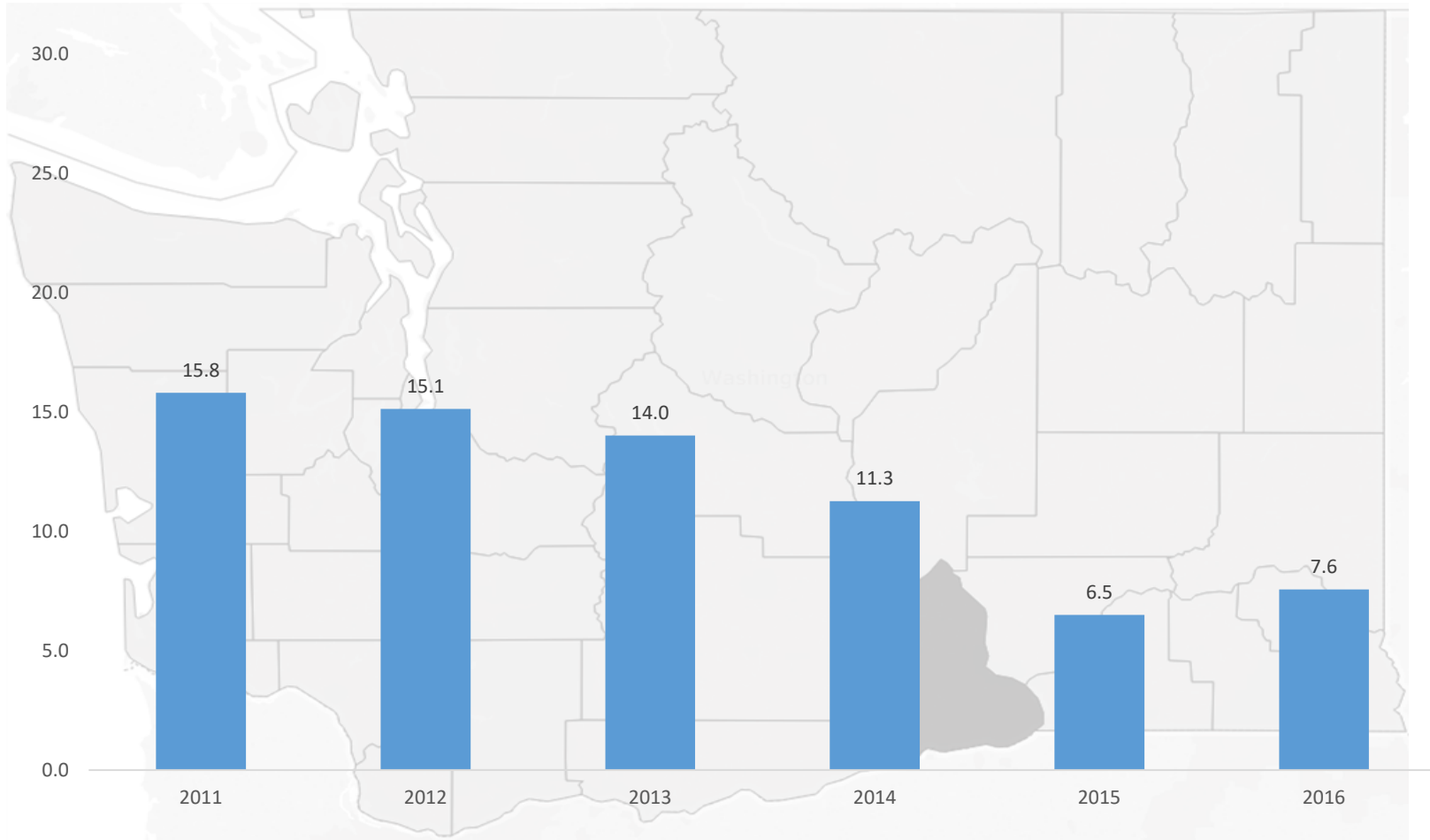
Chart 8. Percent Uninsured, Asotin County, 2011-16

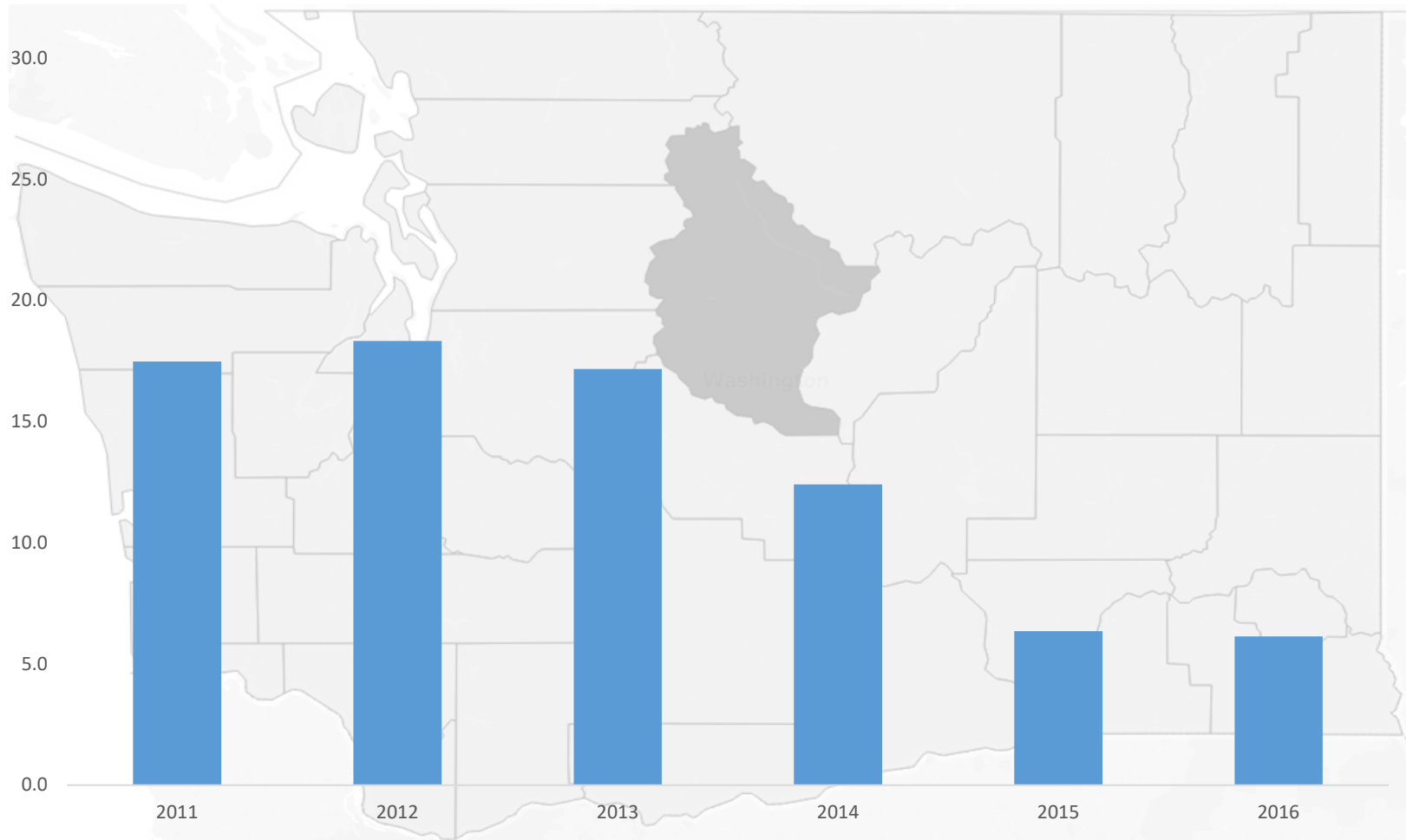
Chart 9. Percent Uninsured, Benton County, 2011-16

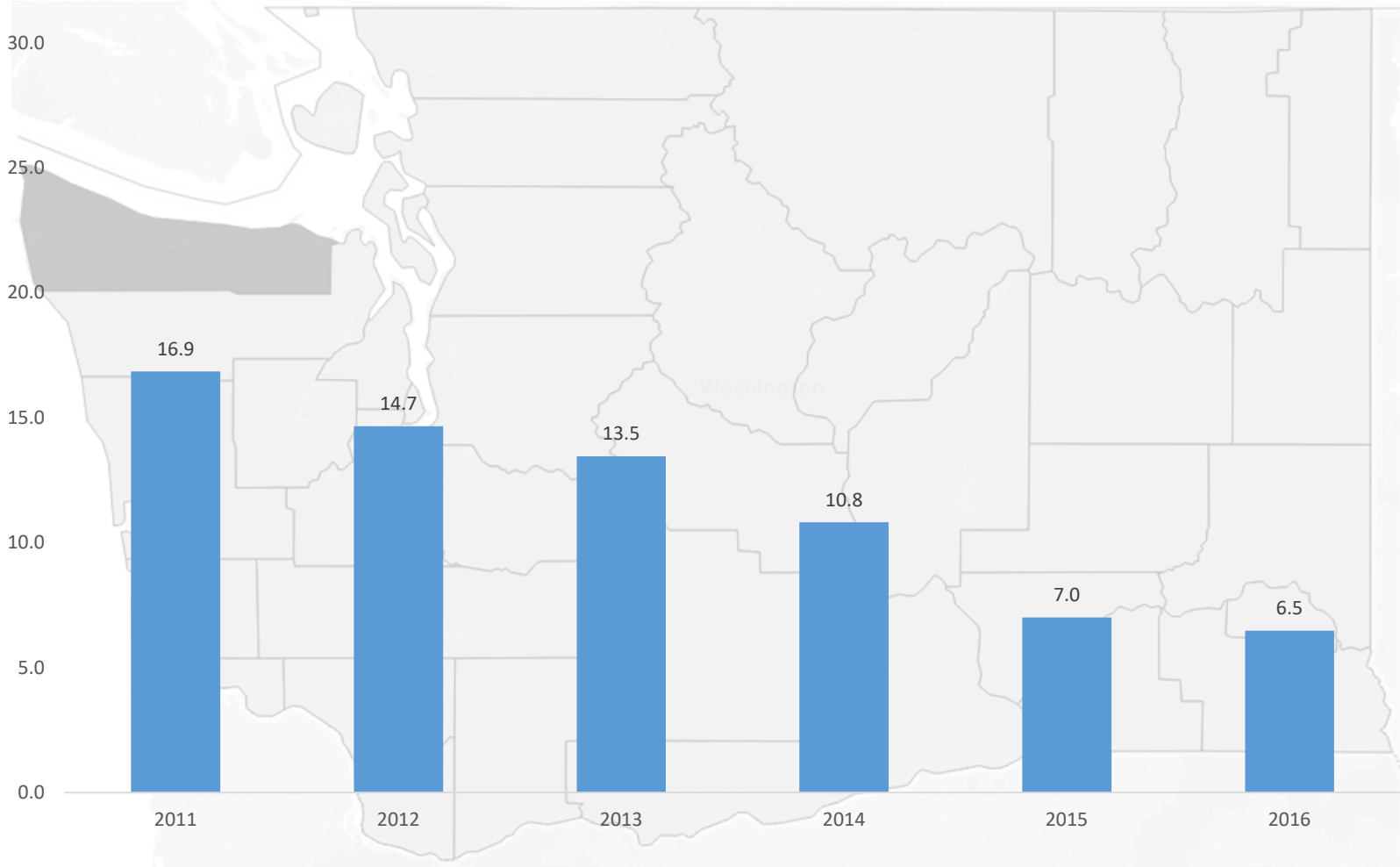
Chart 10. Percent Uninsured, Chelan County, 2011-16

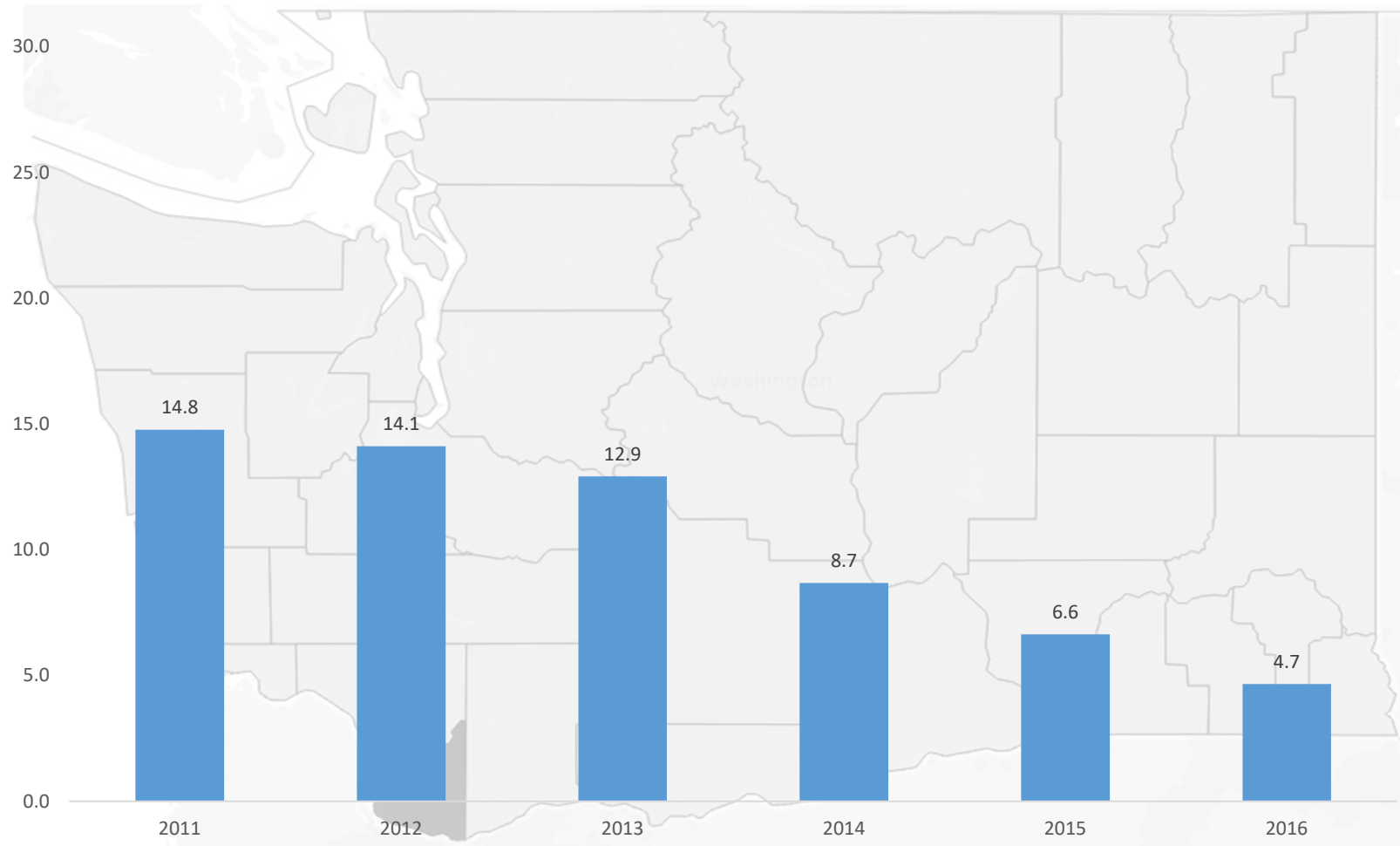
Chart 11. Percent Uninsured, Clallam County, 2011-16

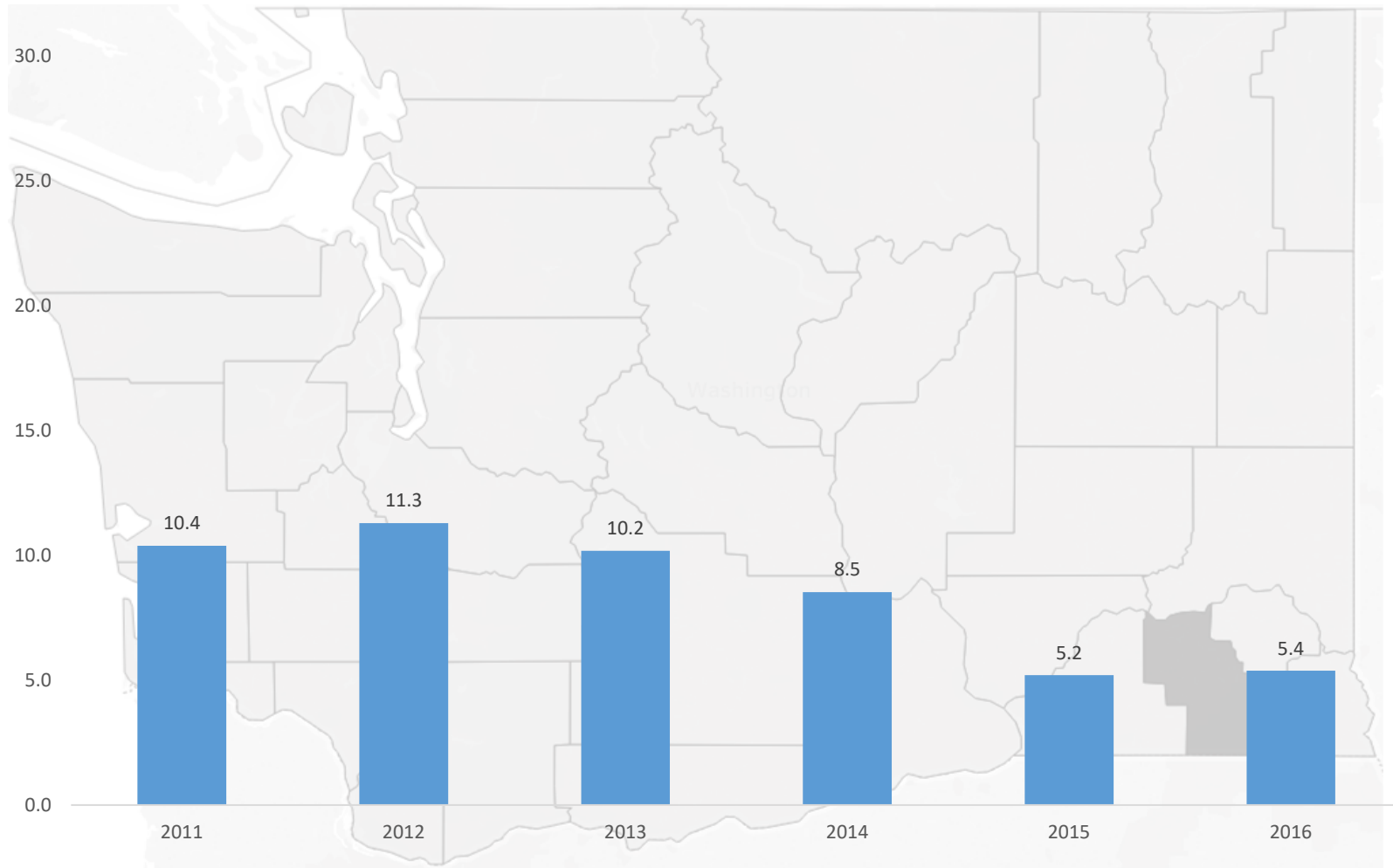
Chart 12. Percent Uninsured, Clark County, 2011-16

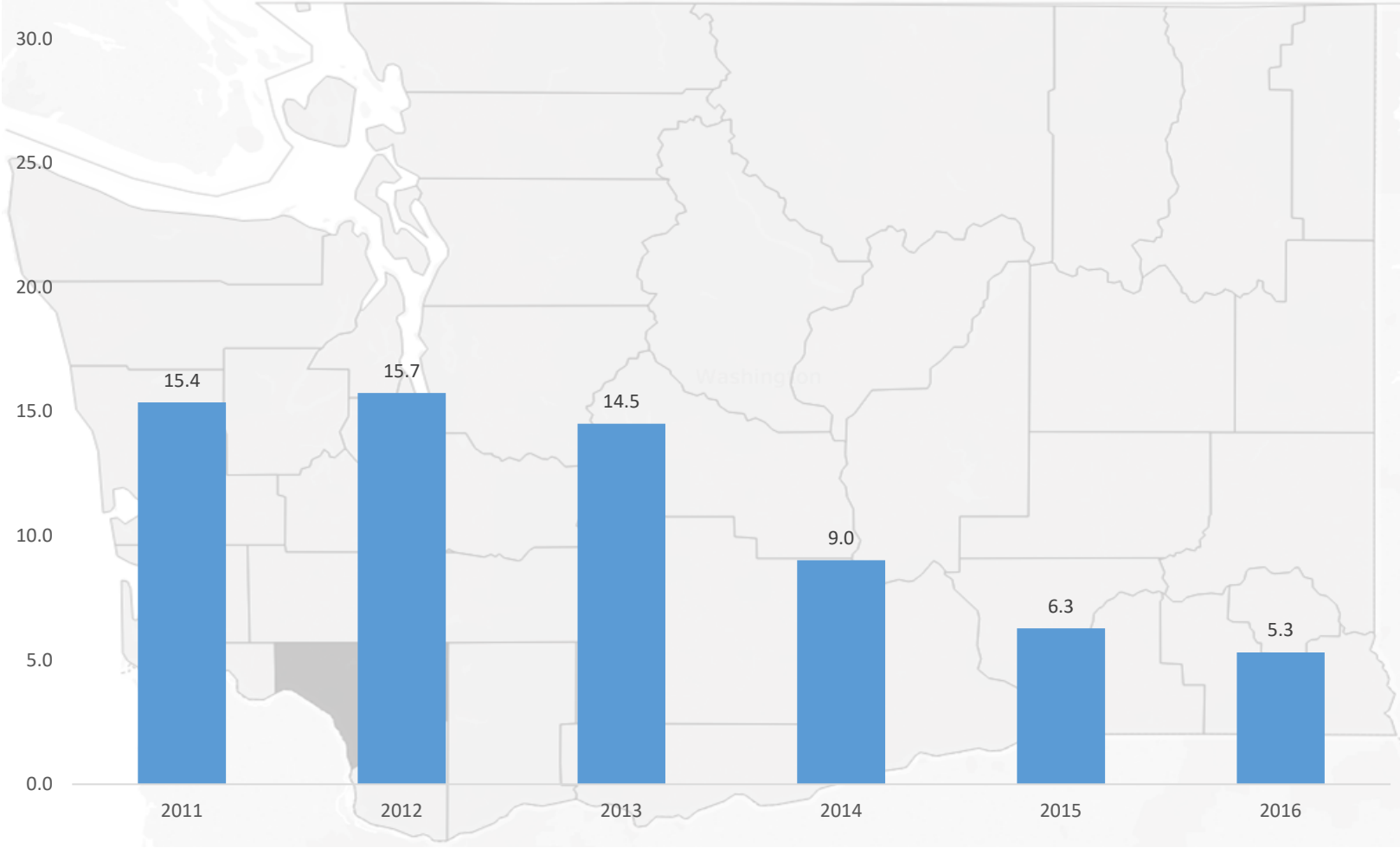
Chart 13. Percent Uninsured, Columbia County, 2011-16

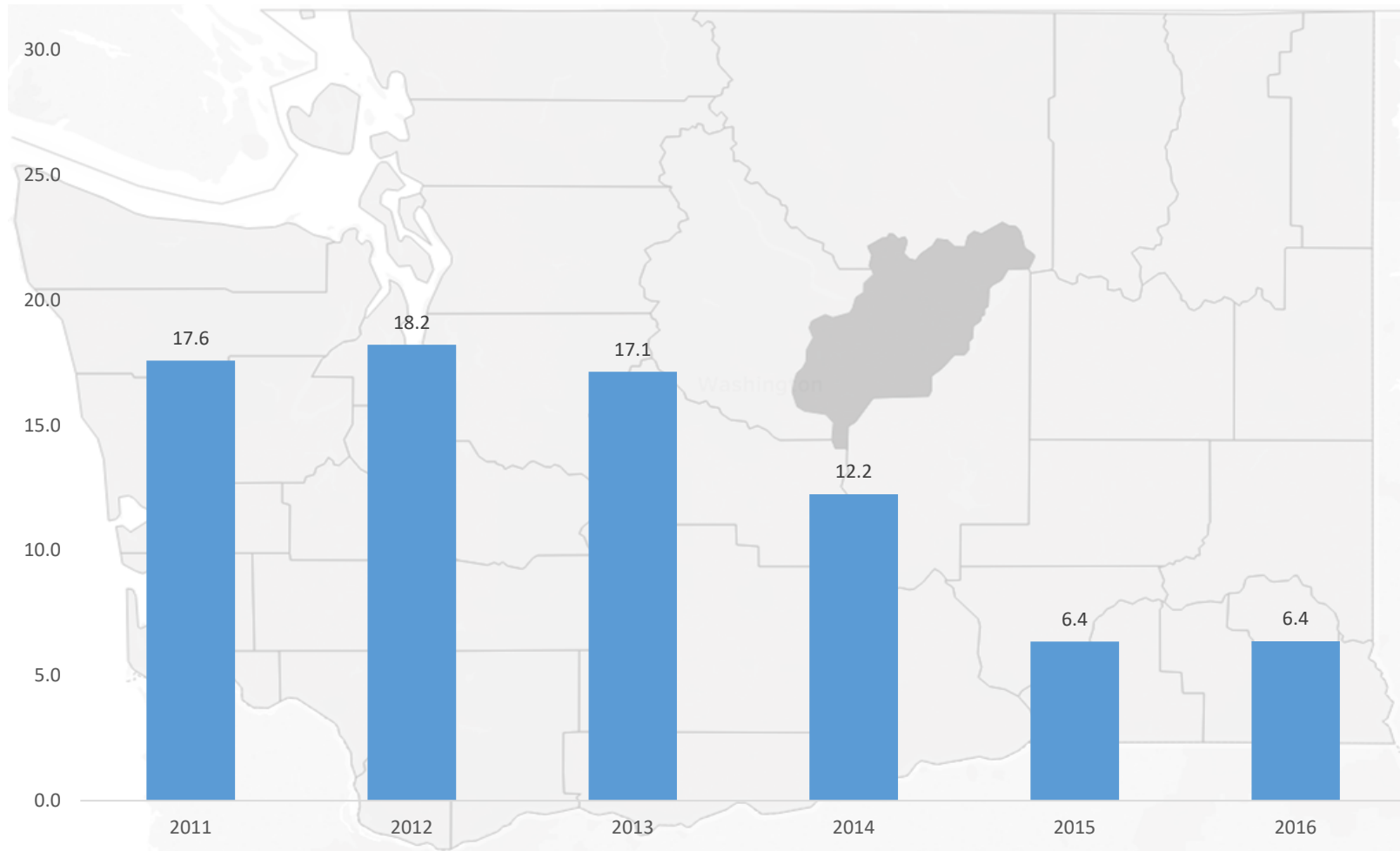
Chart 14. Percent Uninsured, Cowlitz County, 2011-16

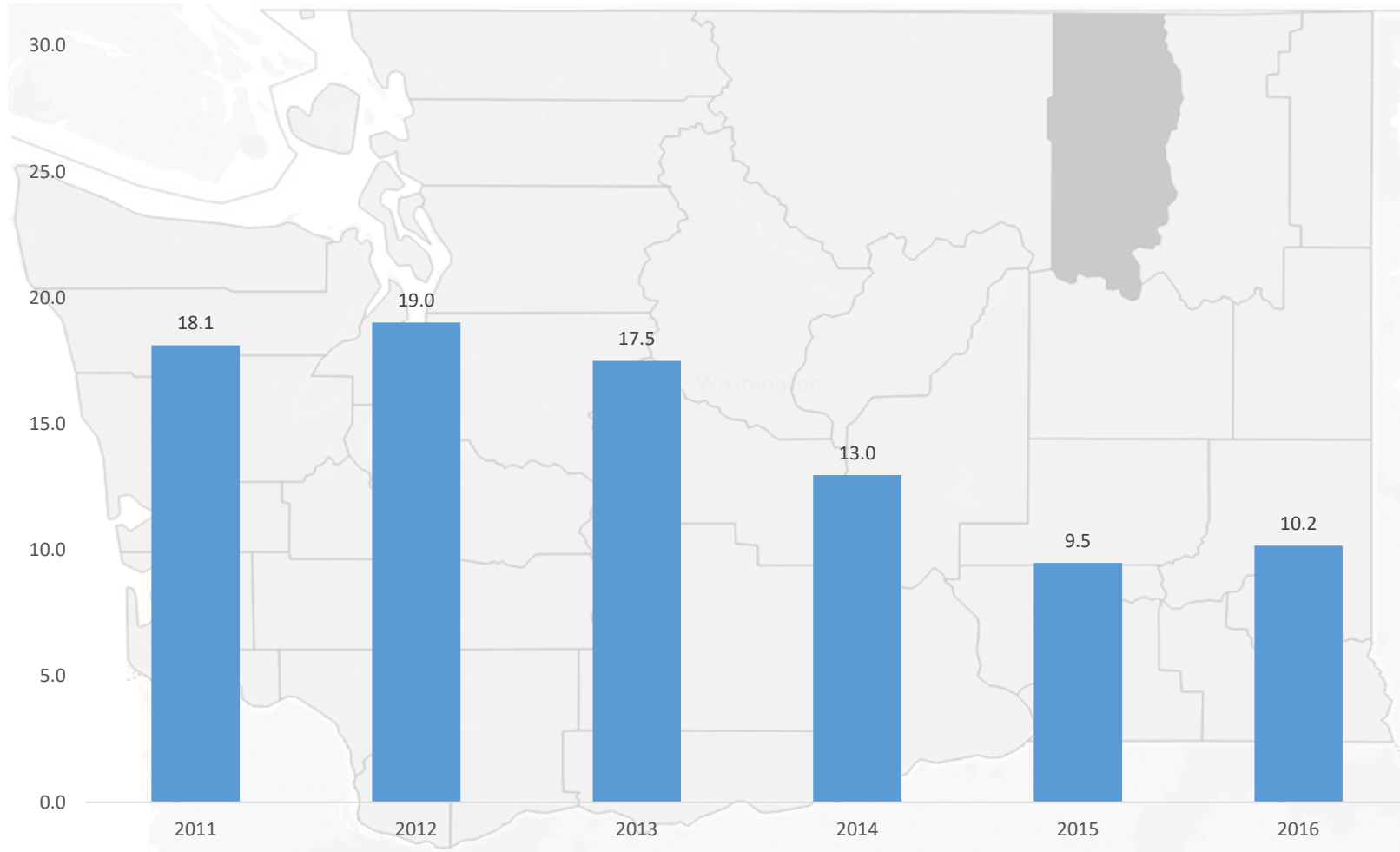
Chart 15. Percent Uninsured, Douglas County, 2011-16

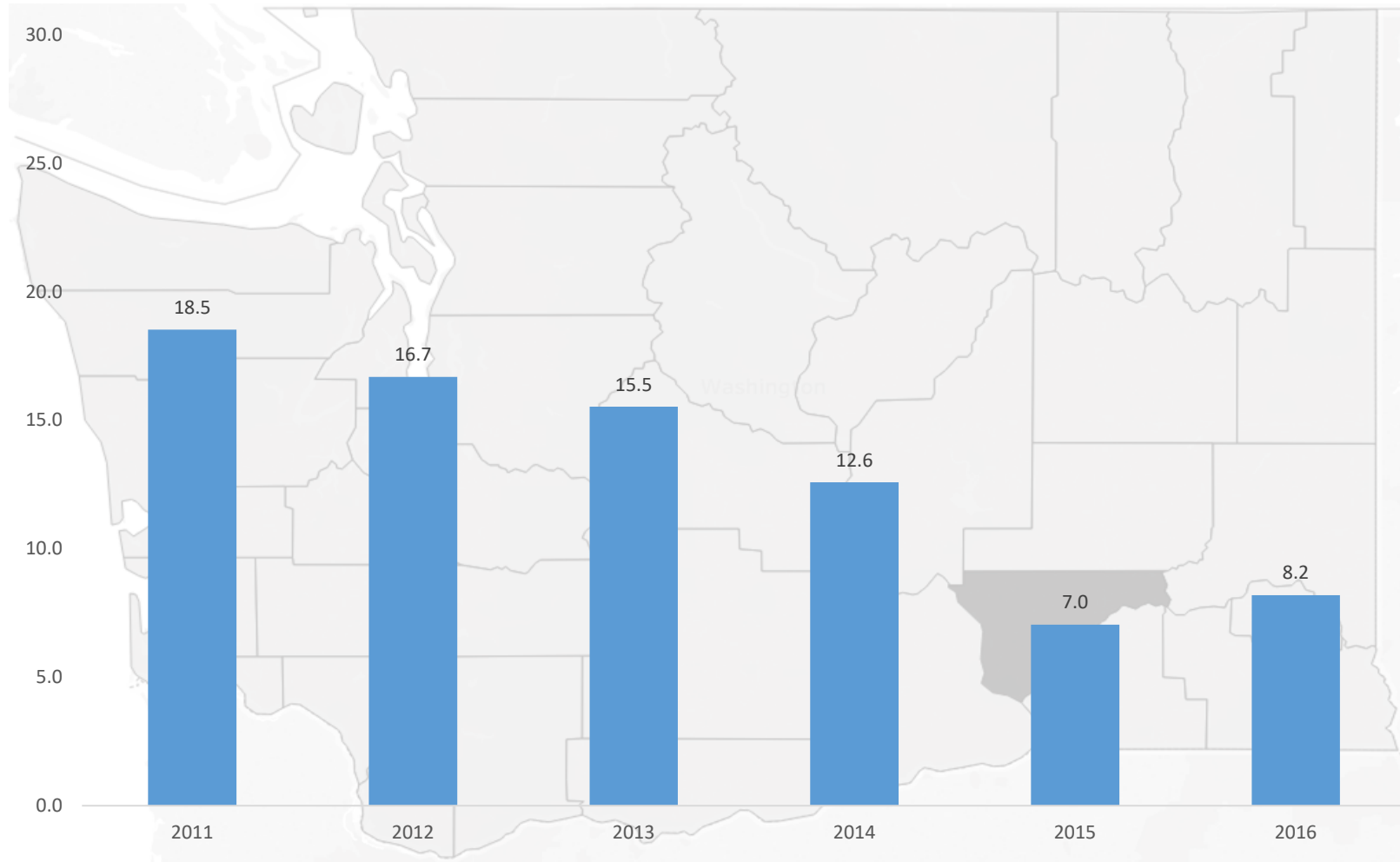
Chart 16. Percent Uninsured, Ferry County, 2011-16

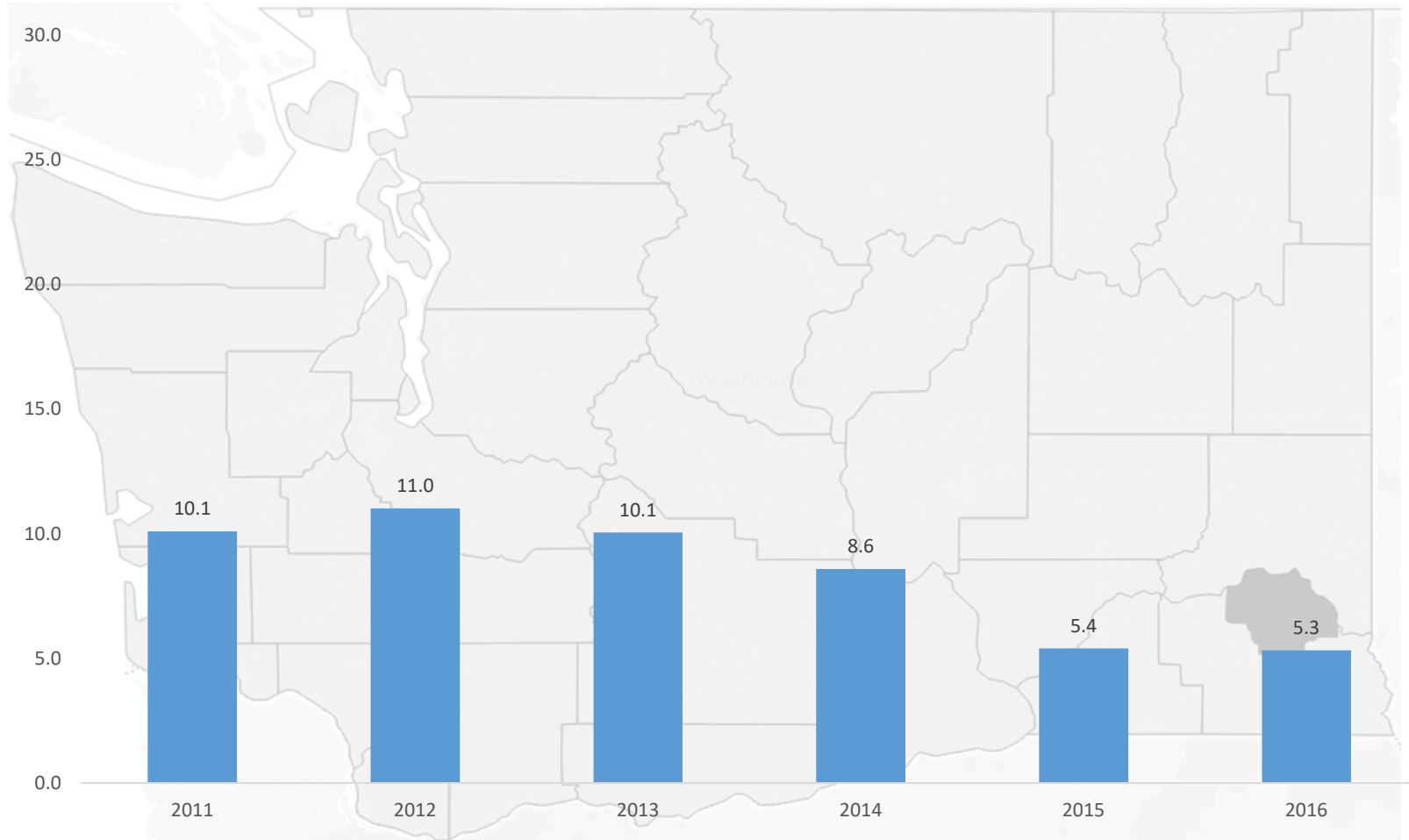
Chart 17. Percent Uninsured, Franklin County, 2011-16

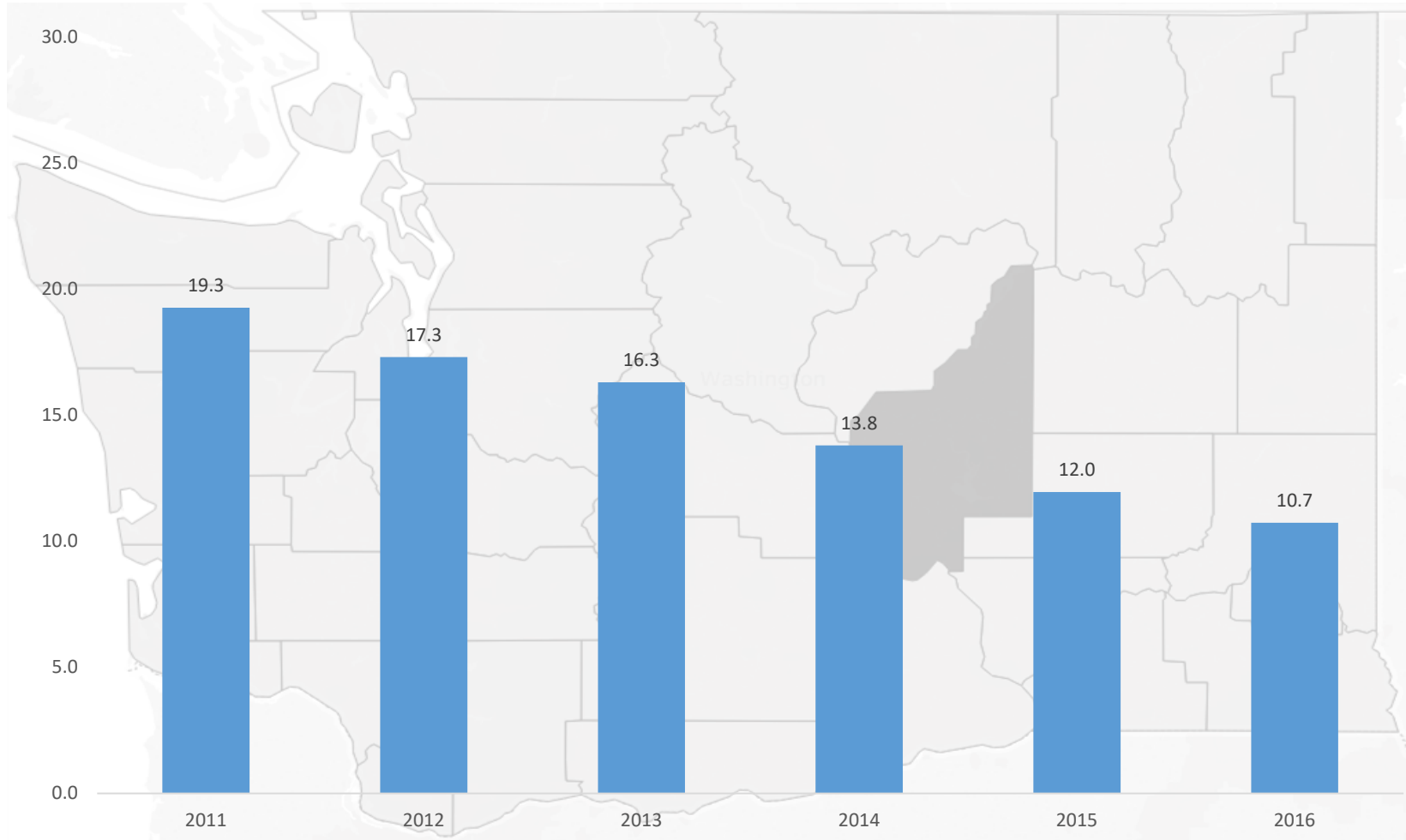
Chart 18. Percent Uninsured, Garfield County, 2011-16

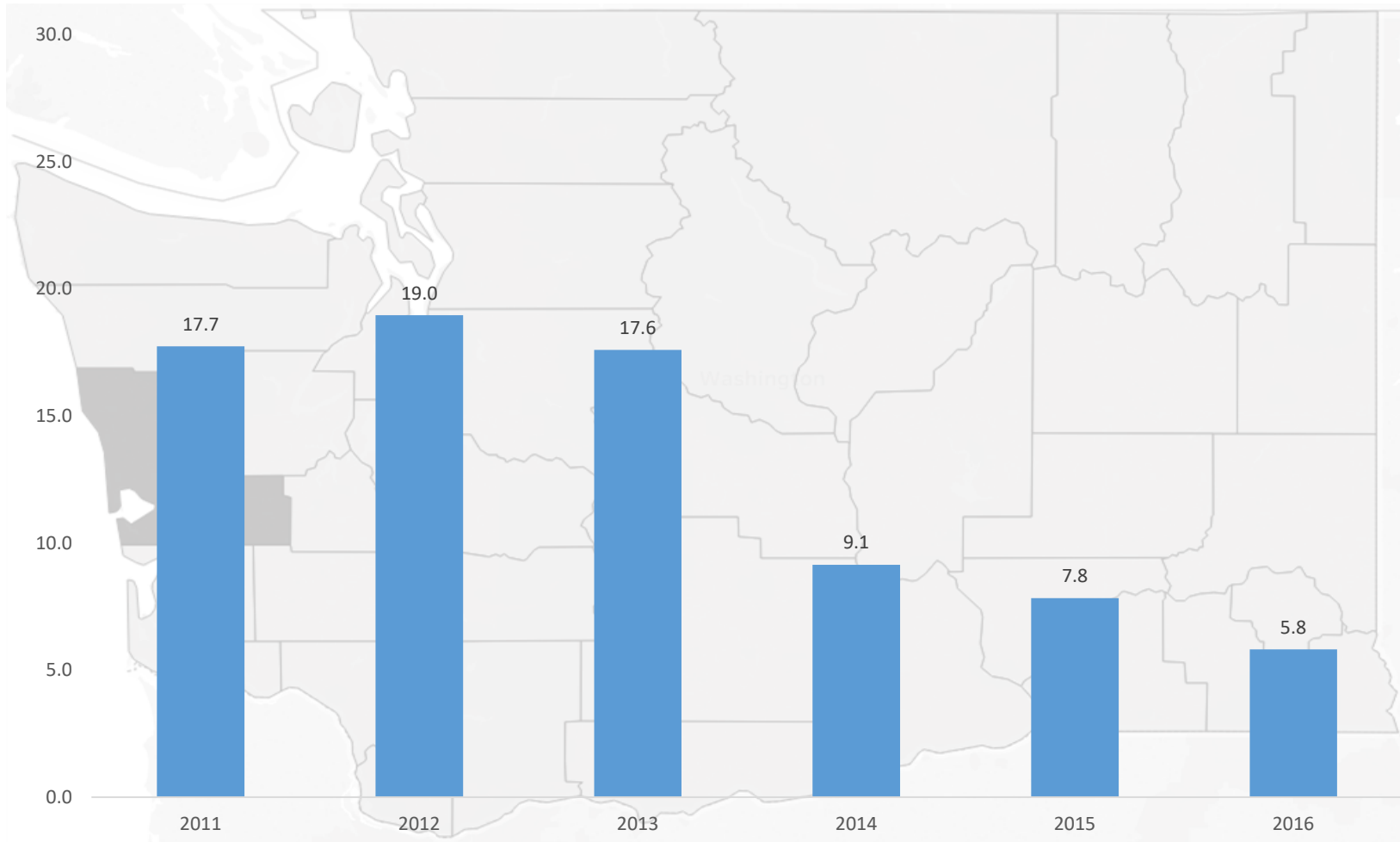
Chart 19. Percent Uninsured, Grant County, 2011-16

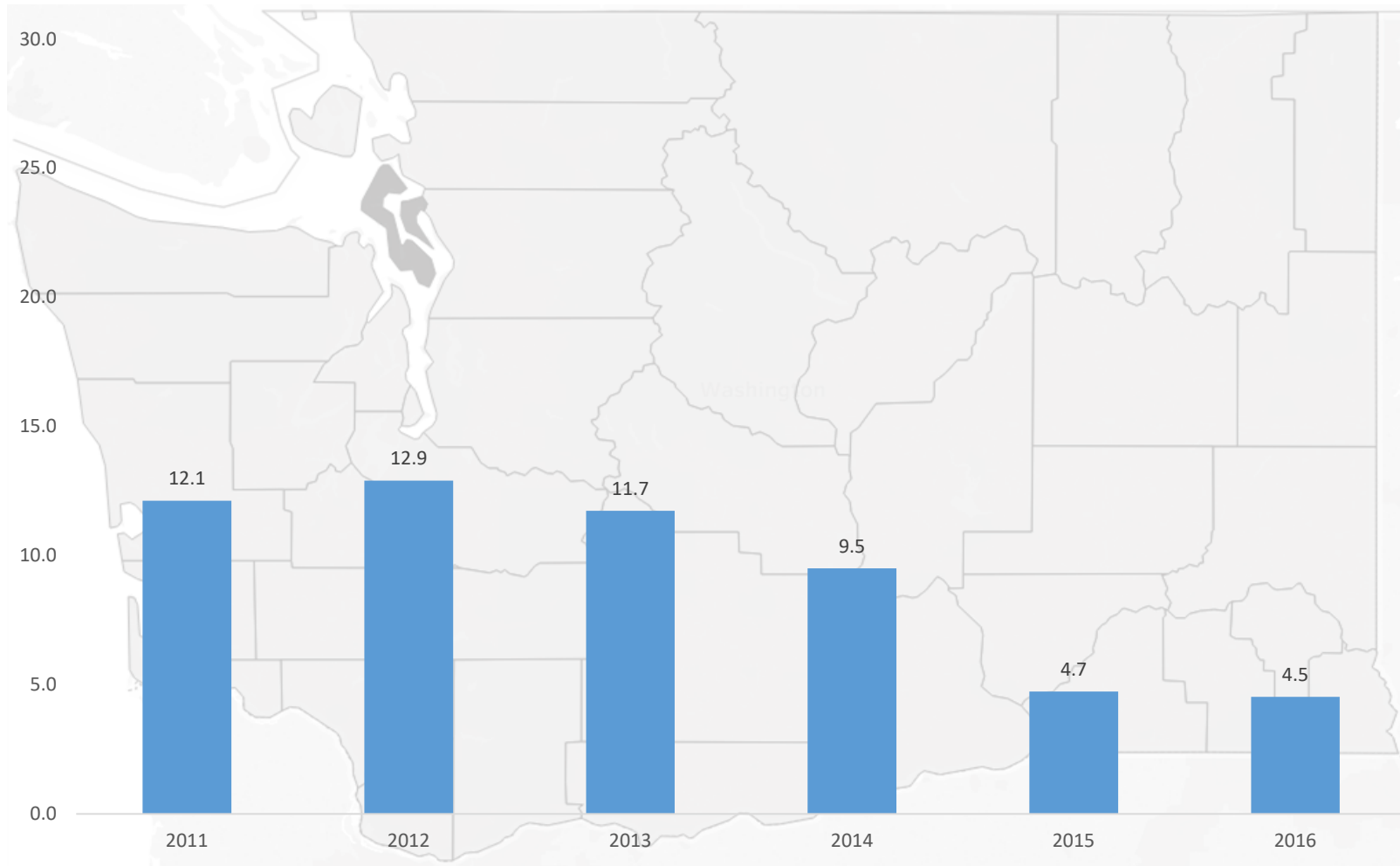
Chart 20. Percent Uninsured, Grays Harbor County, 2011-16

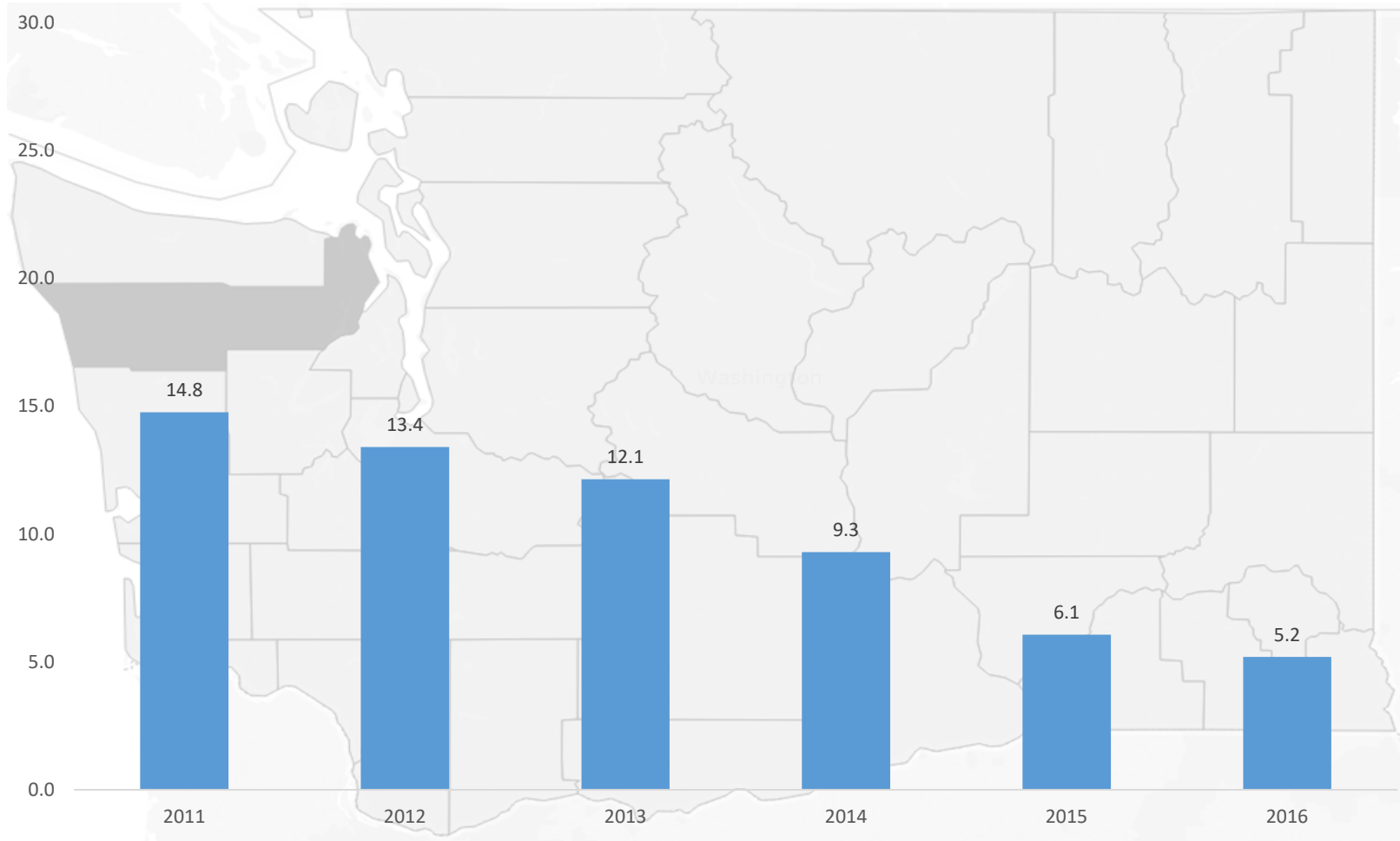
Chart 21. Percent Uninsured, Island County, 2011-16

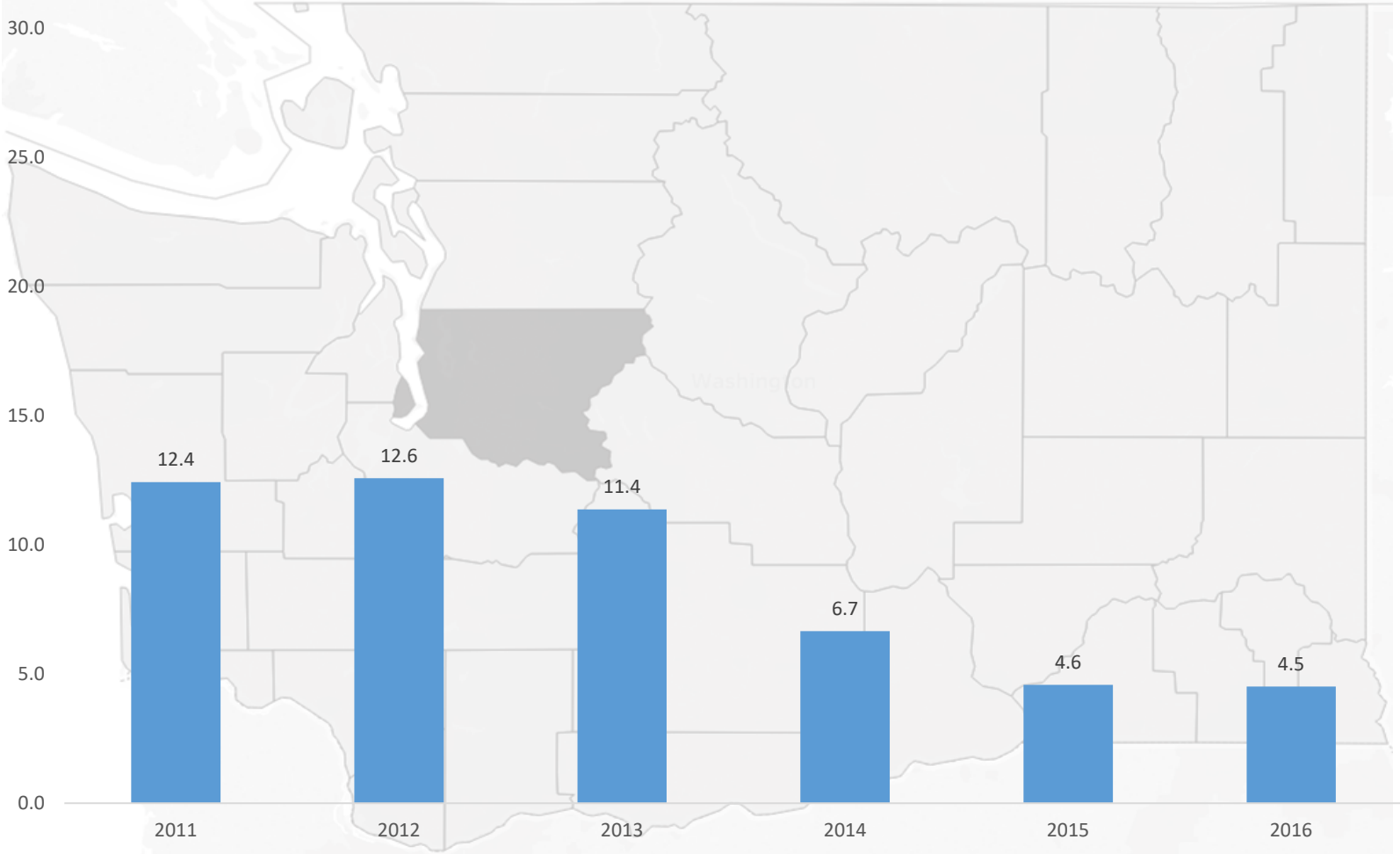
Chart 22. Percent Uninsured, Jefferson County, 2011-16

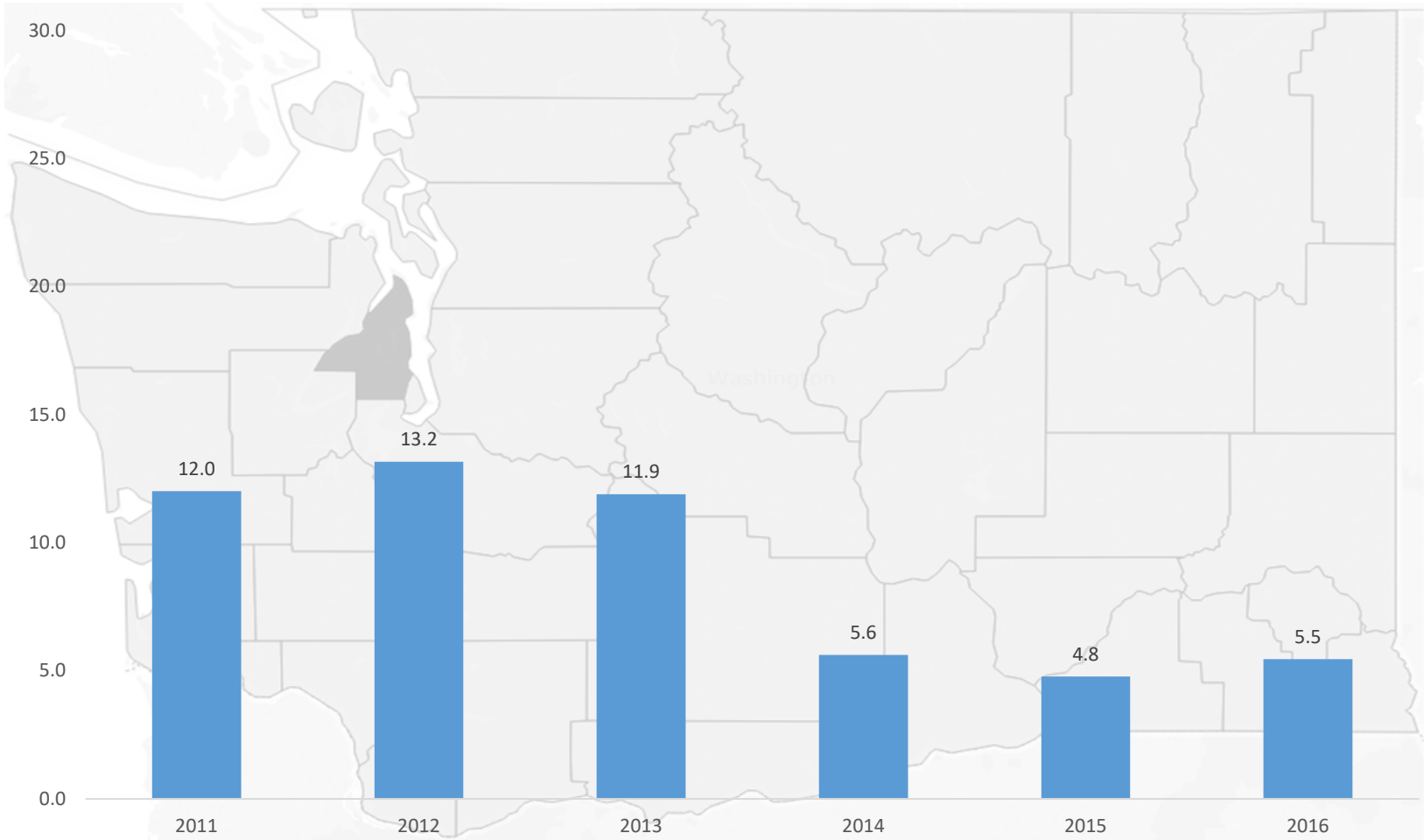
Chart 23. Percent Uninsured, King County, 2011-16

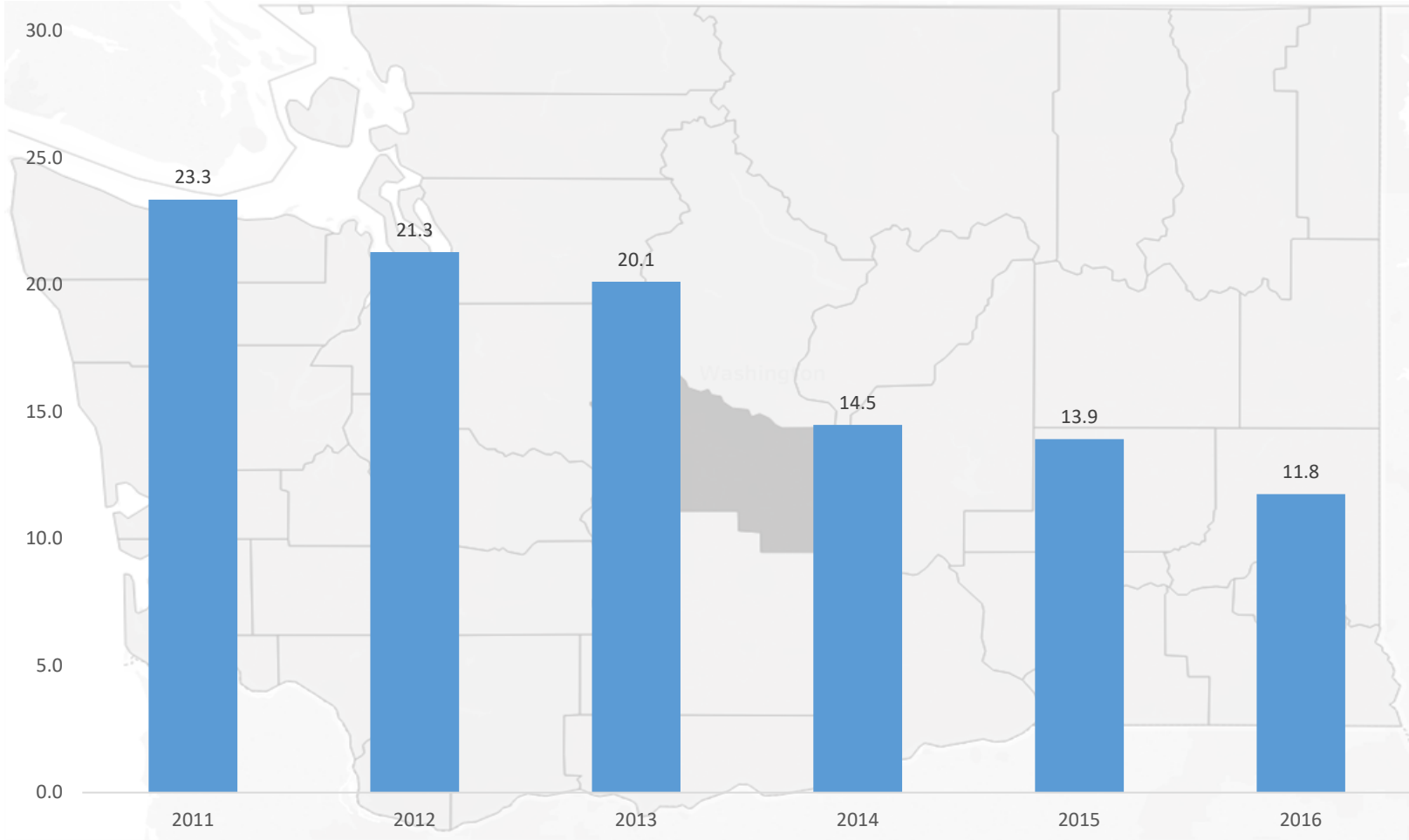
Chart 24. Percent Uninsured, Kitsap County, 2011-16

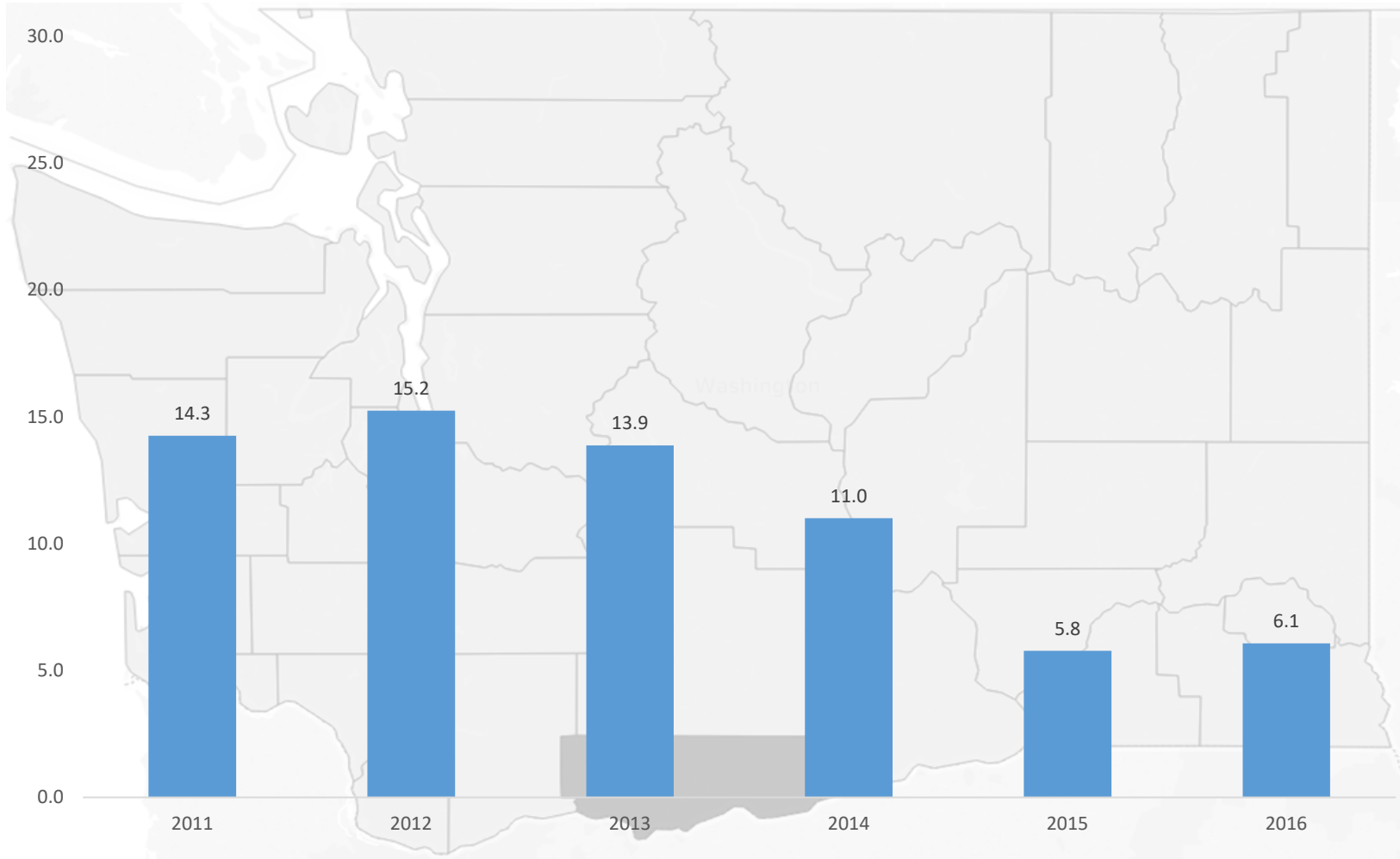
Chart 25. Percent Uninsured, Kittitas County, 2011-16

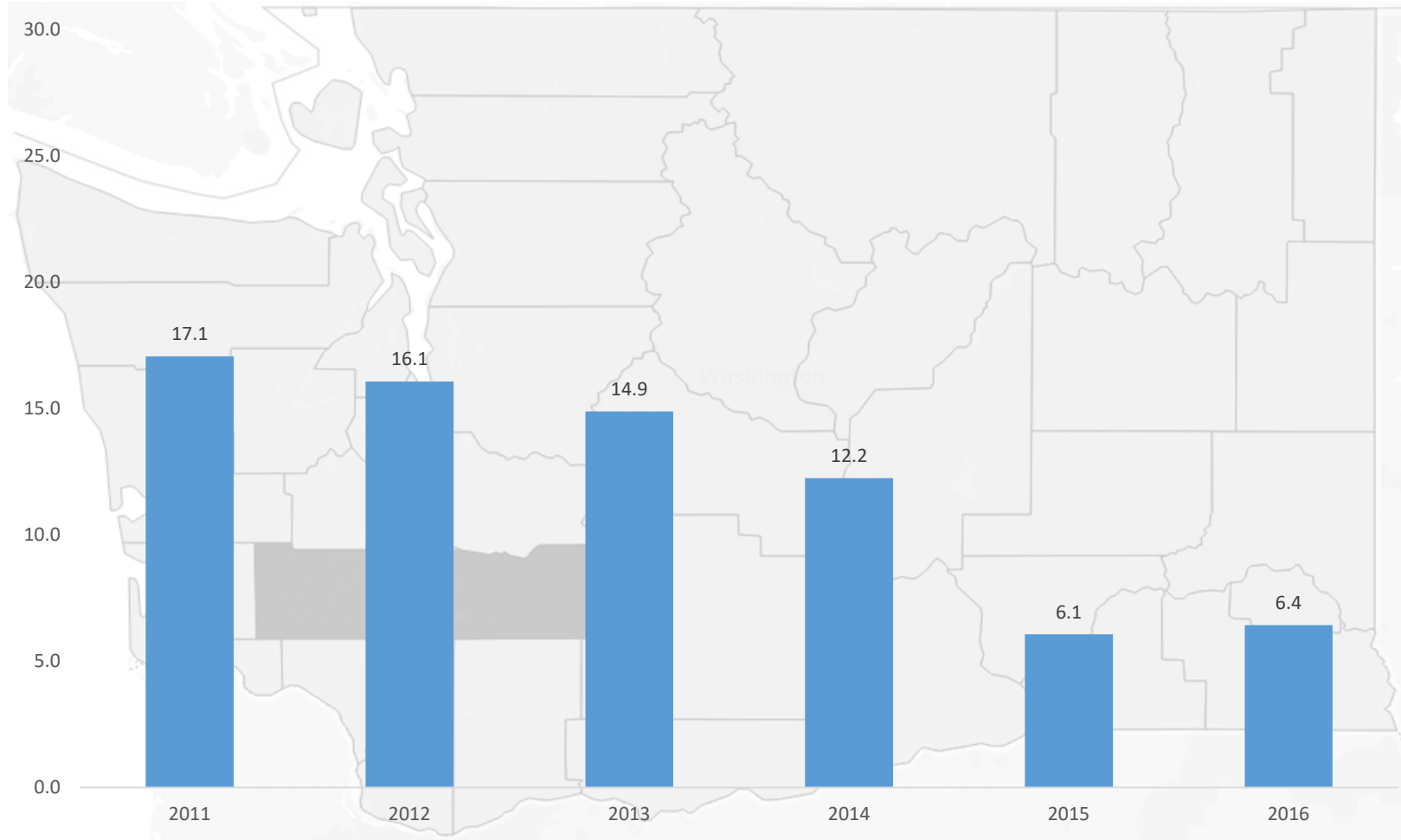
Chart 26. Percent Uninsured, Klickitat County, 2011-16

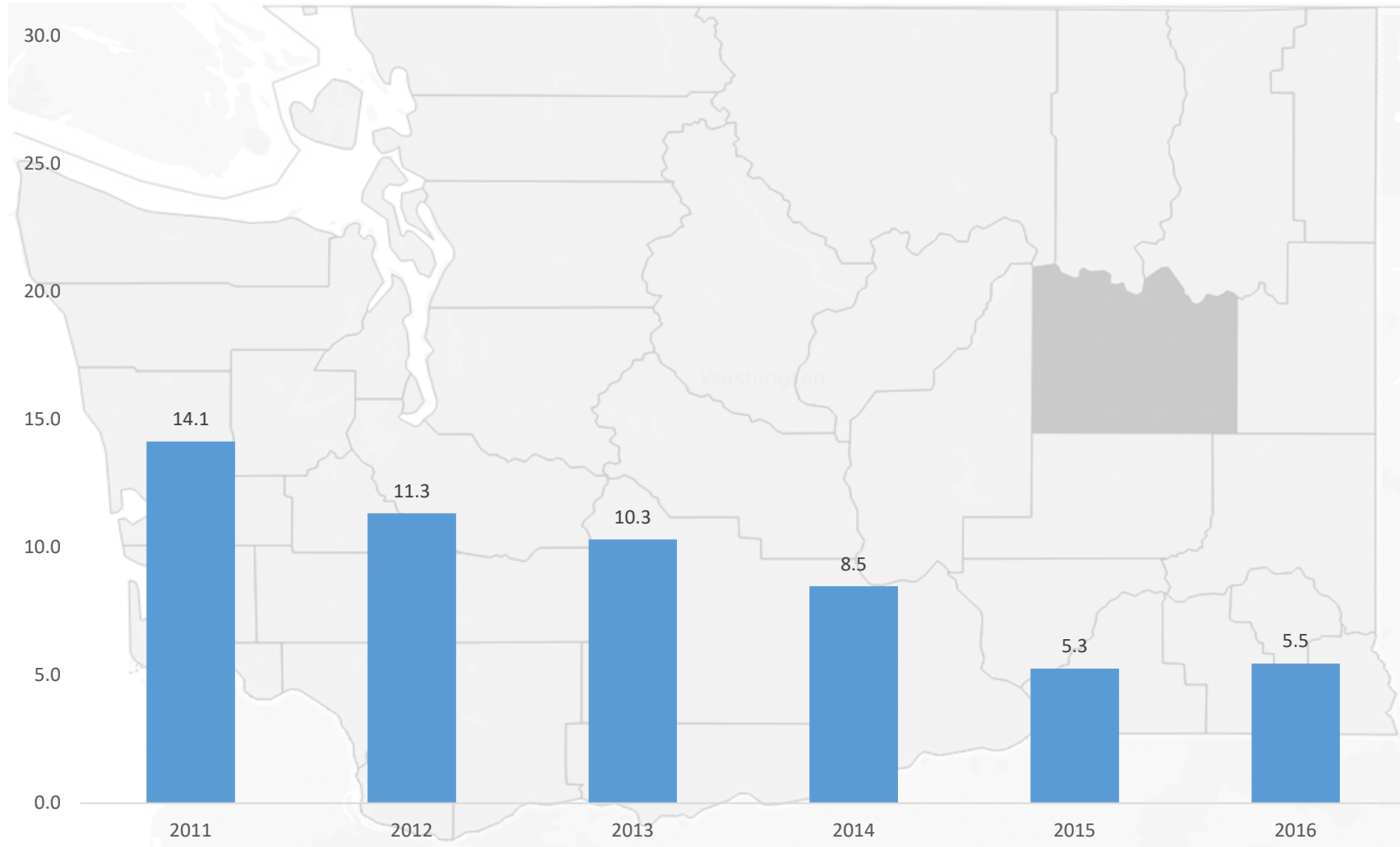
Chart 27. Percent Uninsured, Lewis County, 2011-16

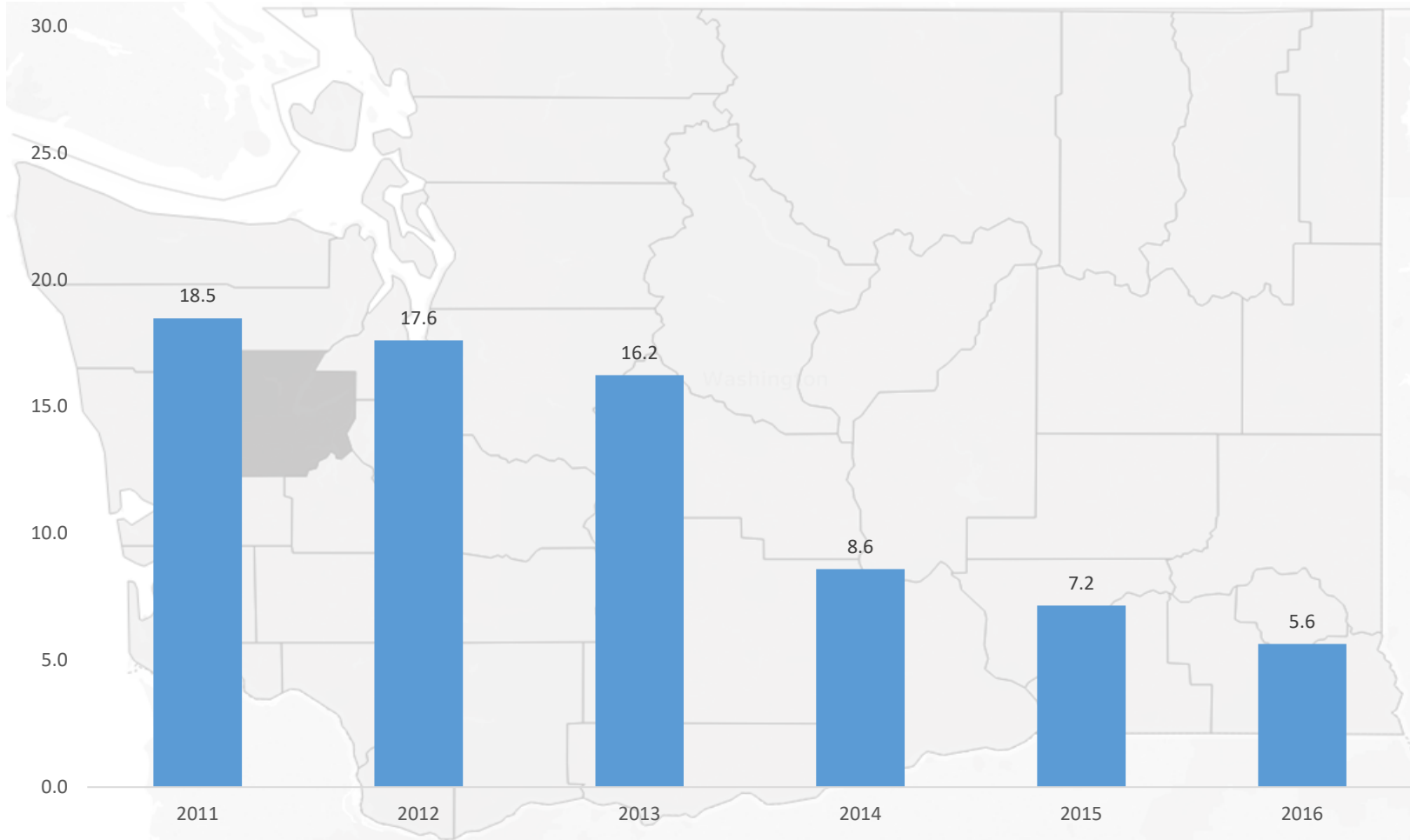
Chart 28. Percent Uninsured, Lincoln County, 2011-16

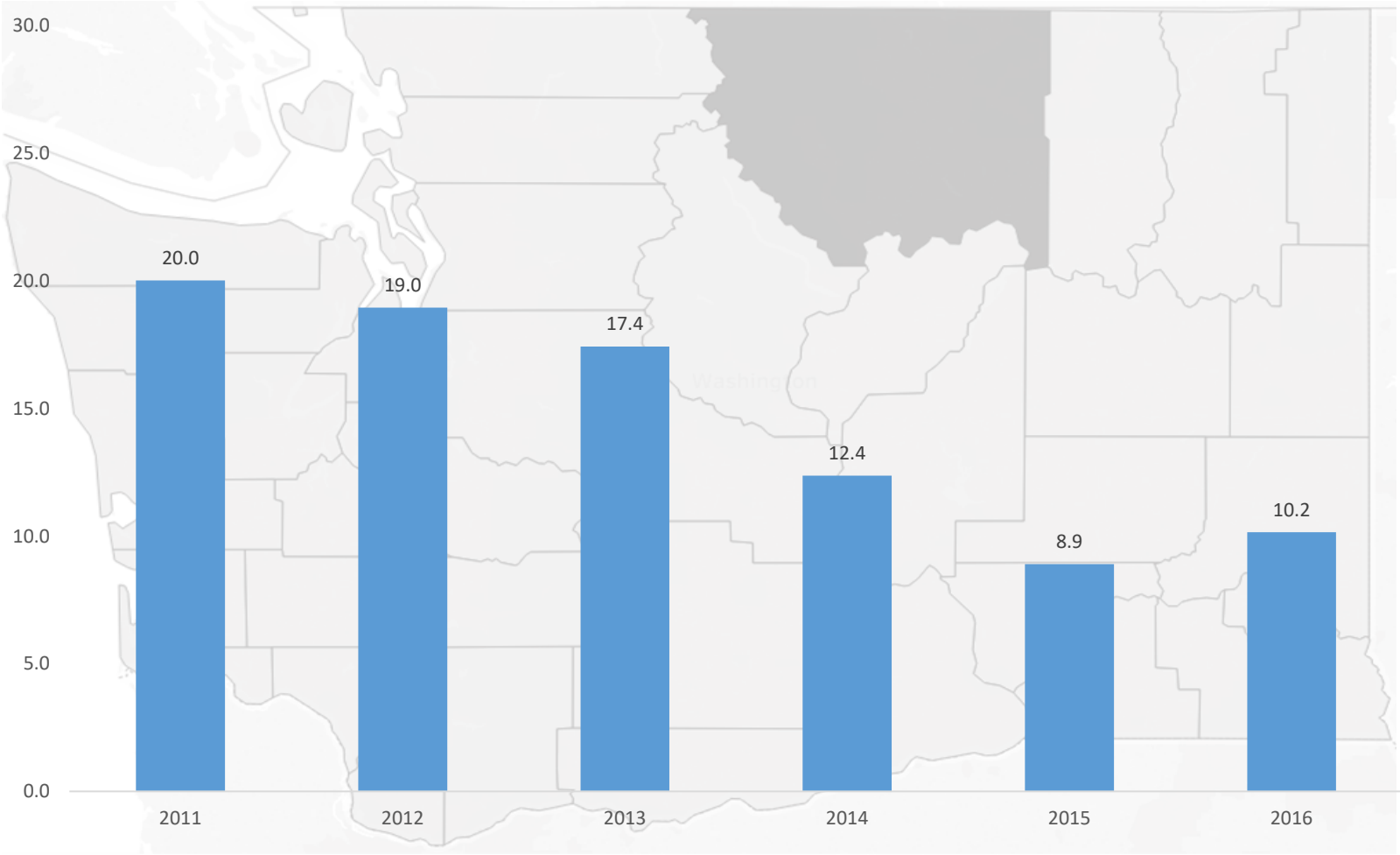
Chart 29. Percent Uninsured, Mason County, 2011-16

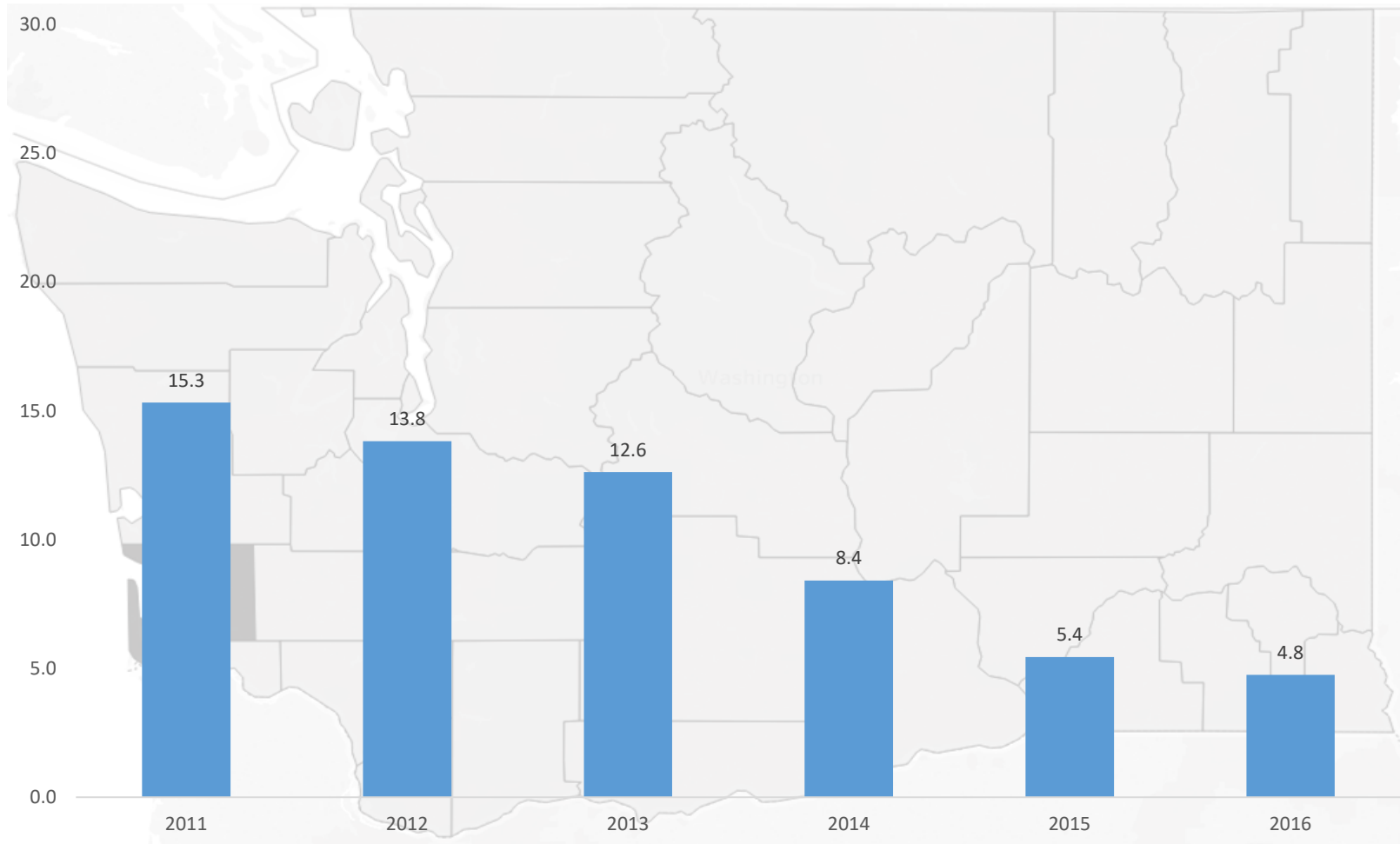
Chart 30. Percent Uninsured, Okanogan County, 2011-16

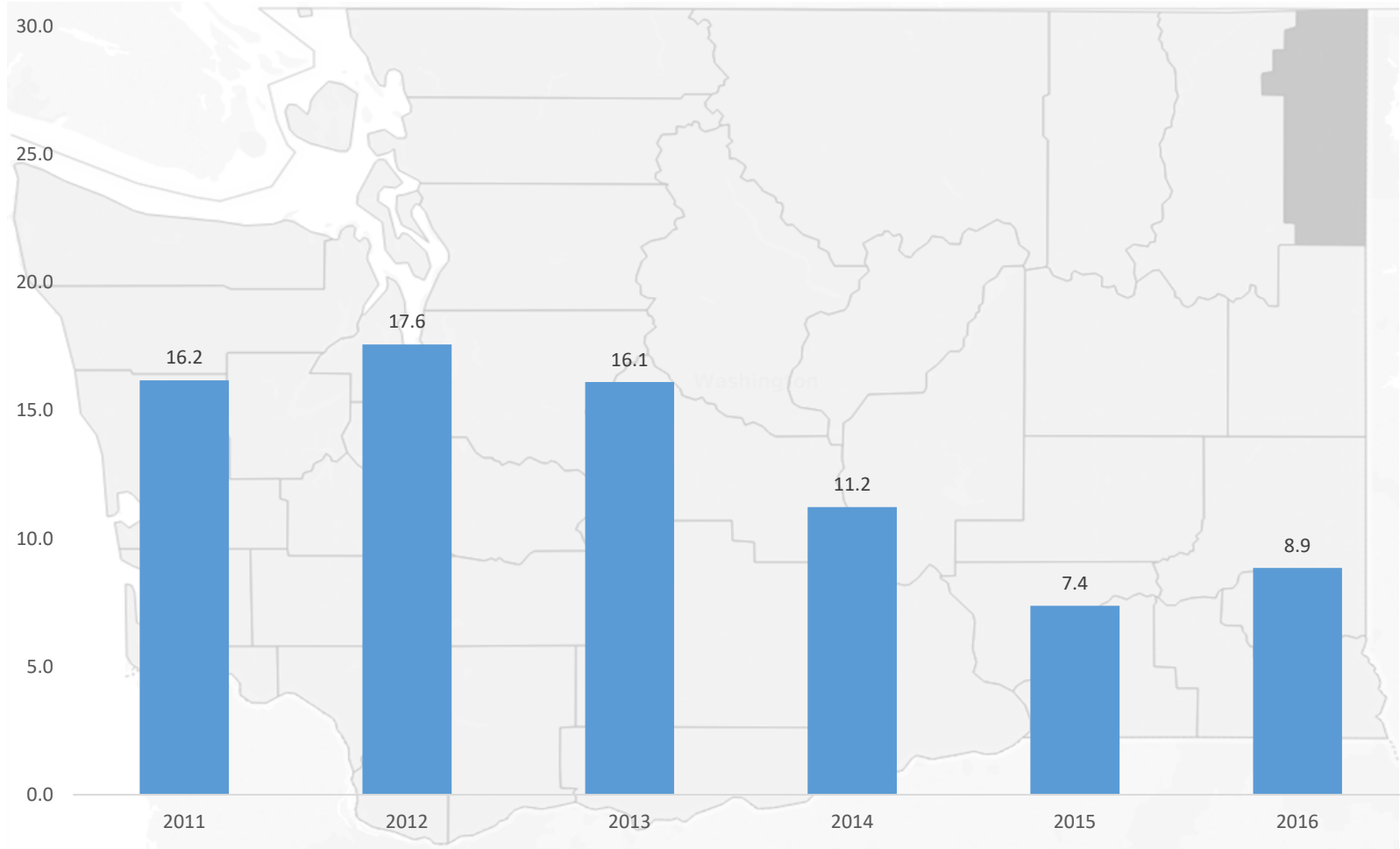
Chart 31. Percent Uninsured, Pacific County, 2011-16

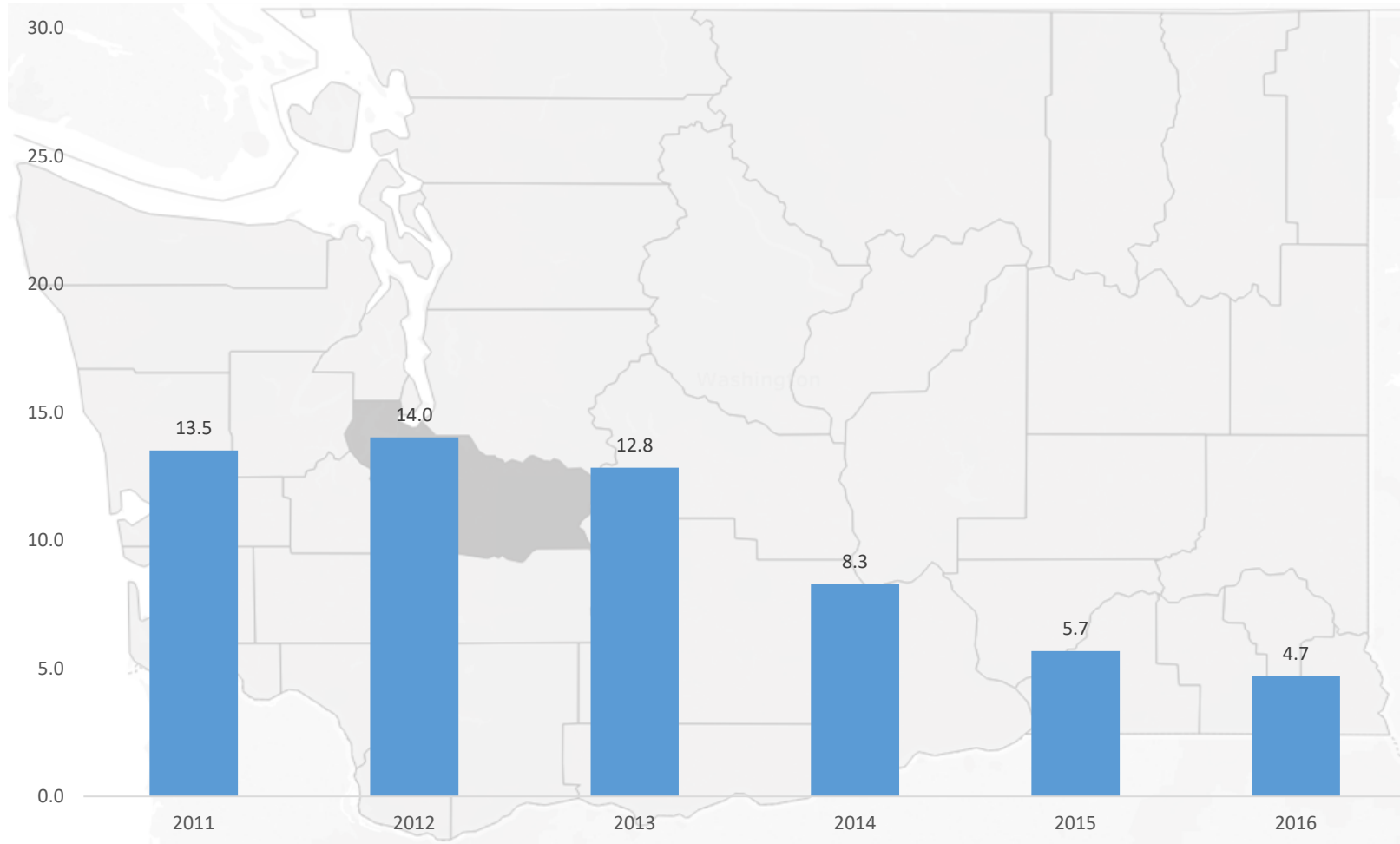
Chart 32. Percent Uninsured, Pend Oreille County, 2011-16

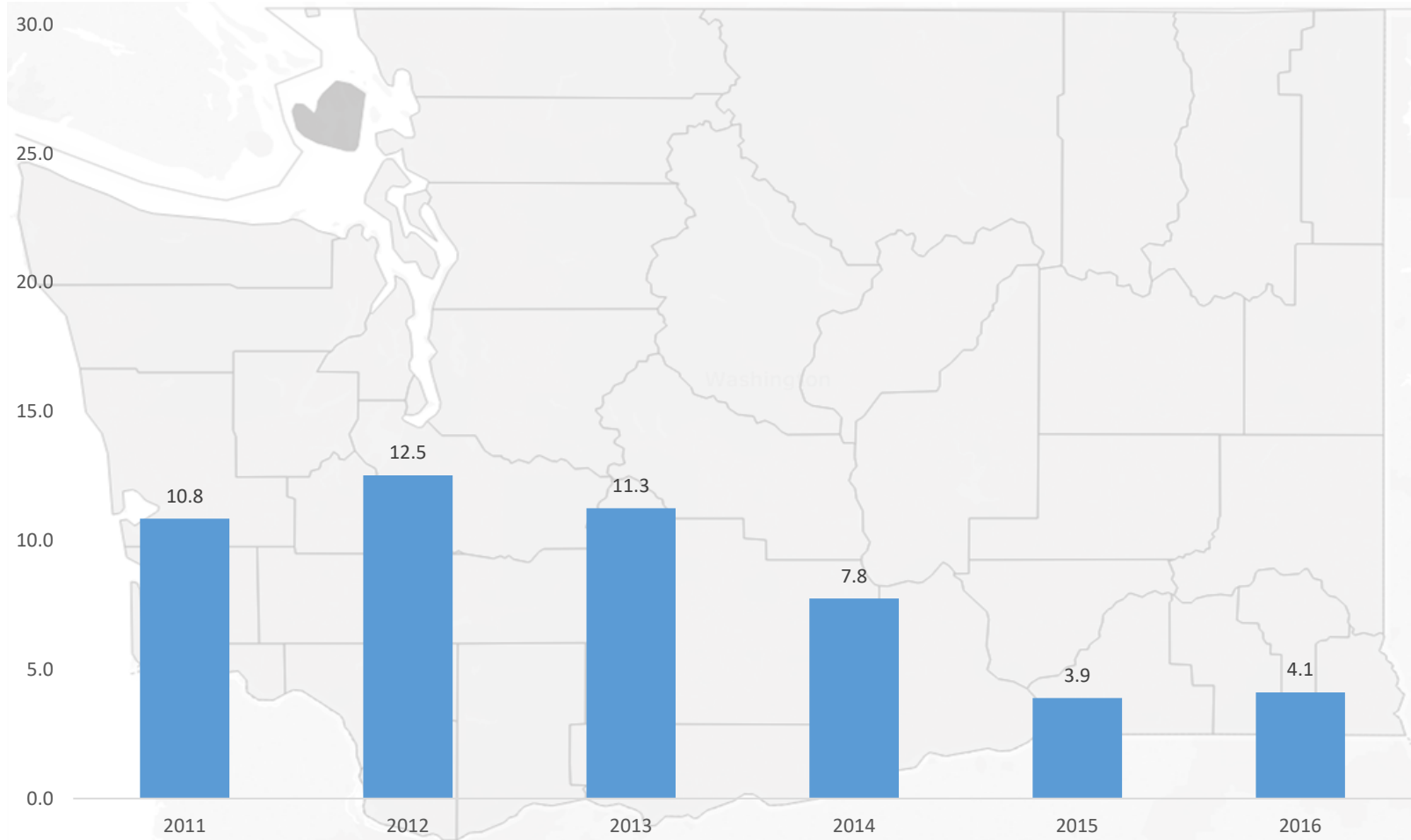
Chart 33. Percent Uninsured, Pierce County, 2011-16

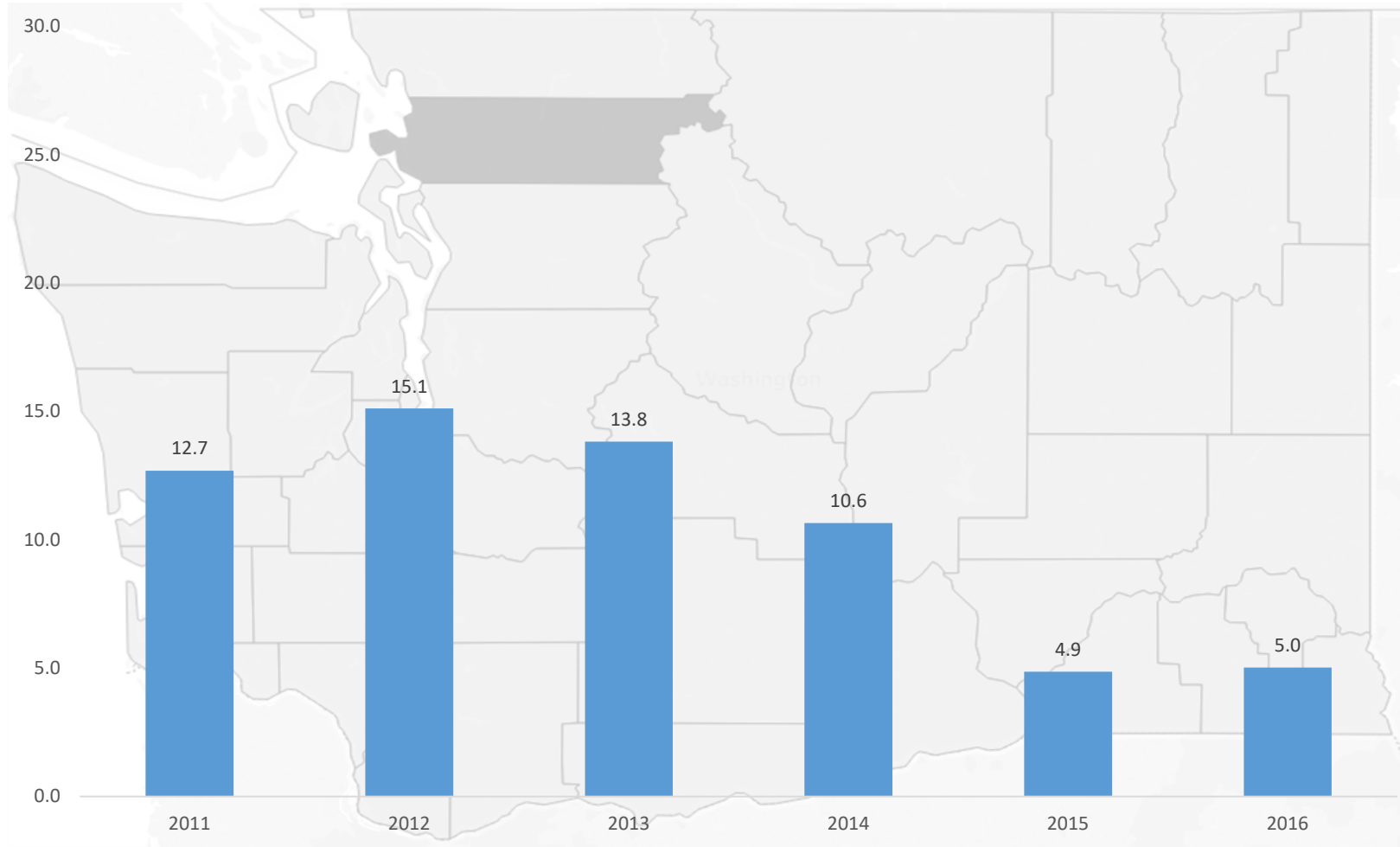
Chart 34. Percent Uninsured, San Juan County, 2011-16

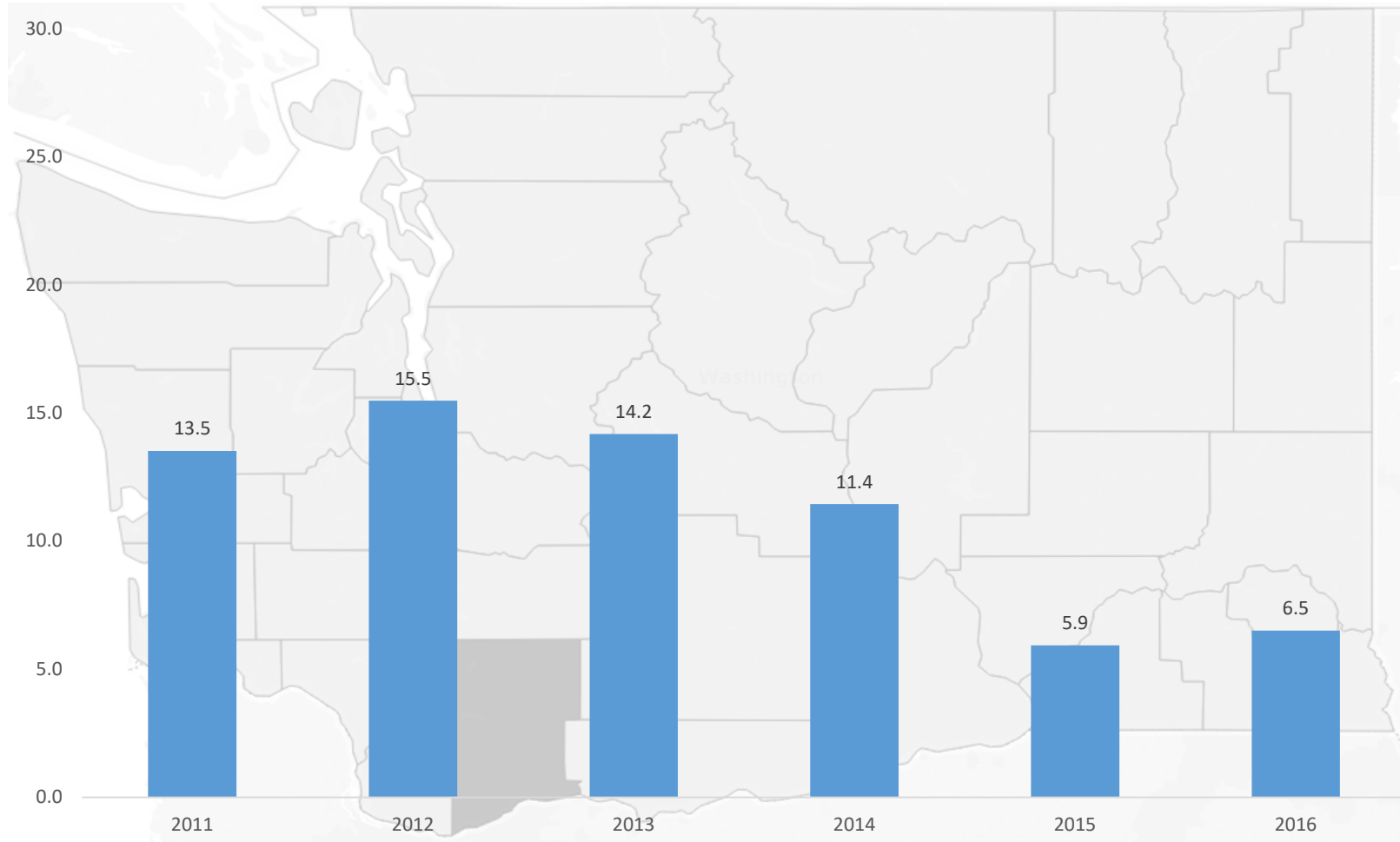
Chart 35. Percent Uninsured, Skagit County, 2011-16

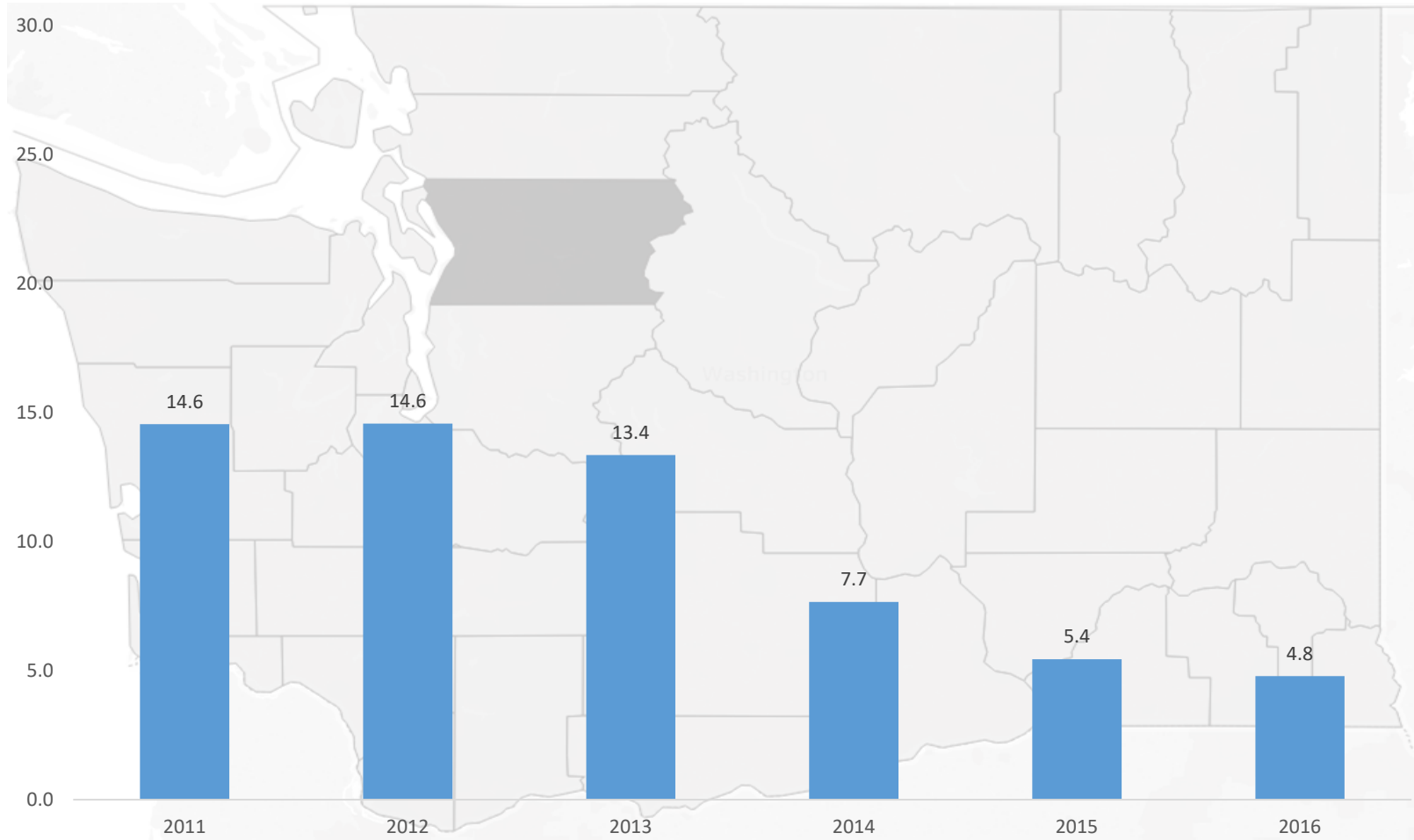
Chart 36. Percent Uninsured, Skamania County, 2011-16

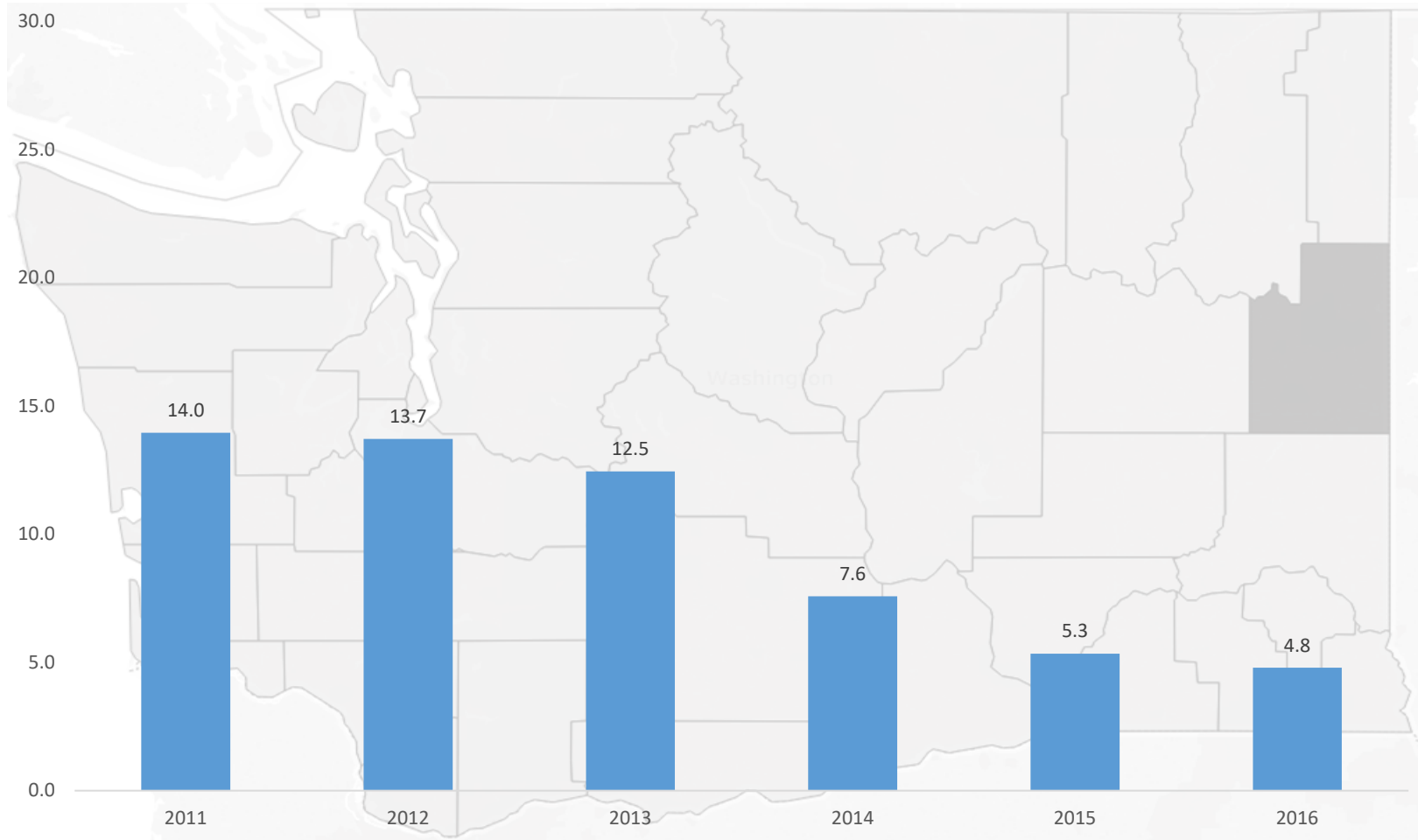
Chart 37. Percent Uninsured, Snohomish County, 2011-16

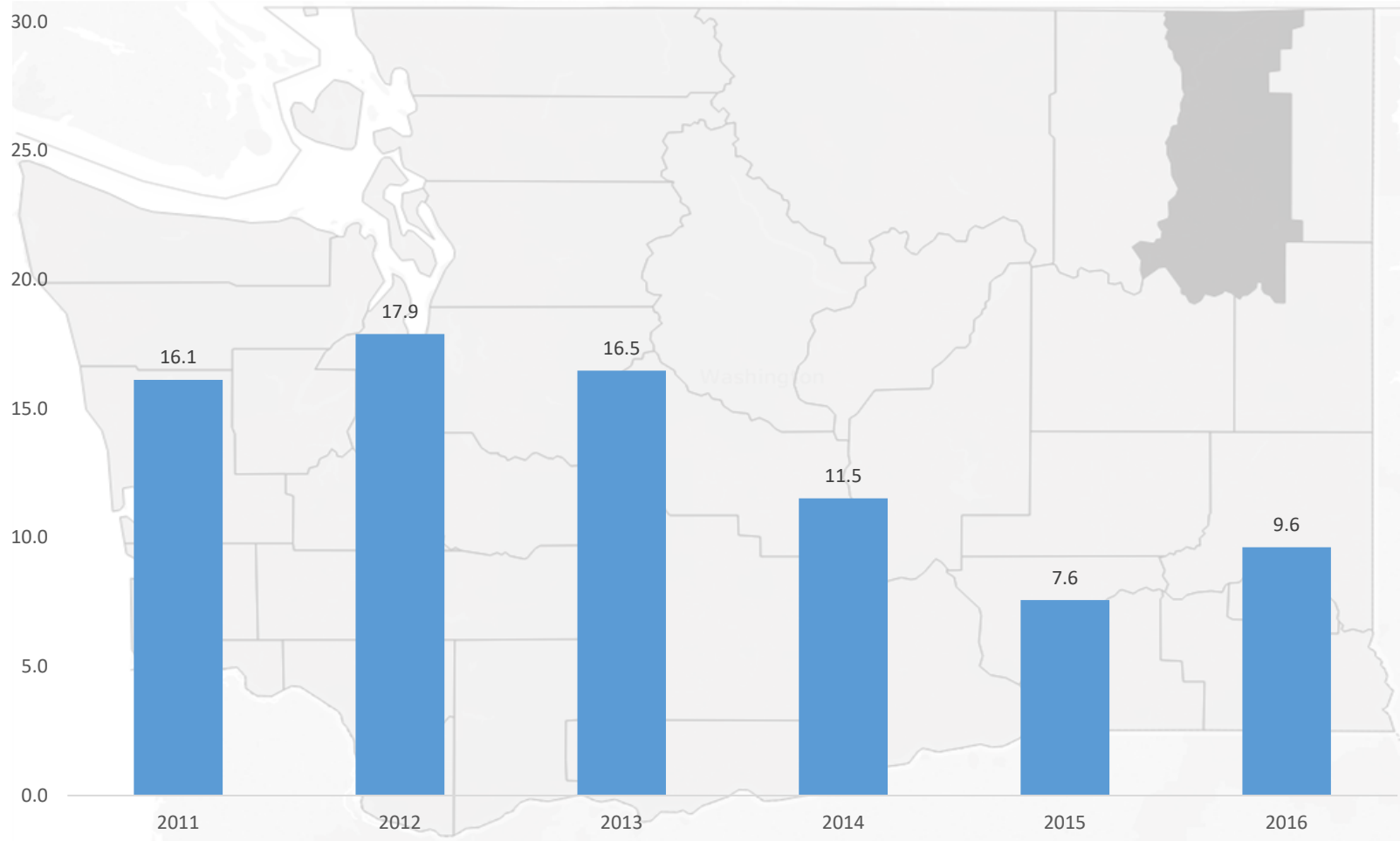
Chart 38. Percent Uninsured, Spokane County, 2011-16

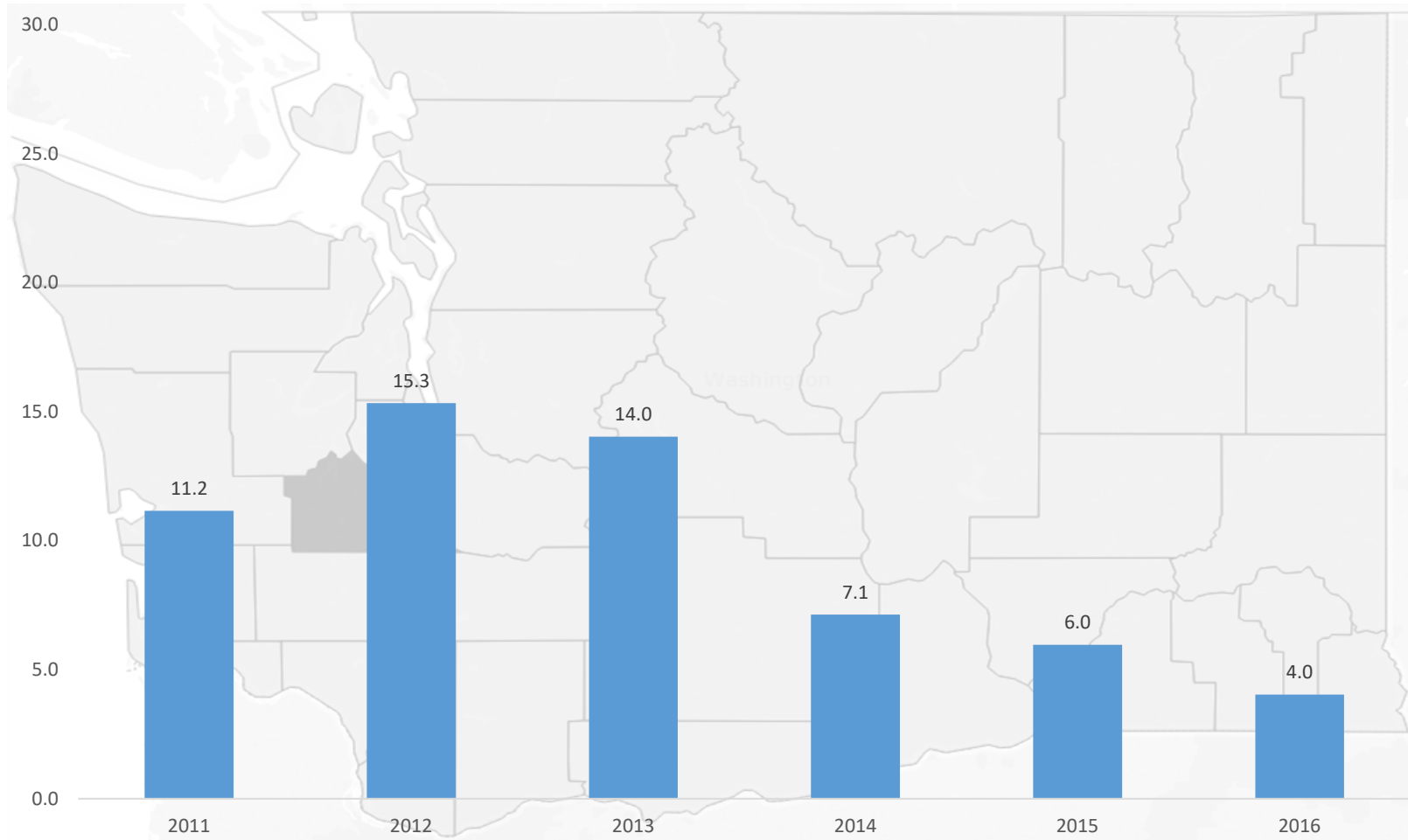
Chart 39. Percent Uninsured, Stevens County, 2011-16

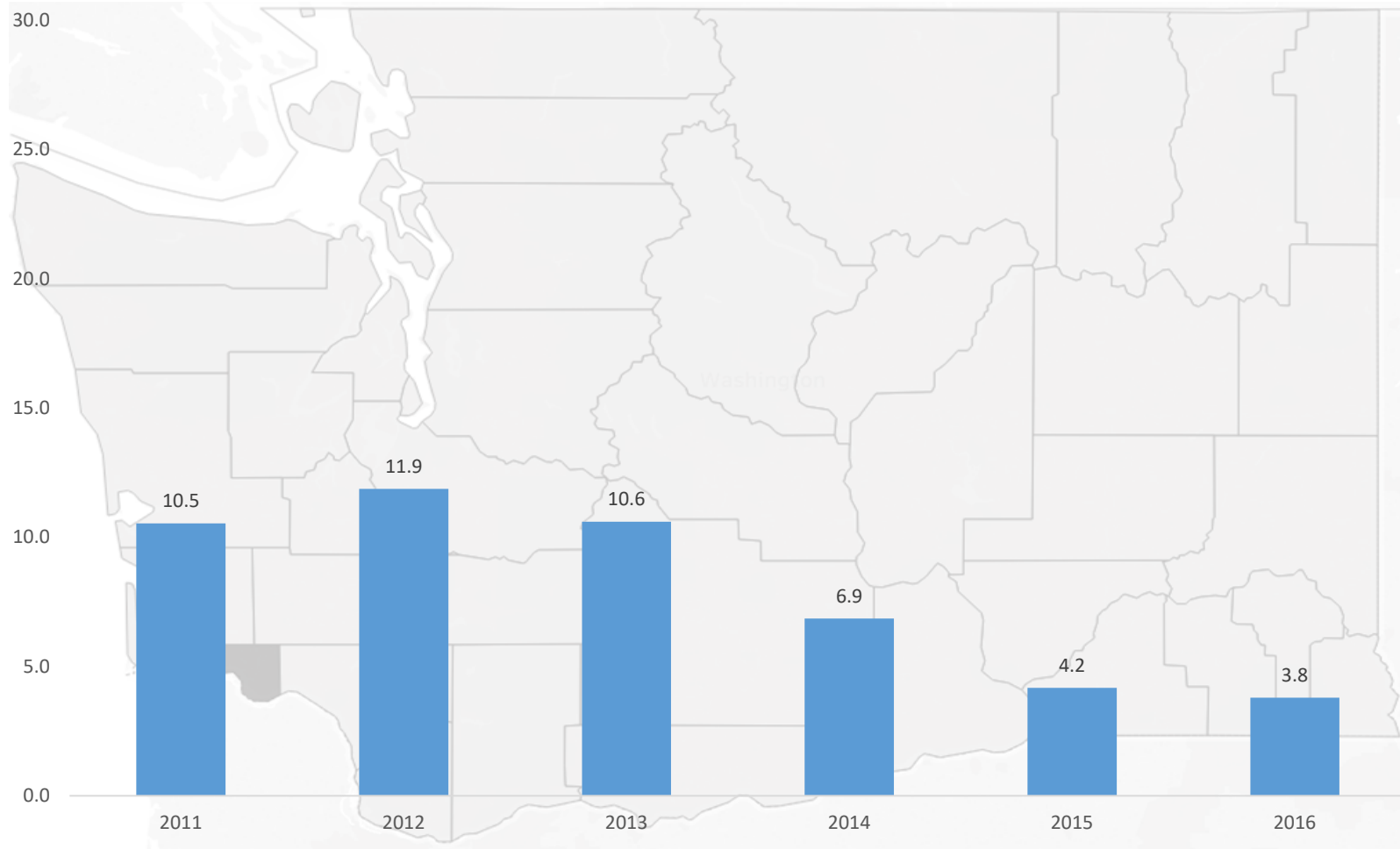
Chart 40. Percent Uninsured, Thurston County, 2011-16

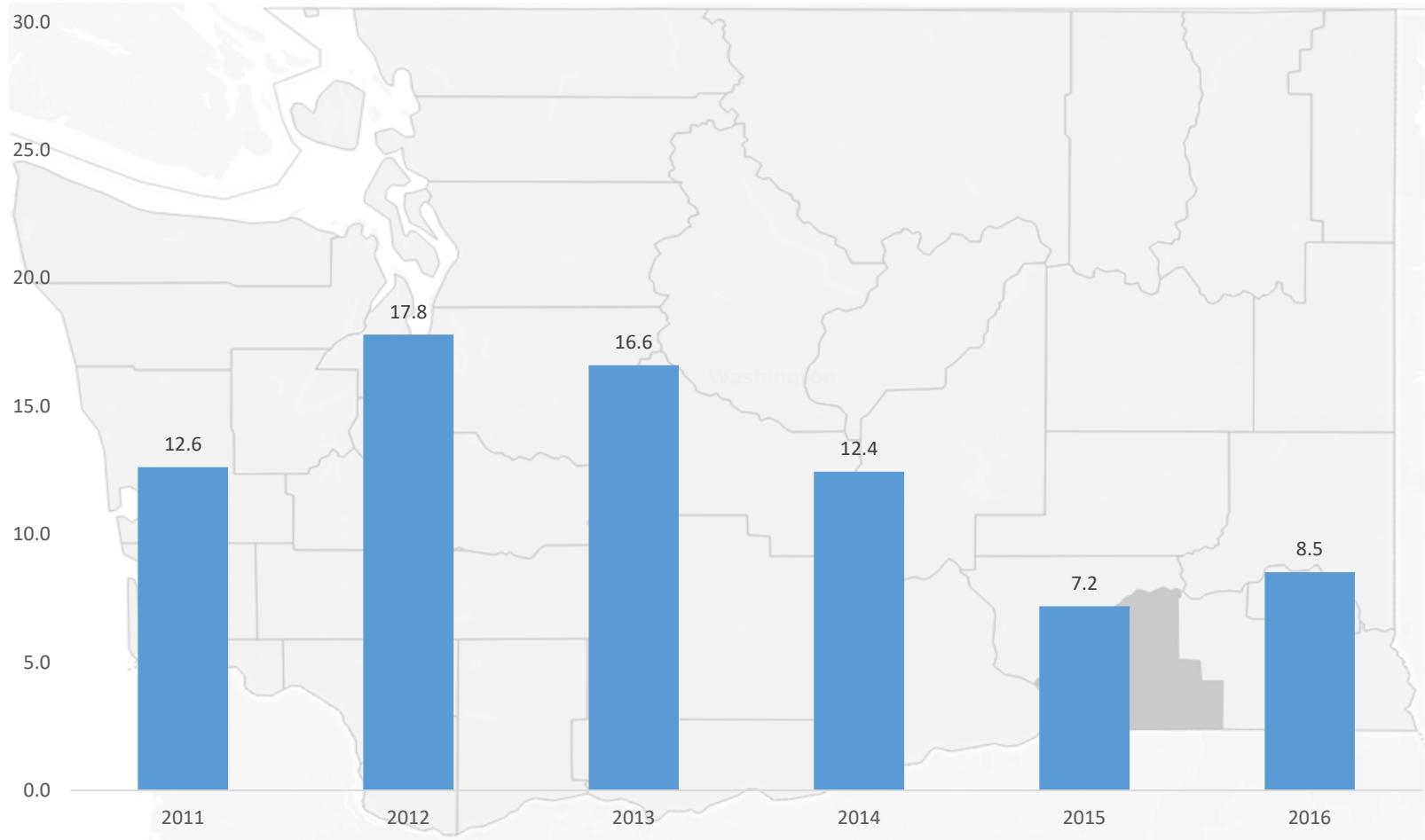
Chart 41. Percent Uninsured, Wahkiakum County, 2011-16

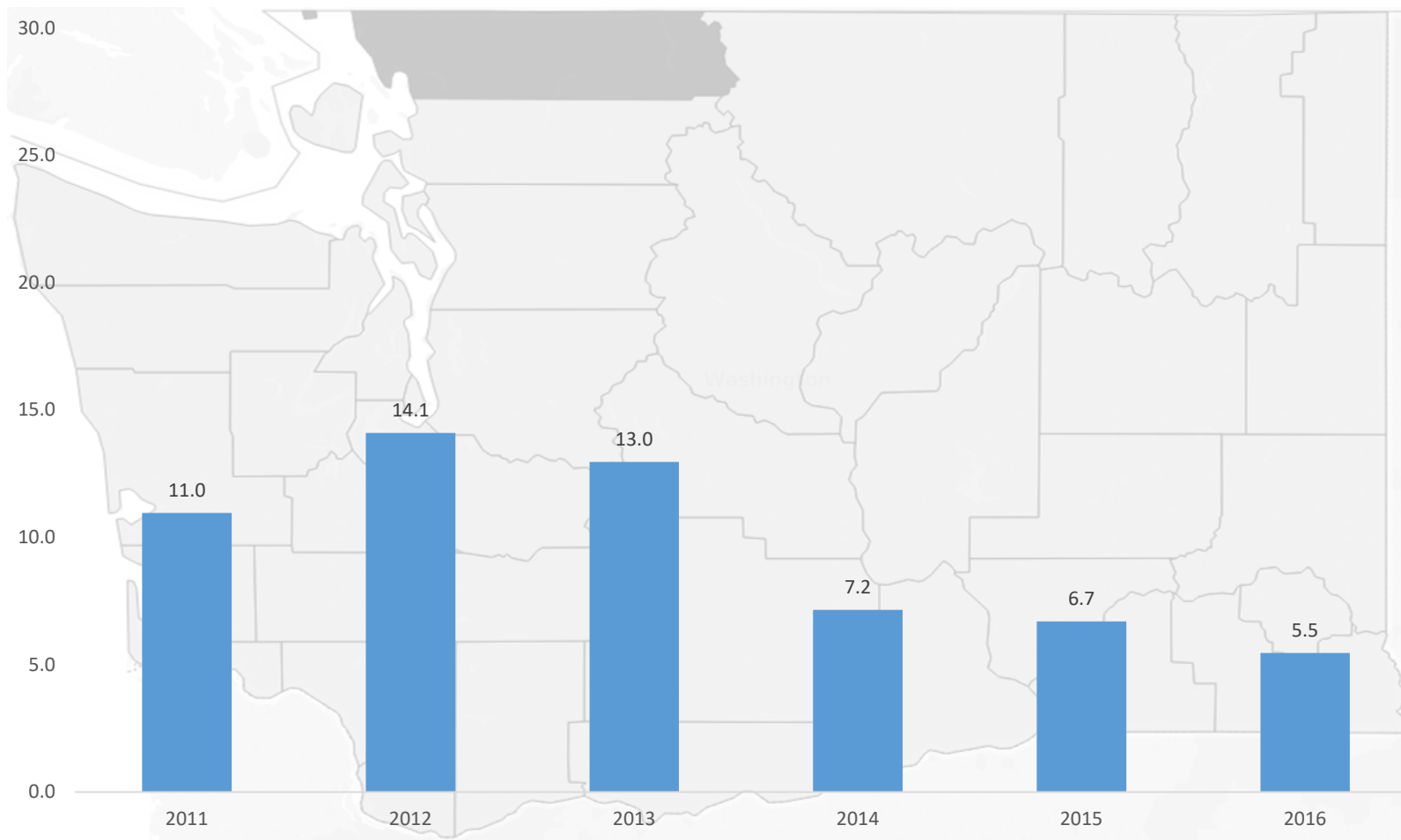
Chart 42. Percent Uninsured, Walla Walla County, 2011-16

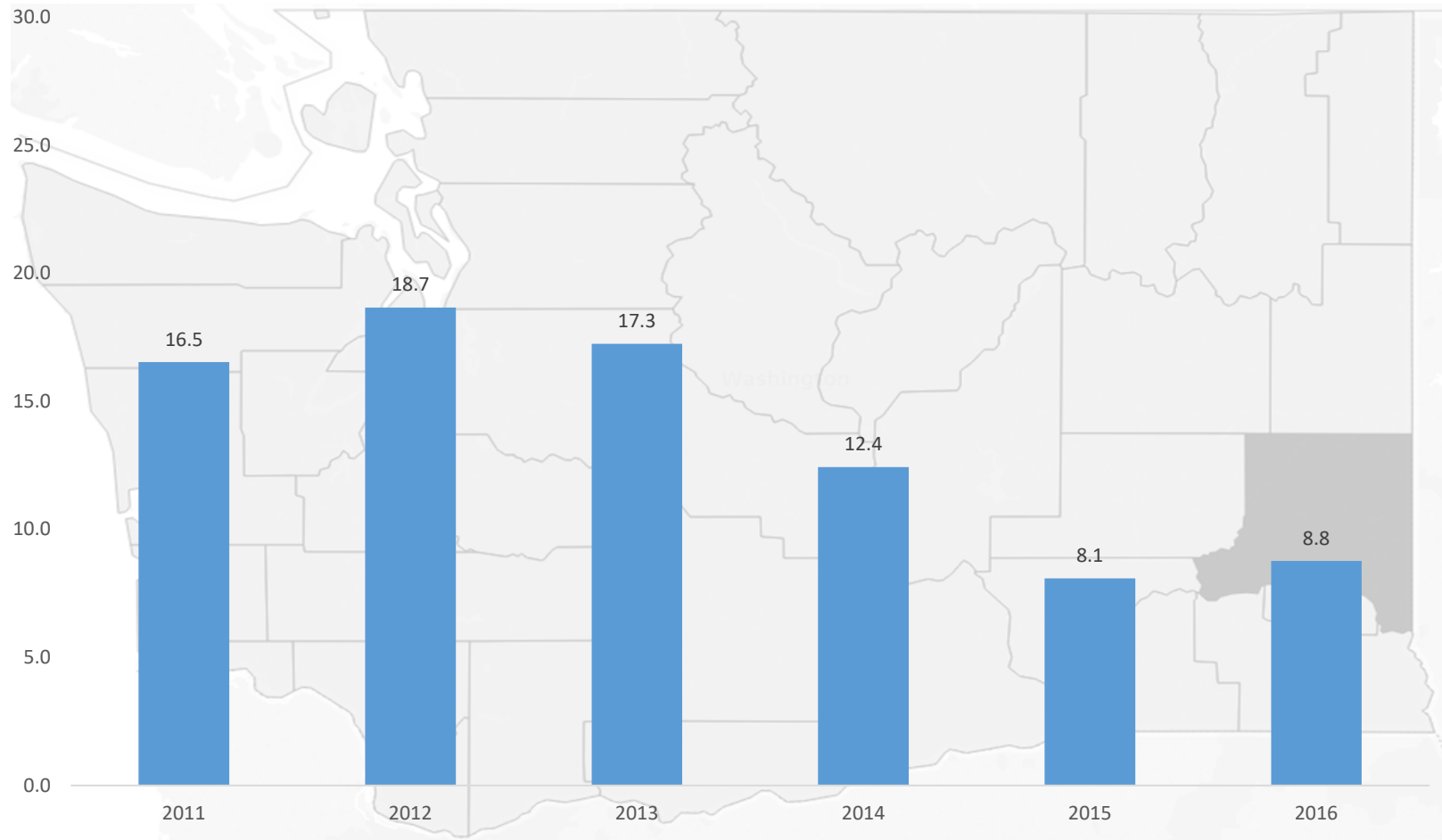
Chart 43. Percent Uninsured, Whatcom County, 2011-16

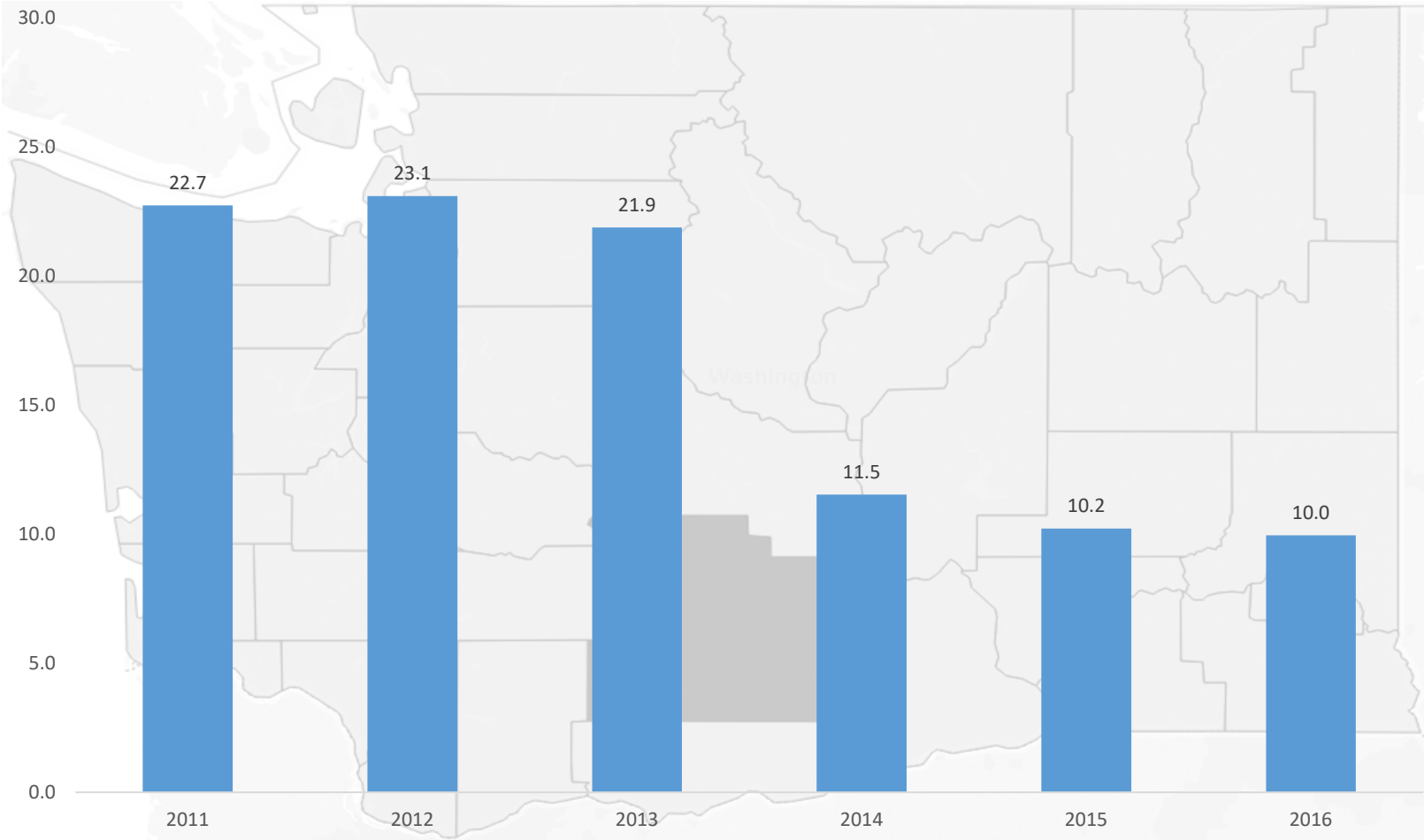
Chart 44. Percent Uninsured, Whitman County, 2011-16

Data Sources and Notes

The original data source for this document is the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey (ACS) 1-year Public Use Microdata Sample file. The Washington State Office Financial Management (OFM) used the ACS data, along with other population data from the OFM, as input to its County Population Estimation Model (CPEM) to produce county-level health insurance coverage estimates.

In working with the ACS data, OFM analysts uncovered a significant undercount of Medicaid enrollment in Washington starting in 2014, the year the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) first rolled out Medicaid expansion program. A decision was made to adjust for the undercount of Medicaid in the 2014-16 ACS using administrative data from the Medicaid program before the ACS data were used in the CPEM.

For this document, the statewide estimates were calculated using the ACS 1-year PUMS for 2011-13 and the adjusted ACS for 2014-16. The county-level estimates were calculated using the OFM CPEM.
