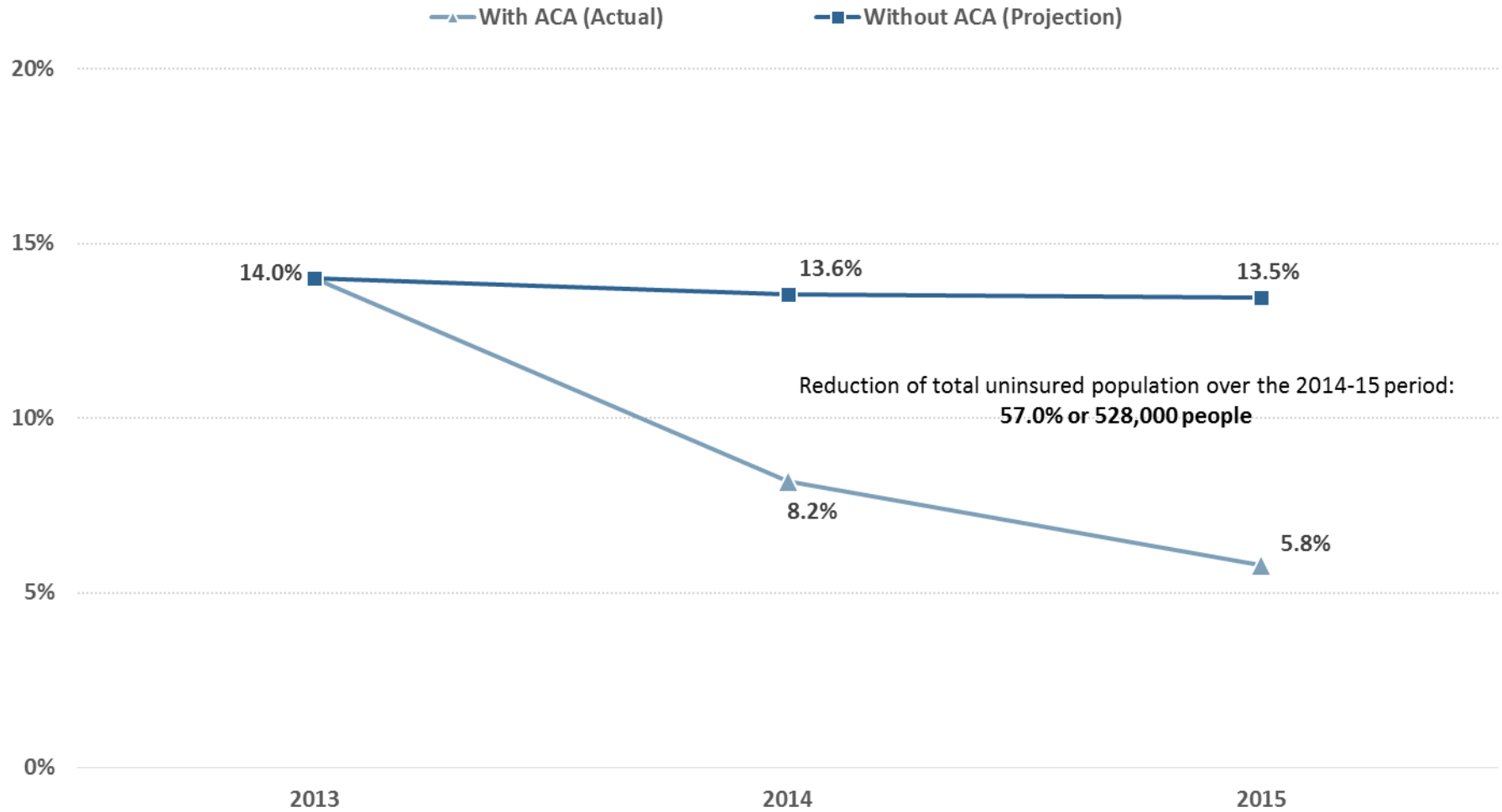

Total Population, 2013-15

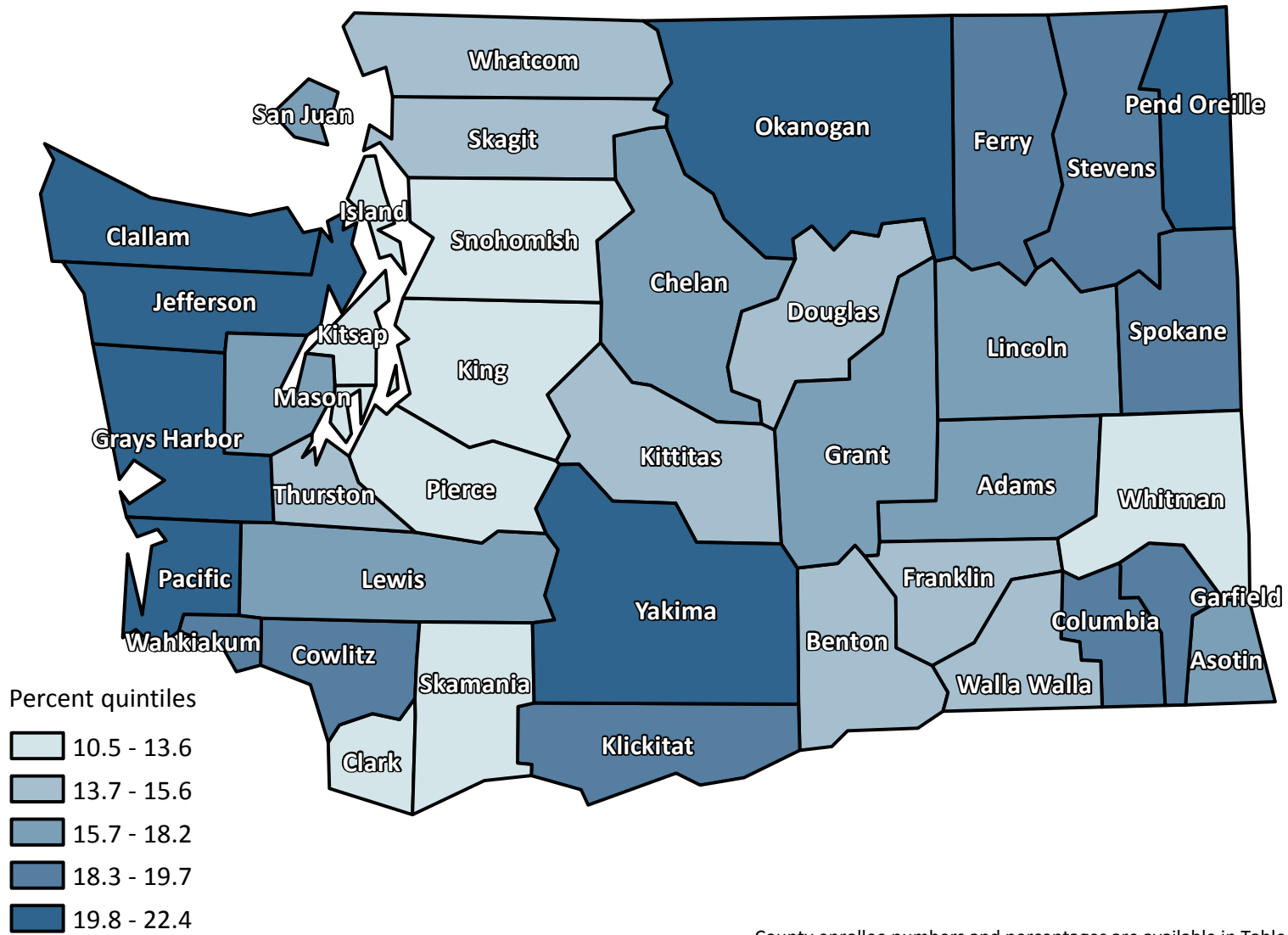

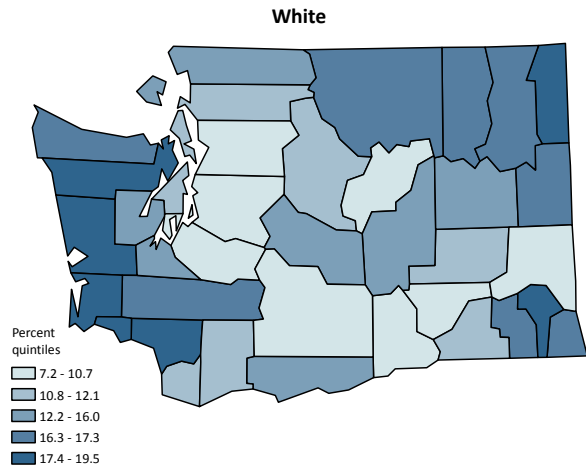
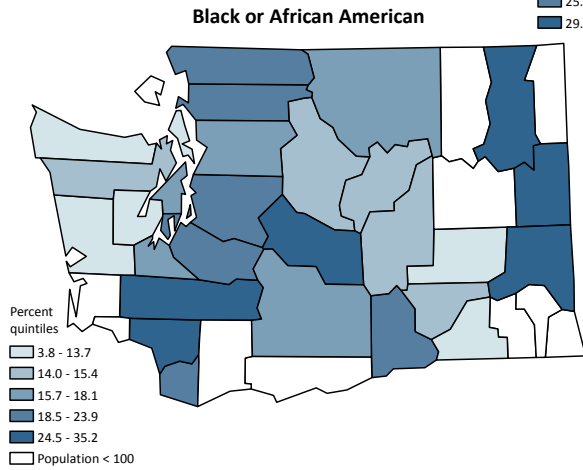
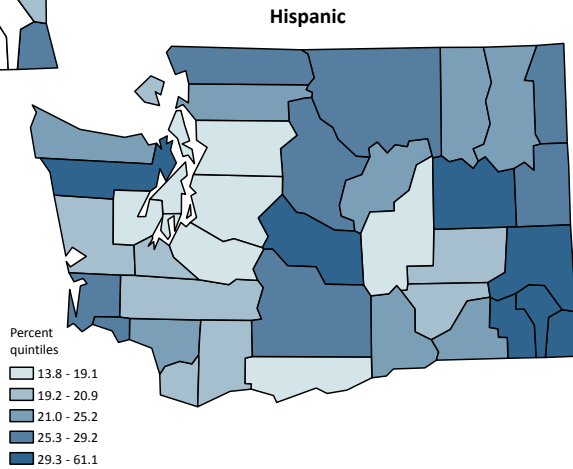
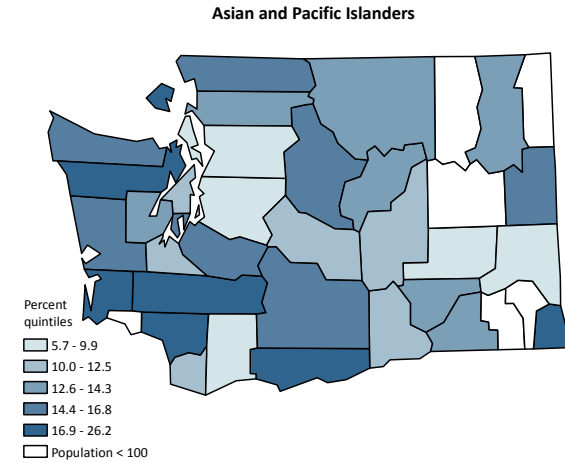
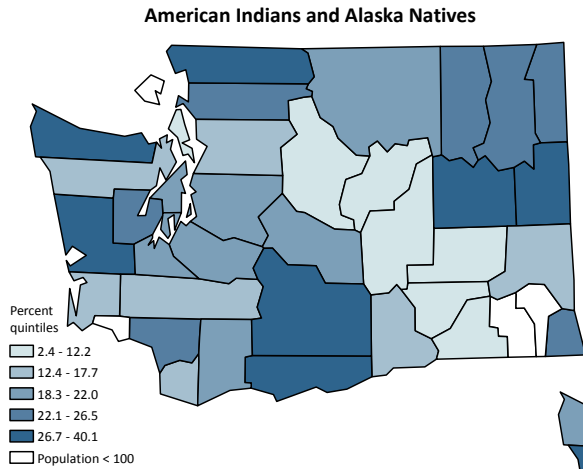
Percent of Adults 19 to 64 Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Counties

Percent by Race and Ethnicity Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Counties

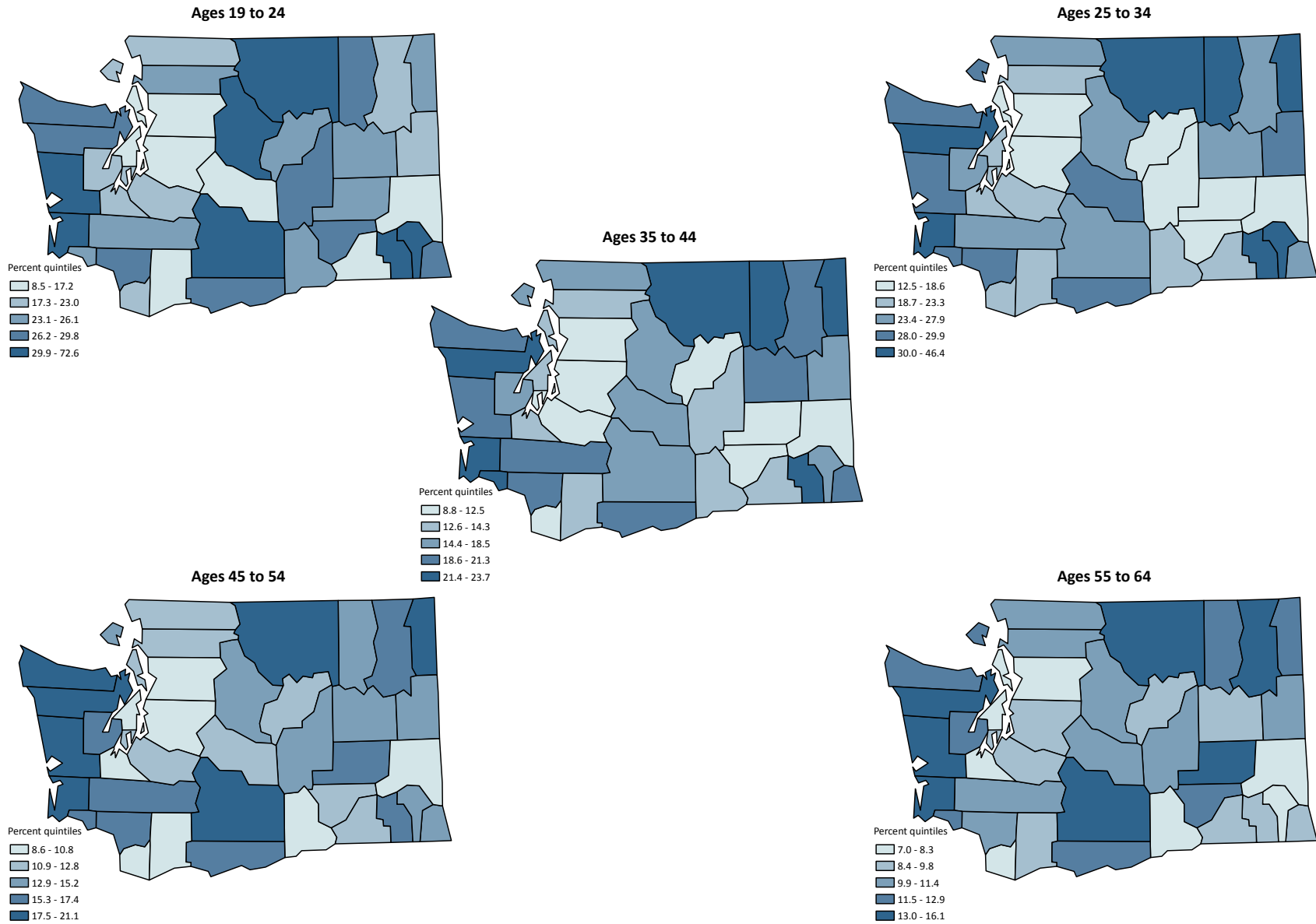

Percent by Age Groups Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Counties

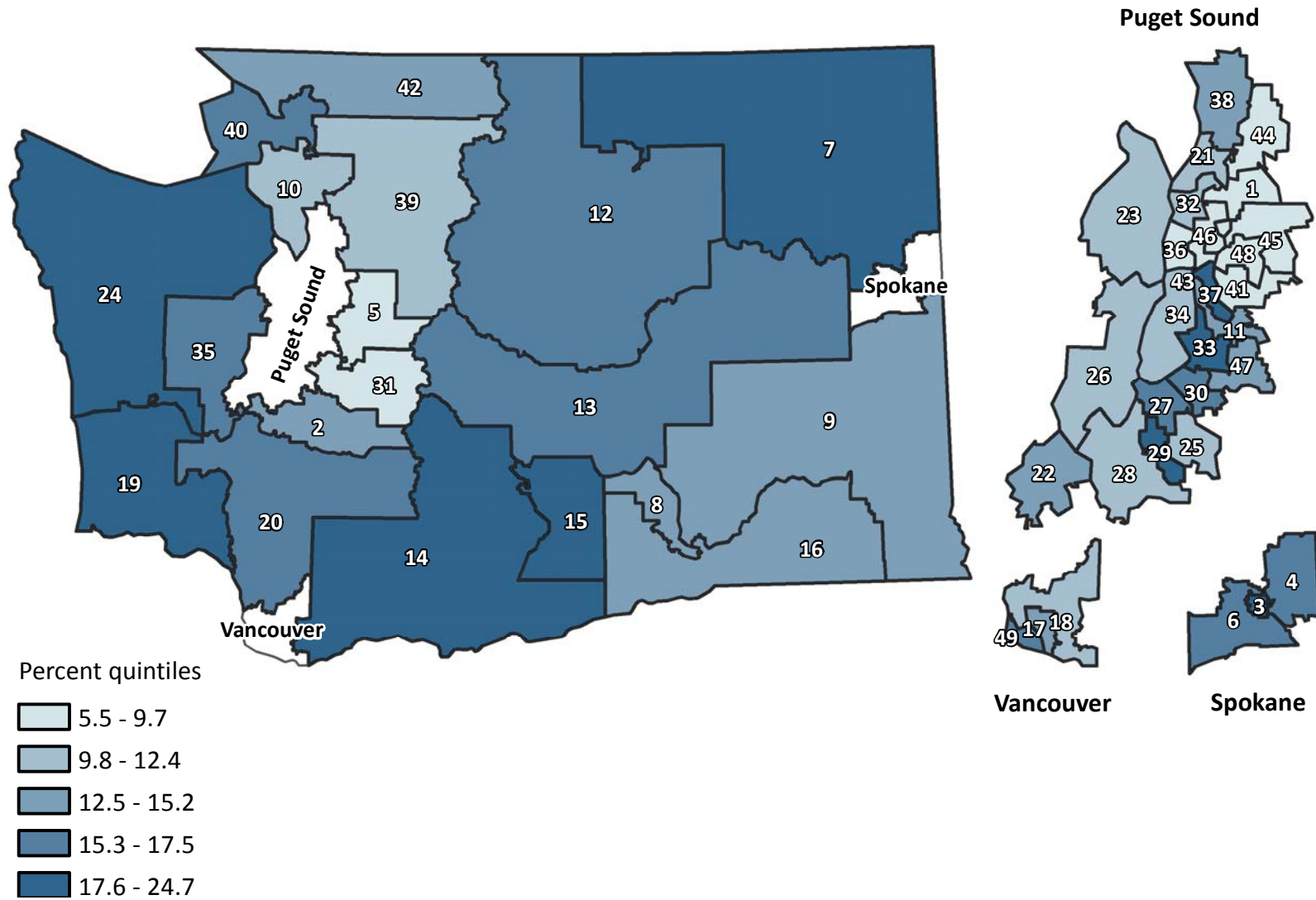

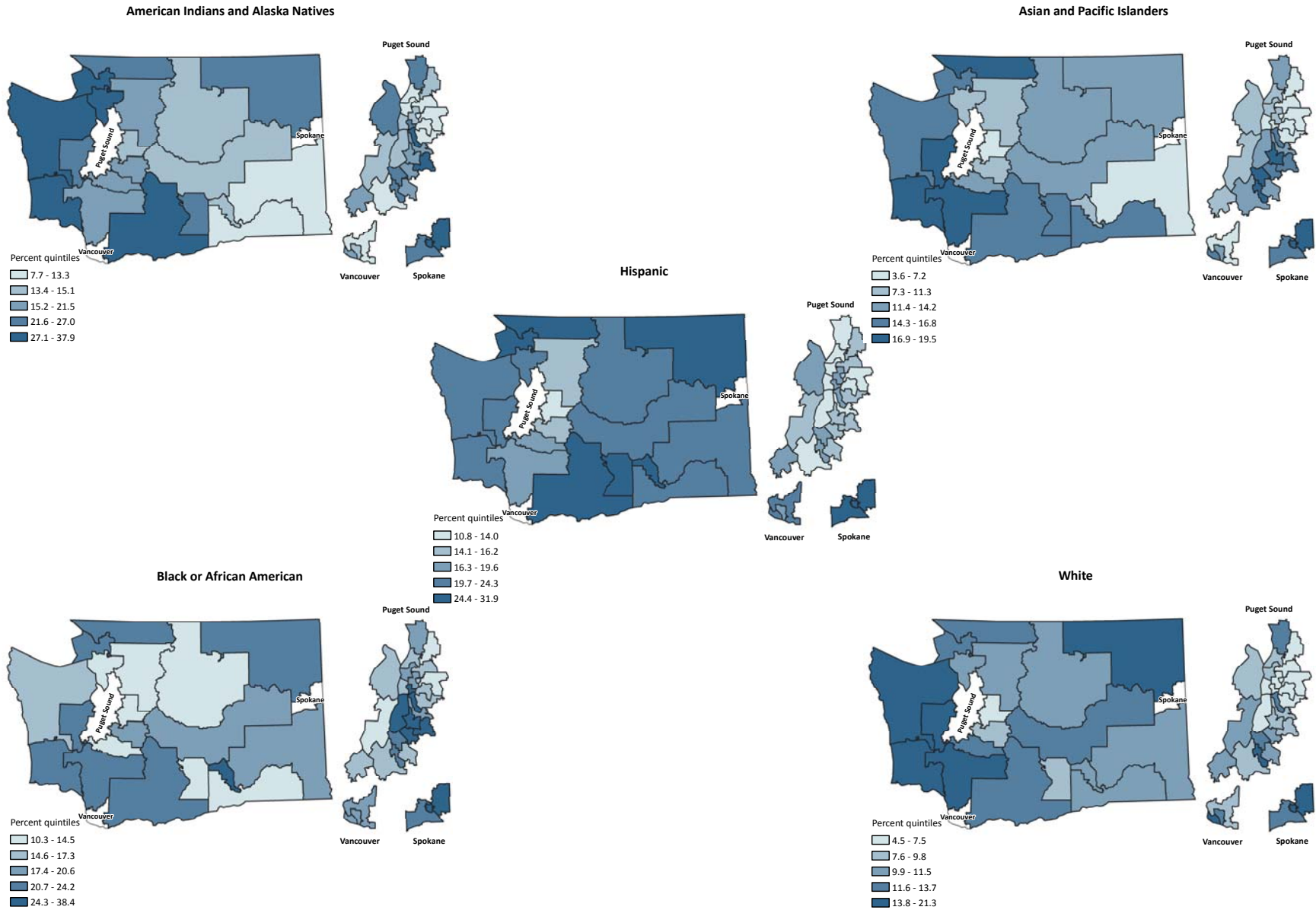
Percent of Adults 19 to 64 Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Legislative Districts

Percent by Race and Ethnicity Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Legislative Districts

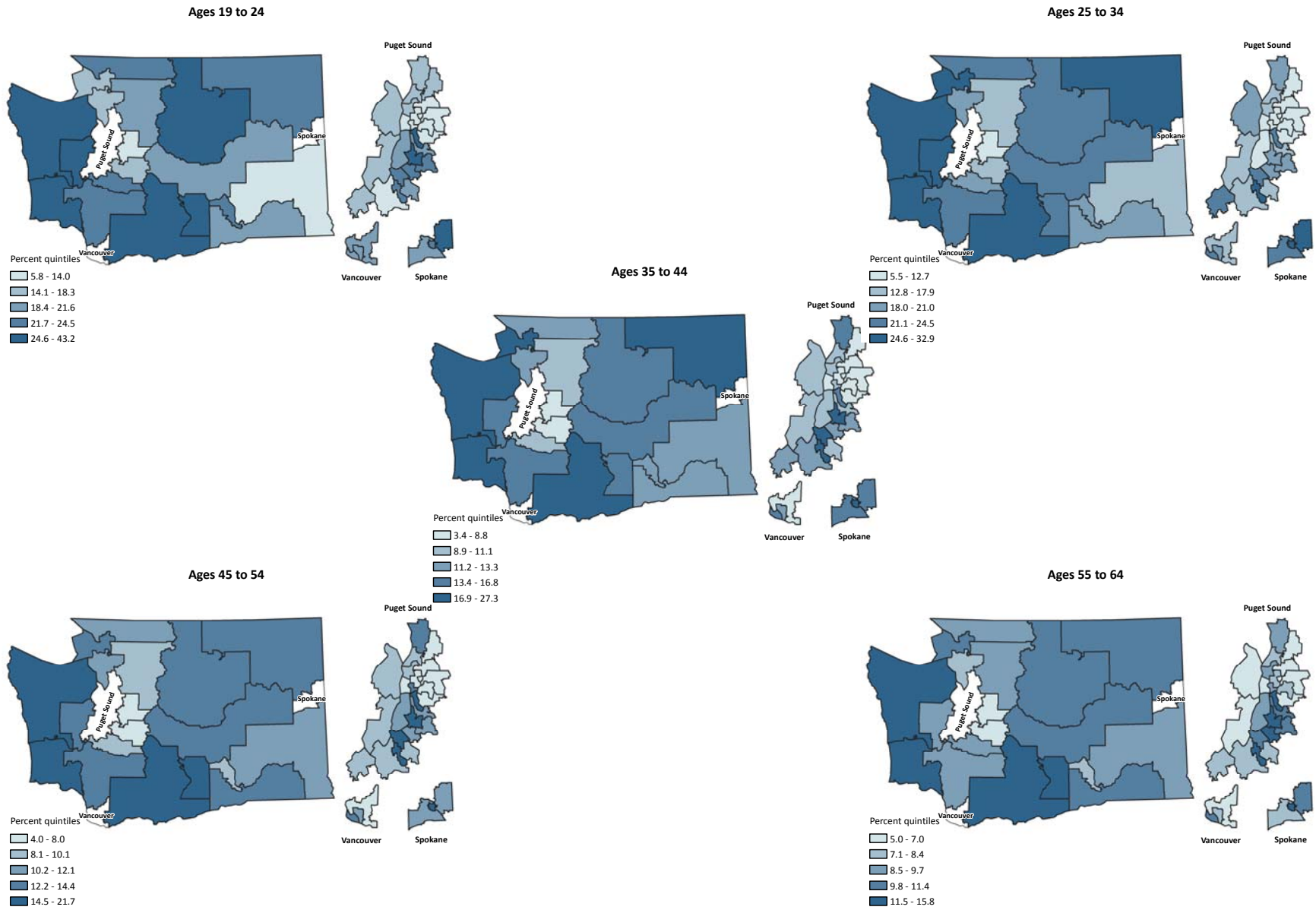

Percent by Age Groups Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Legislative Districts

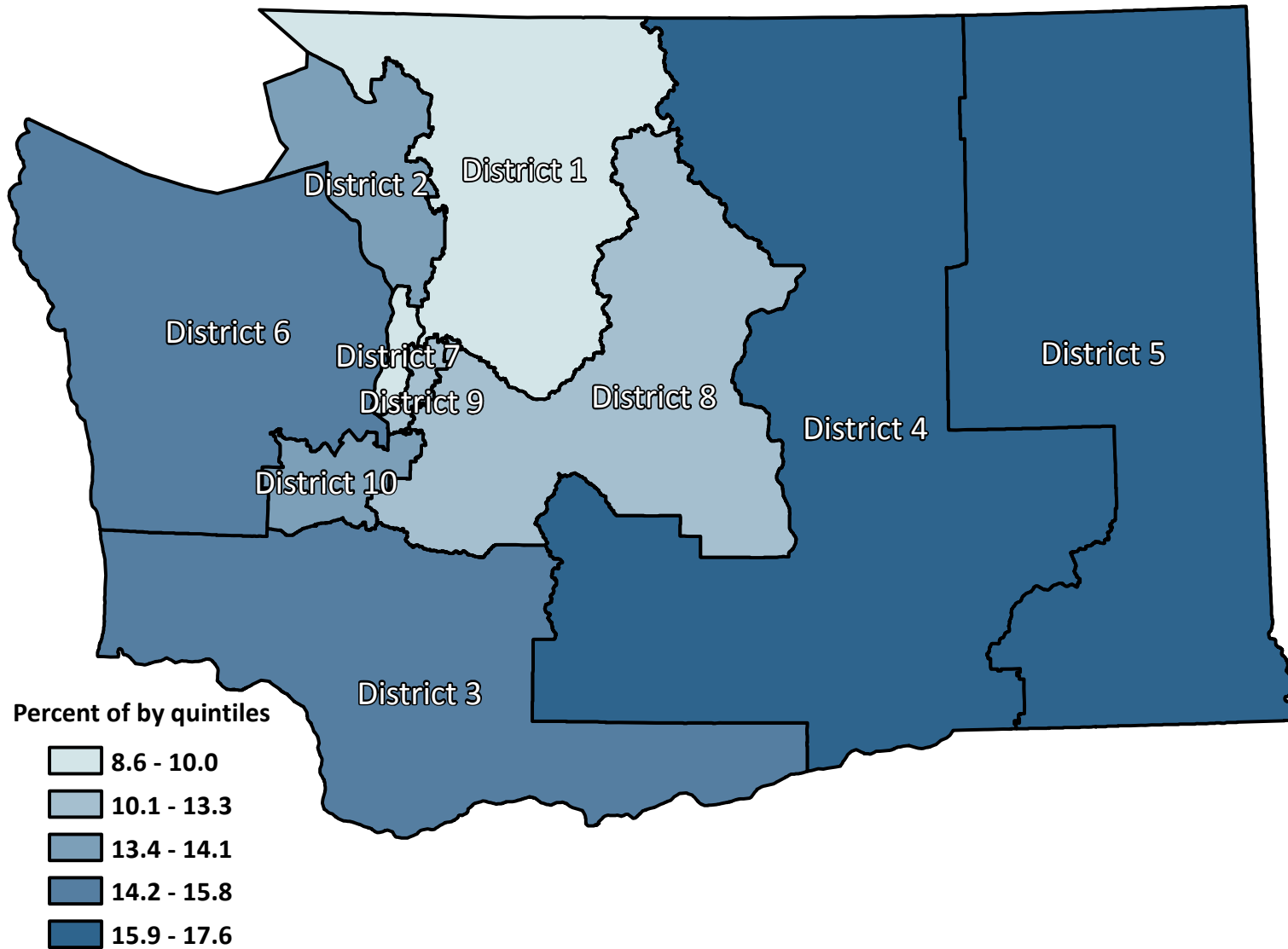

Percent of Adults 19 to 64 Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Congressional Districts

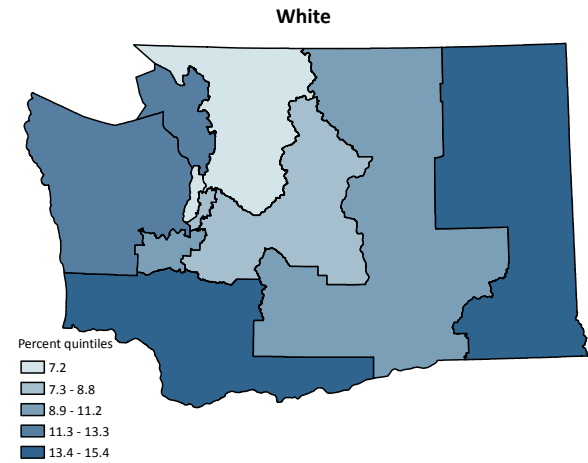
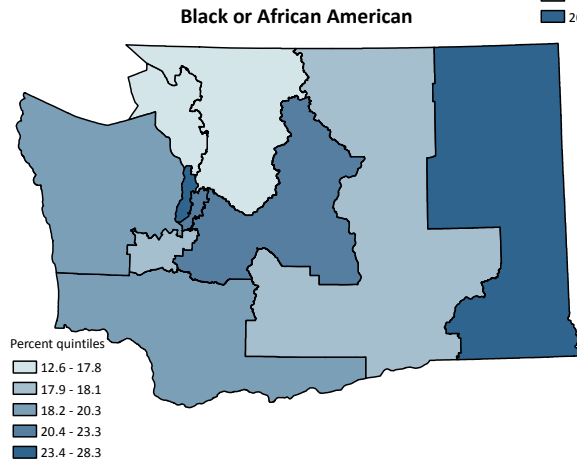
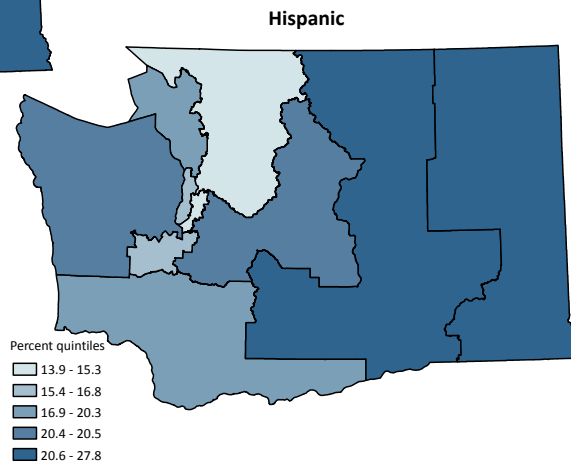
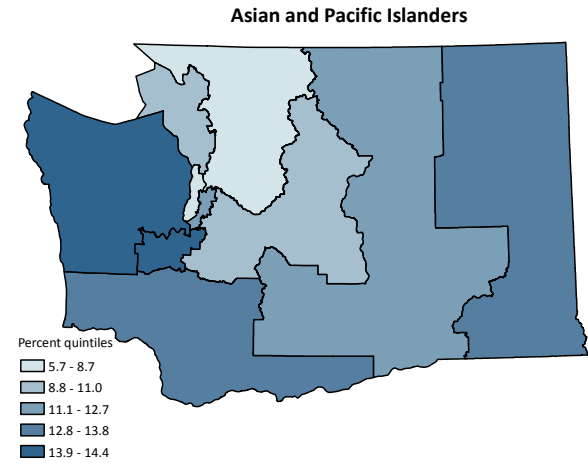
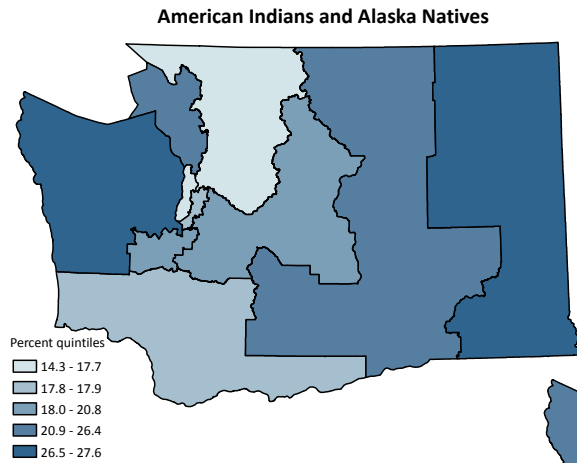

Percent by Race and Ethnicity Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Congressional Districts

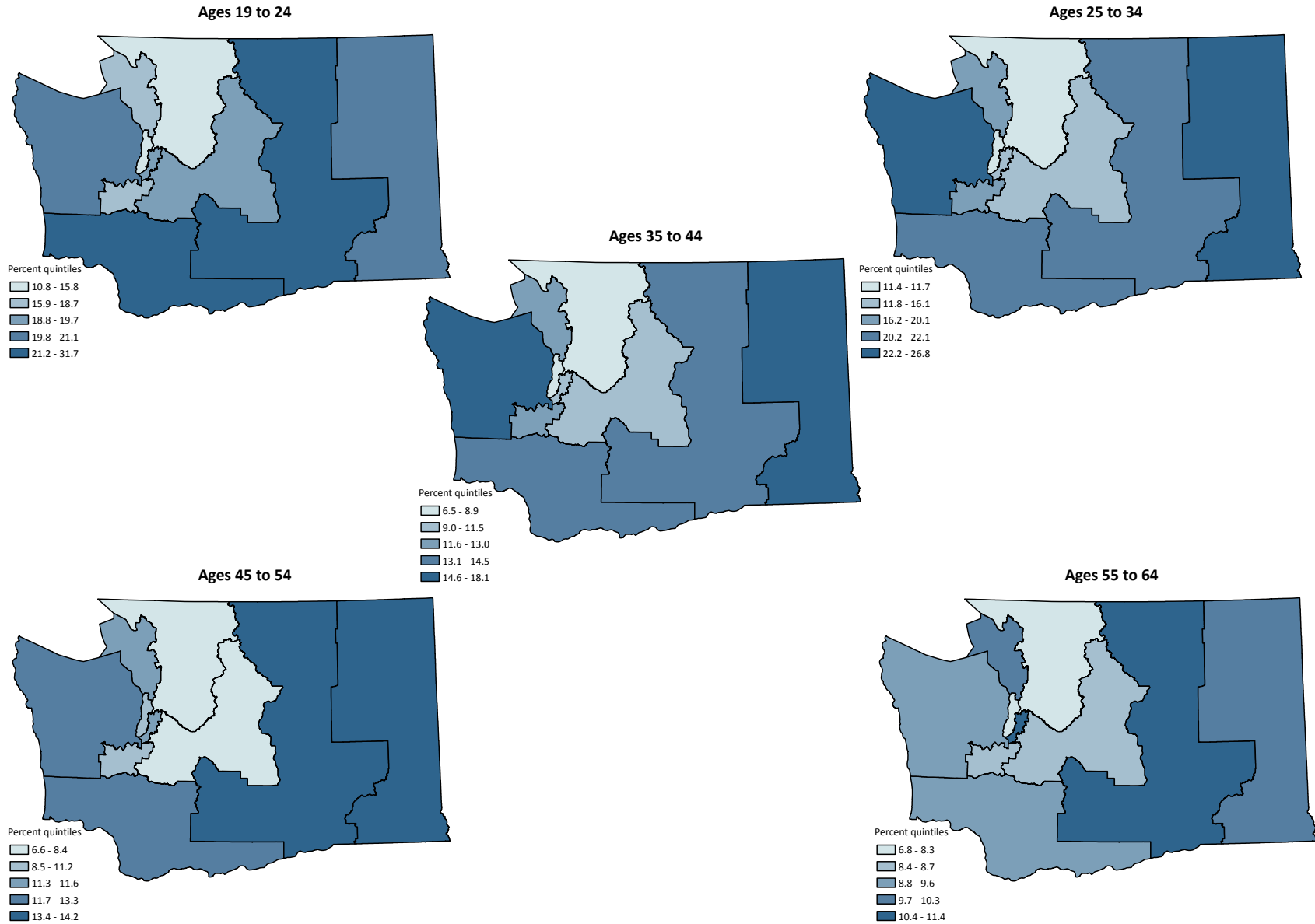

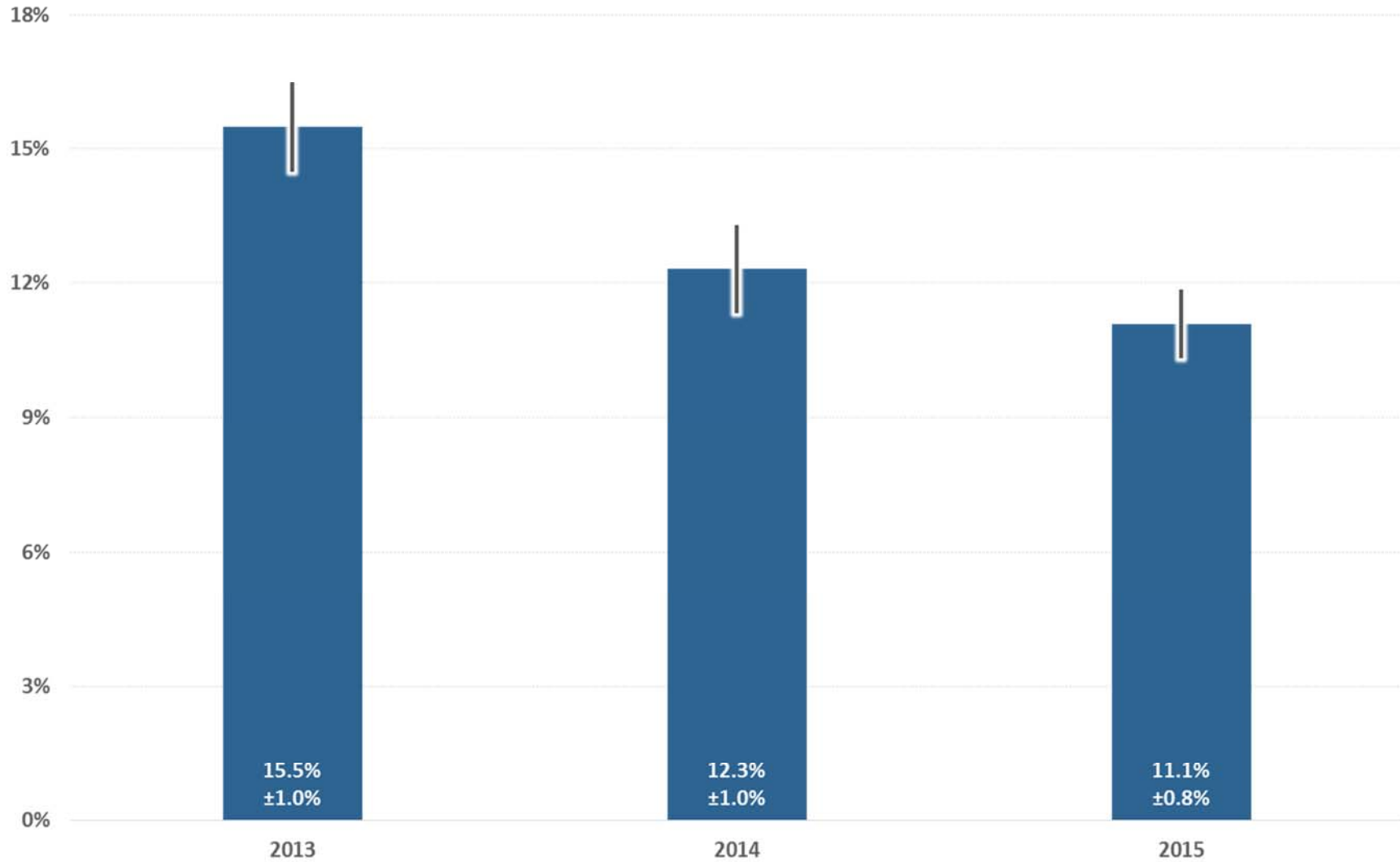
Percent by Age Groups Enrolled under Medicaid Expansion in 2016: Congressional Districts

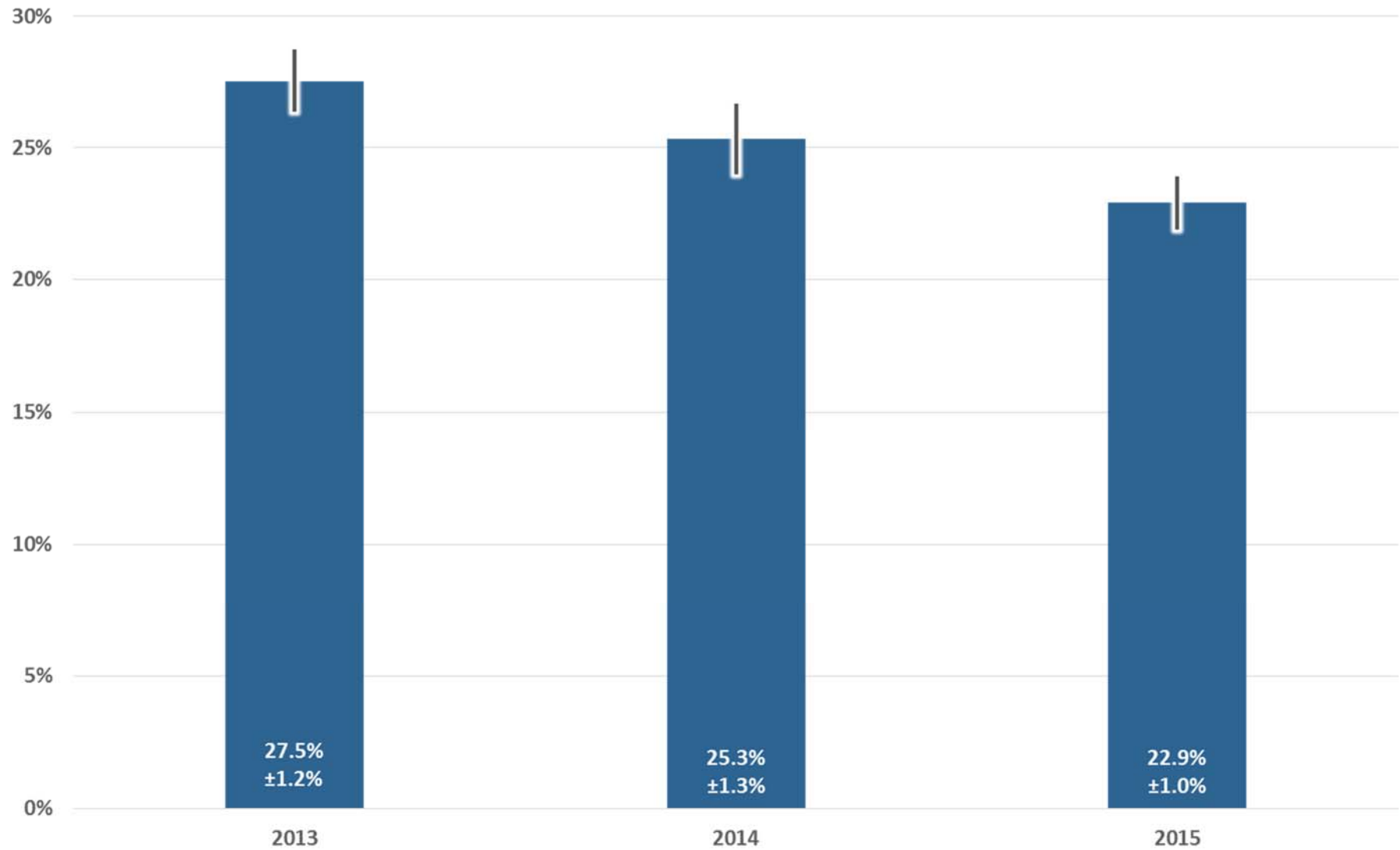

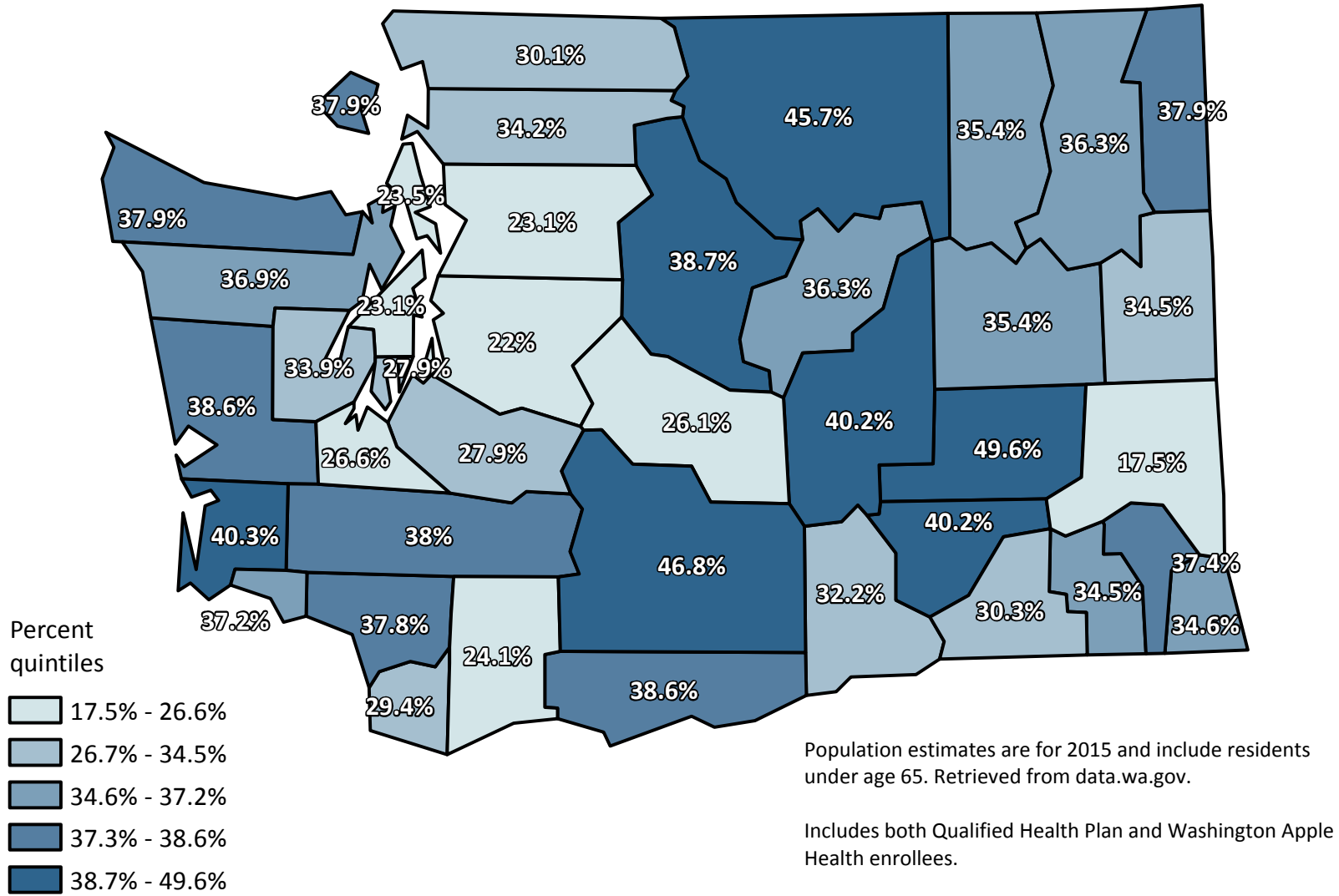

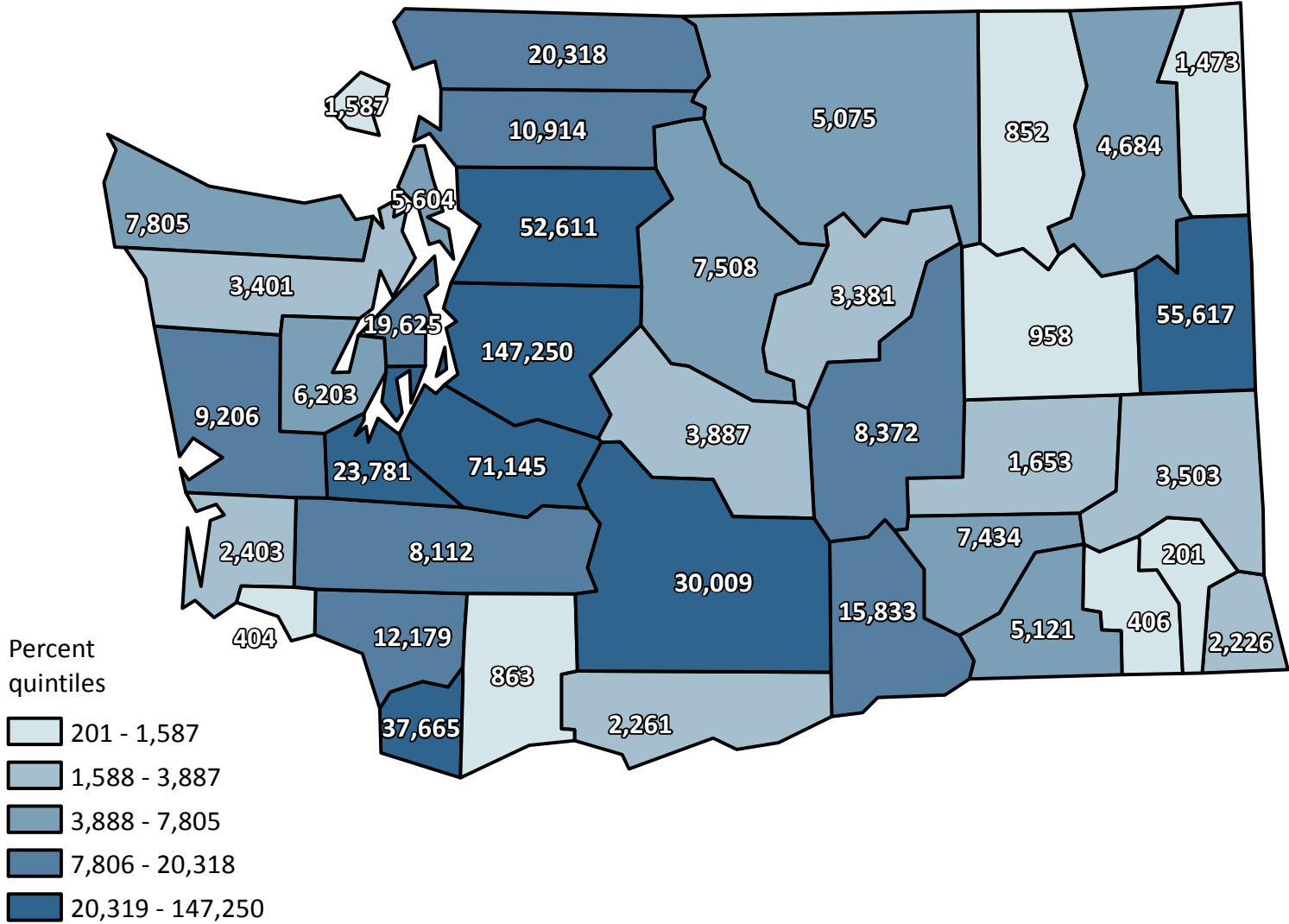
Share of Population Enrolled through Washington Healthplanfinder

Washington Apple Health by County - Adult Expansion Population Only

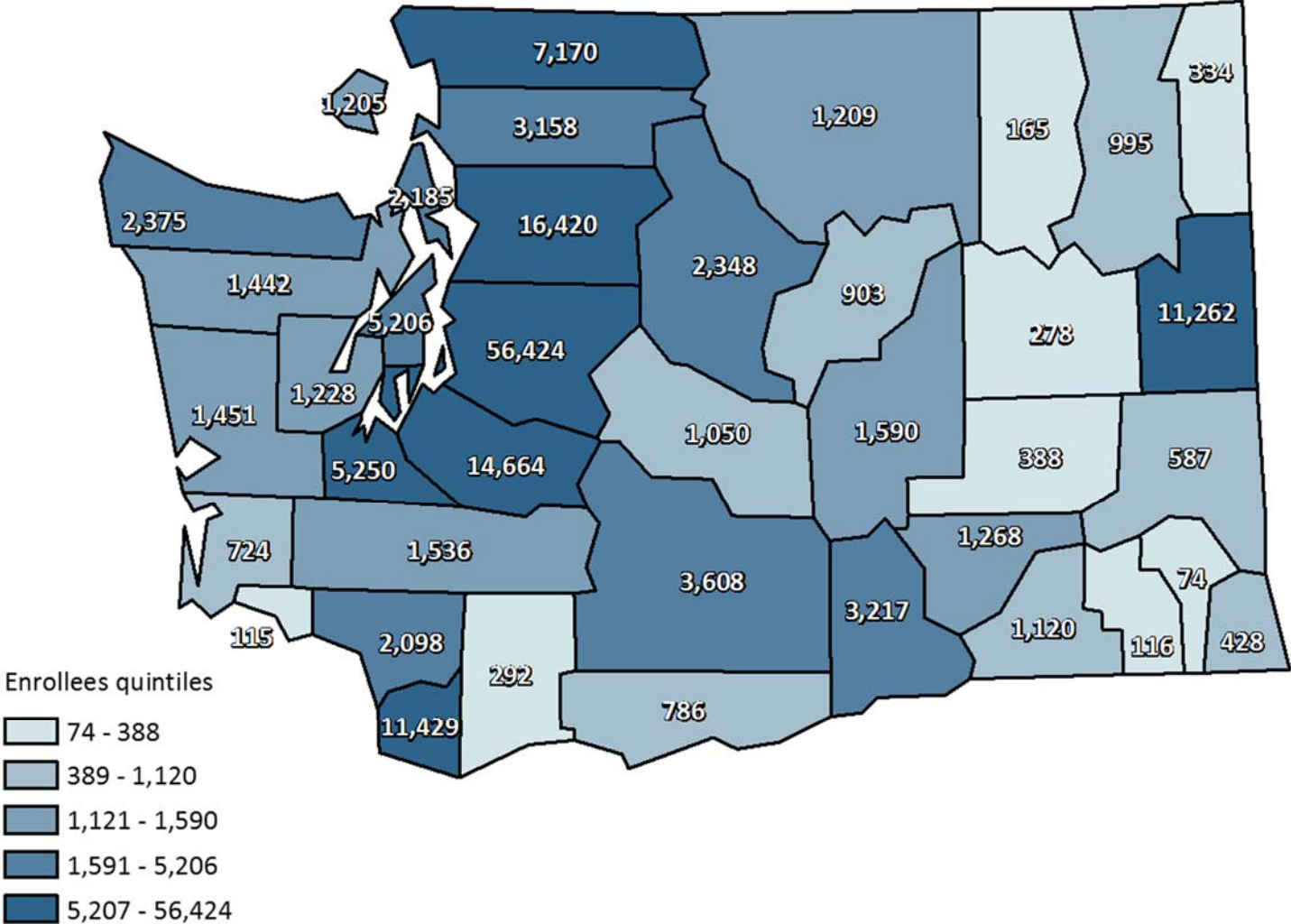

Number of Individuals Enrolled in Qualified Health Plans by County

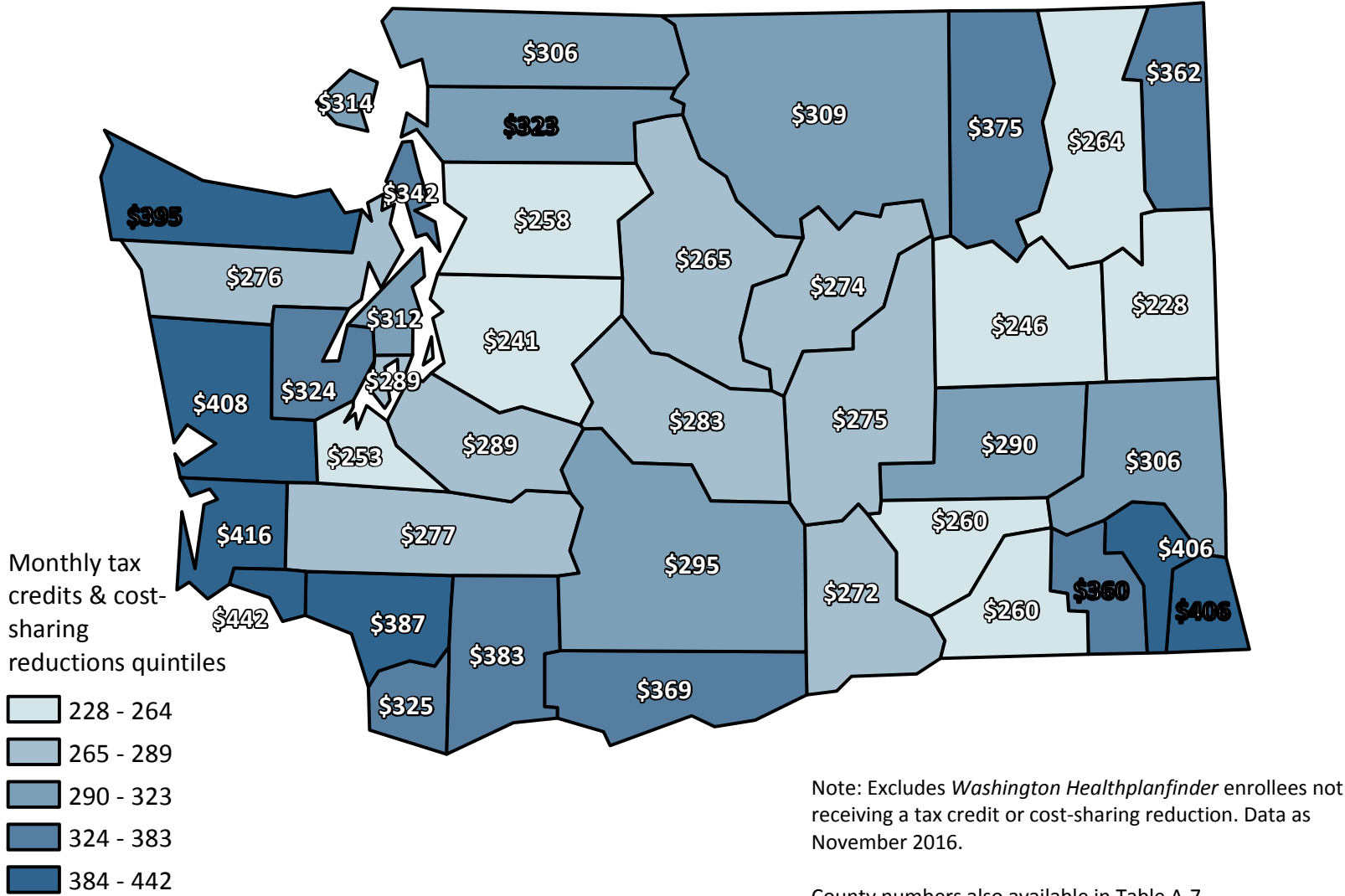

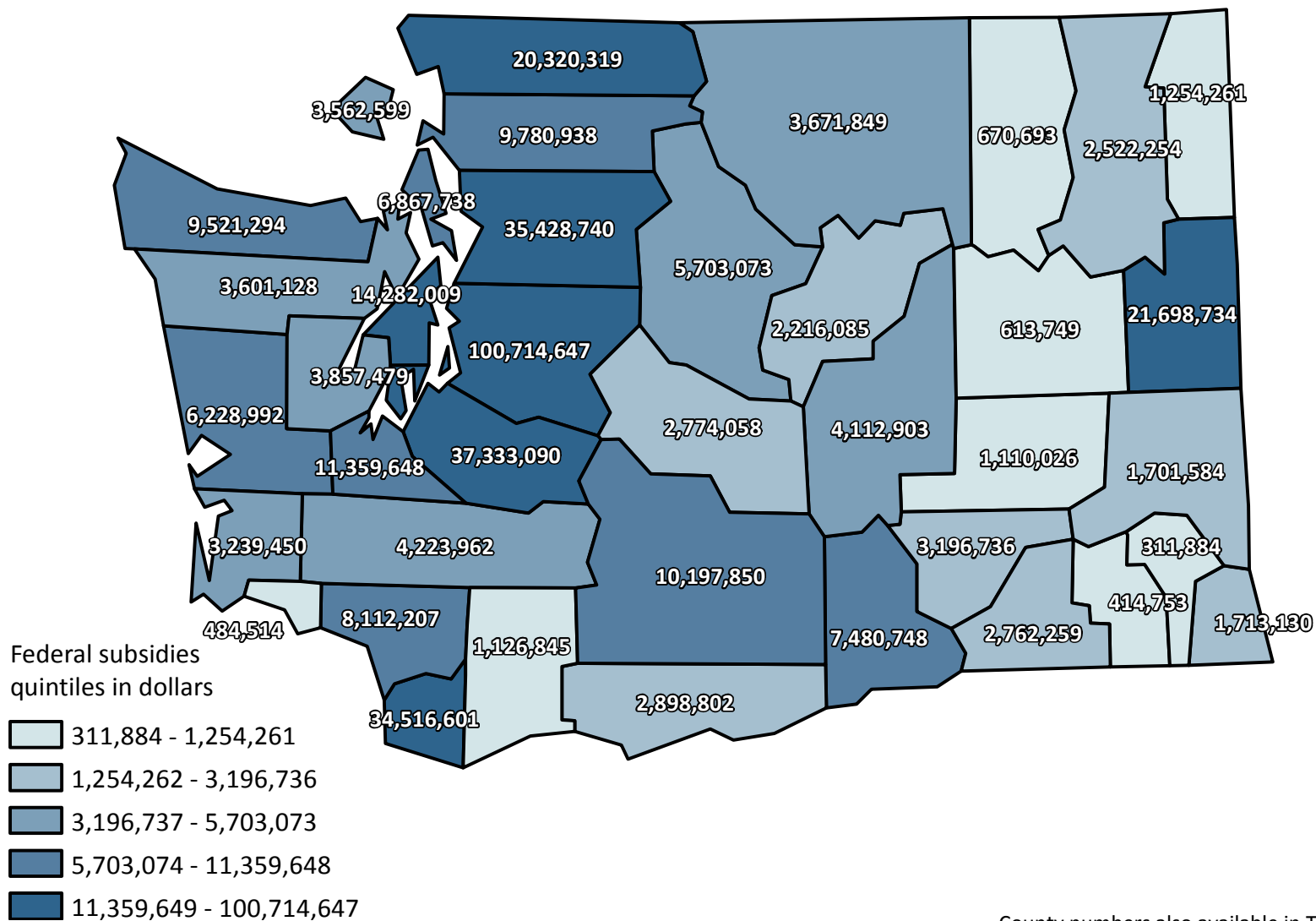
Average Monthly Tax Credits & Cost-Sharing Reductions per Subsidized Enrollee, 2016

Federal Subsidies (Tax Credits & Cost-Sharing Reductions) in Dollars for 2016 - \$400M Annually

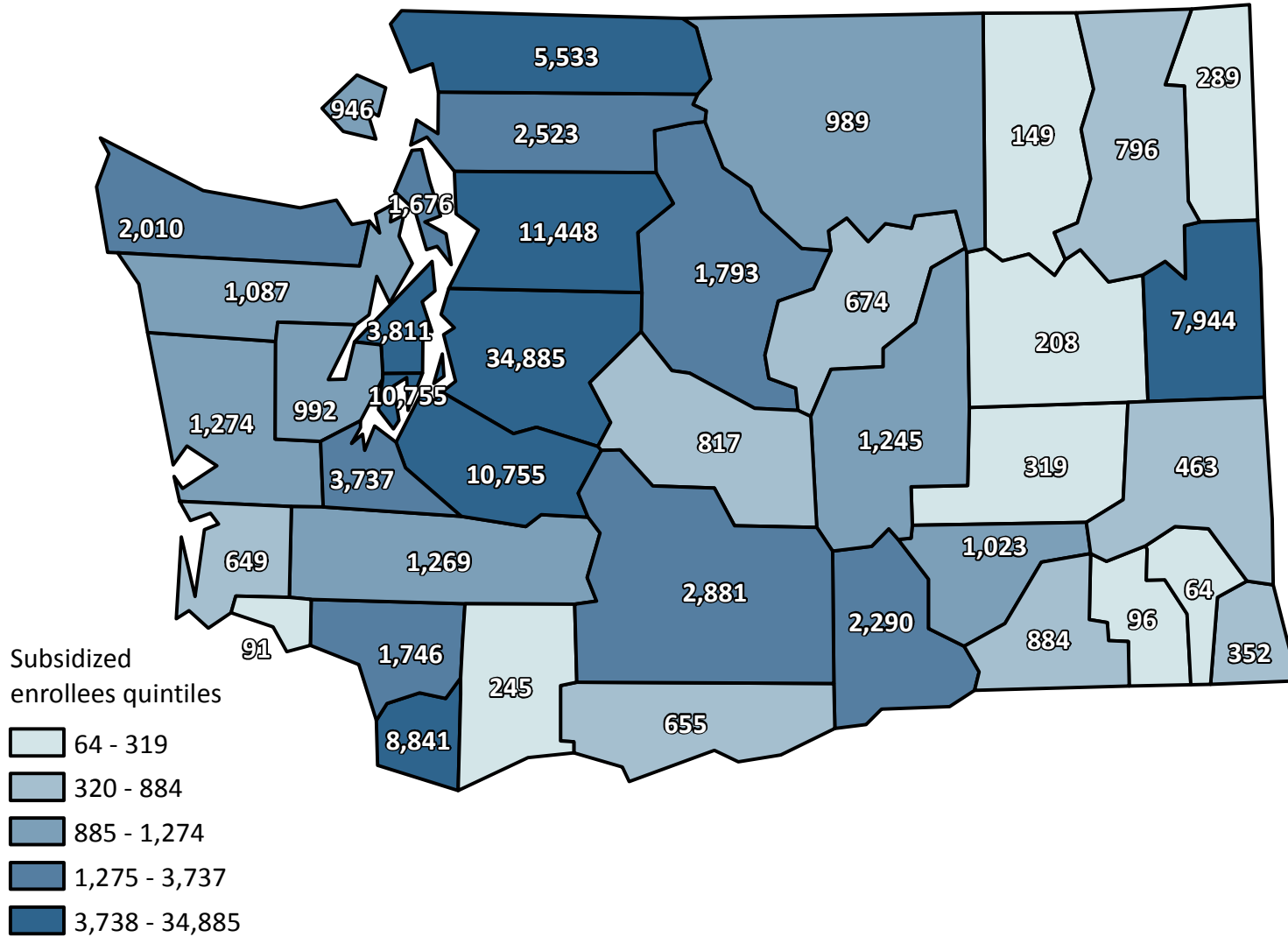

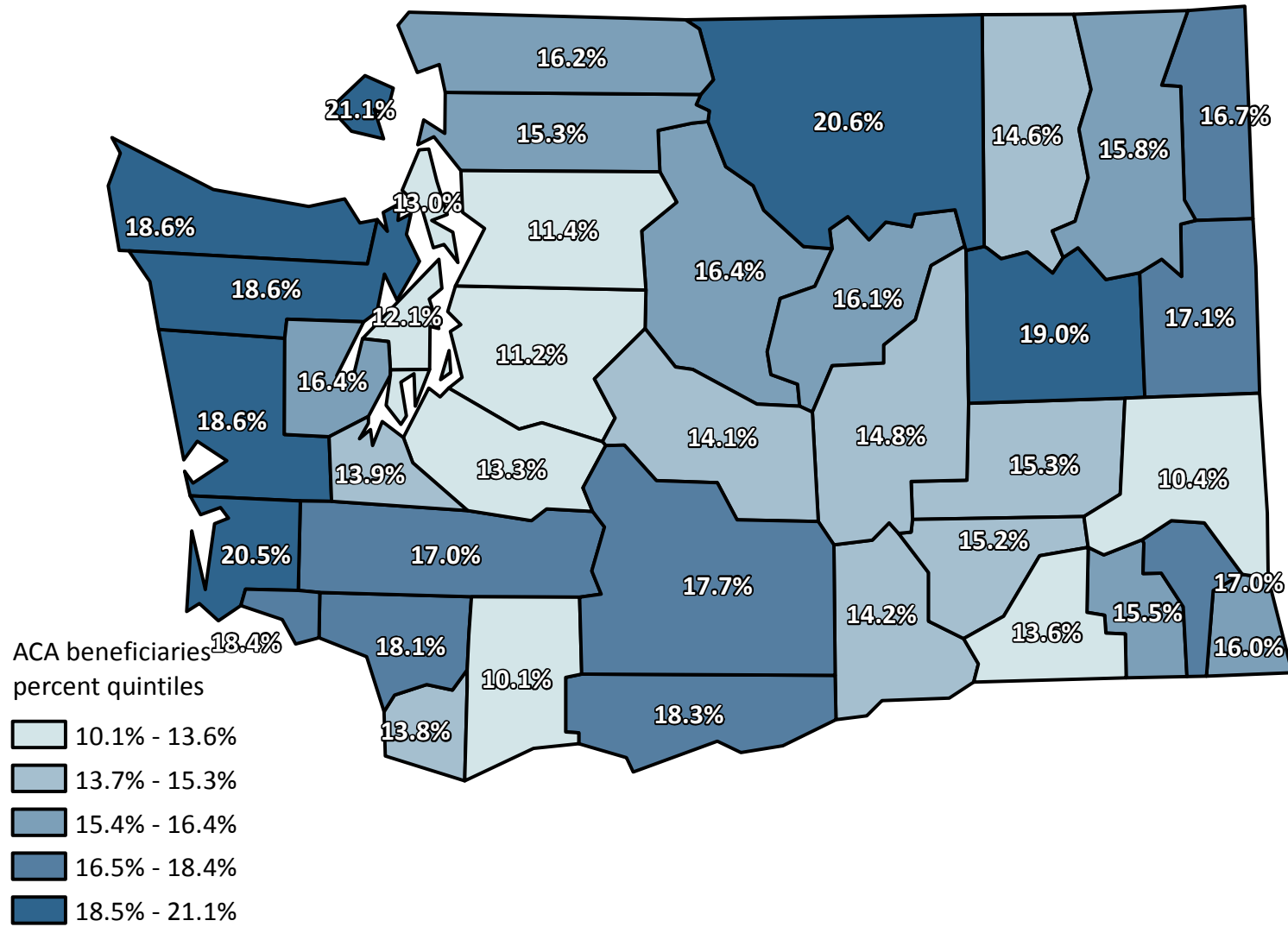
Average Number of Subsidized Enrollees (Receiving Tax Credits and/or Cost Sharing reductions) in 2016

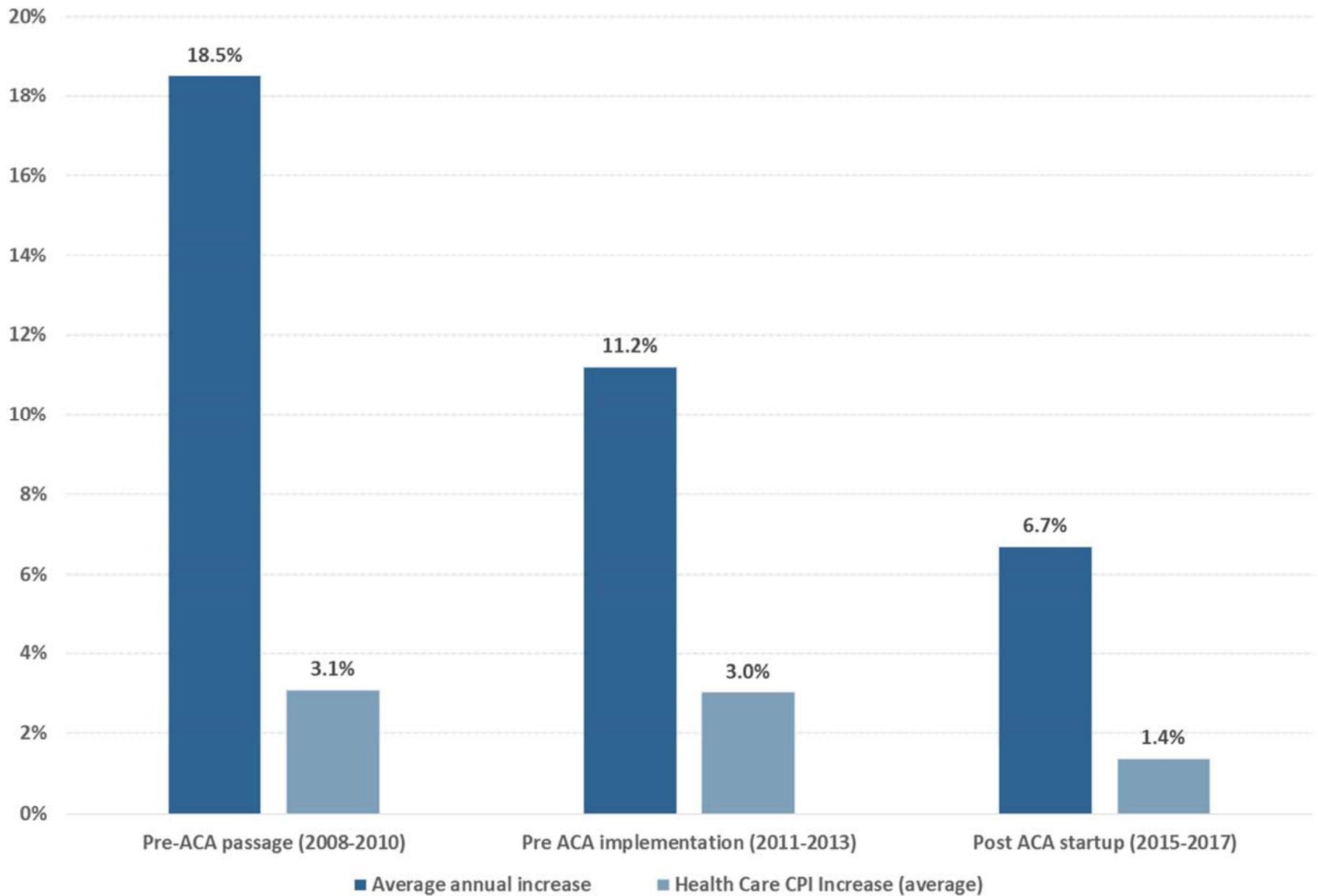
Affordable Care Act Beneficiaries as a Percent of the Under 65 Population
