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



Map 2. Number and Percent of Physicians: County Regions, 2020







Physician Median Age by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 3. Physician Median Age by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 5. Median Age of Physicians: Counties, 2019




Map 6. Median Age of Physicians: Counties, 2020




Percentage of Female Physicians by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 4. Percentage of Female Physicians by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 7. Percentage of Female Physicians: Counties, 2019




Map 8. Percentage of Female Physicians: Counties, 2020




Specialist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 6. Specialist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 11. Specialists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 12. Specialists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Anesthesiologist Rates (Per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020


Figure 7. Anesthesiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 13. Anesthesiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 14. Anesthesiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Cardiologist Rates by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 8. Cardiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 15. Cardiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 16. Cardiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Emergency Medicine Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 9. Emergency Medicine Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 17. Emergency Medicine Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 18. Emergency Medicine Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Family Medicine/General Practice Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 10. Family Medicine/General Practice Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 19. Family Medicine/General Practice Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 20. Family Medicine/General Practice Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Hospitalist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 11. Hospitalist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 21. Hospitalists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 22. Hospitalists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 12. Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 23. Internal Medicine (General) Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 24. Internal Medicine (General) Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




OB/GYN Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 13. OB/GYN Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 25. OB/GYNs per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 26. OB/GYNs per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Orthopedic Surgeon Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 14. Orthopedic Surgeon Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 27. Orthopedic Surgeons per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 28. Orthopedic Surgeons per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Pediatrician (General) Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 15. Pediatrician (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 29. Pediatricians (General) per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 30. Pediatricians (General) per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Surgeon (General) Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 18. Surgeon (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020



Map 35. Surgeons (General) per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2019




Map 36. Surgeons (General) per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020




Other Specialty Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2019 and 2020


Figure 19. Other Specialty Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2019 and 2020
