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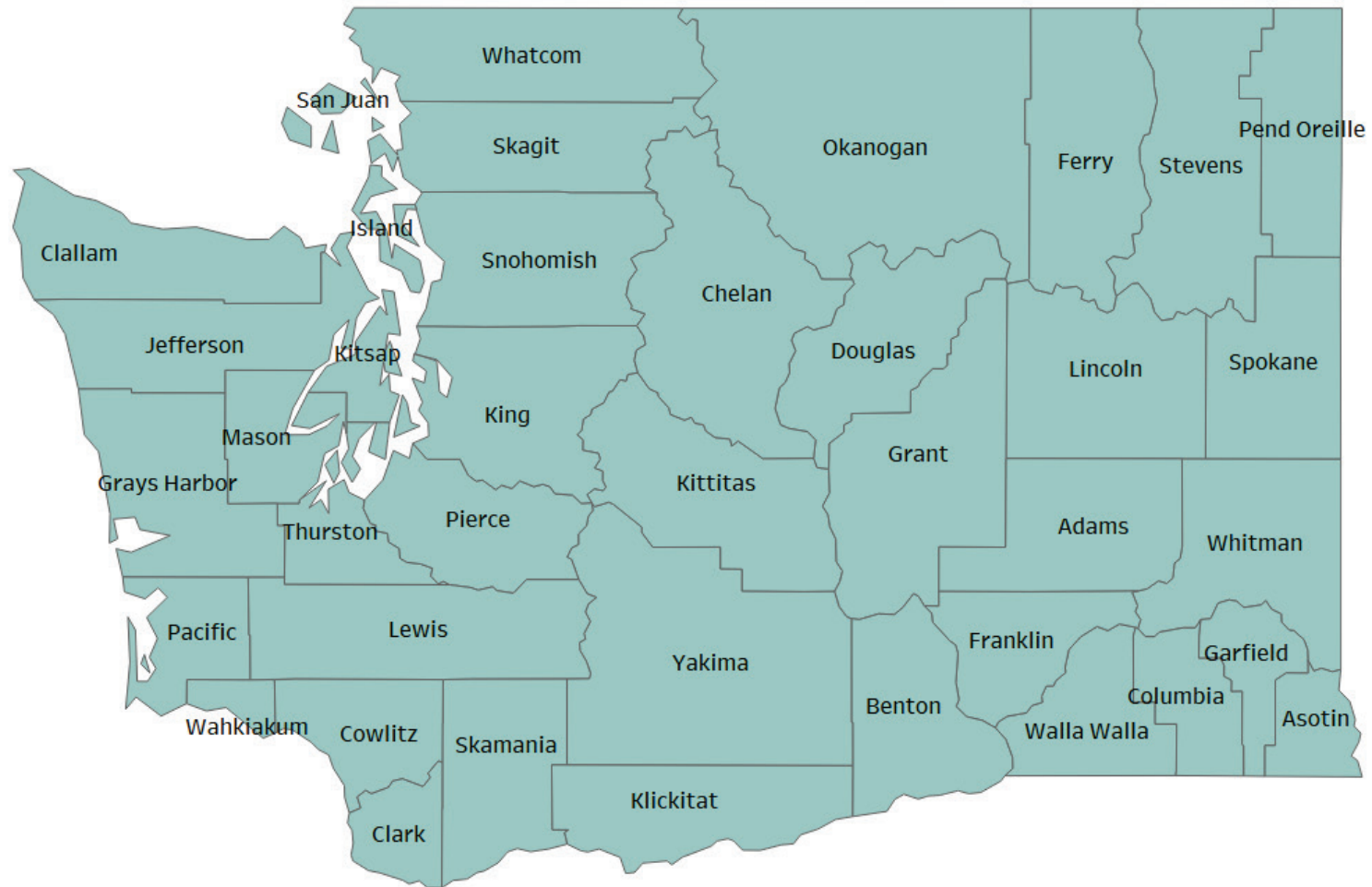
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## Map of Washington State Counties

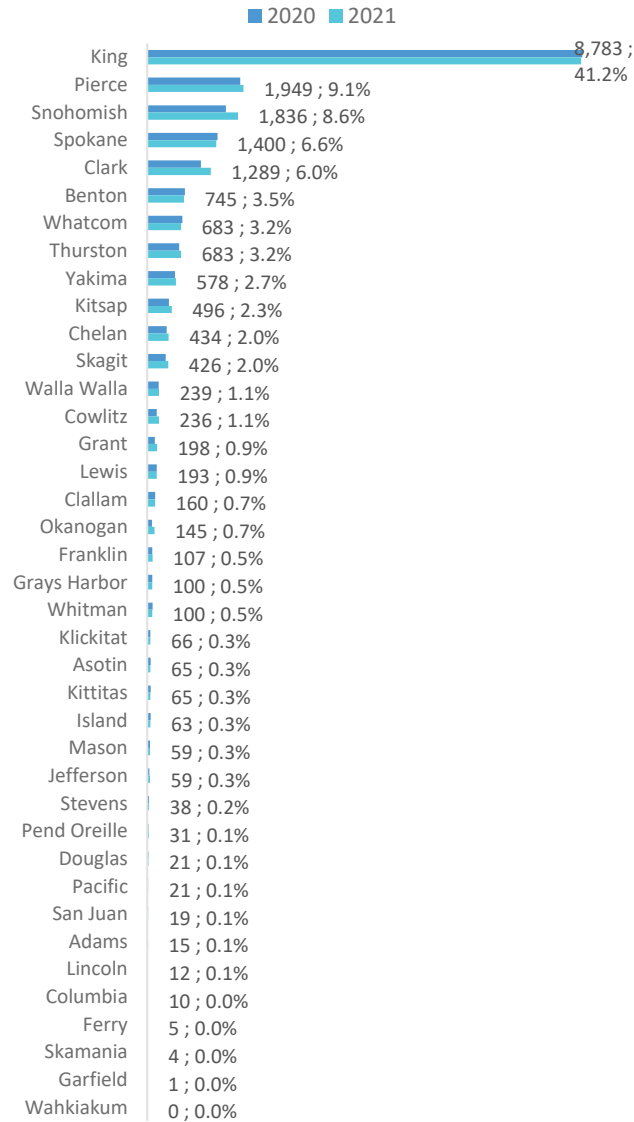

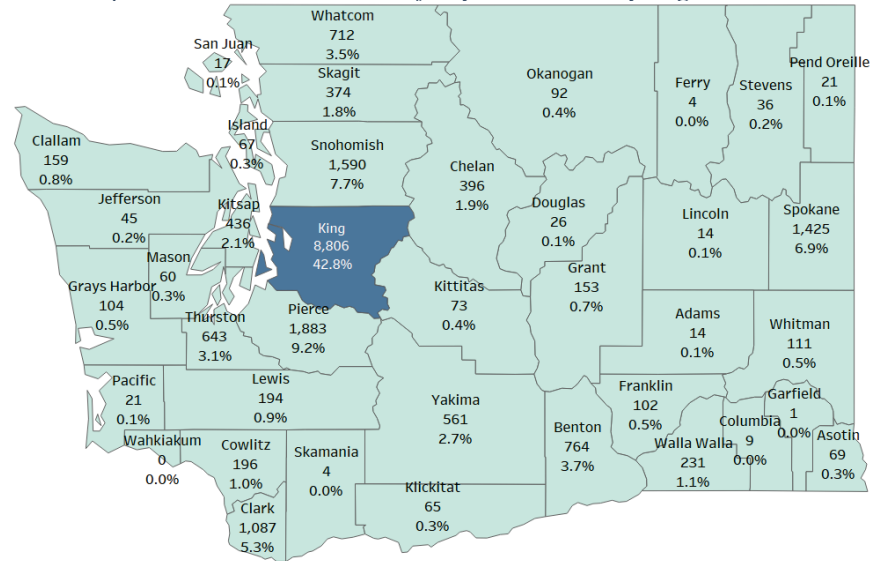

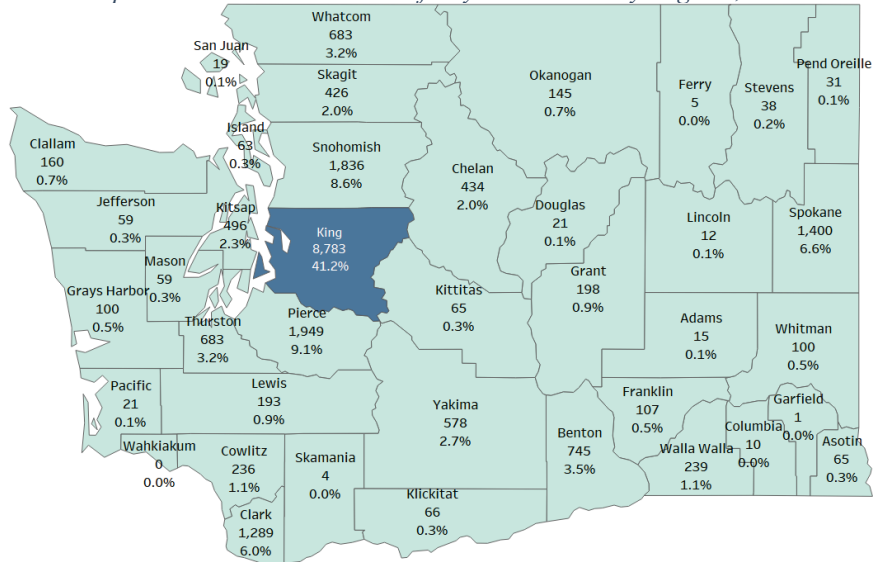
Figure C1. Number and Percent of Physicians by County: 2019 and 2020

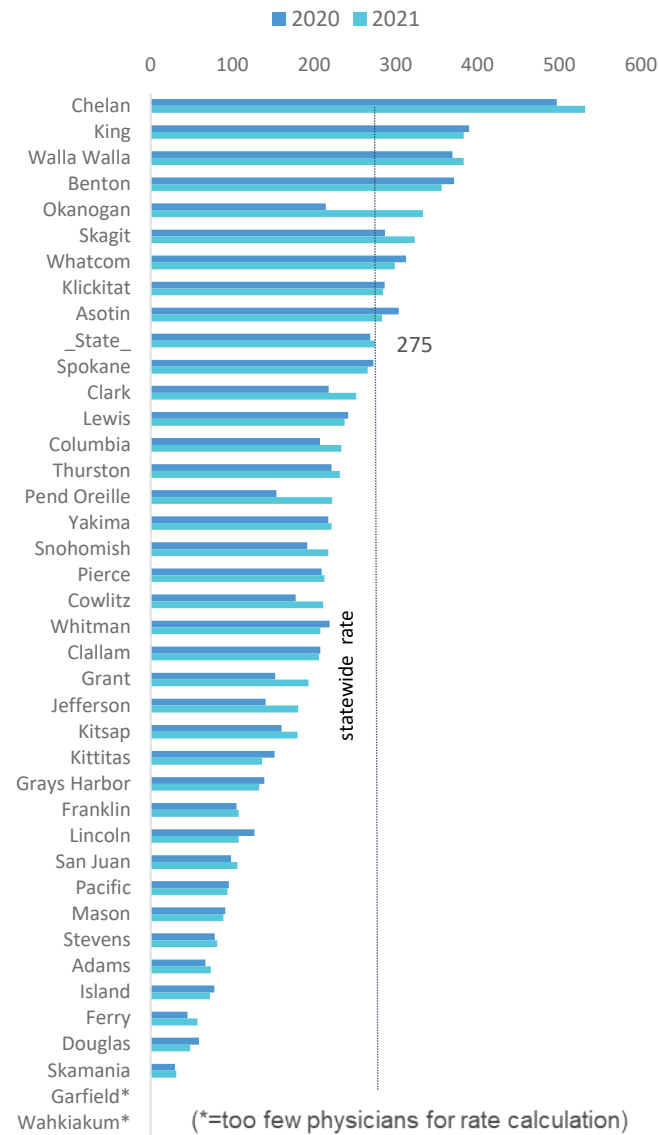

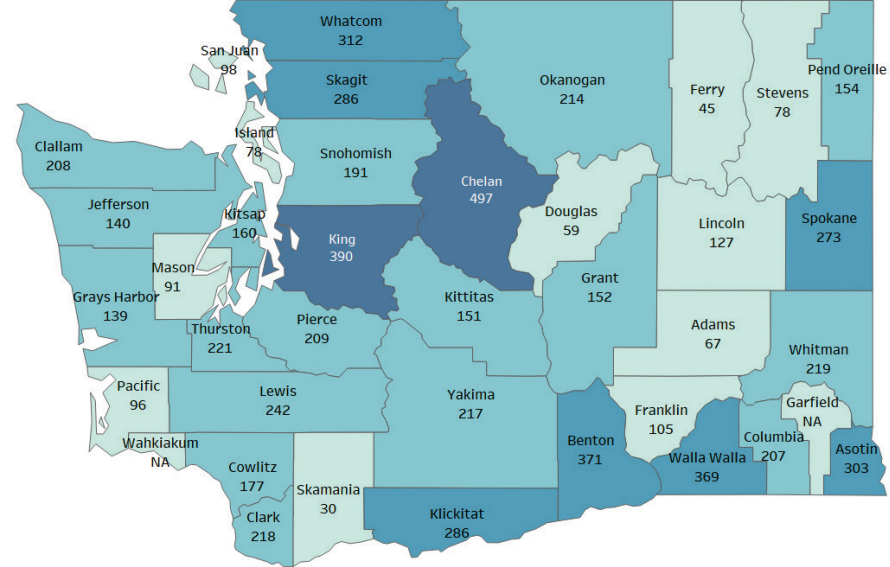

## Overall Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

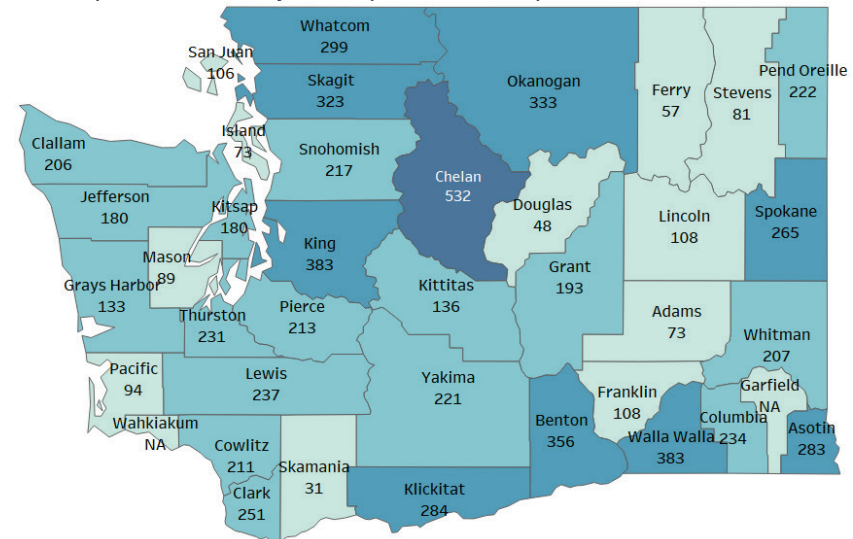
Figure C2. Overall Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C3. Overall Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020



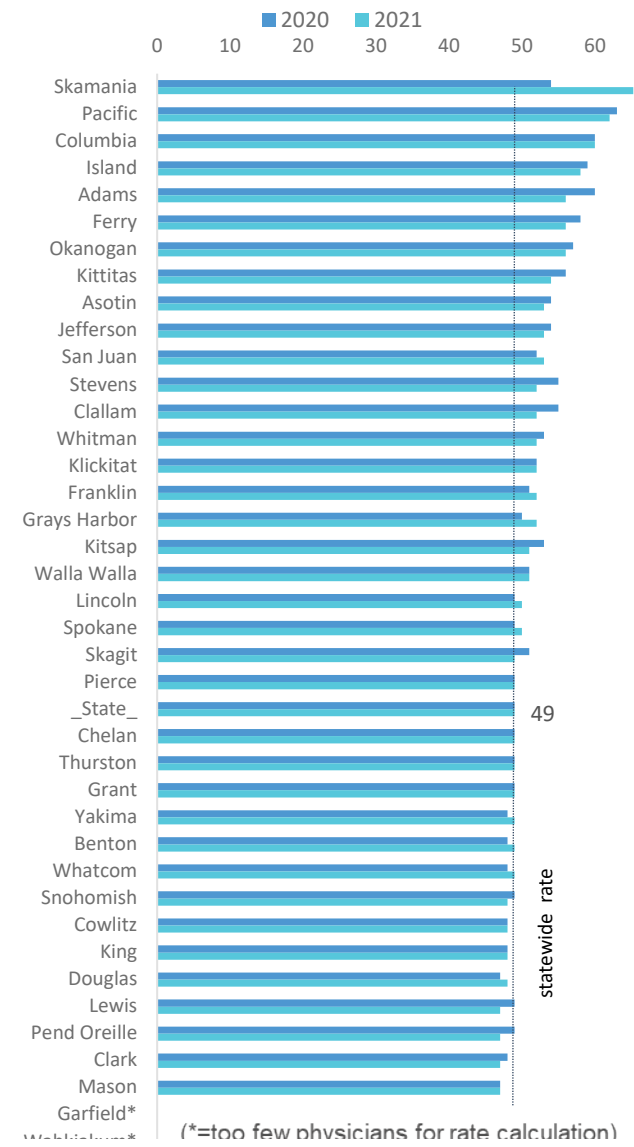
Map C4. Overall Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021



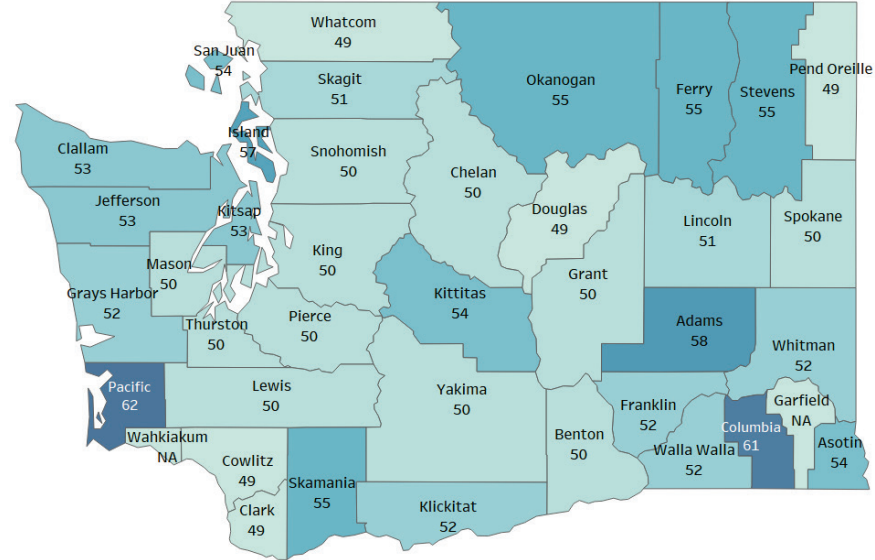


# Physician Median Age by County: 2020 and 2021

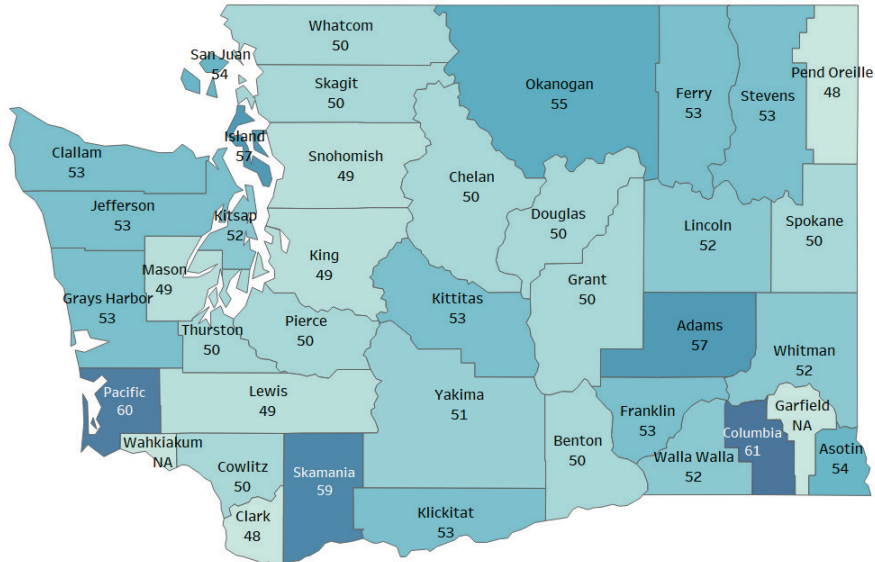
Figure C3. Physician Median Age by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C5. Median Age of Physicians: Counties, 2020

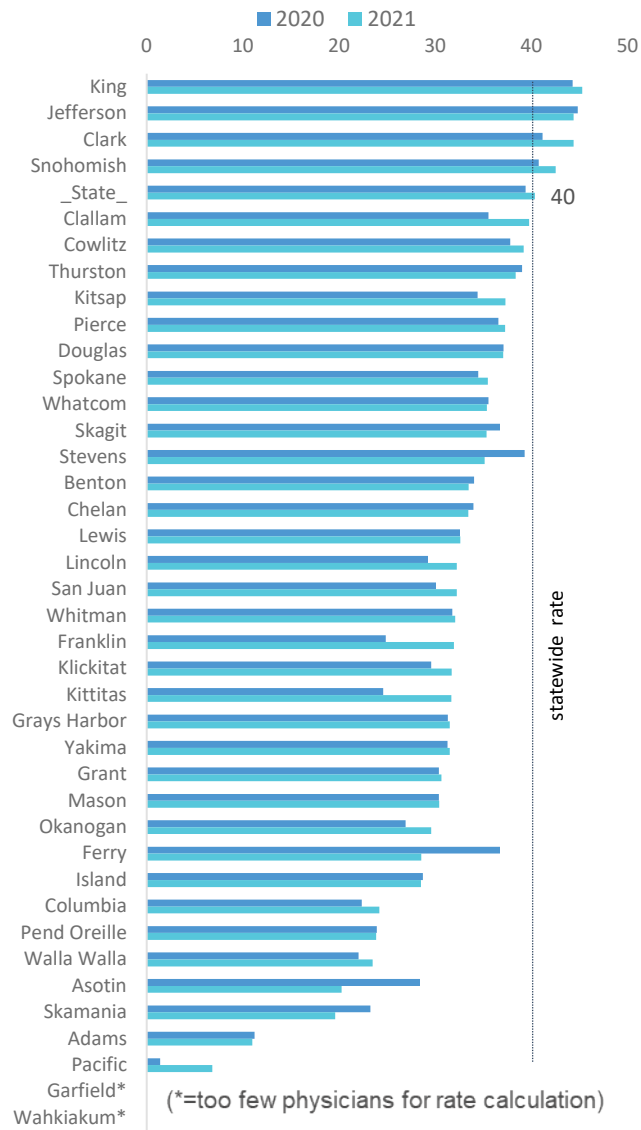


Map C6. Median Age of Physicians: Counties, 2021

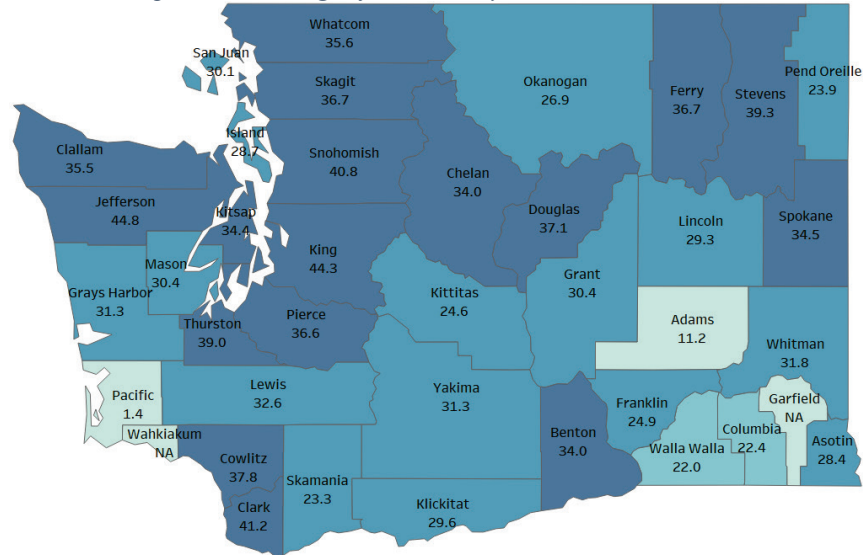


# Percentage of Female Physicians by County: 2020 and 2021

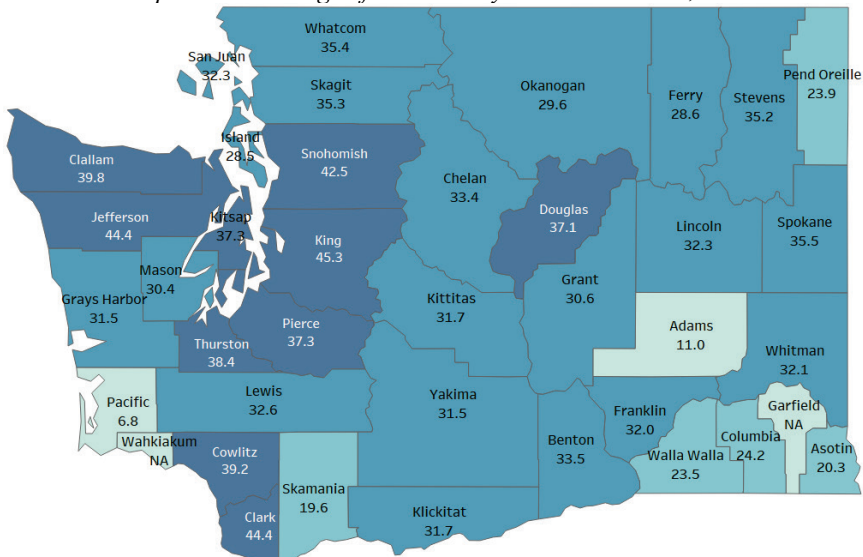
Figure C4. Percentage of Female Physicians by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C7. Percentage of Female Physicians: Counties, 2020

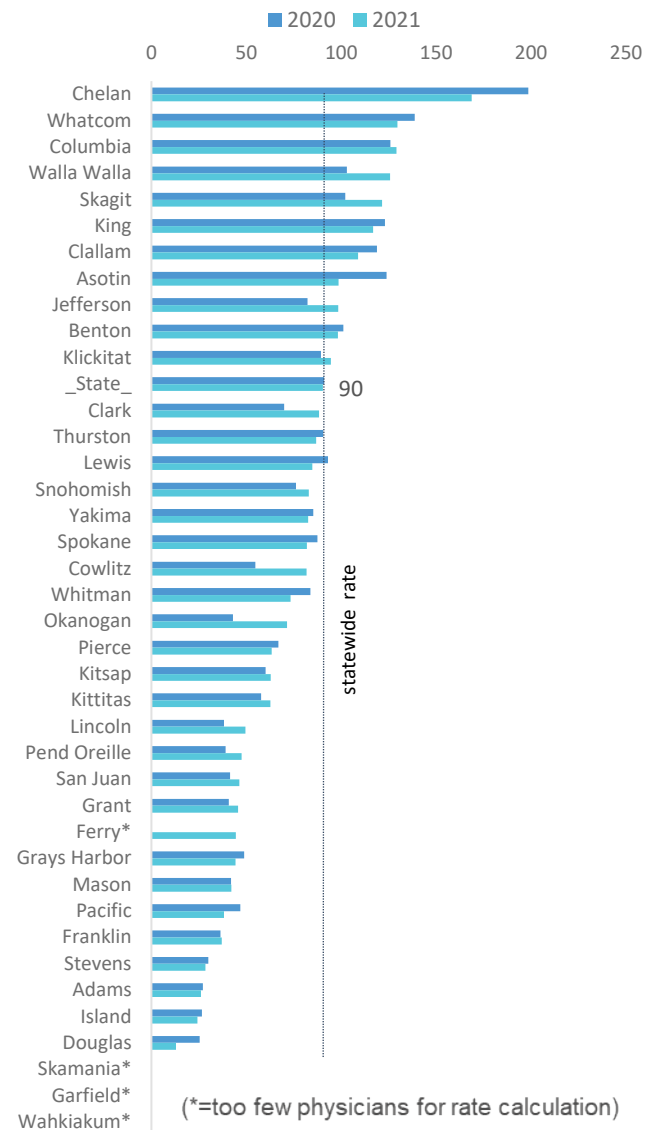


Map C8. Percentage of Female Physicians: Counties, 2021

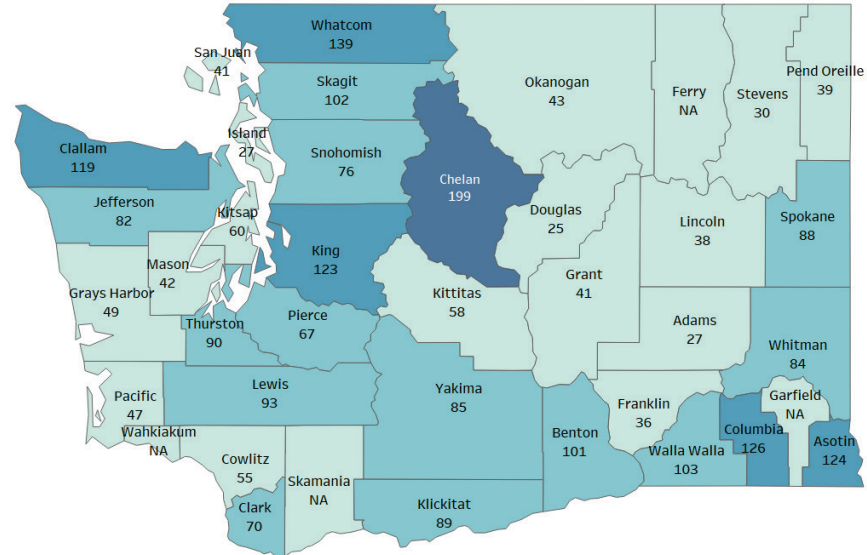


## PCP Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

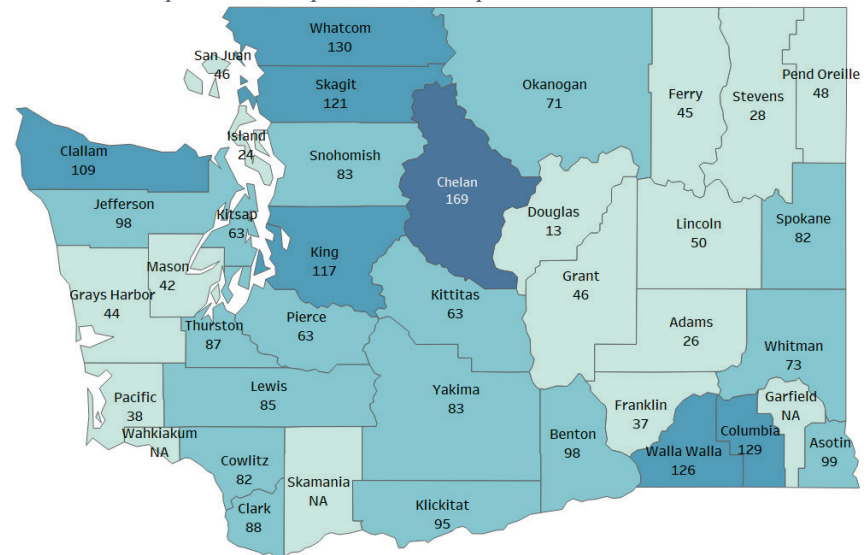
Figure C5. PCP Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C9. PCPs per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

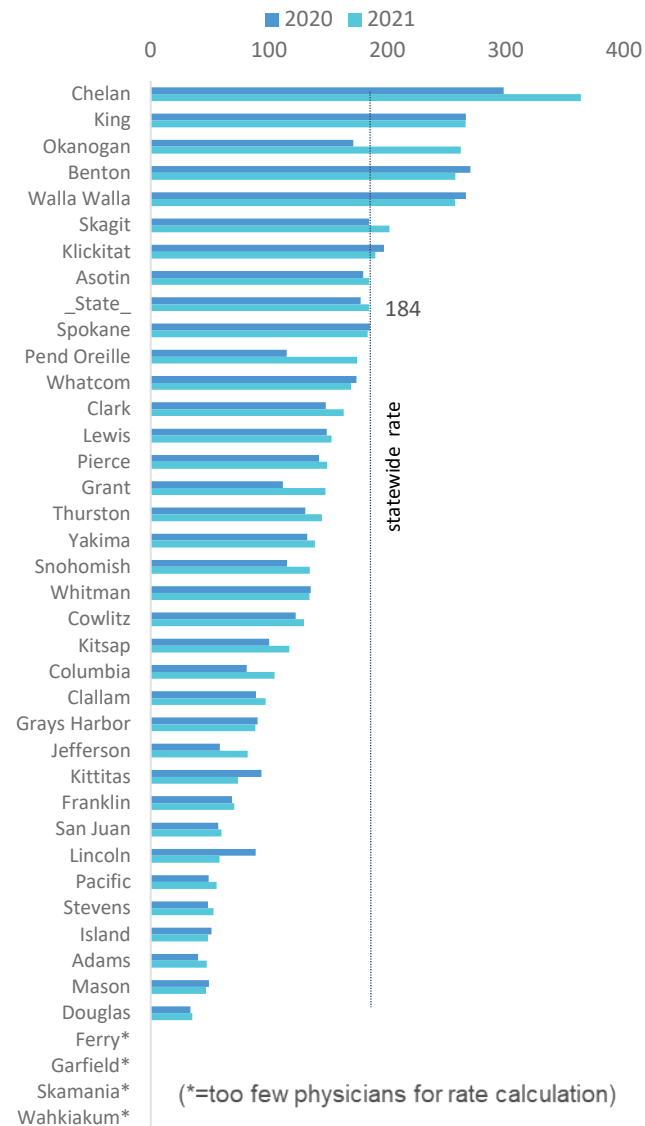


Map C10. PCPs per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

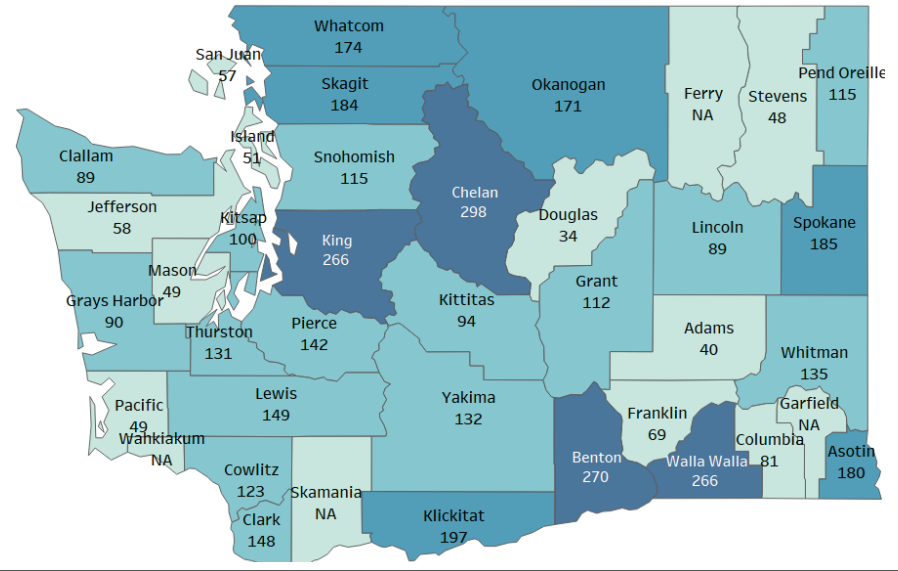


## Specialist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

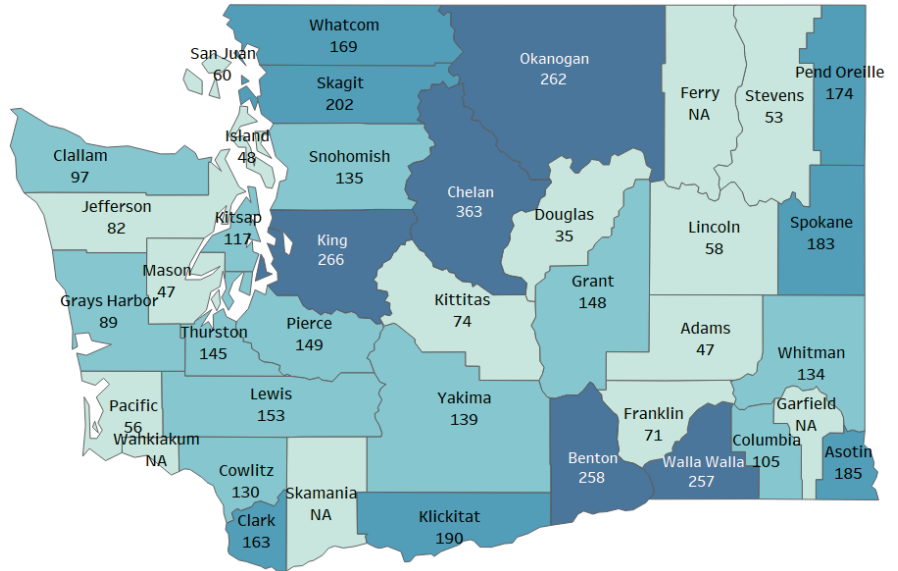
Figure C6. Specialist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C11. Specialists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

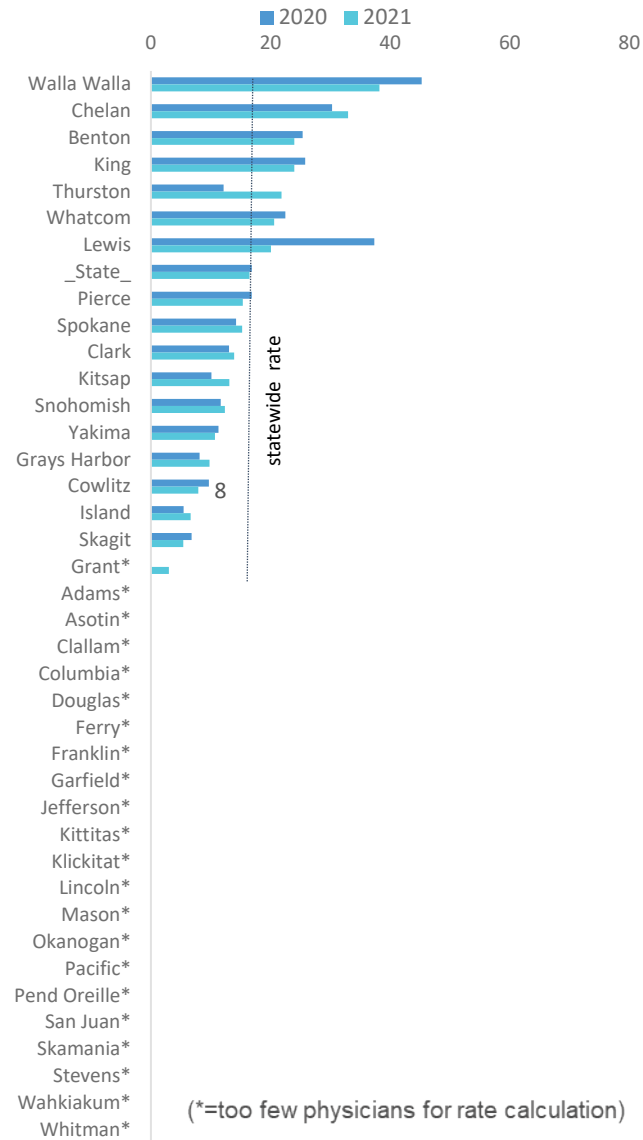


Map C12. Specialists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

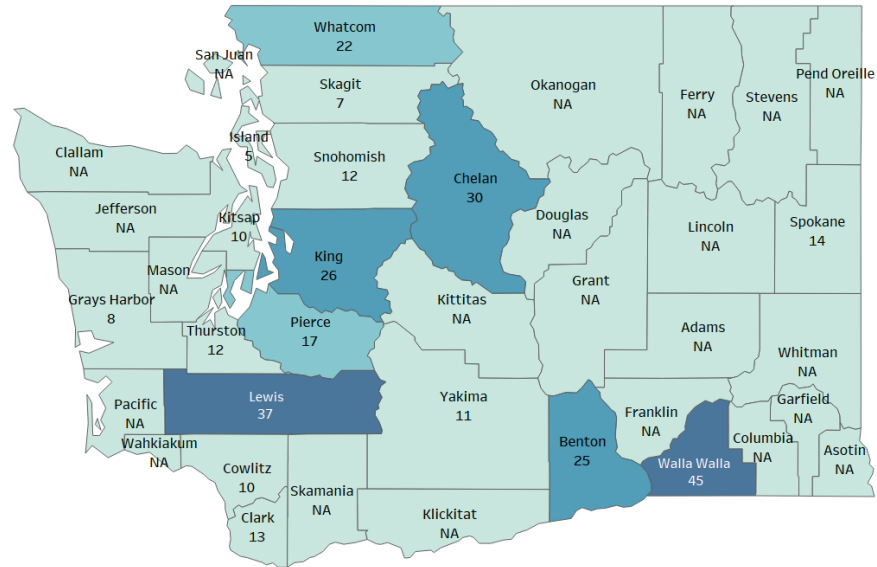


# Anesthesiologist Rates (Per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021

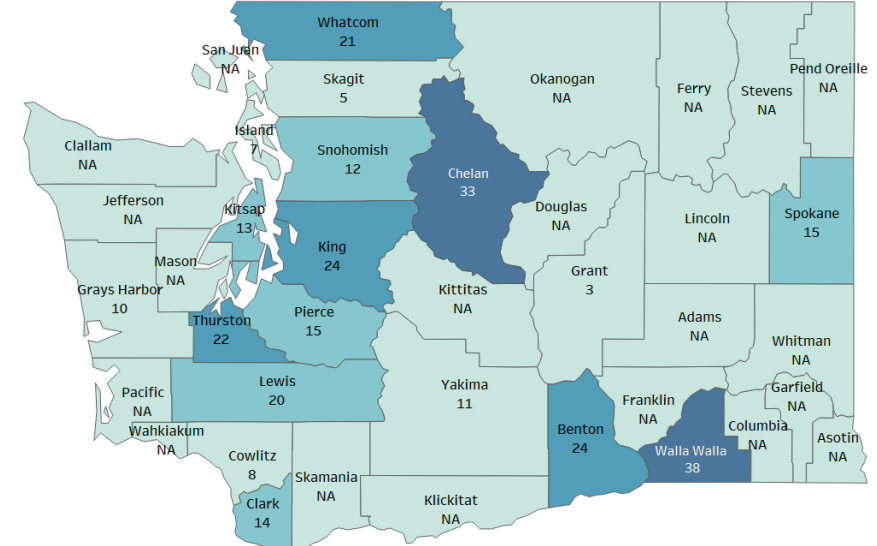
Figure C7. Anesthesiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C13. Anesthesiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

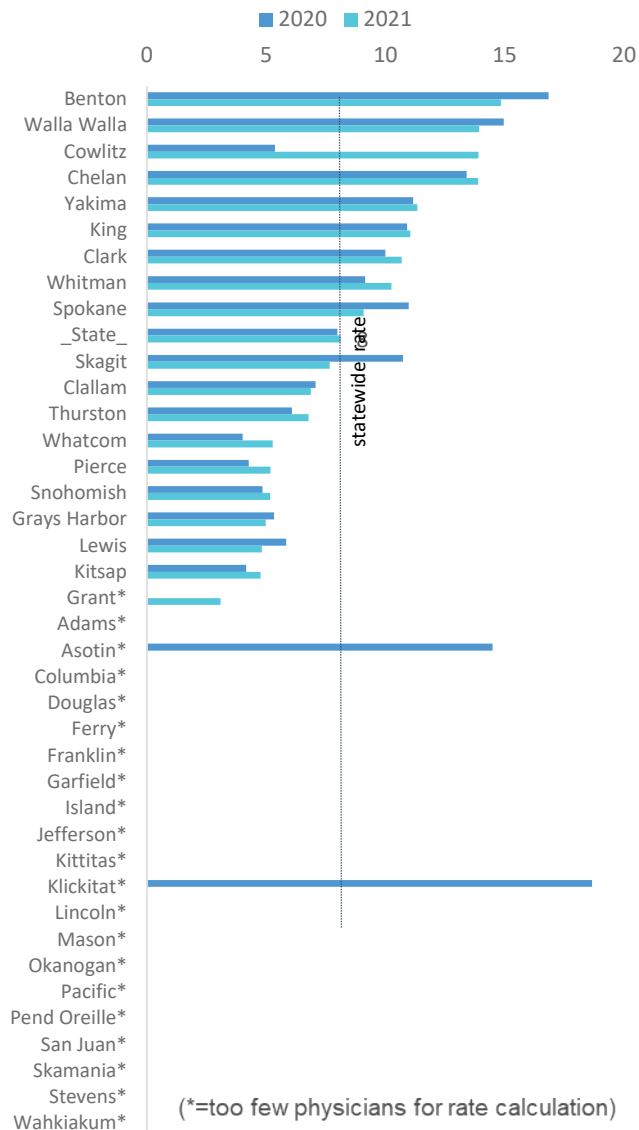


Map C14. Anesthesiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

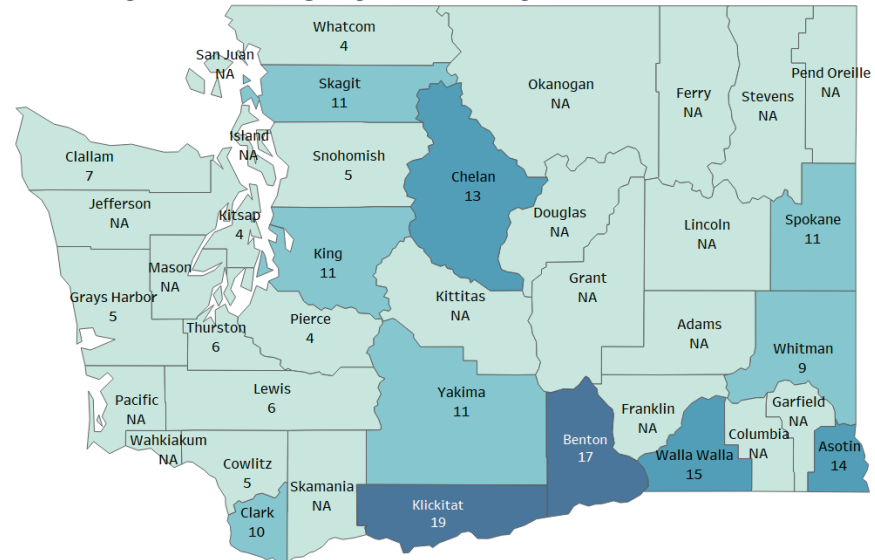


## Cardiologist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

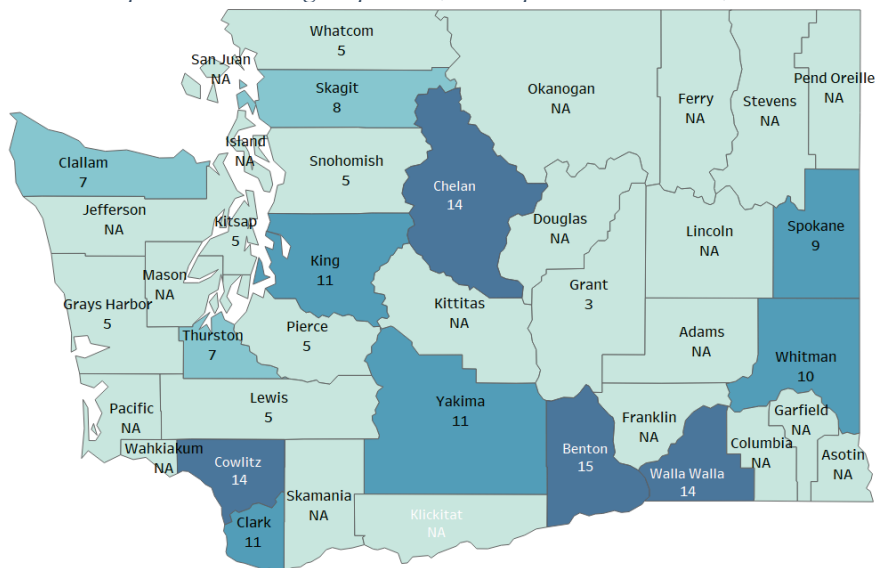
Figure C8. Cardiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C15. Cardiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

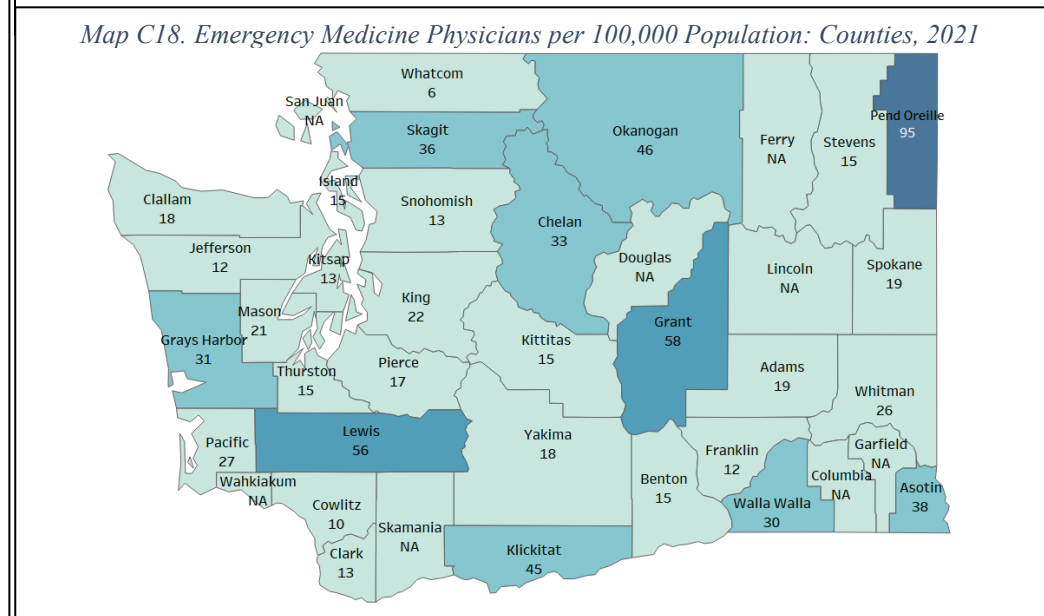
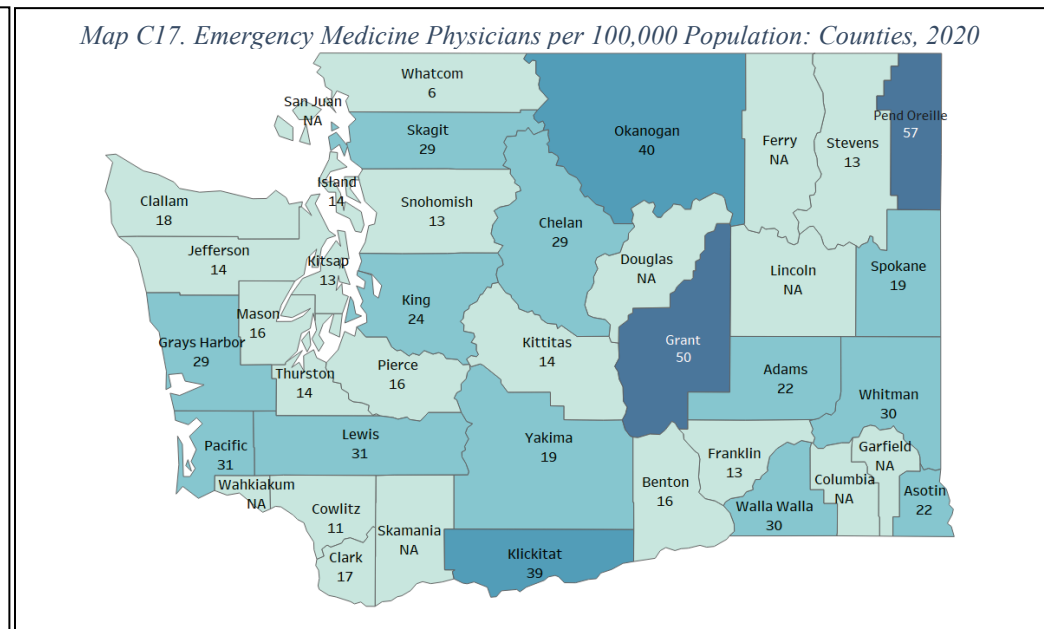
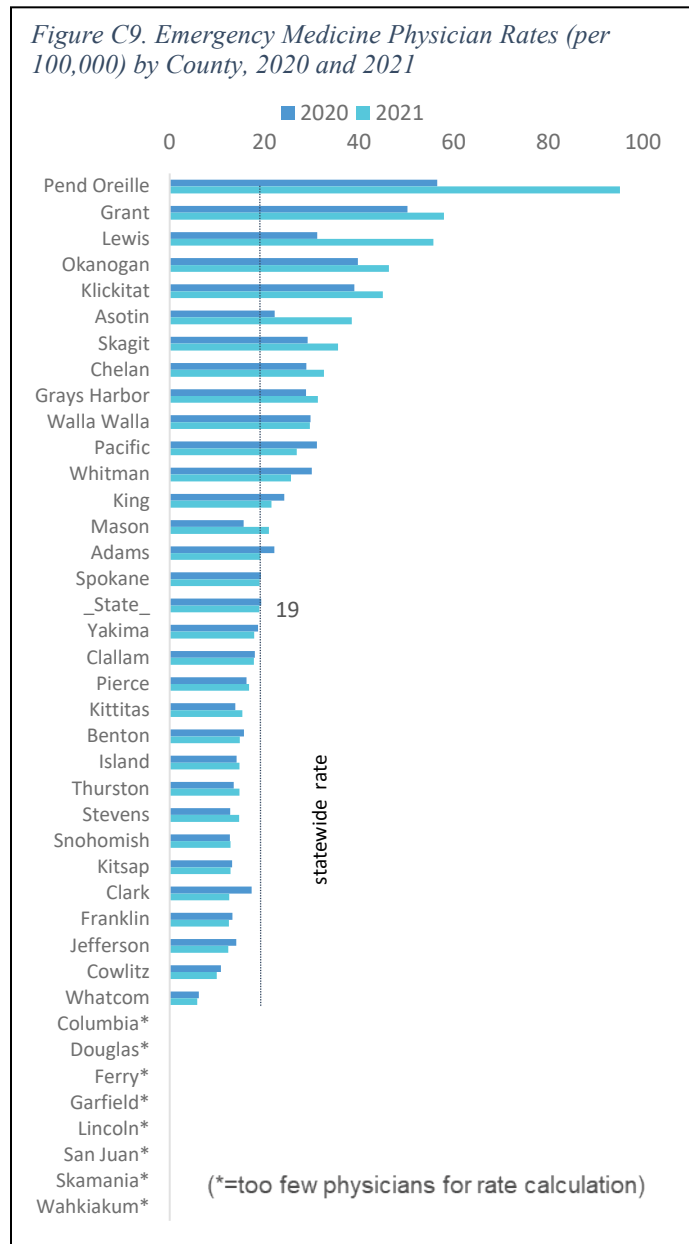


Map C16. Cardiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021



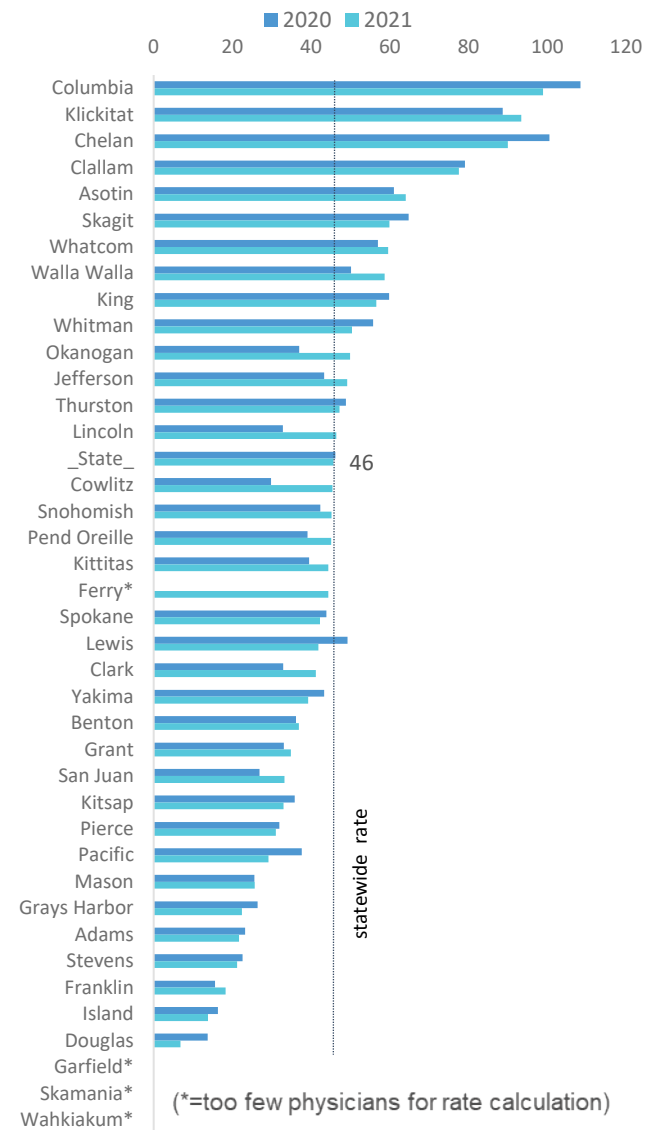


## Emergency Medicine Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

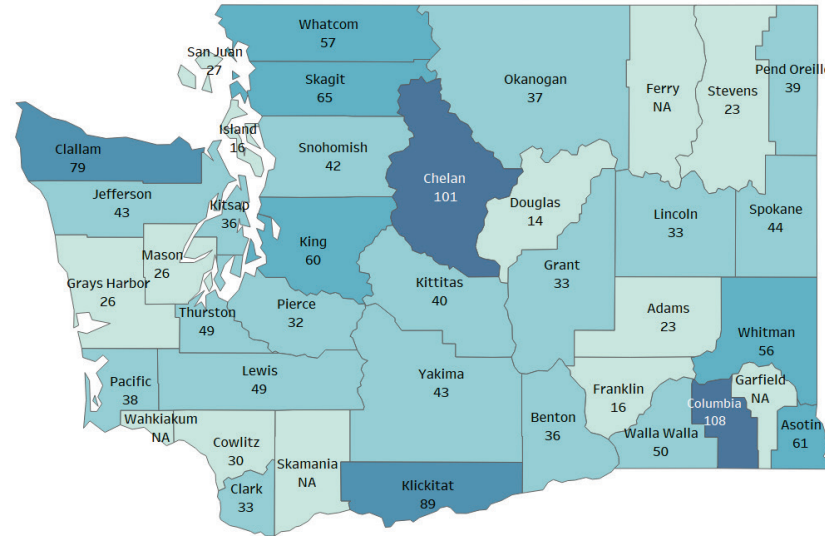

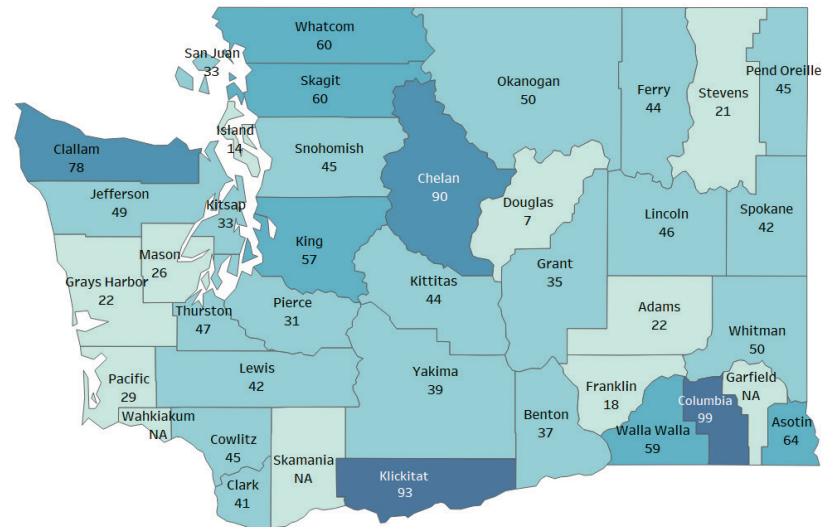
Figure C10. Family Medicine/General Practice Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C19. Family Medicine/General Practice Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020



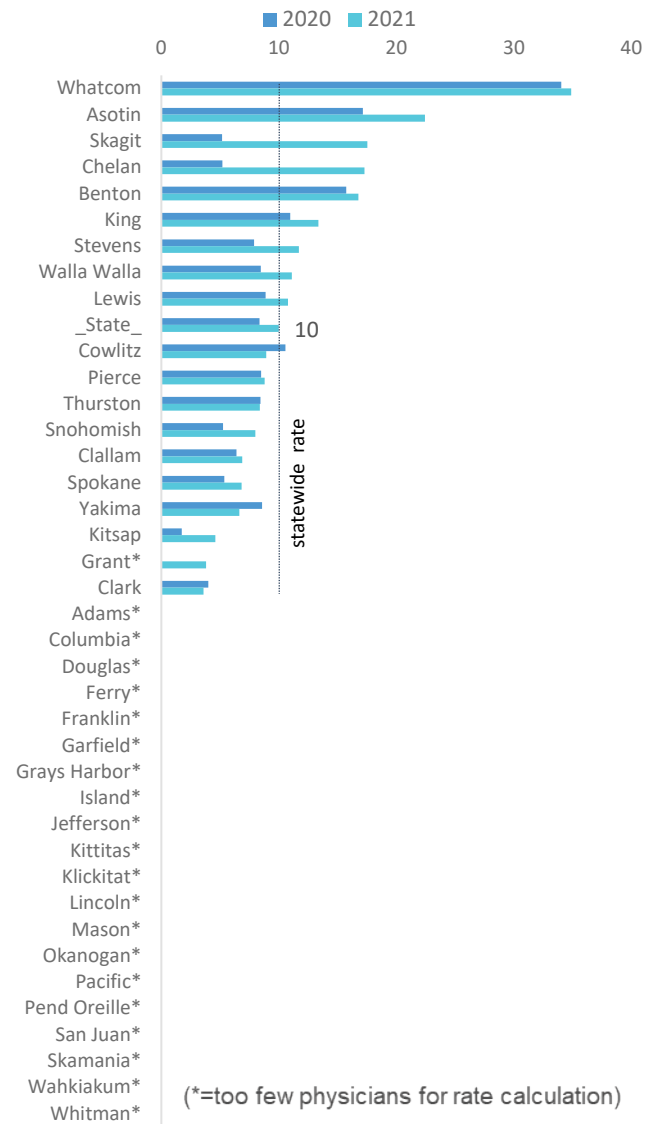
Map C20. Family Medicine/General Practice Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021



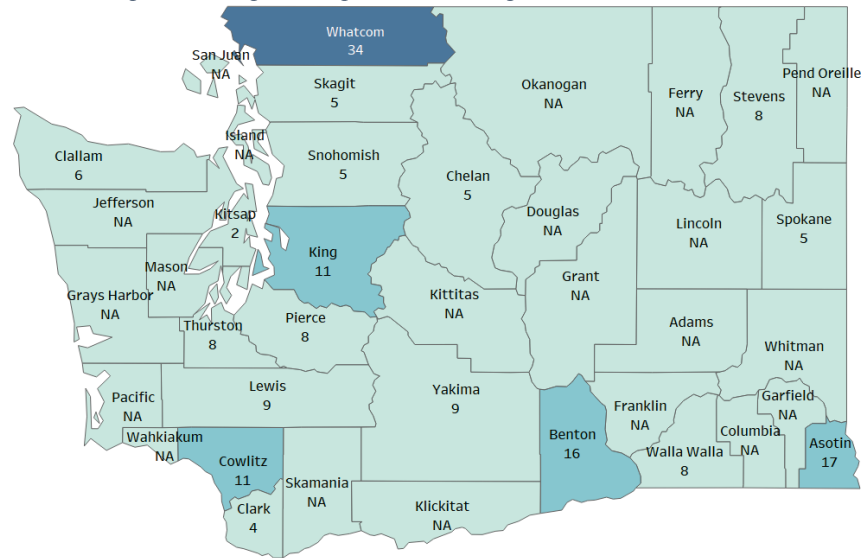


### Hospitalist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

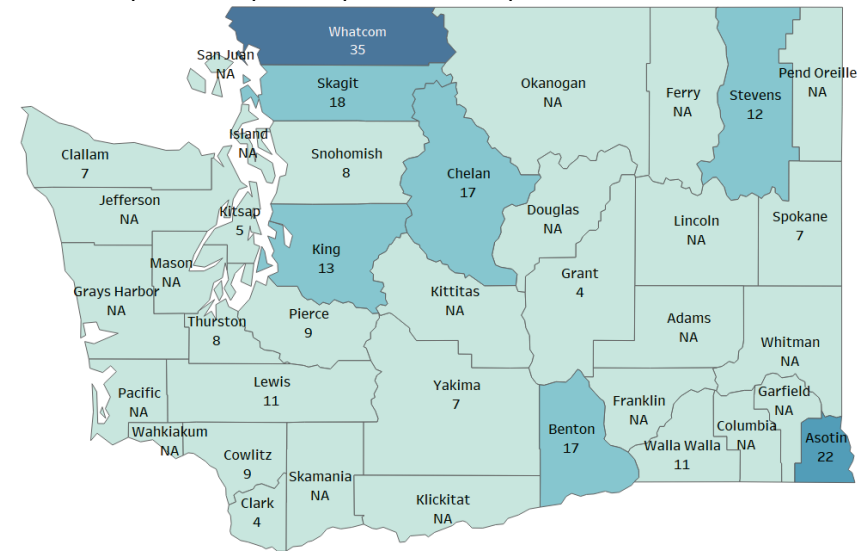
Figure C11. Hospitalist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C21. Hospitalists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

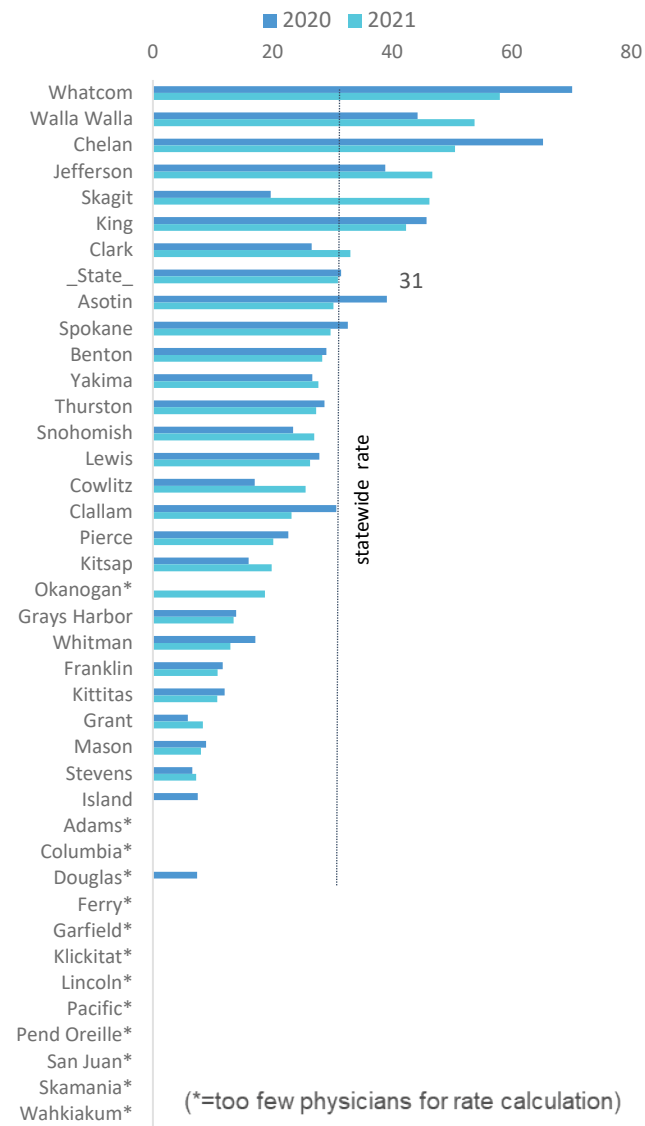


Map C22. Hospitalists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

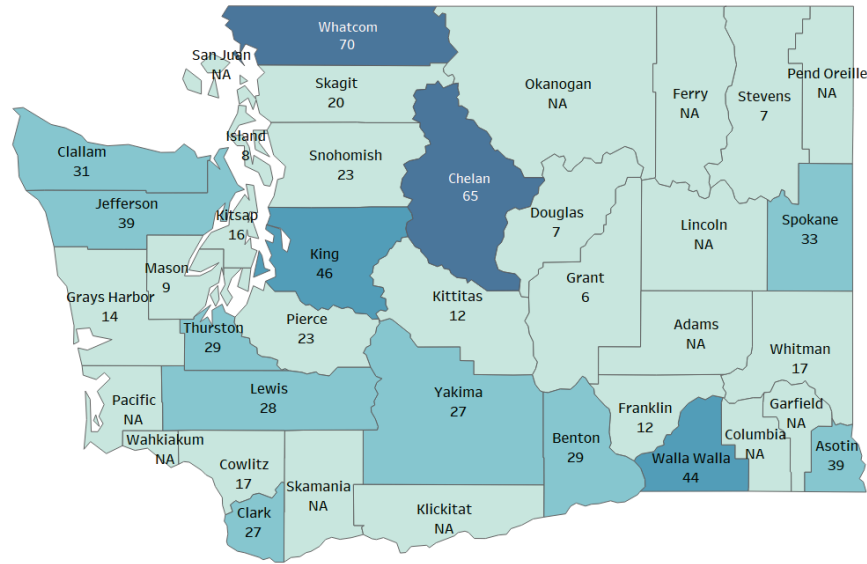


## Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

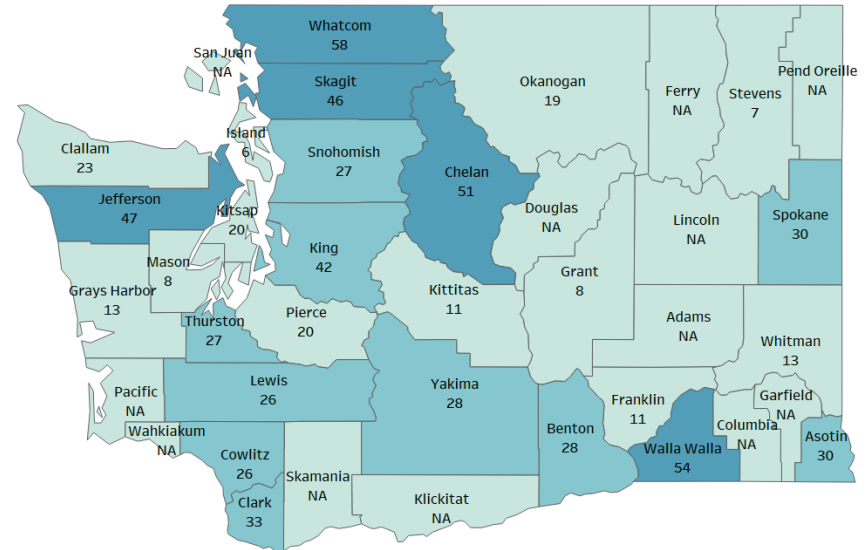
Figure C12. Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



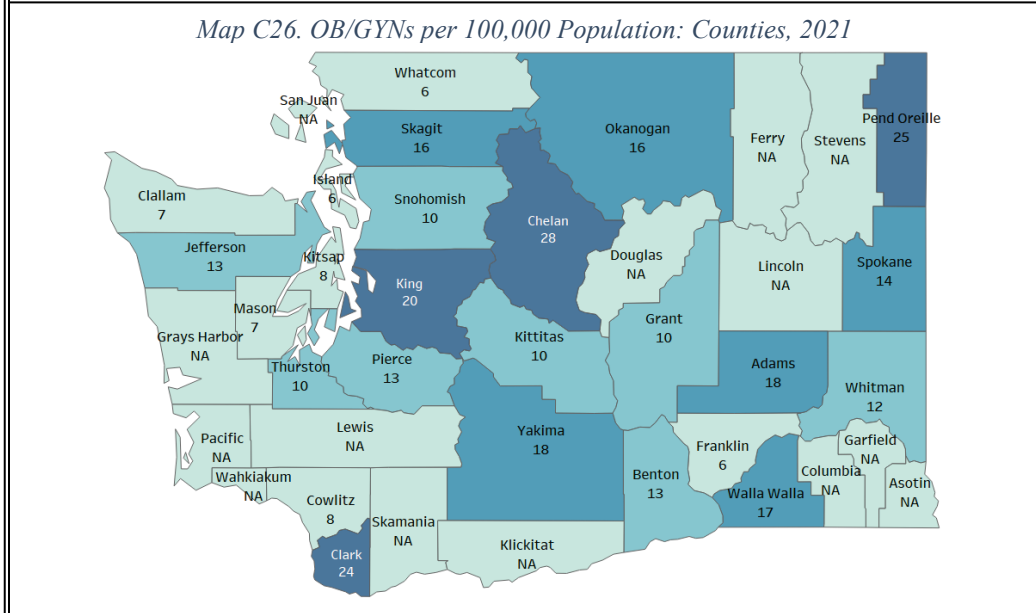
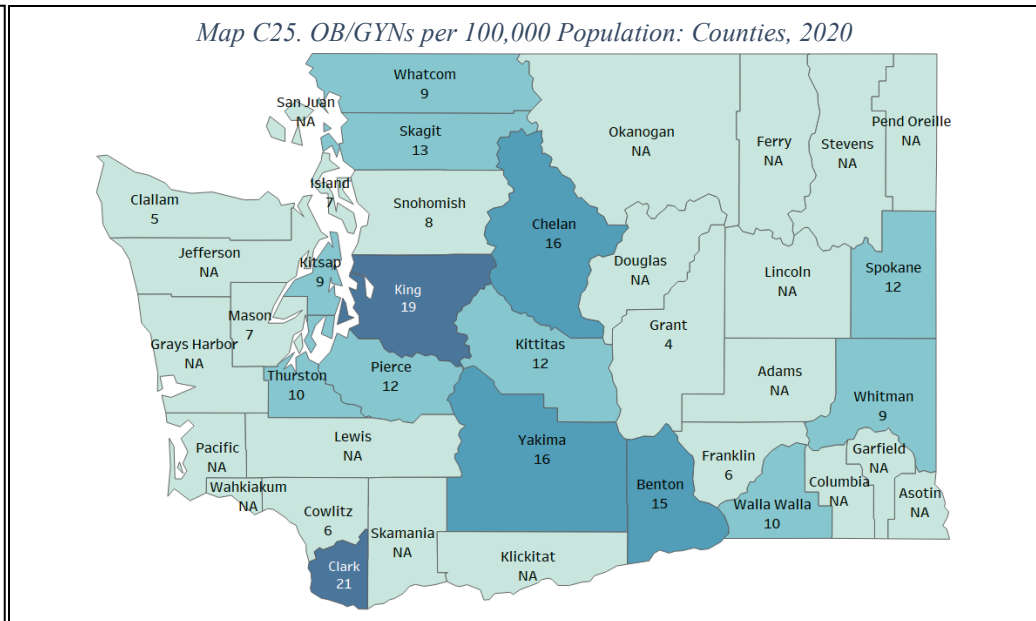
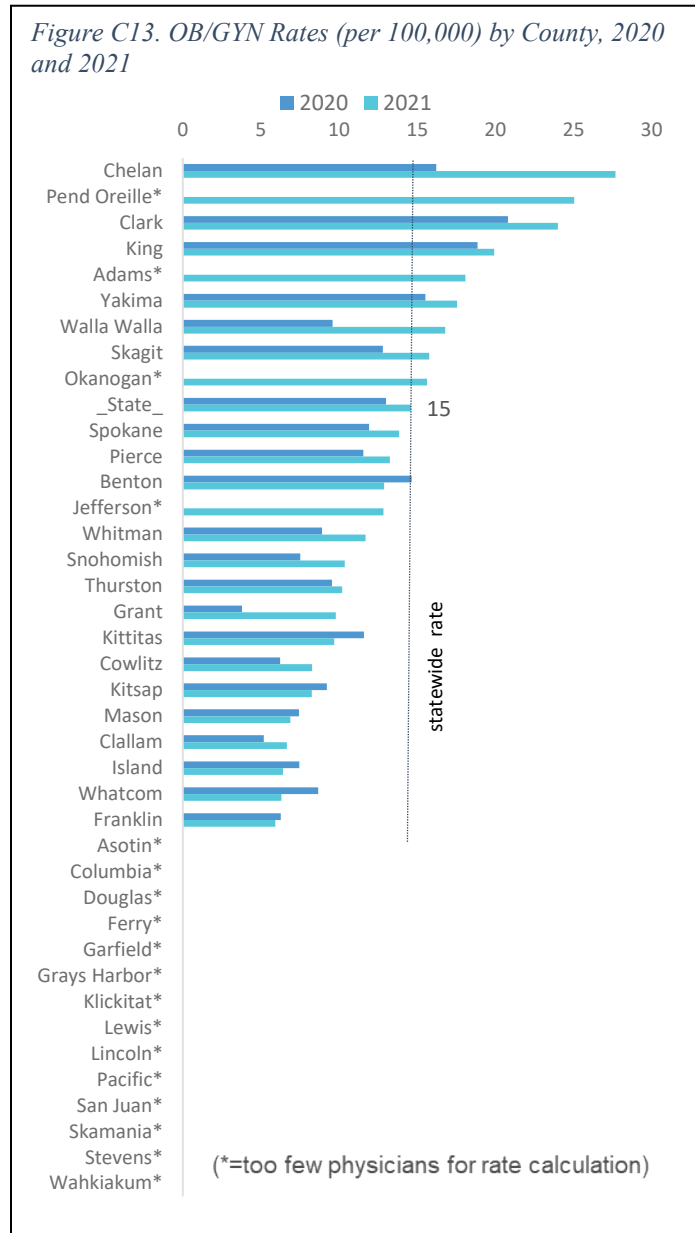
Map C23. Internal Medicine (General) Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020



Map C24. Internal Medicine (General) Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

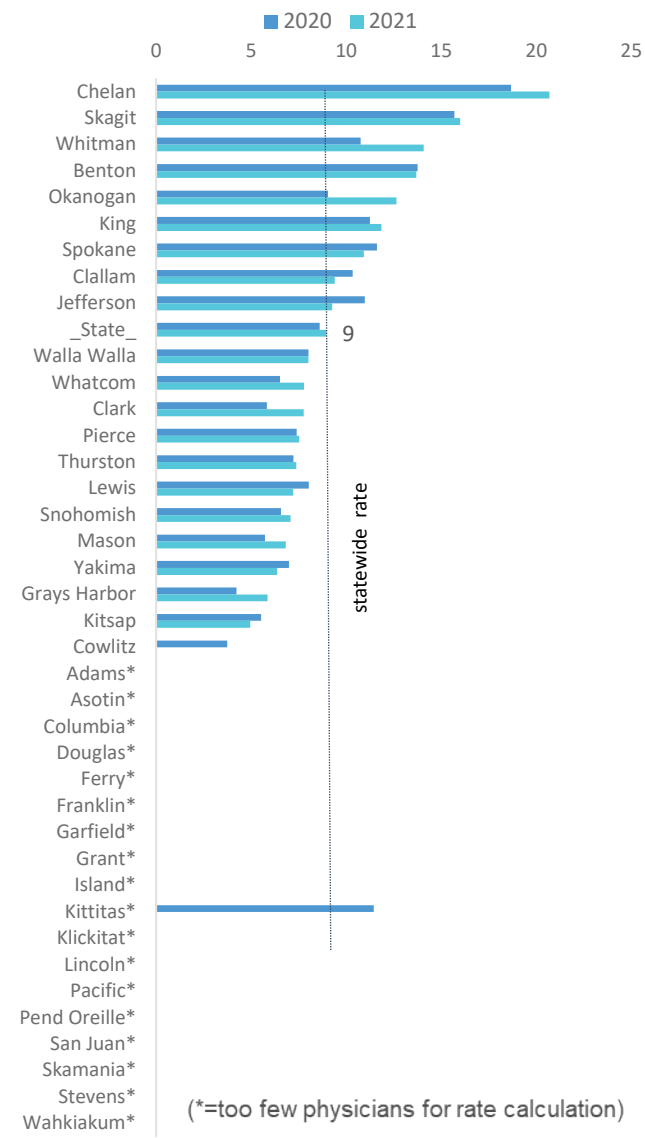


## OB/GYN Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

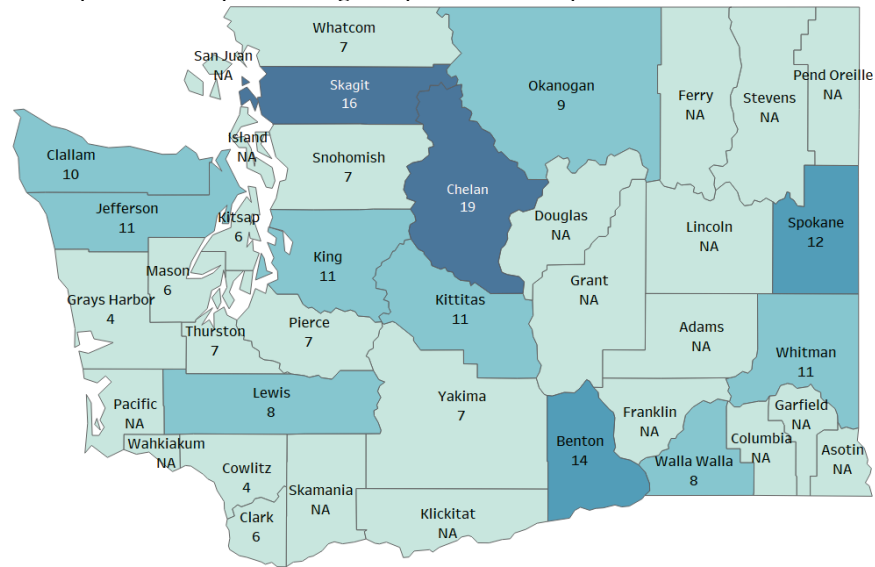


# Orthopaedic Surgeon Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

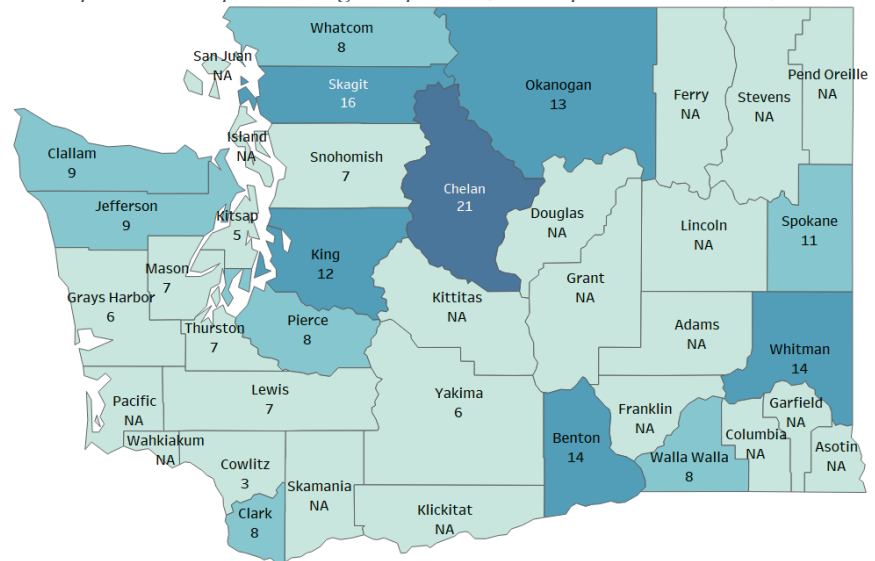
Figure C14. Orthopaedic Surgeon Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C27. Orthopaedic Surgeons per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

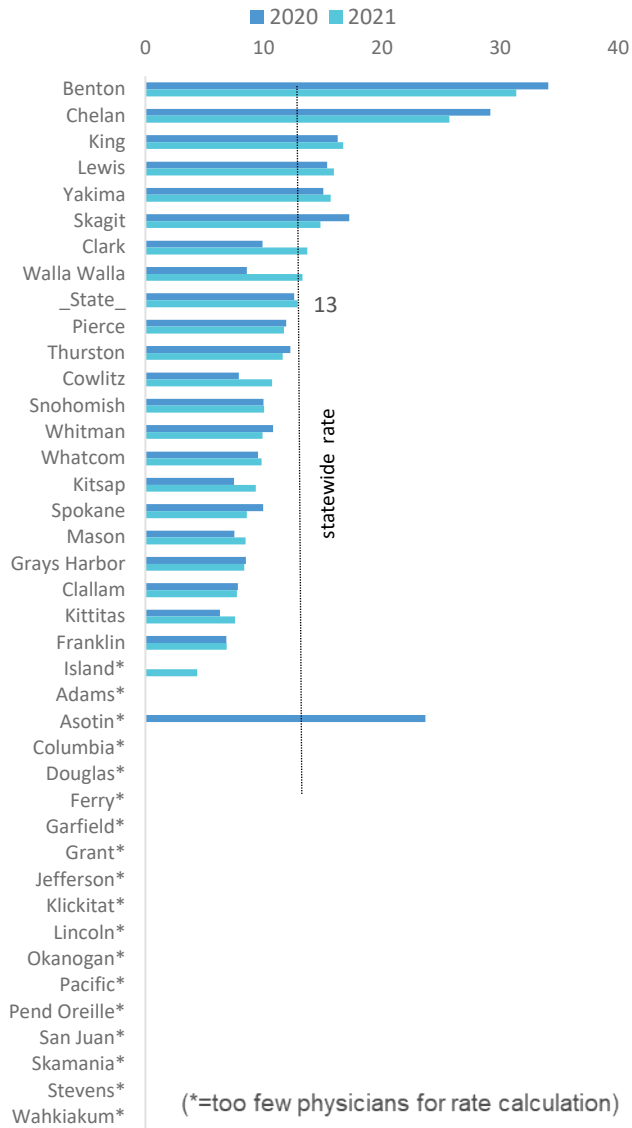


Map C28. Orthopaedic Surgeons per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

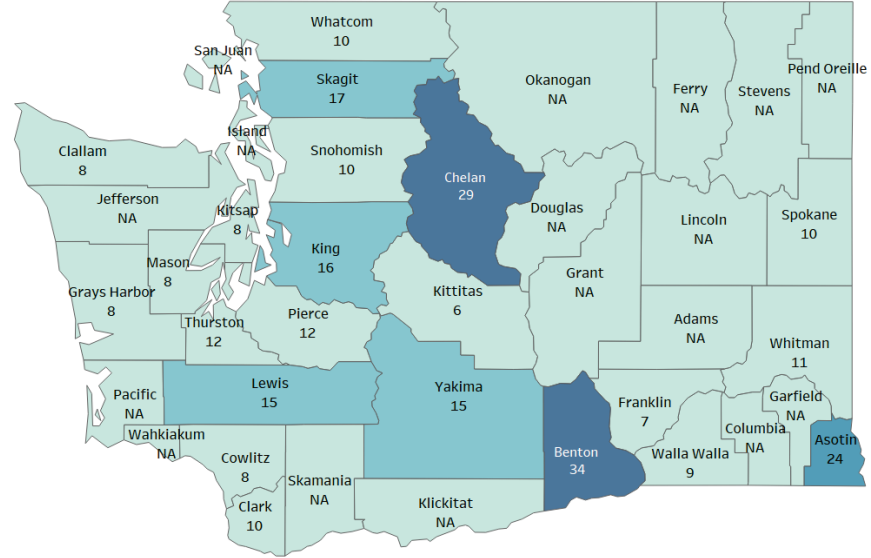


## Pediatrician (General) Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

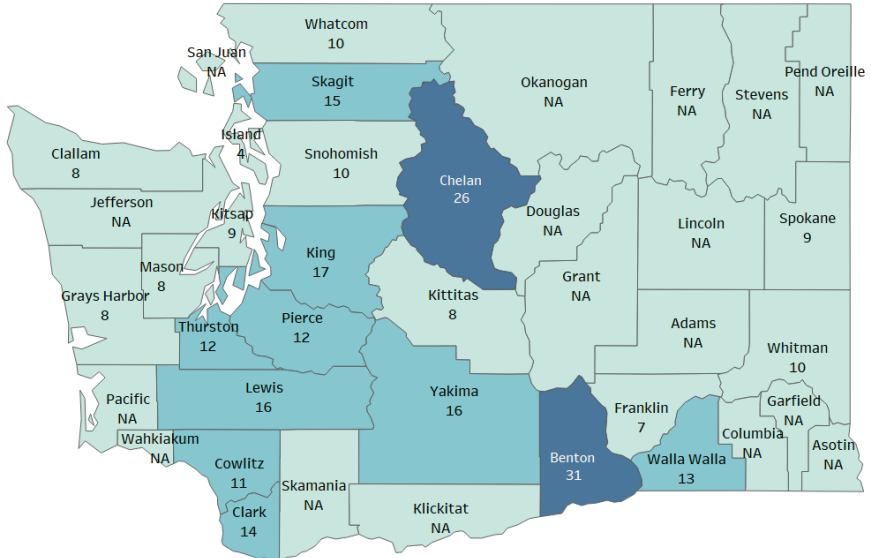
Figure C15. Pediatrician (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C29. Pediatricians (General) per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

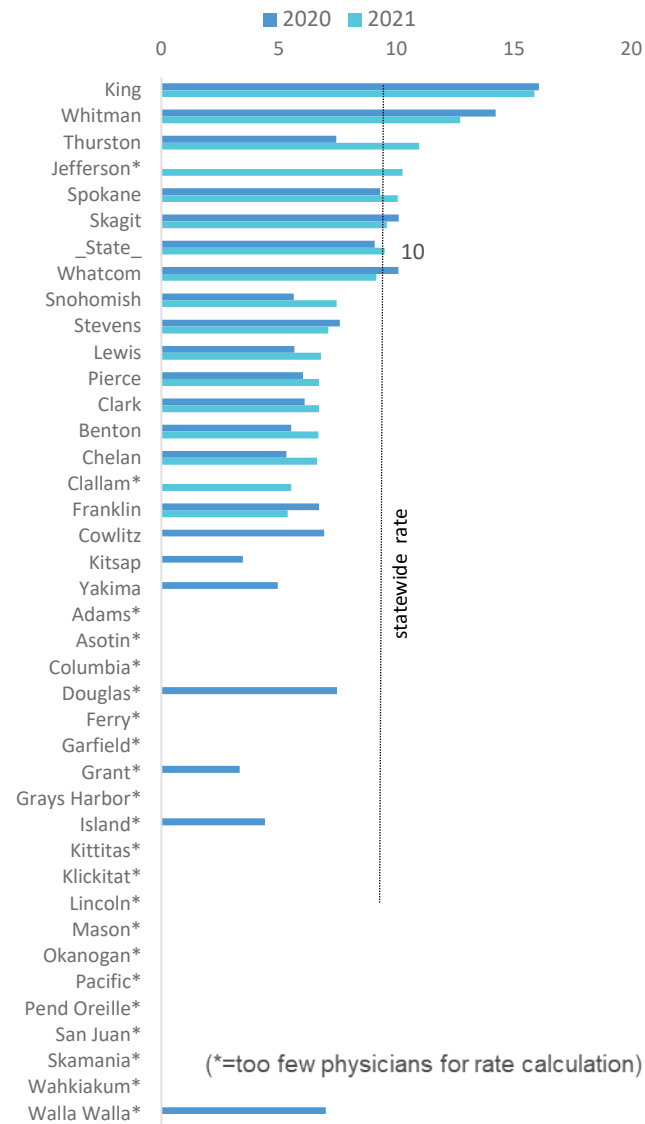


Map C30. Pediatricians (General) per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

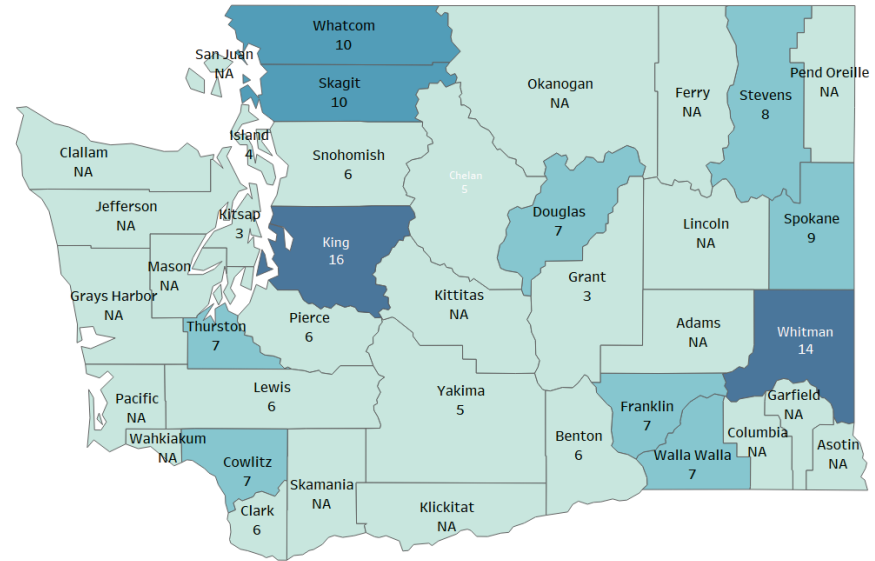


## Psychiatrist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

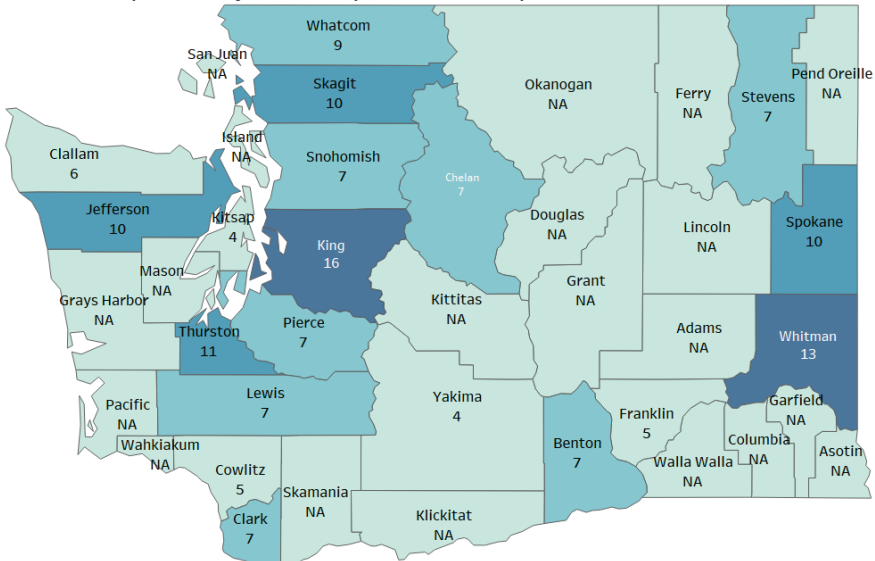
Figure C16. Psychiatrist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C31. Psychiatrists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

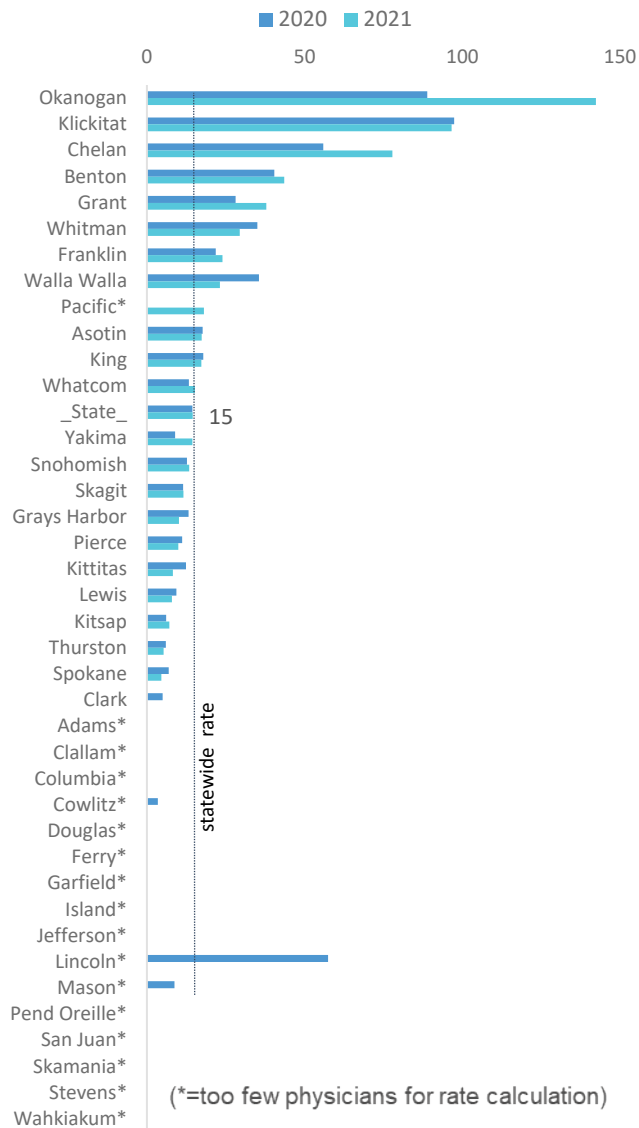


Map C32. Psychiatrists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

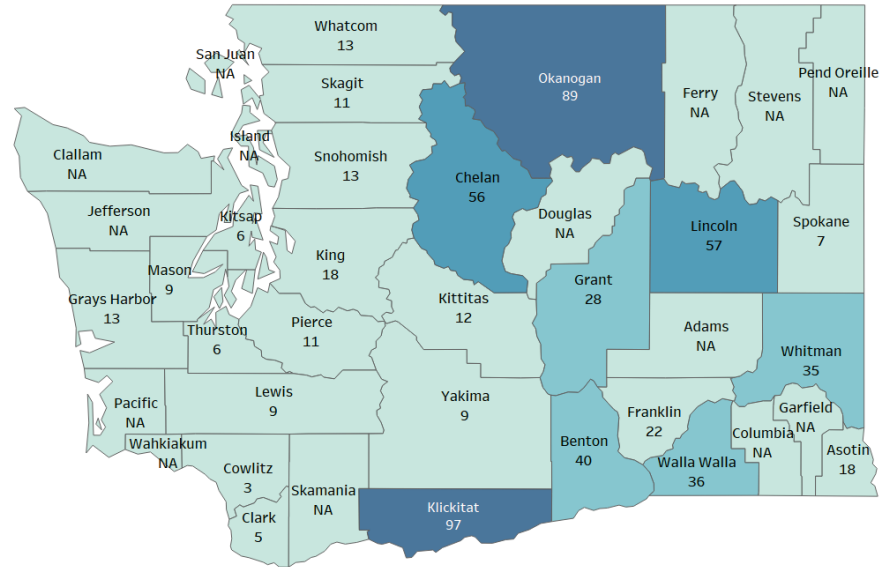


## Radiologist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

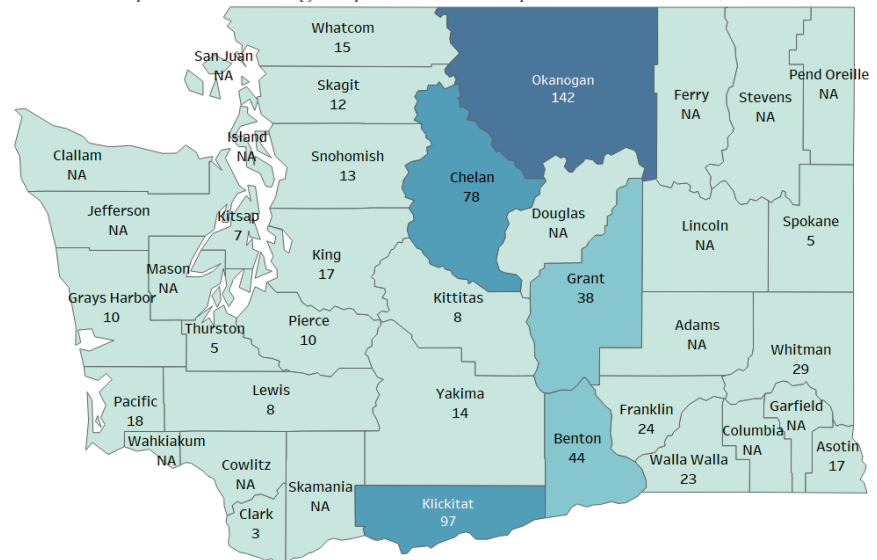
Figure C17. Radiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C33. Radiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020

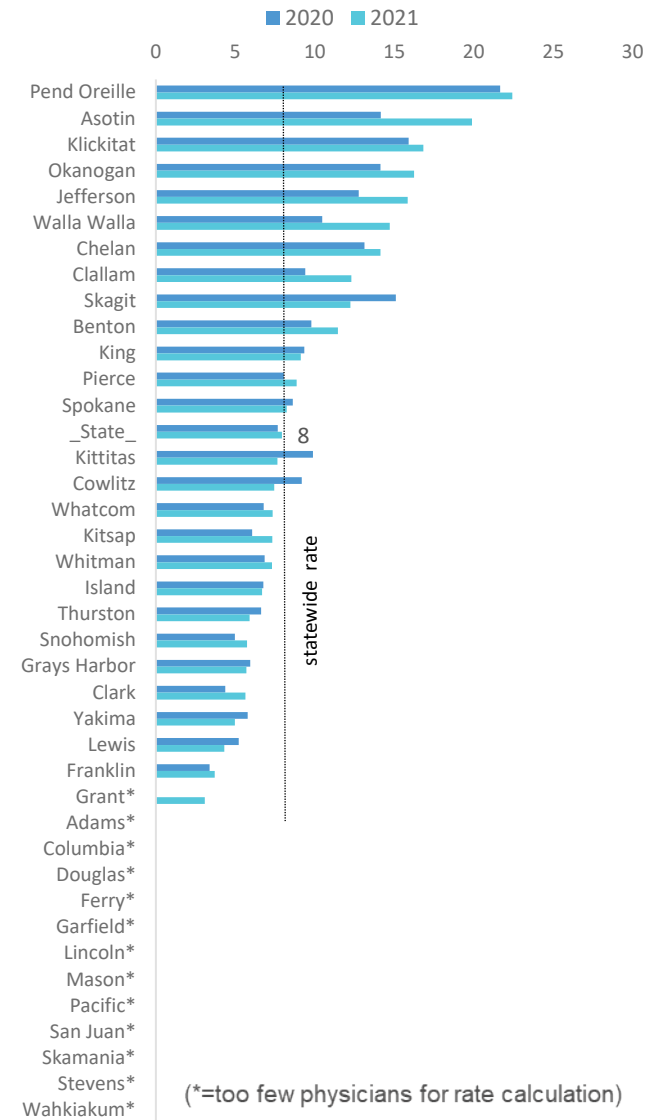


Map C34. Radiologists per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021

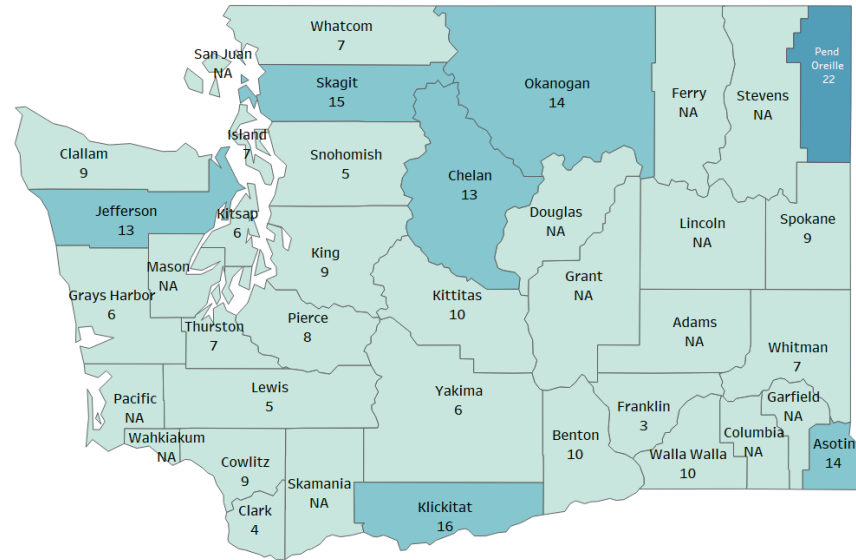


## Surgeon (General) Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2020 and 2021

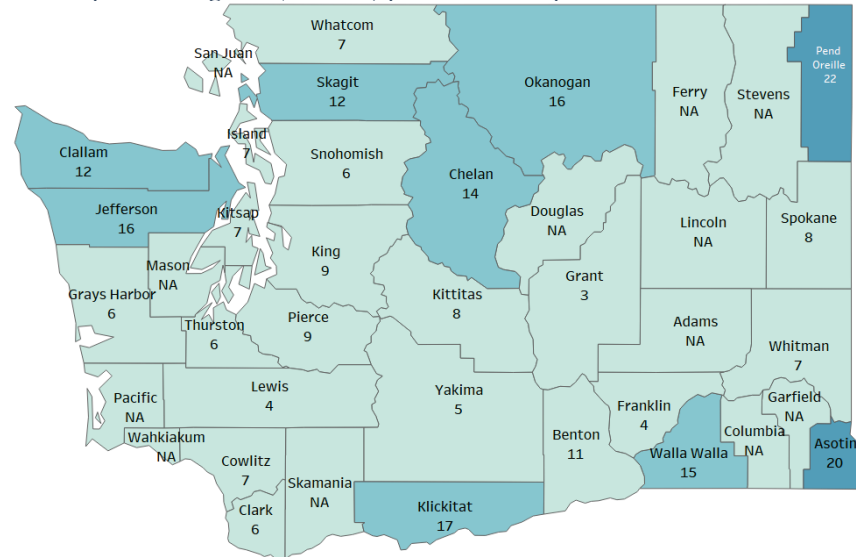
Figure C18. Surgeon (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021



Map C35. Surgeons (General) per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2020



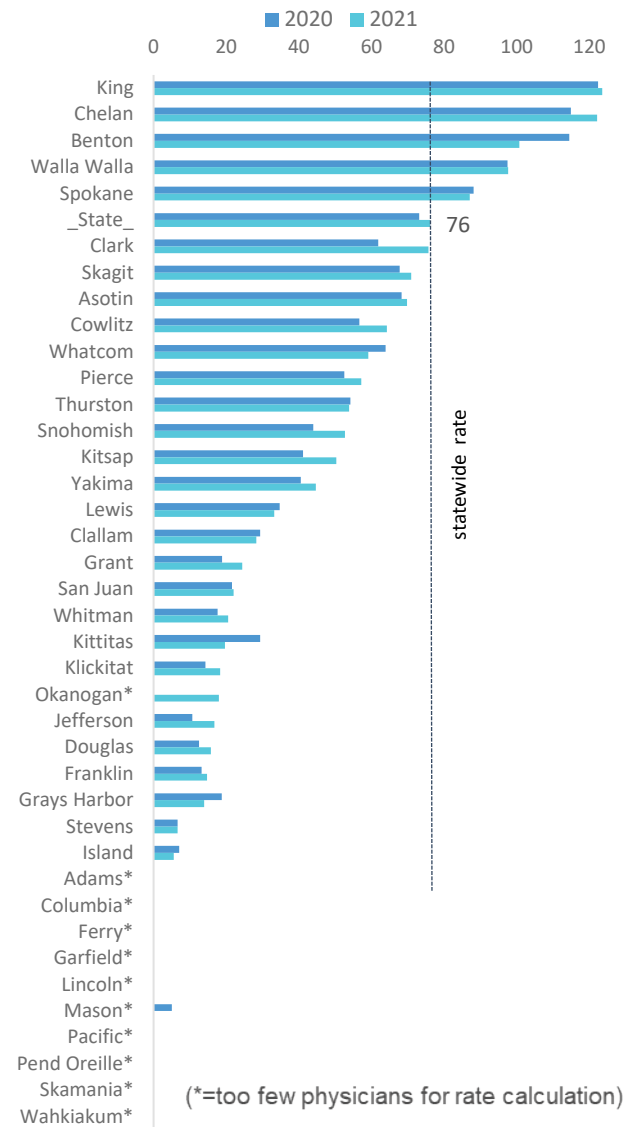
Map C36. Surgeons (General) per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021



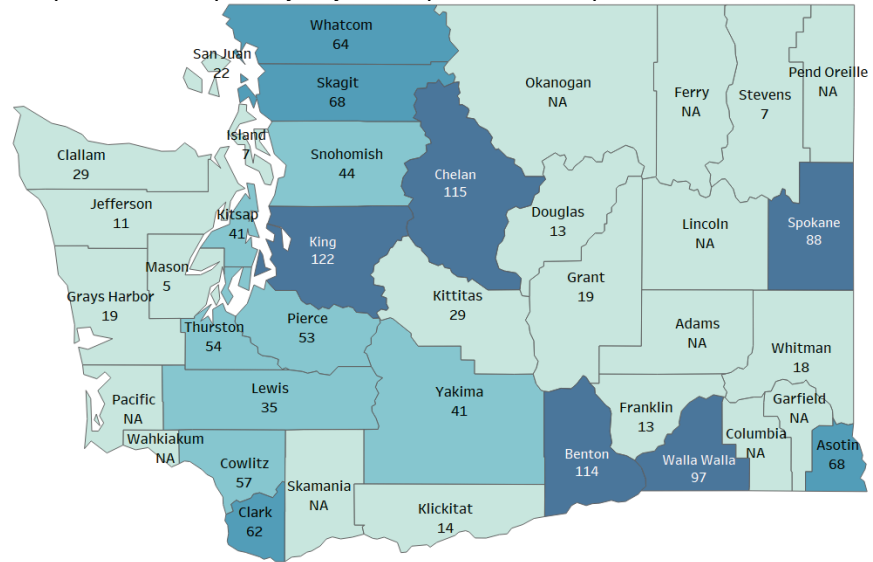

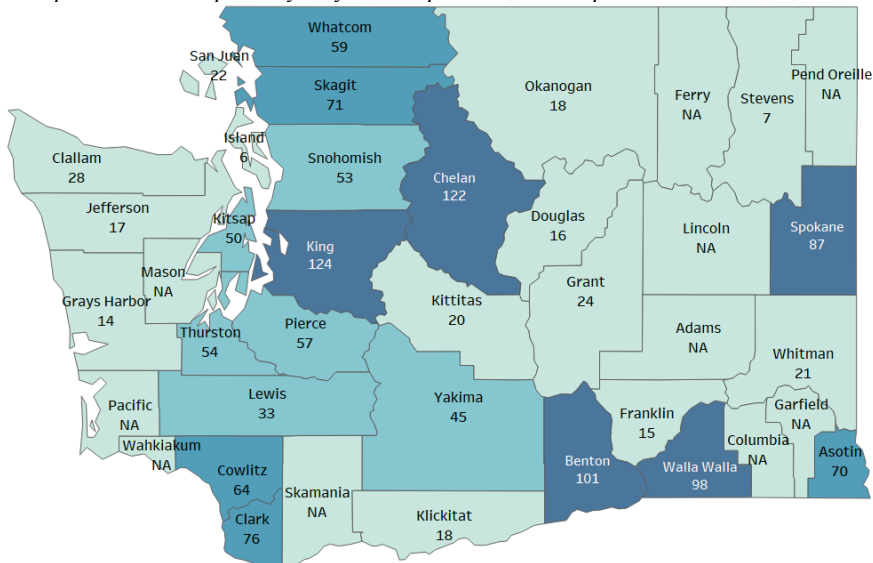
Figure C19. Other Specialty Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2020 and 2021
