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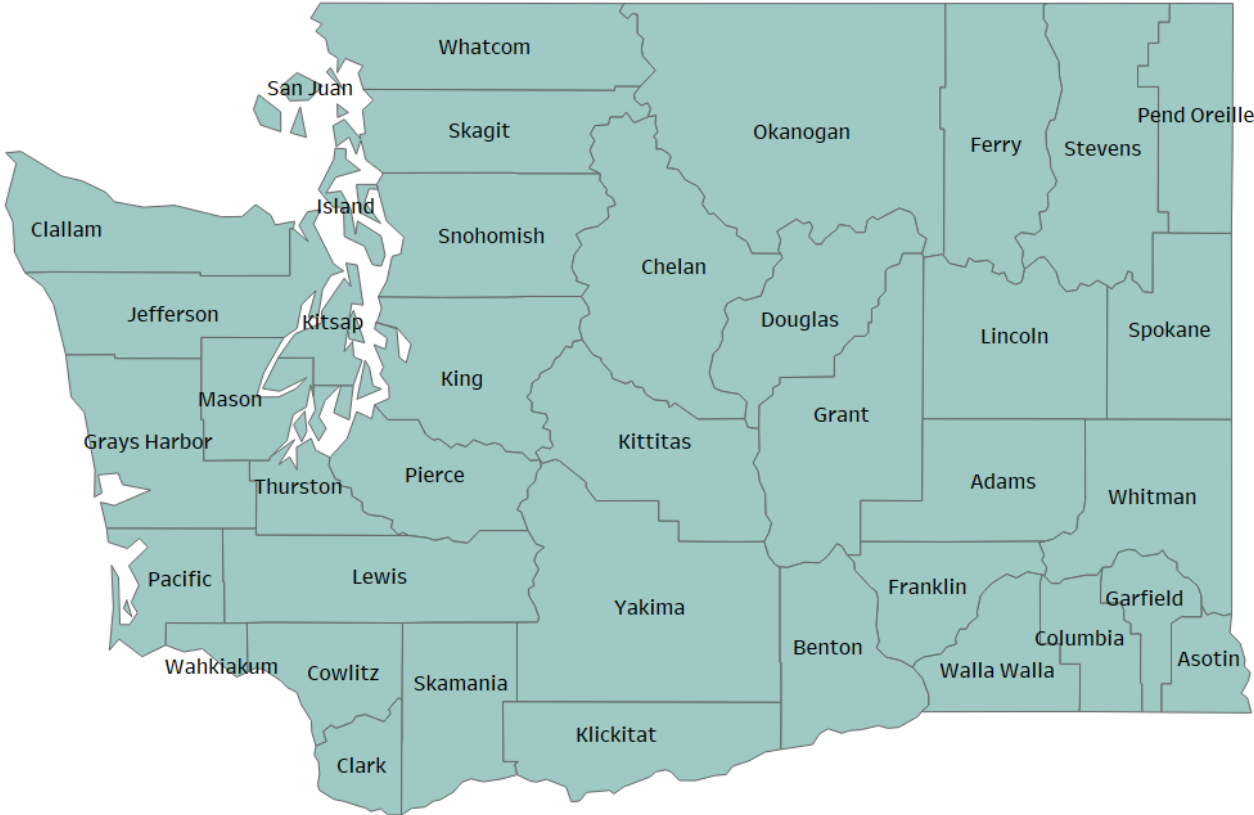
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Map of Washington State Counties



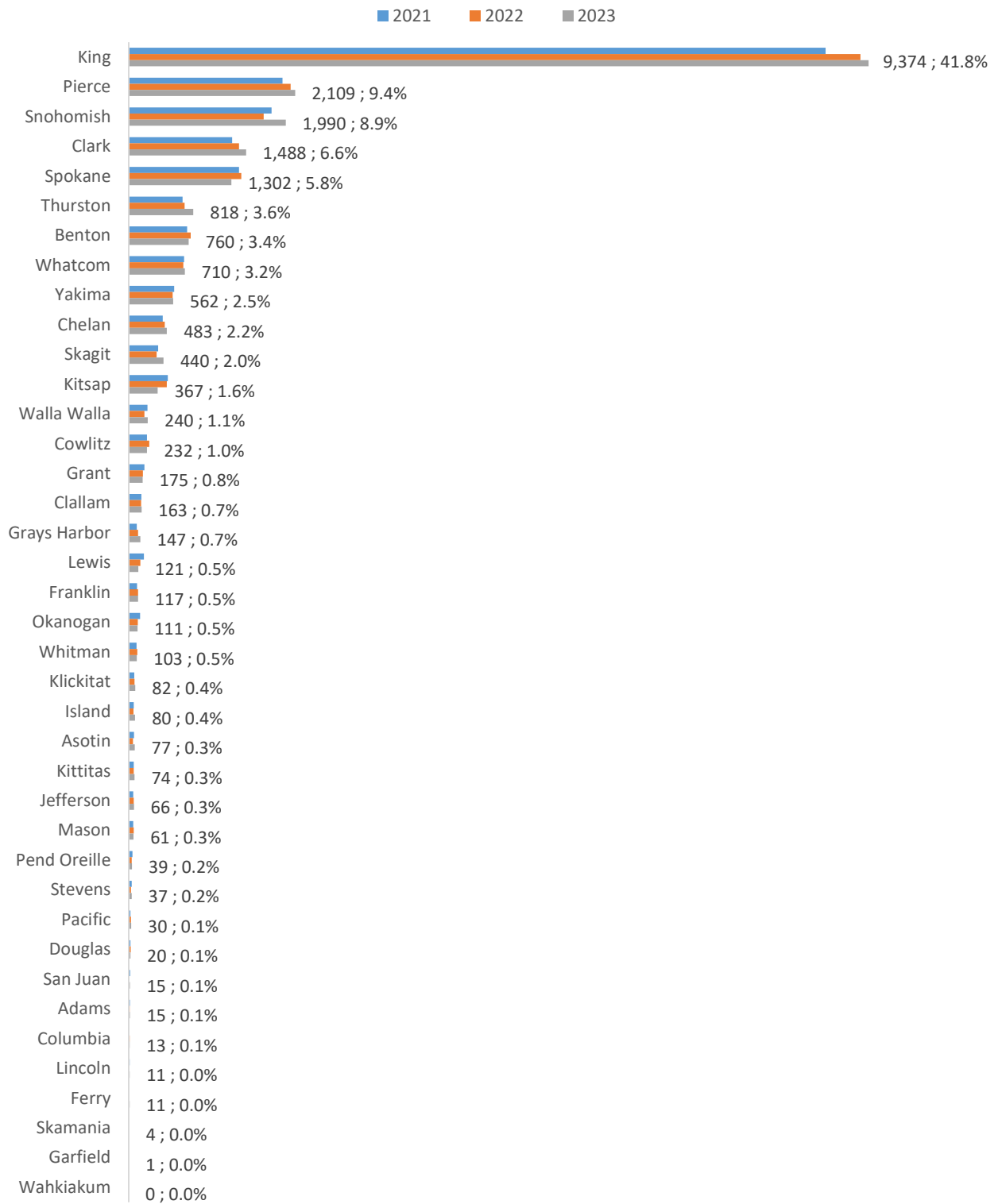

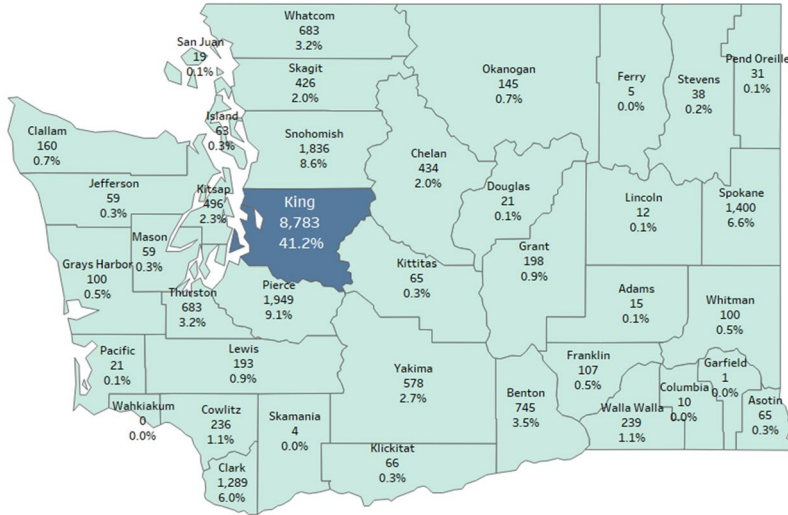

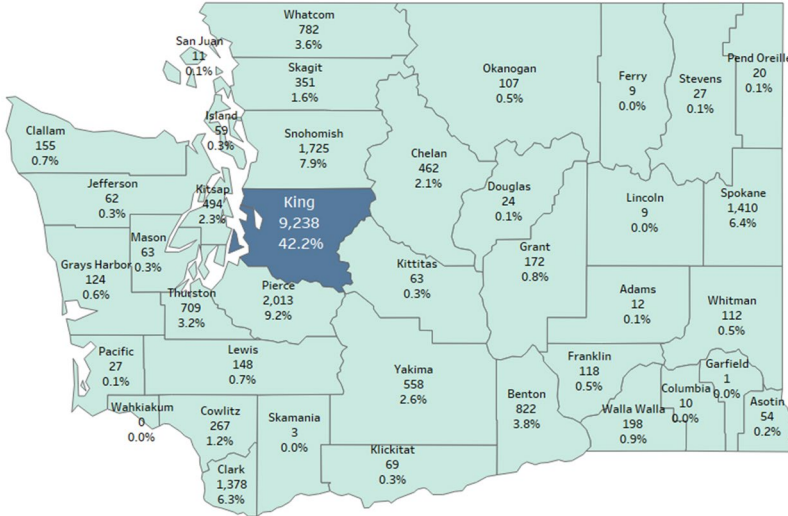
Figure C1. Number and Percent of Physicians by County: 2021–23

Map C3. Number and Percent of Physicians: County Regions, 2023

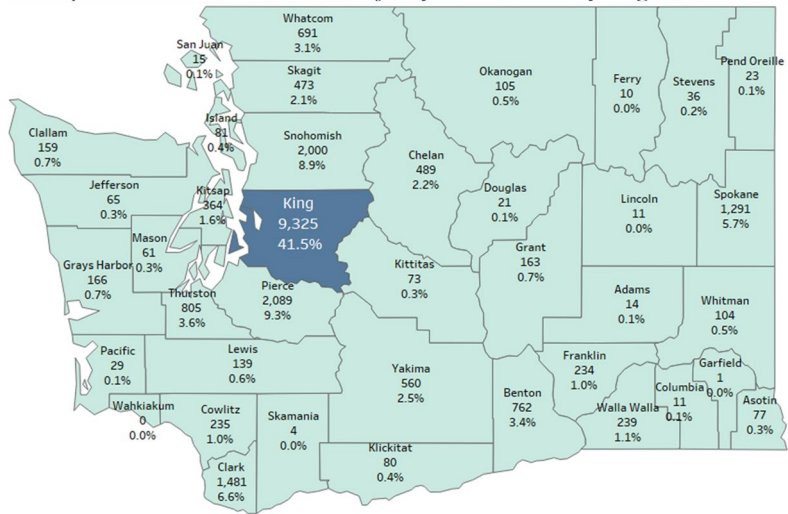

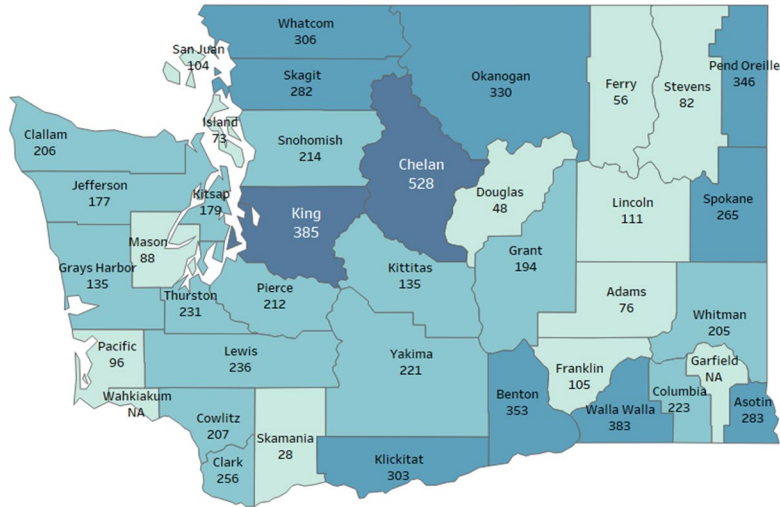

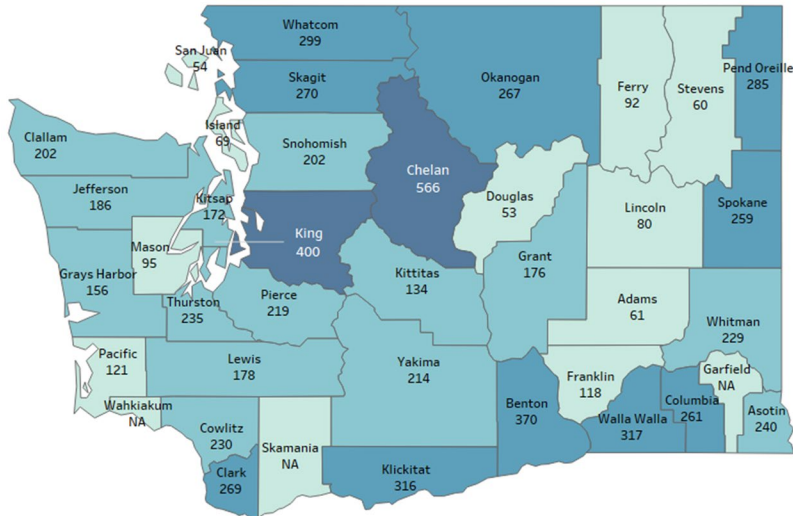
Figure C2. Number of Physicians per 100,000 Population by County: 2021–23
(sorted by 2023 distribution)



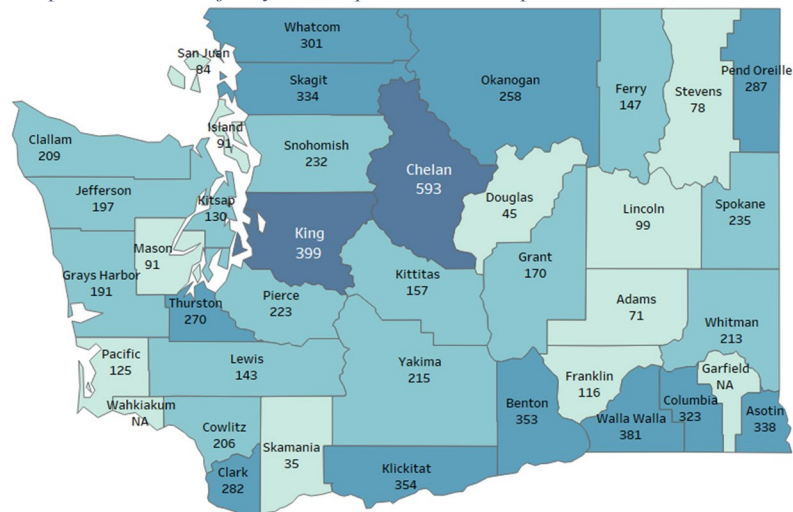
Map C4. Number of Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2021



Map C5. Number of Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2022

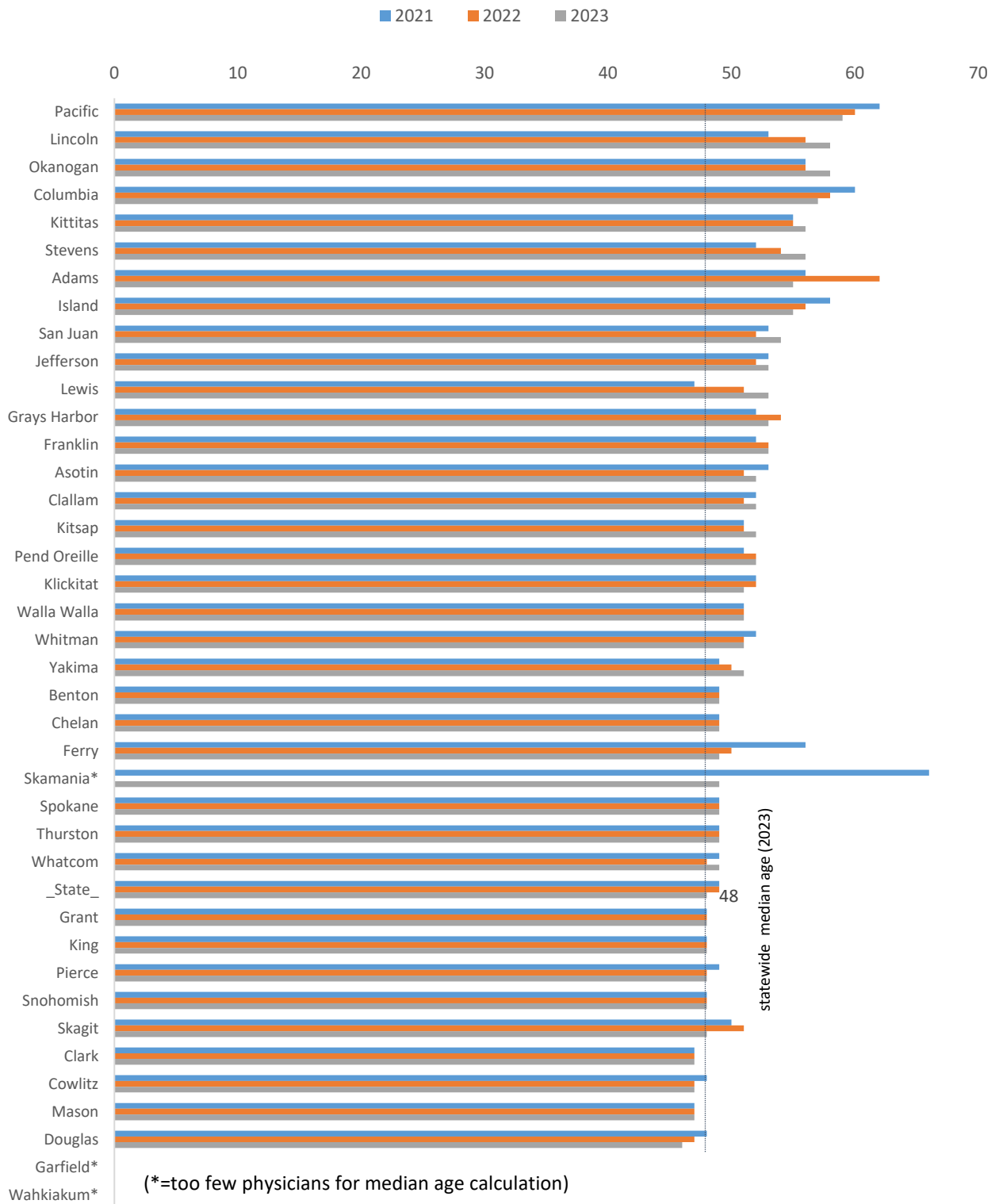


Map C6. Number of Physicians per 100,000 Population: Counties, 2023

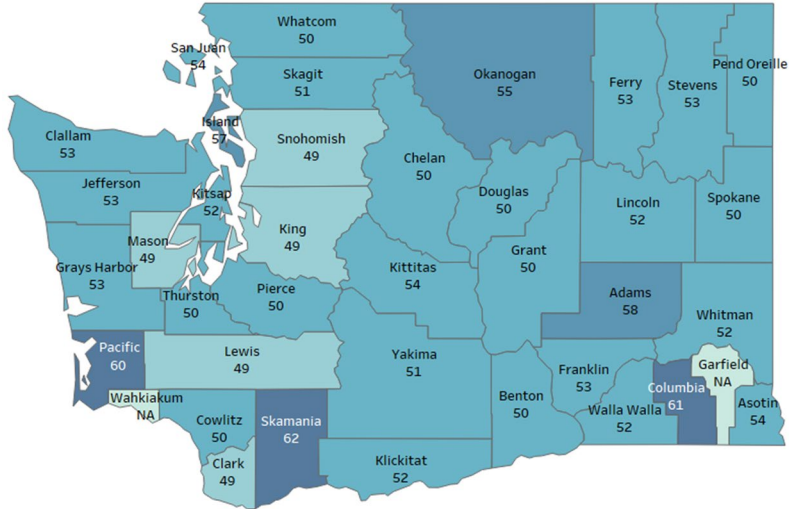


Physician Median Age by County: 2021–23

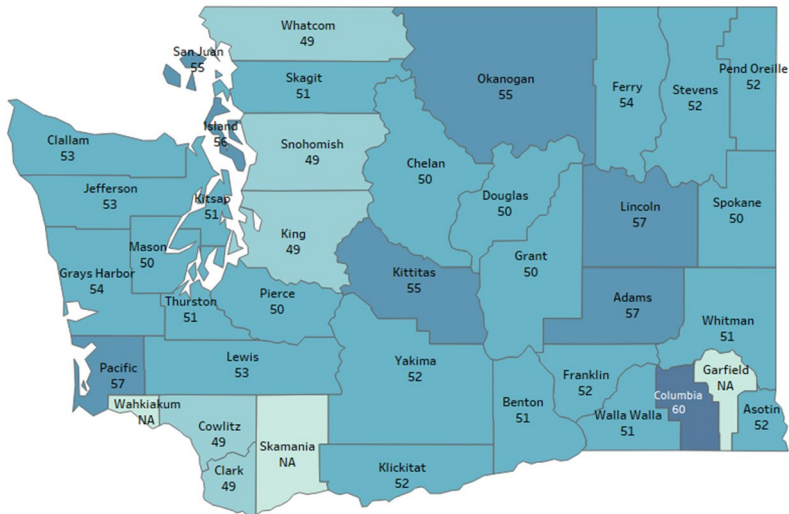
Figure C3. Physician Median Age by County: 2021–23
(sorted by 2023 distribution)



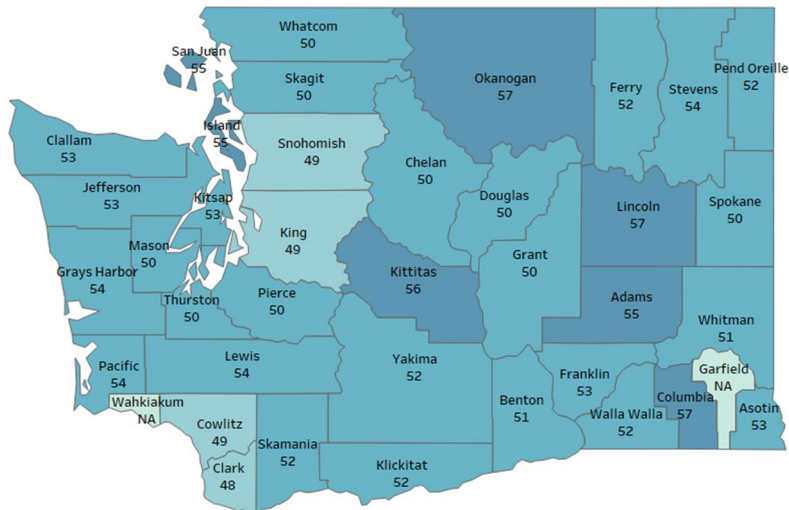
Map C7. Median Age of Physicians: Counties, 2021



Map C8. Median Age of Physicians: Counties, 2022

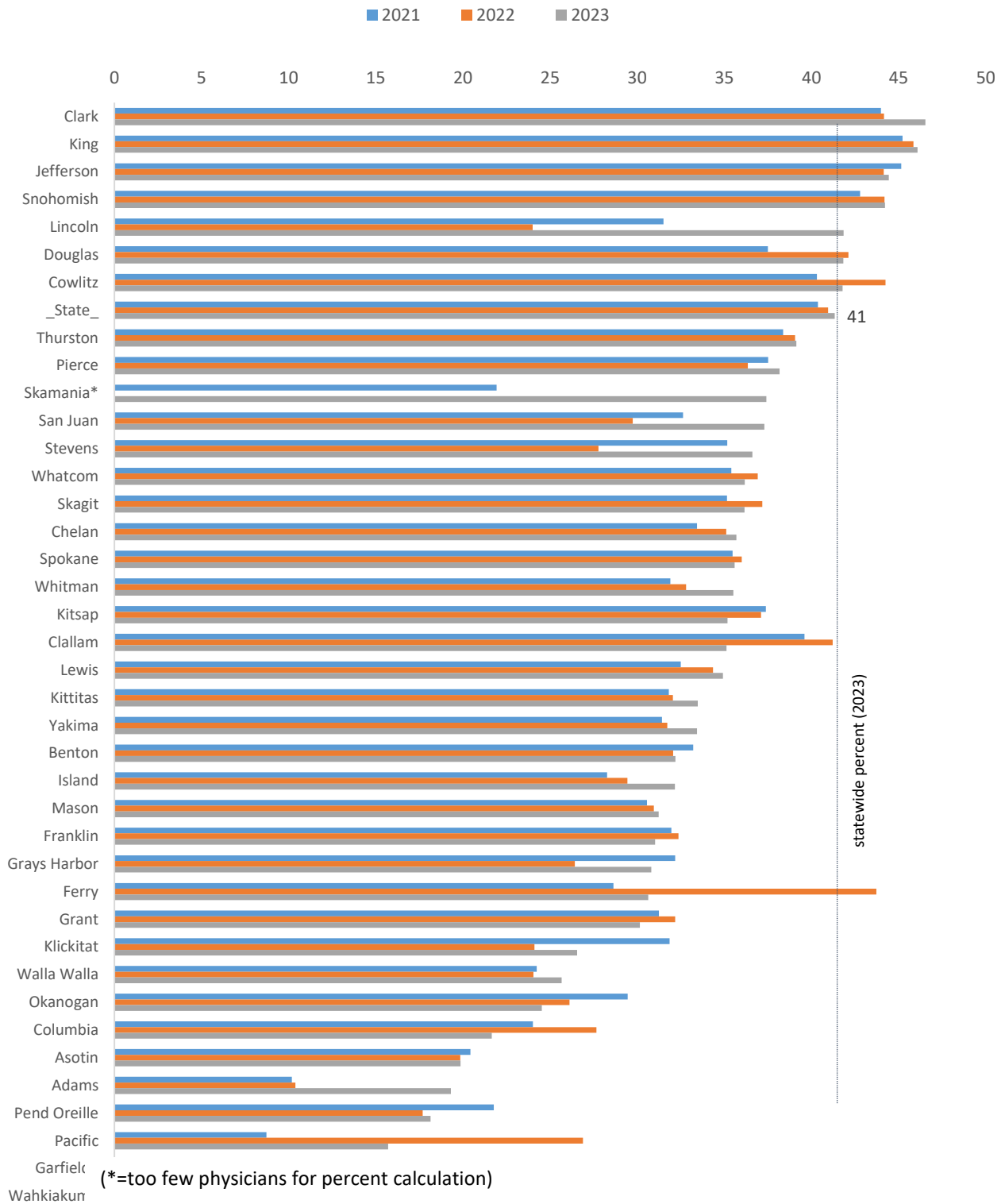


Map C9. Median Age of Physicians: Counties, 2023

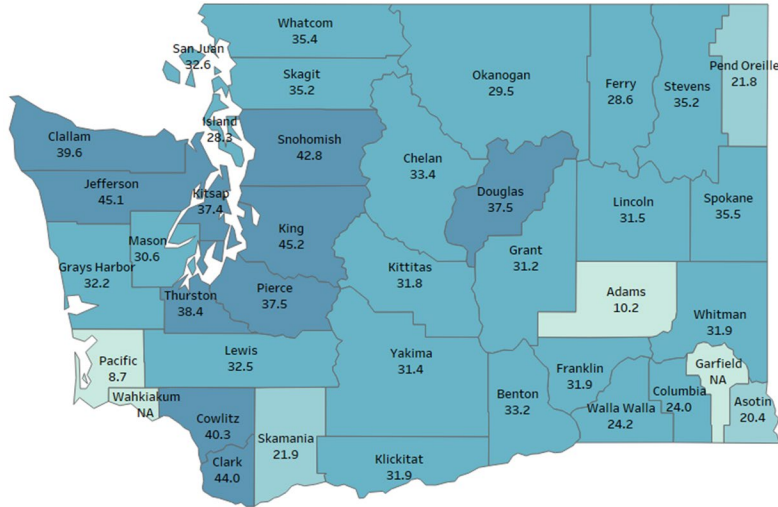


Percentage of Female Physicians by County: 2021–23

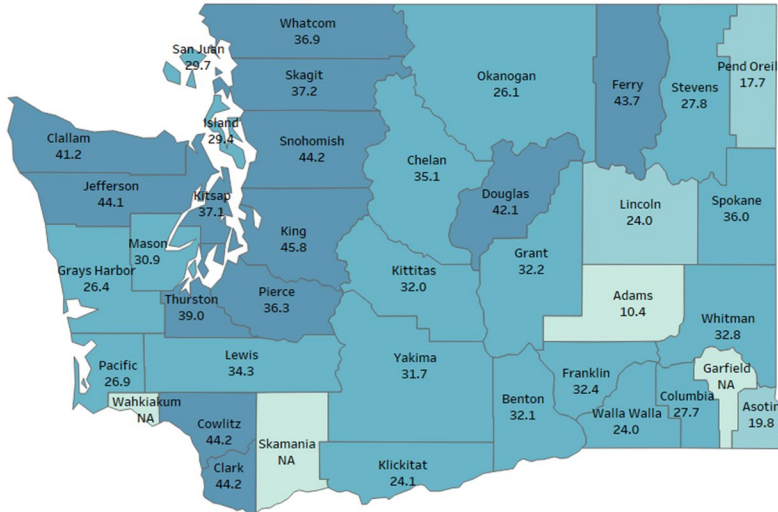
Figure C4. Percentage of Female Physicians: Counties, 2021–23
(sorted by 2023 distribution)



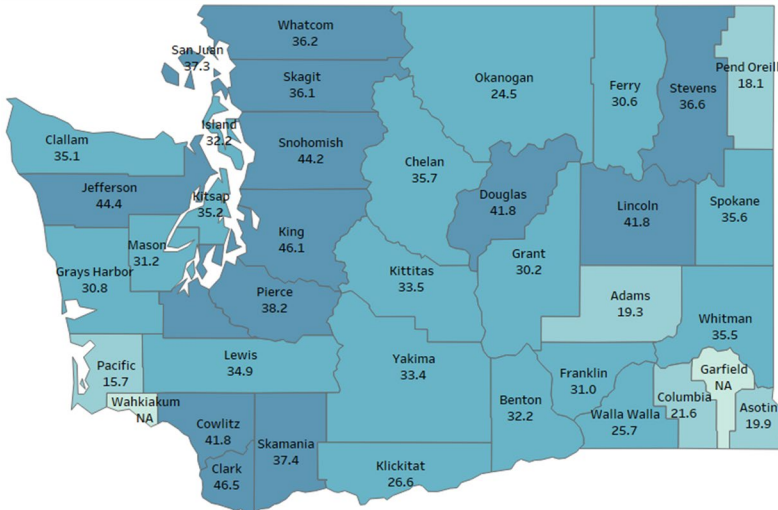
Map C10. Percentage of Female Physicians: Counties, 2021



Map C11. Percentage of Female Physicians: Counties, 2022



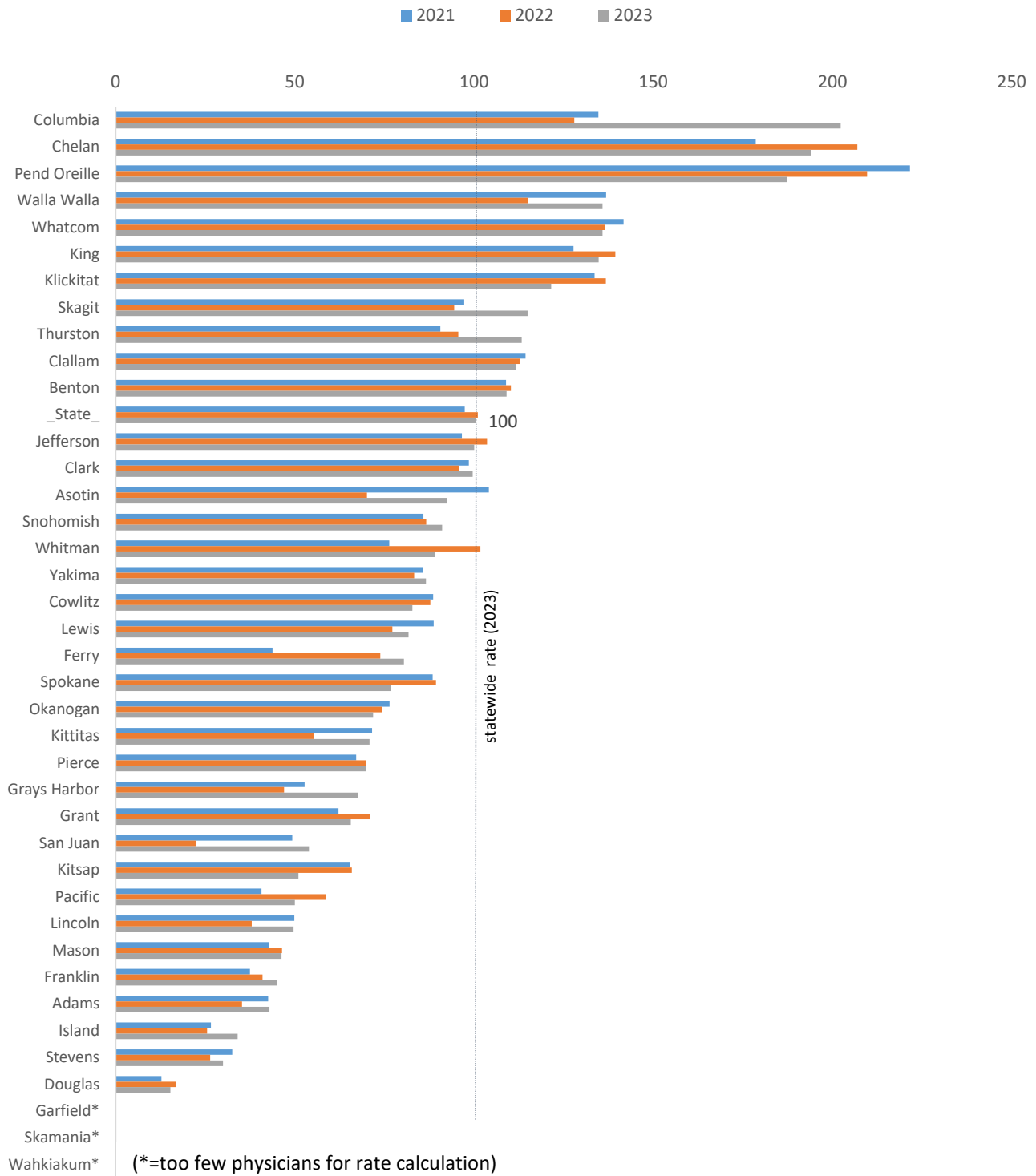
Map C12. Percentage of Female Physicians: Counties, 2023



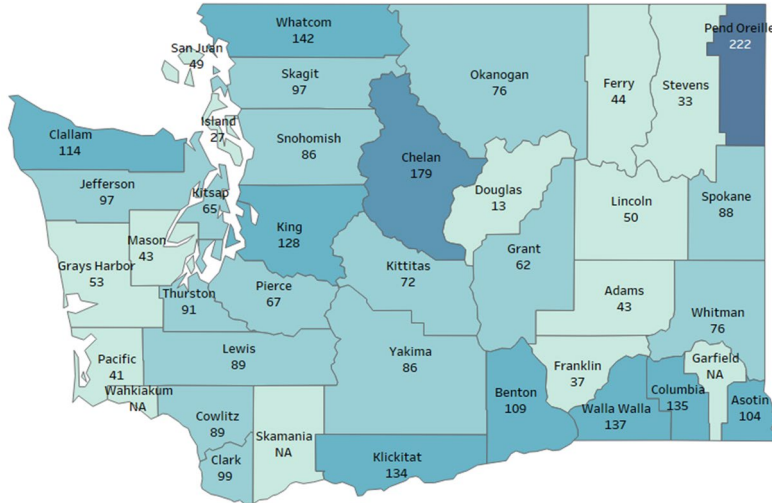

Figure C5. PCP Rate (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

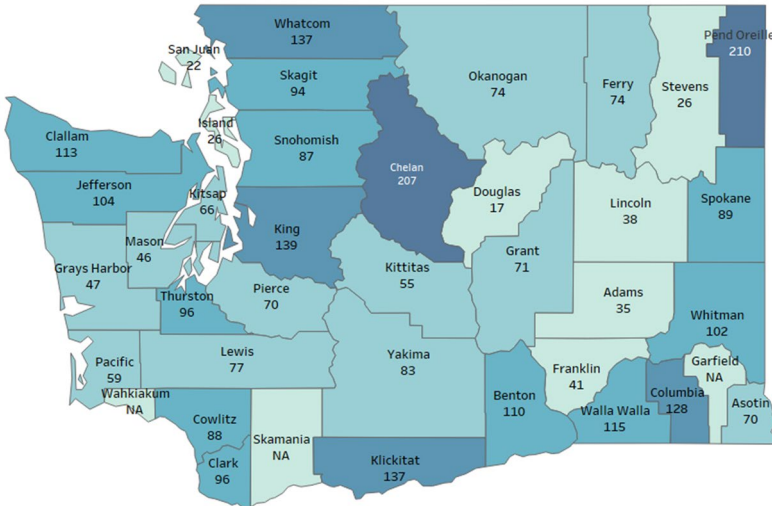

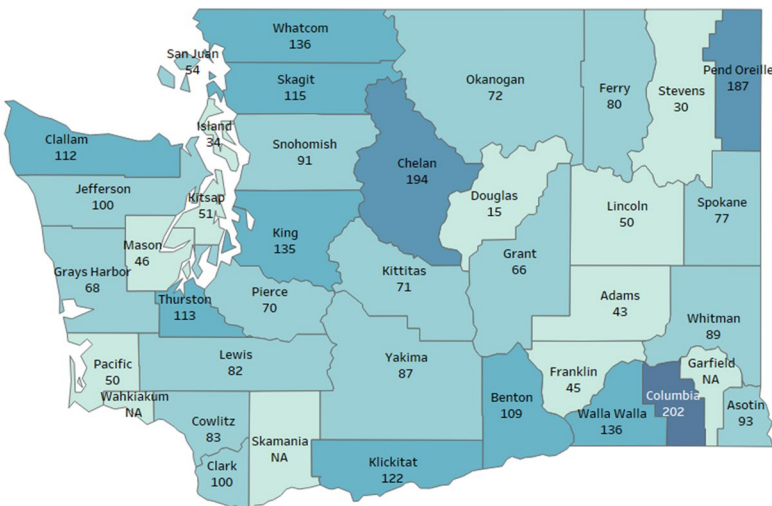
Map C13. PCP Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C14. PCP Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022



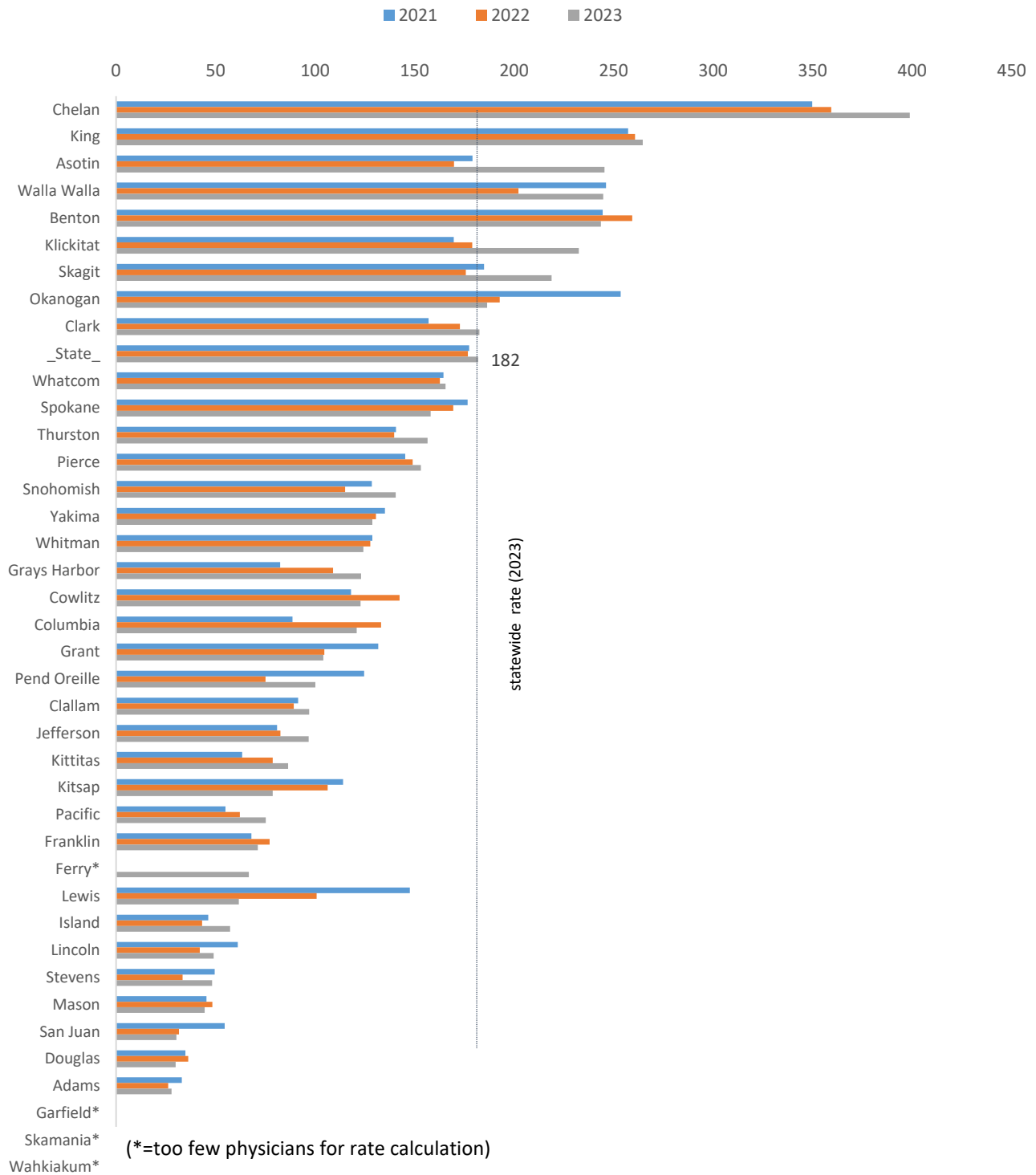
Map C15. PCP Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023



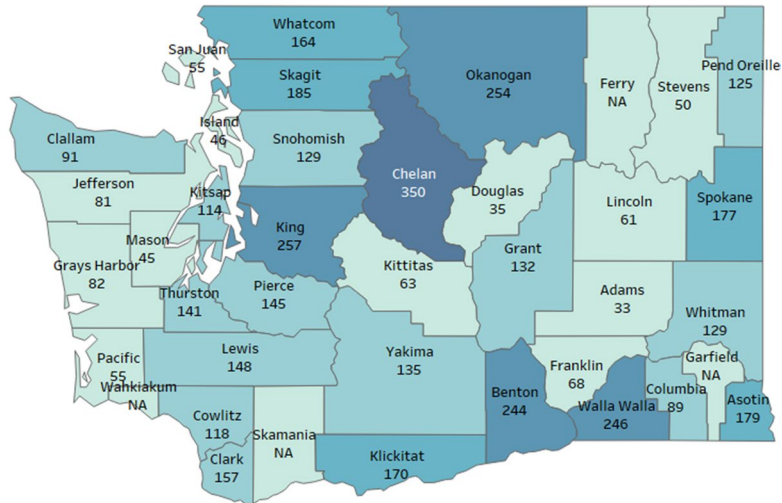
Specialist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

Figure C6. Specialist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

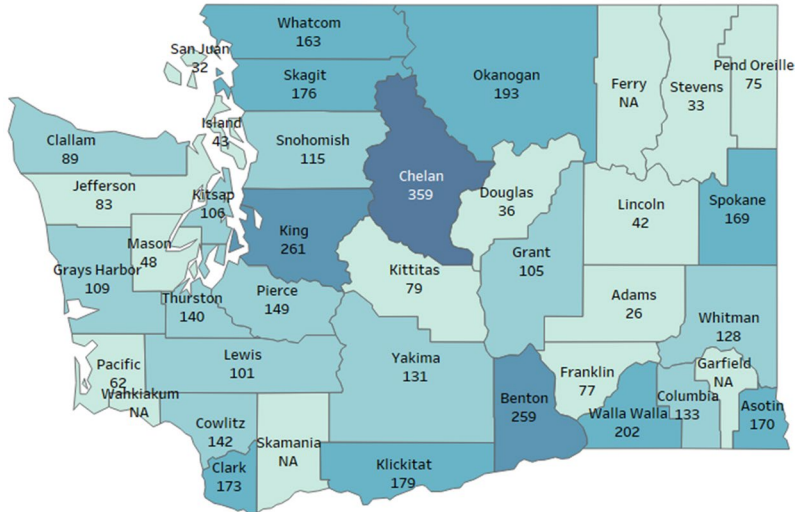

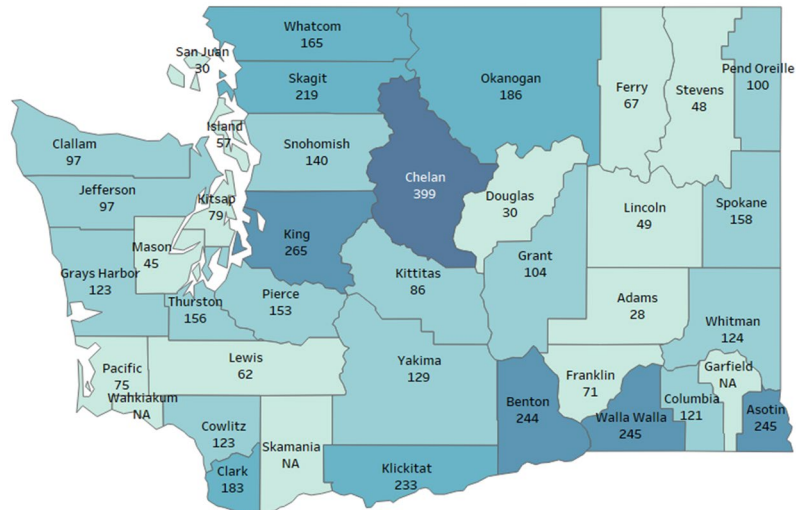
Map C16. Specialist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C17. Specialist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

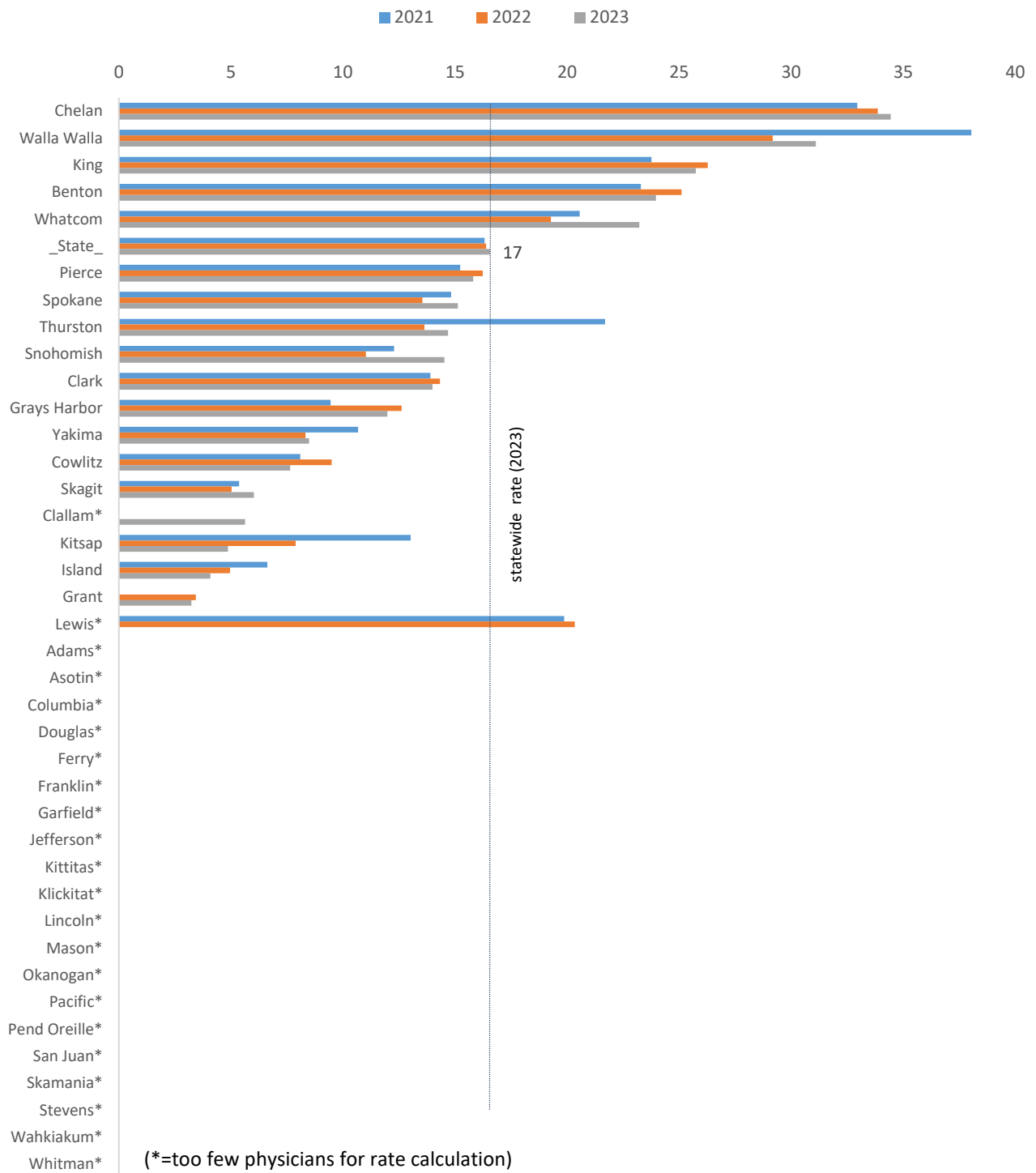


Map C18. Specialist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

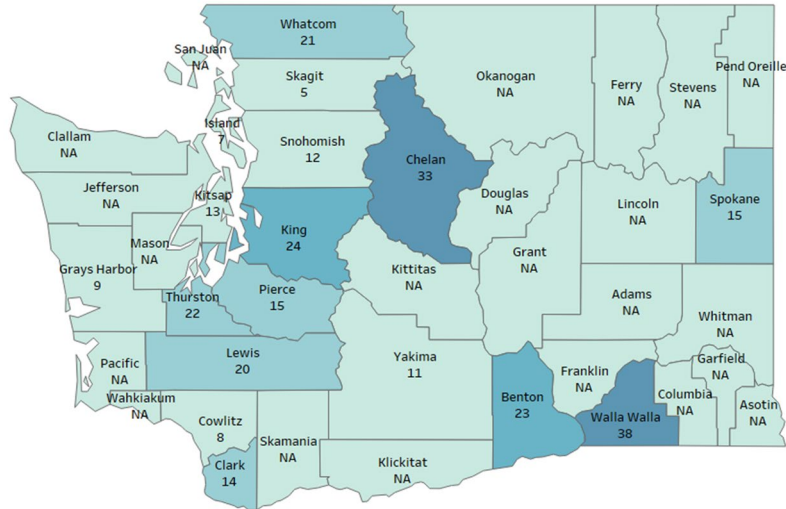


Anesthesiologist Rates (Per 100,000) by County, 2021–23

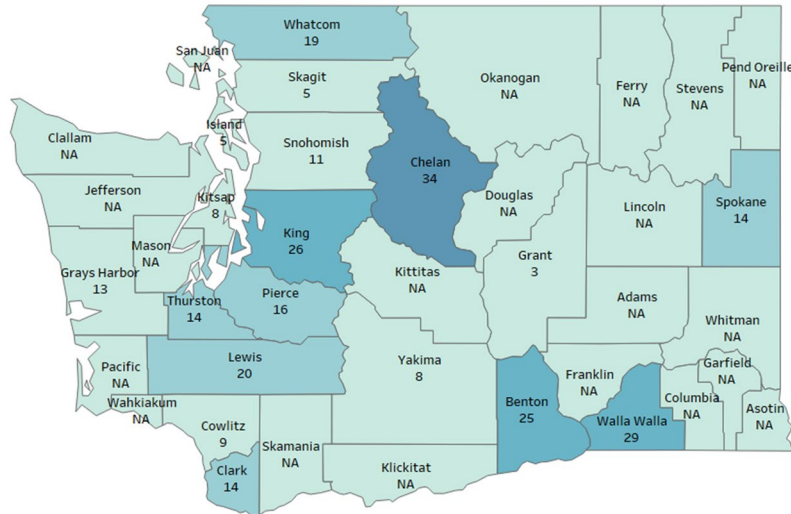
Figure C7. Anesthesiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23
(sorted by 2023 distribution)



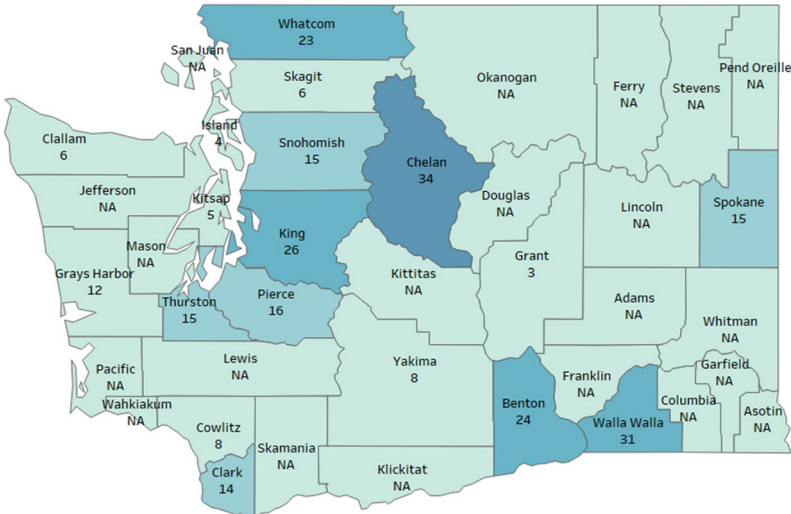
Map C19. Anesthesiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C20. Anesthesiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

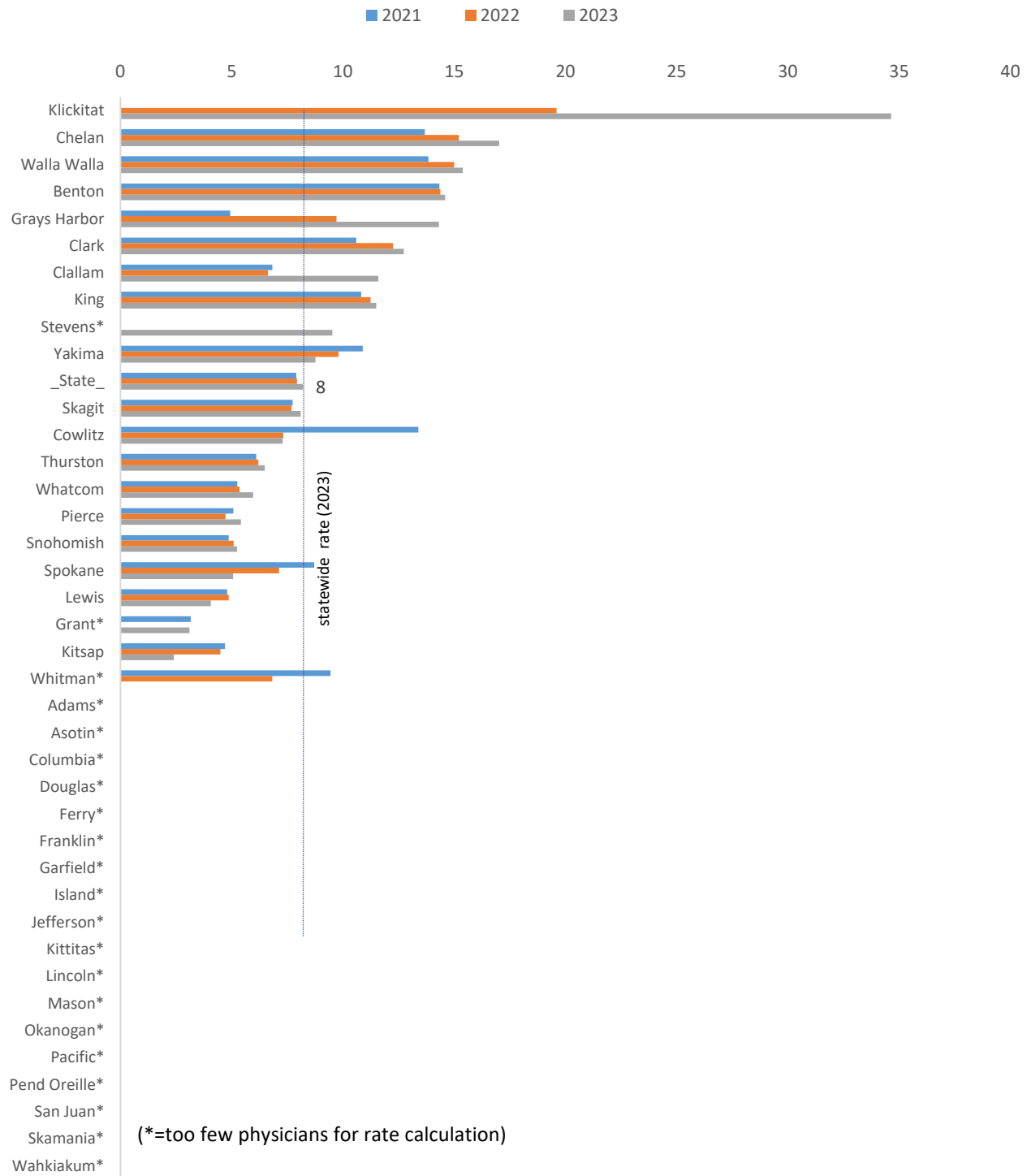


Map C21. Anesthesiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

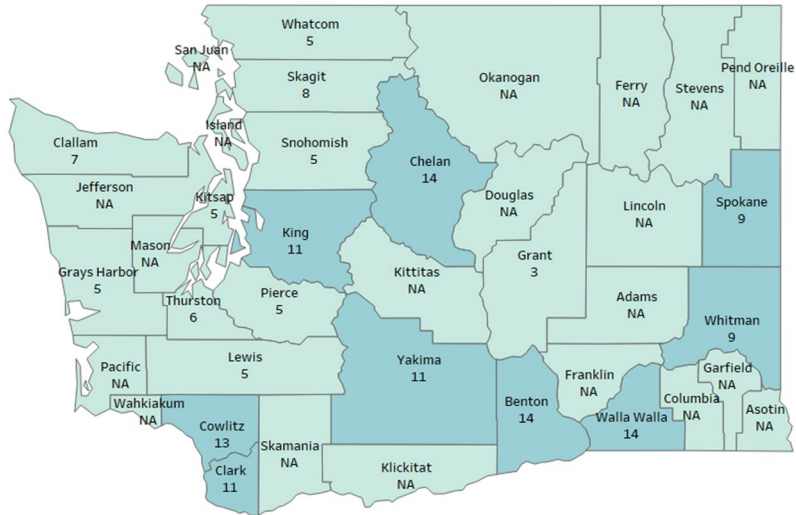


Cardiologist Rates by County: 2021–23

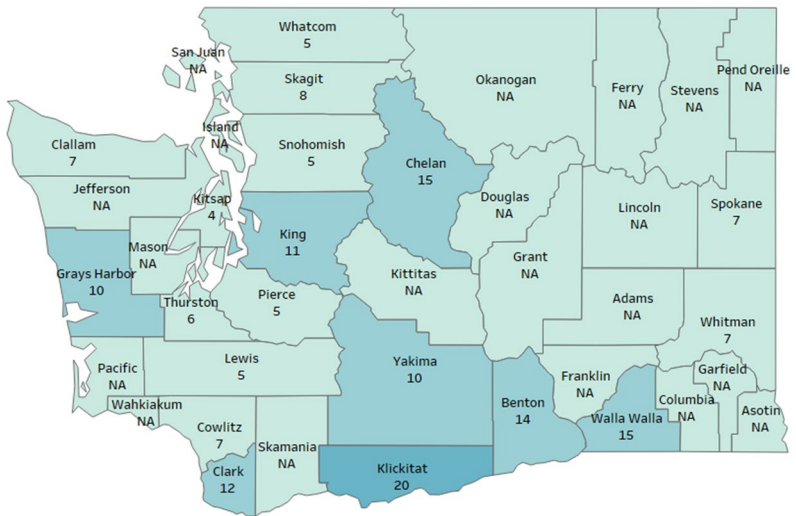
Figure C8. Cardiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23
(sorted by 2023 distribution)



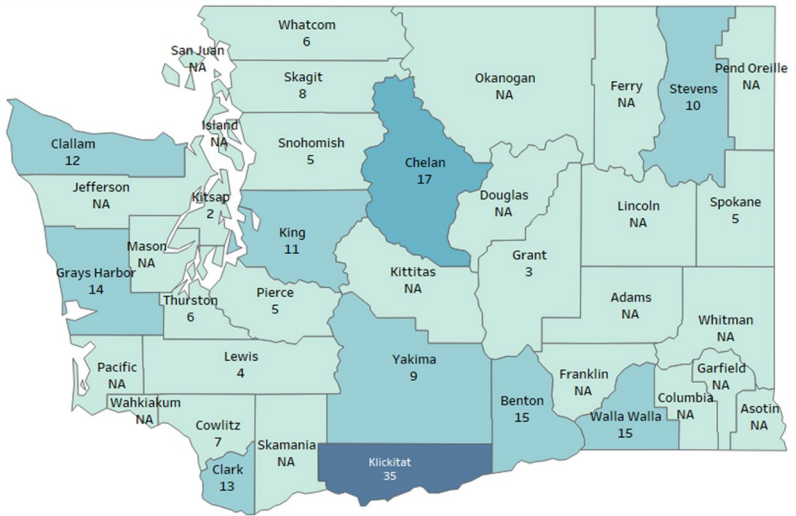
Map C22. Cardiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021

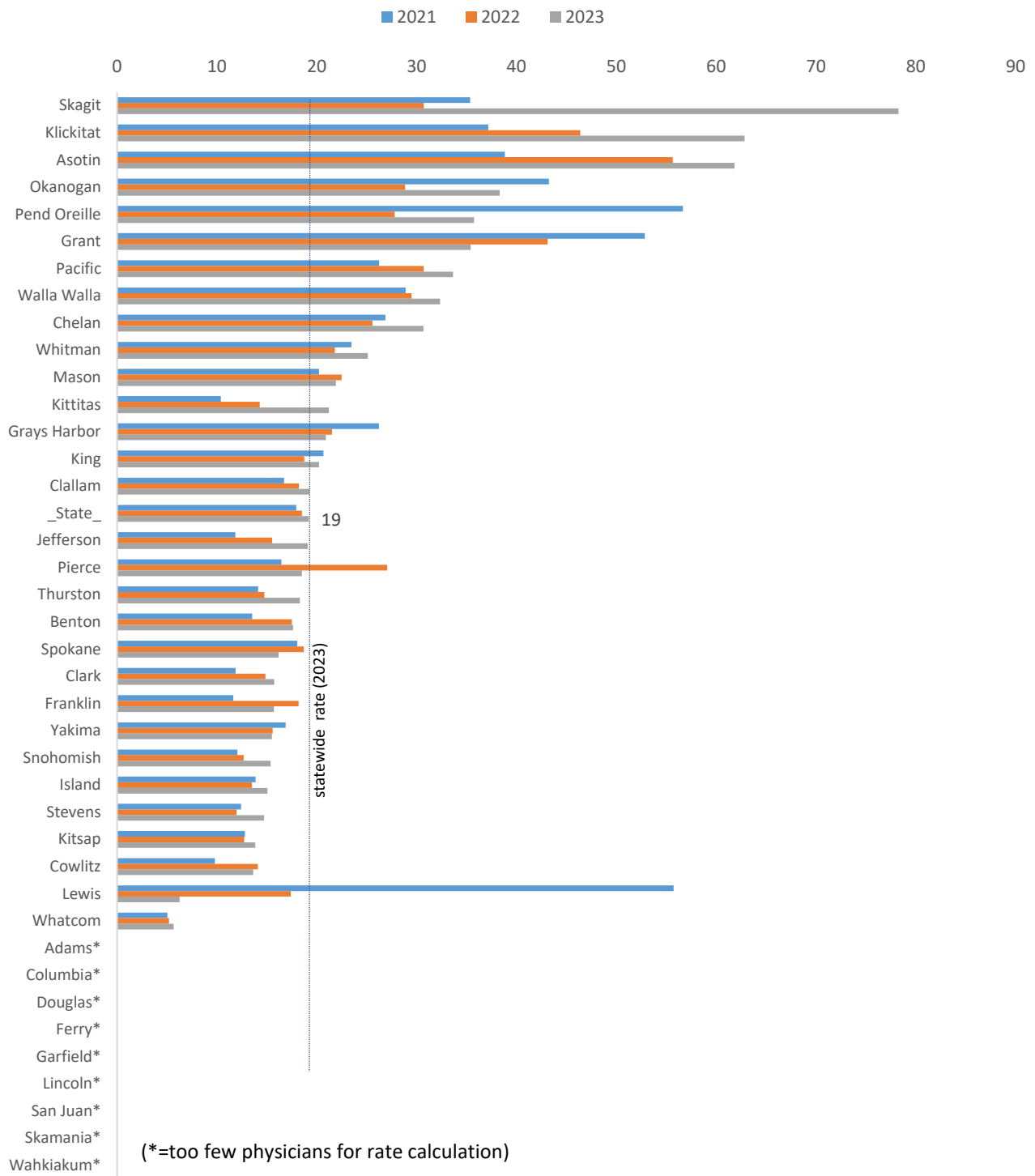


Map C24. Cardiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

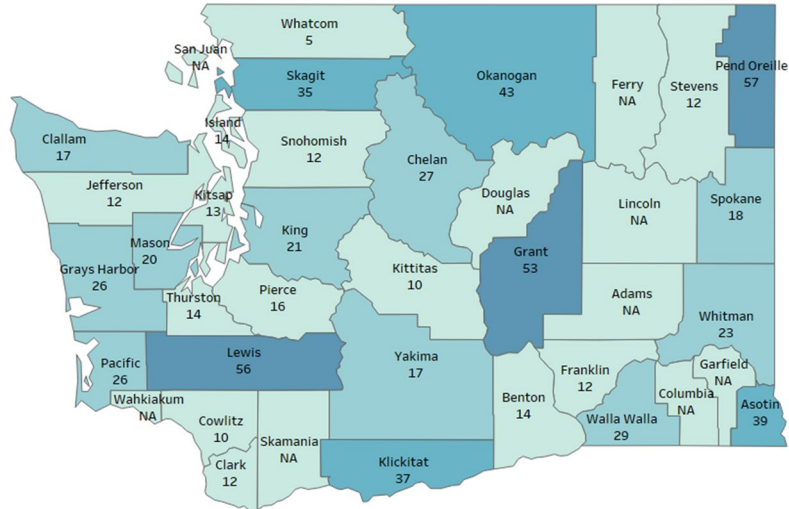


Emergency Medicine Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

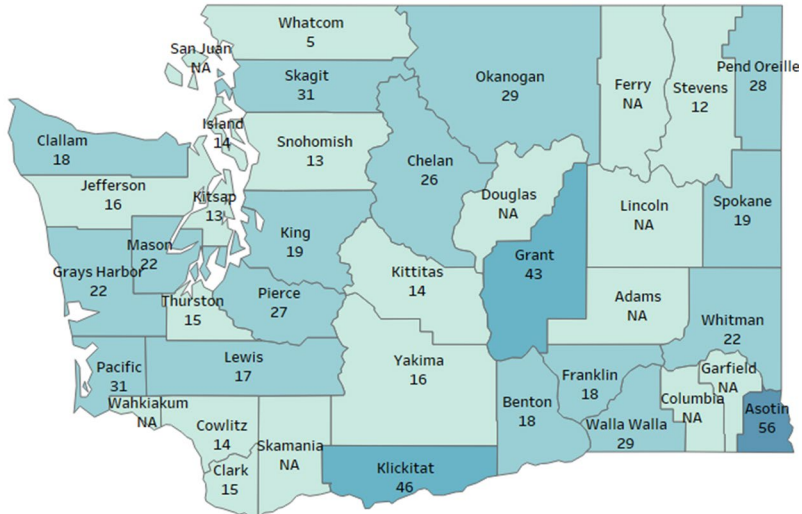
Figure C9. Emergency Medicine Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

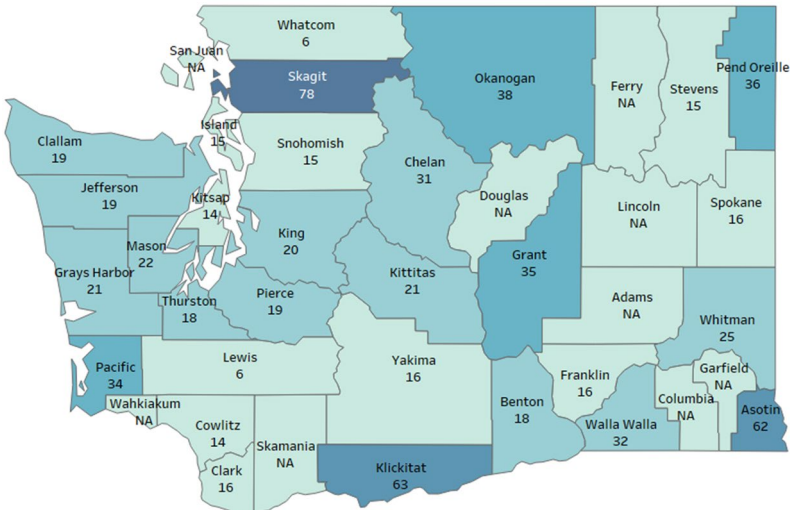
Map C25. Emergency Medicine Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C26. Emergency Medicine Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

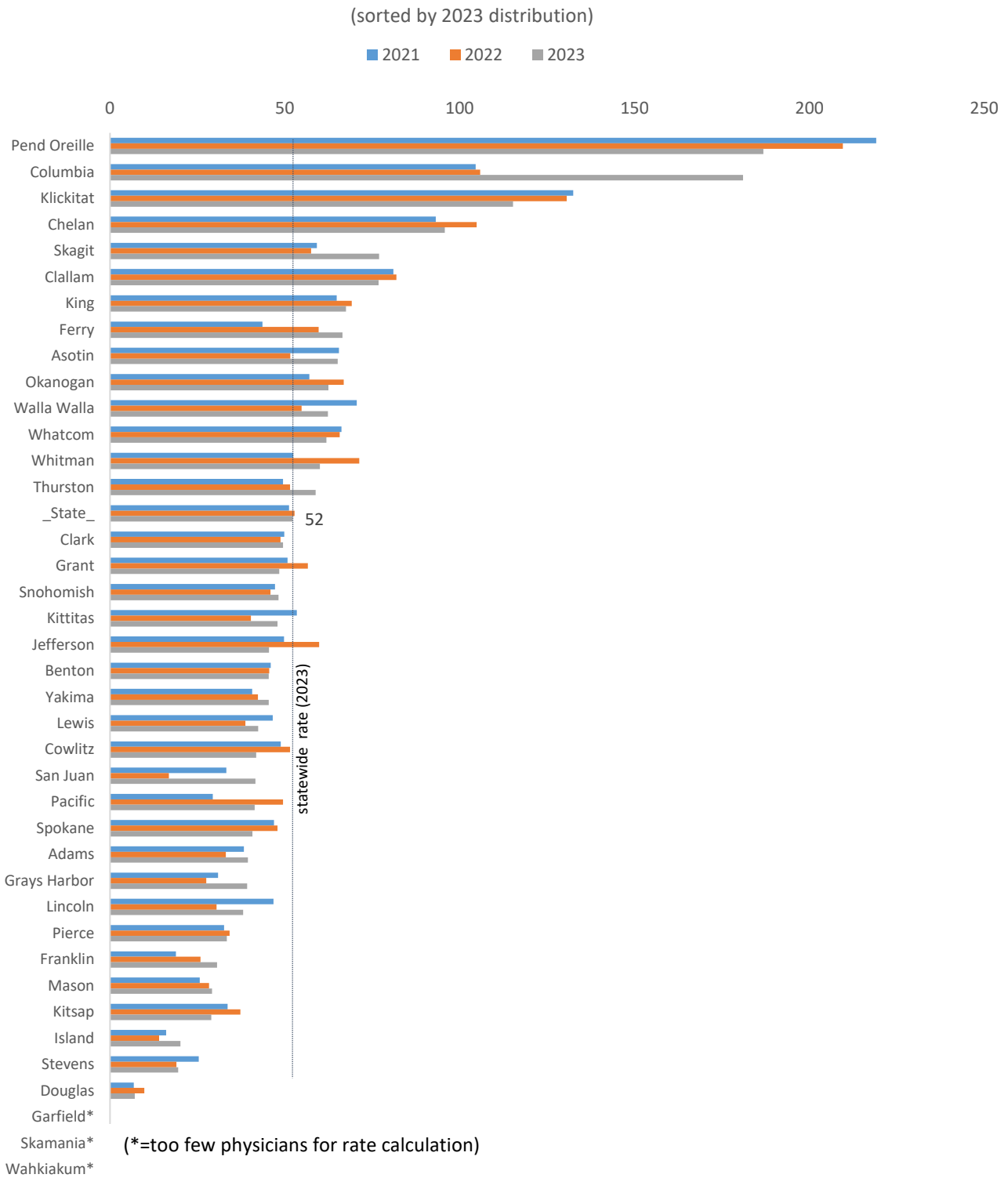


Map C27. Emergency Medicine Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

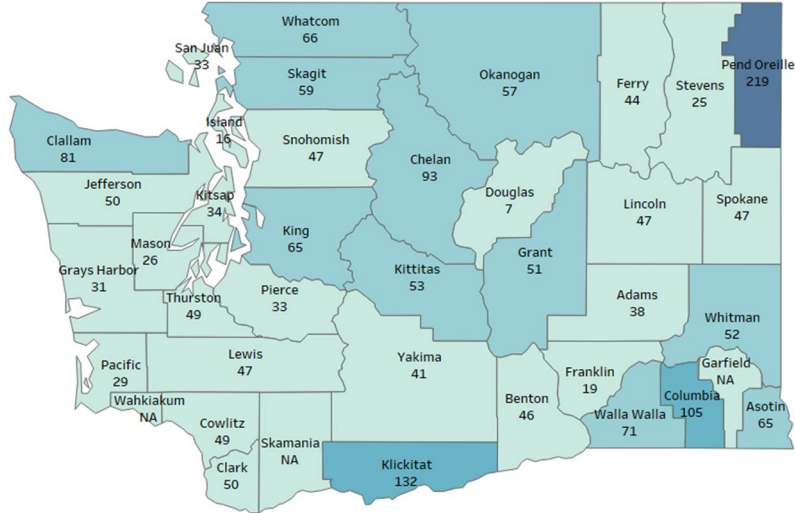


Family Medicine/General Practice Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

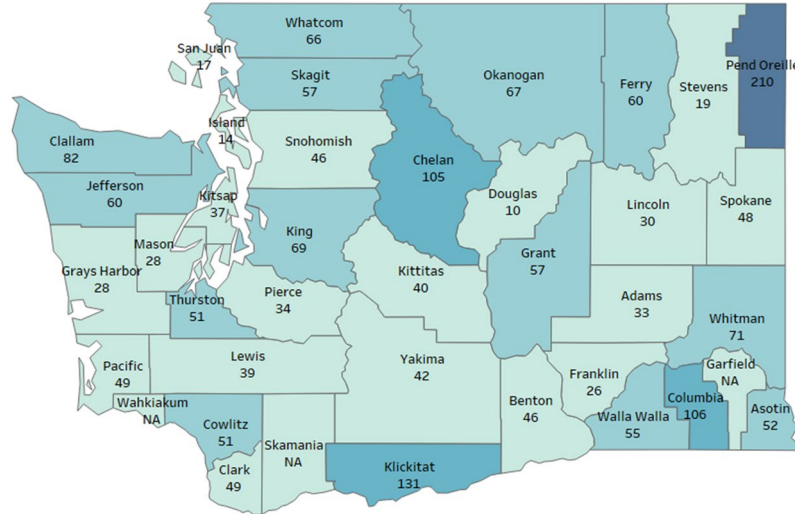
Figure C10. Family Medicine/General Practice Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23



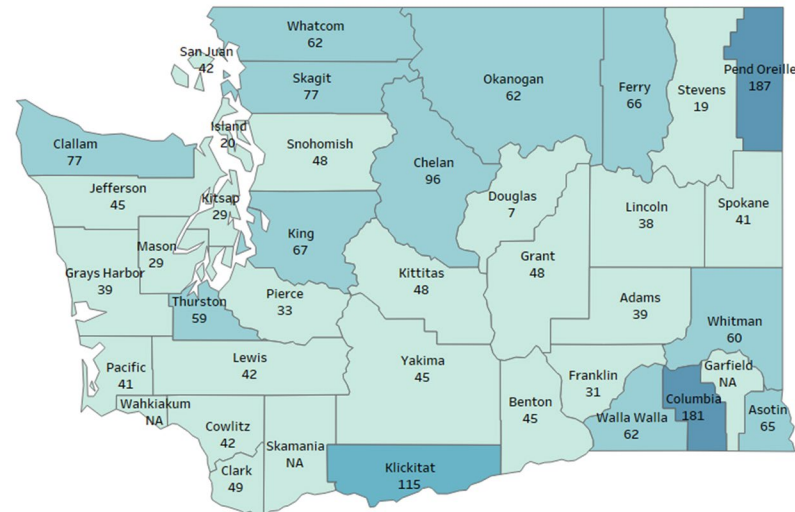
Map C28. Family Med./Gen. Practice Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C29 Family Med./Gen. Practice Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

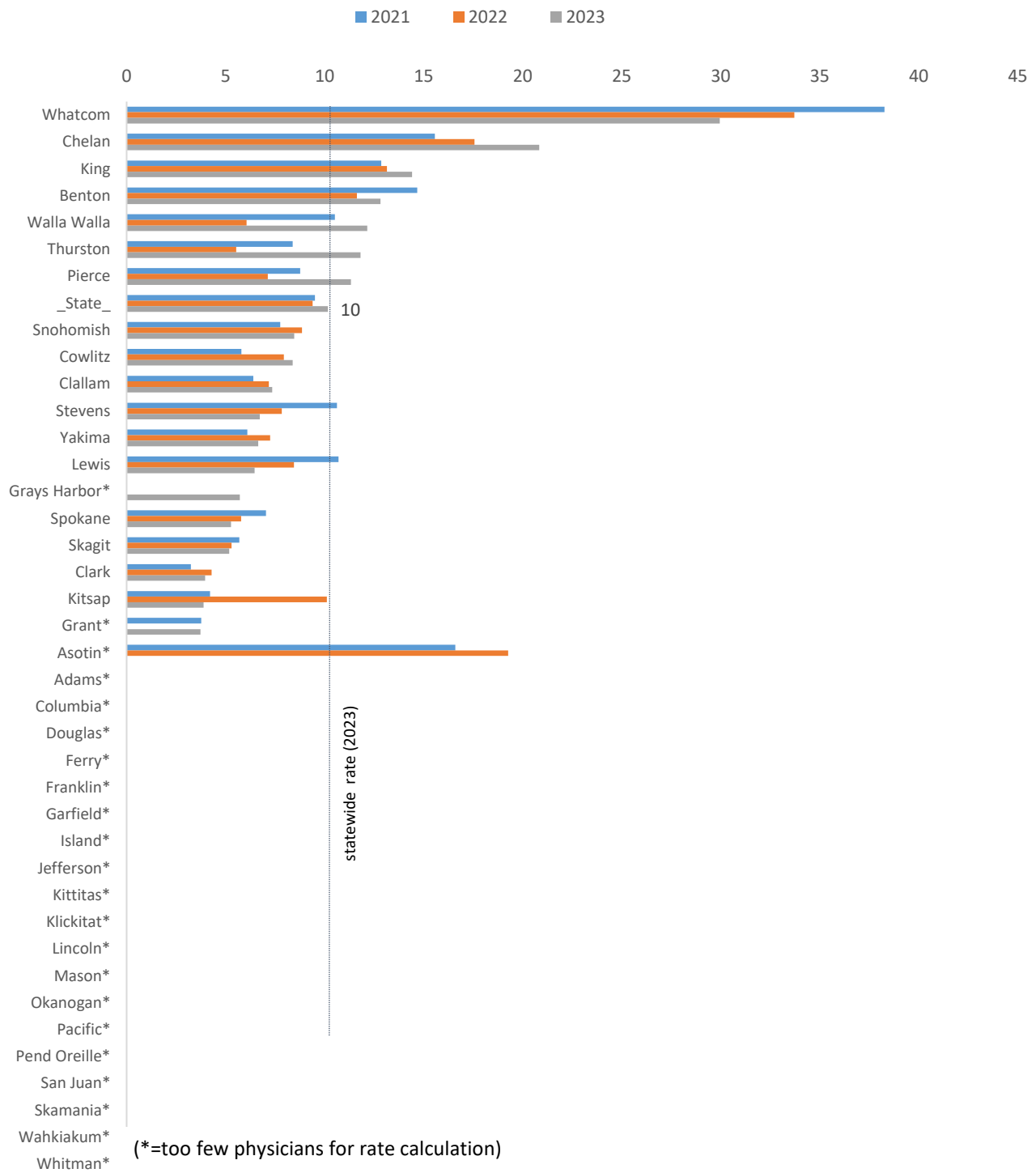


Map C30. Family Med./Gen. Practice Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

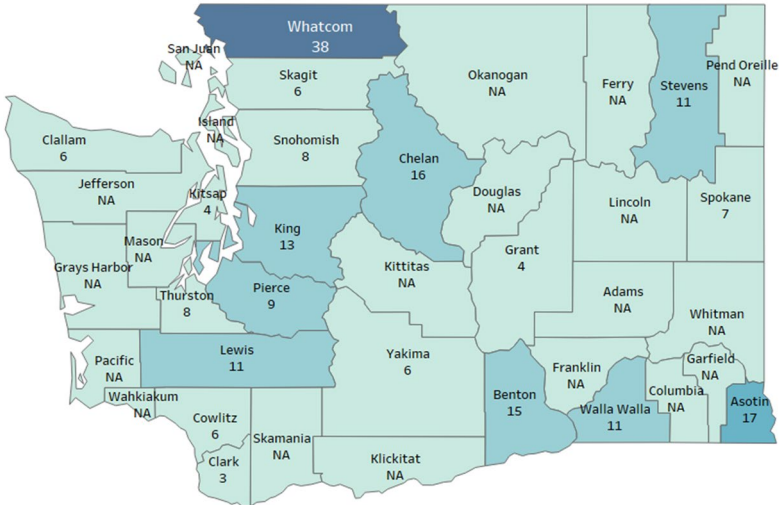


Hospitalist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

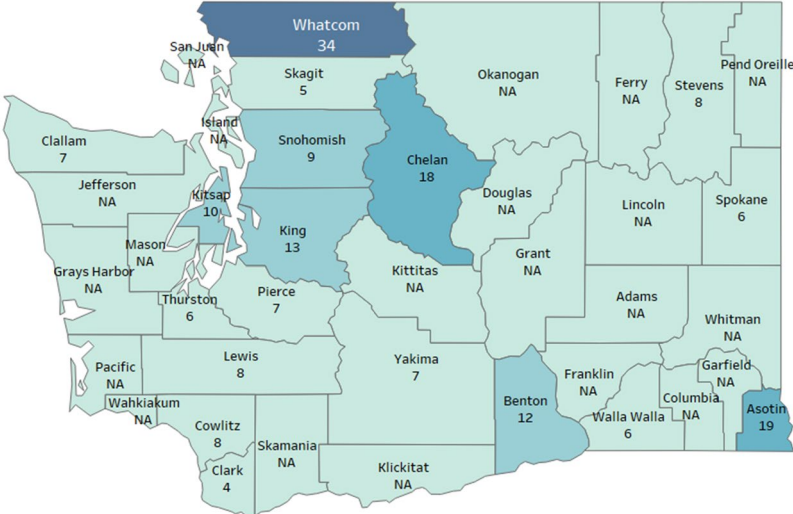
Figure C11. Hospitalist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

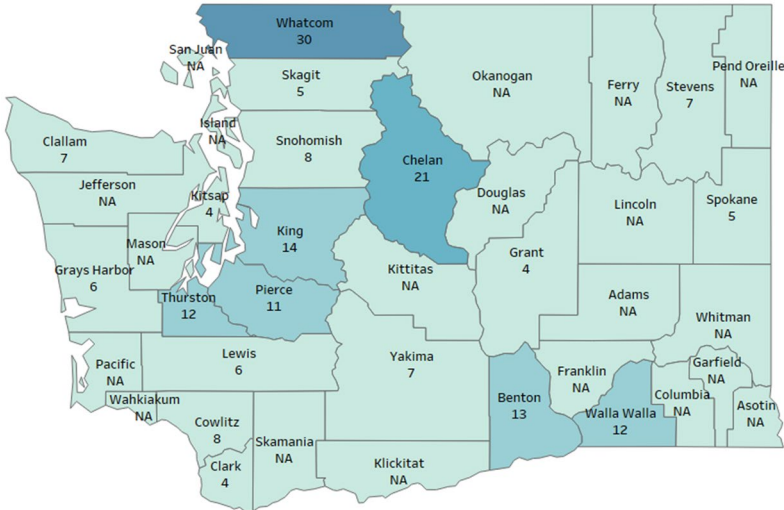
Map C31. Hospitalist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C32. Hospitalist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

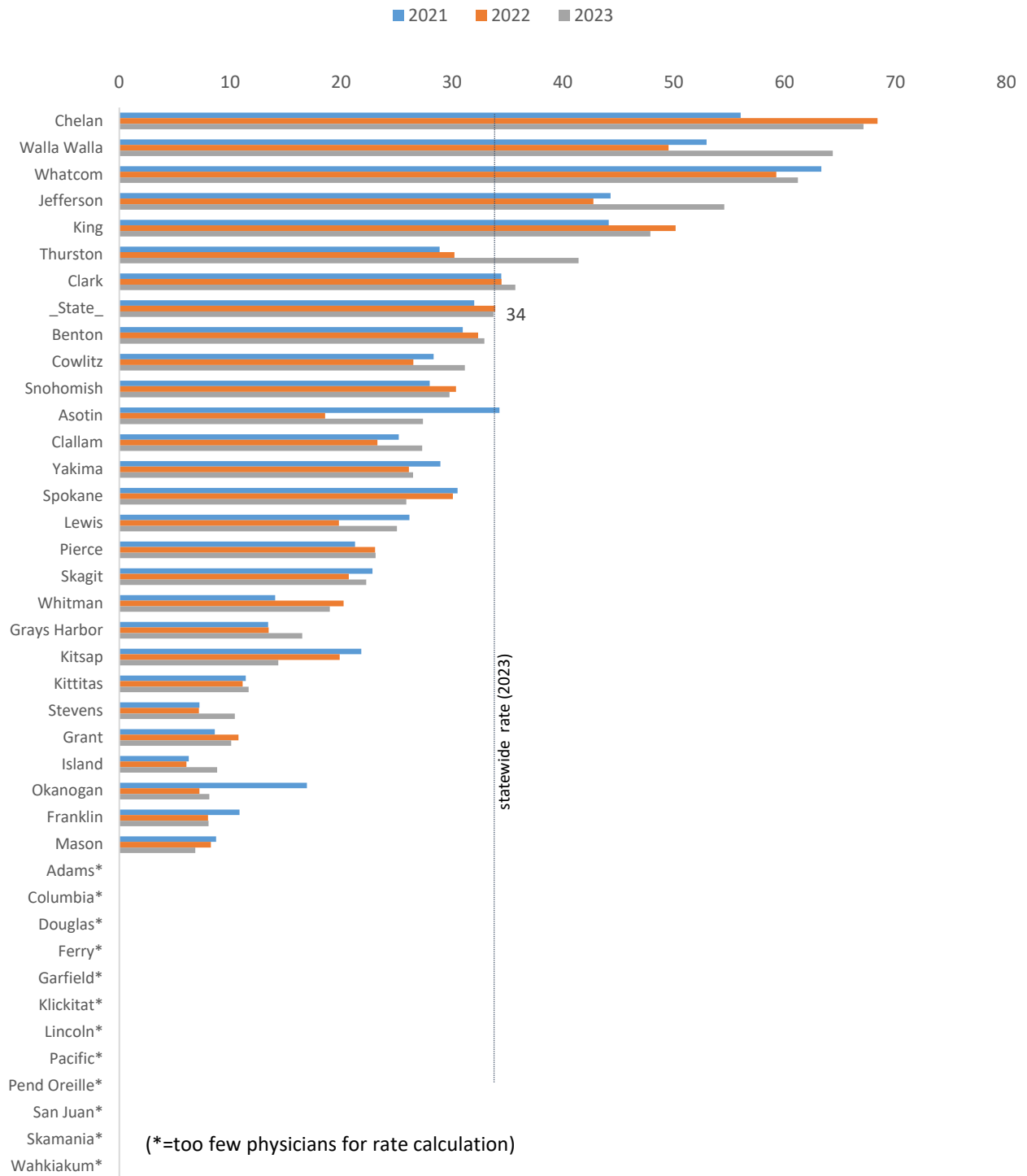


Map C33. Hospitalist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

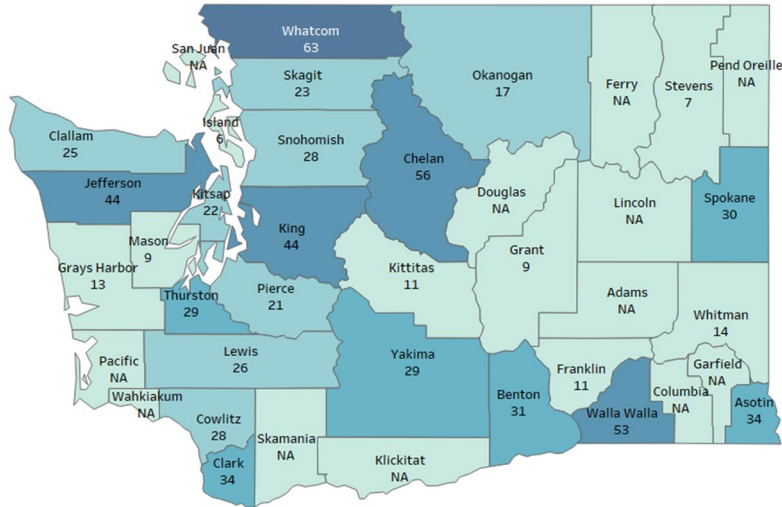


Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

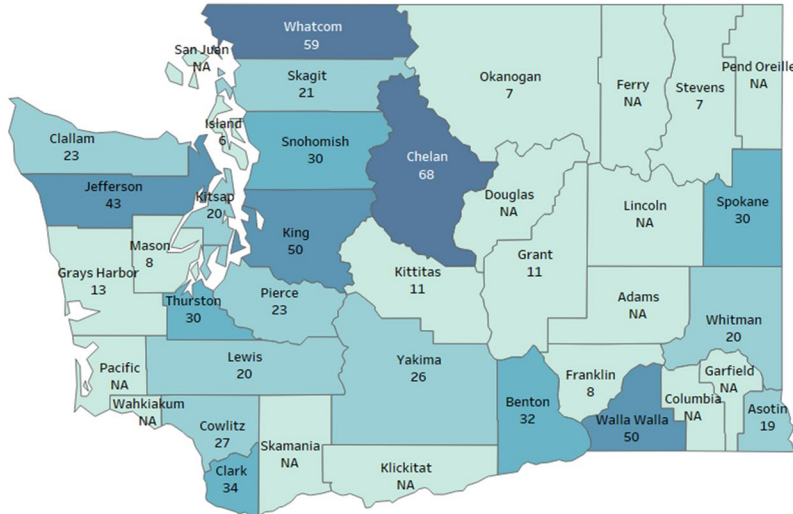
Figure C12. Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23
(sorted by 2023 distribution)



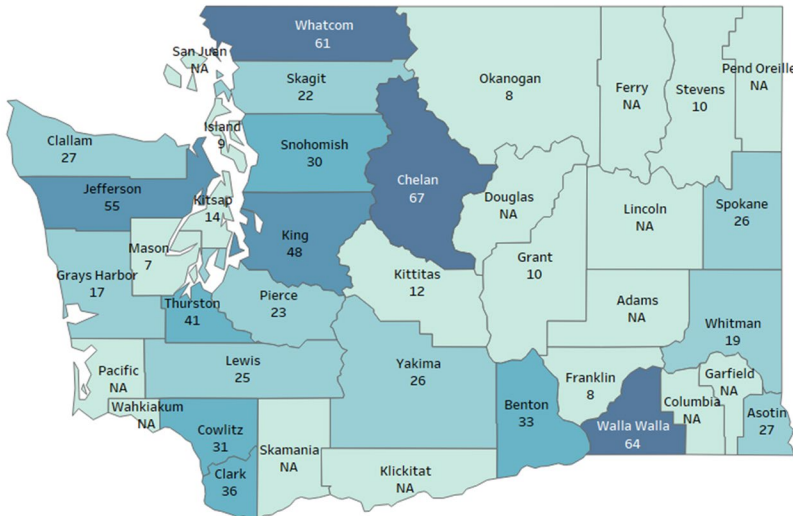
Map C34. Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C35. Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

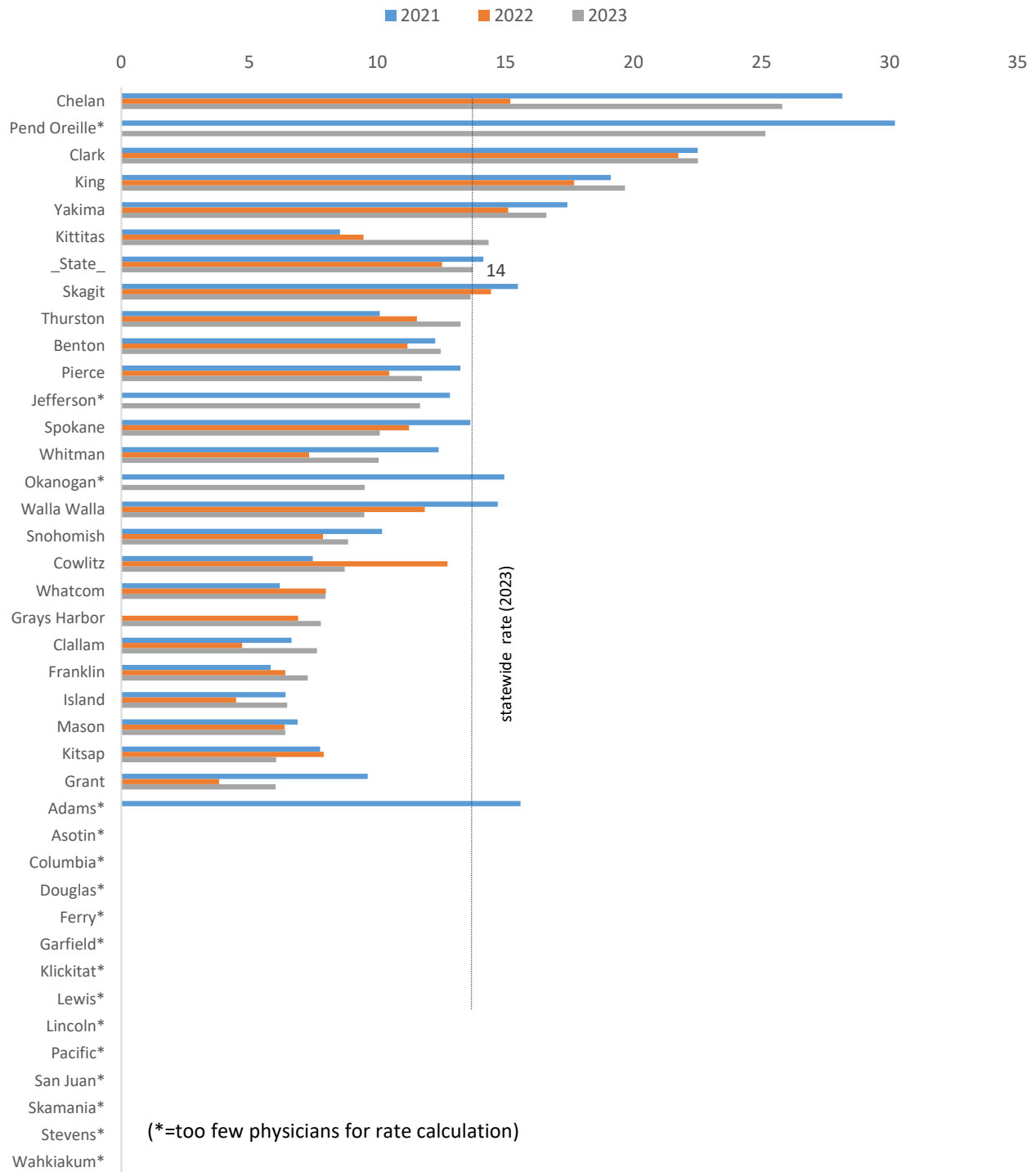


Map C36. Internal Medicine (General) Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

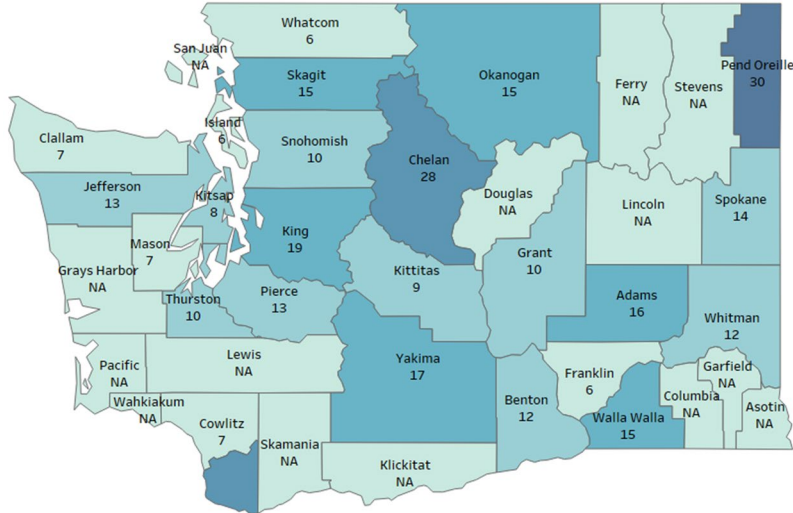


OB/GYN Rates (per 100,000) by County, 2021–23

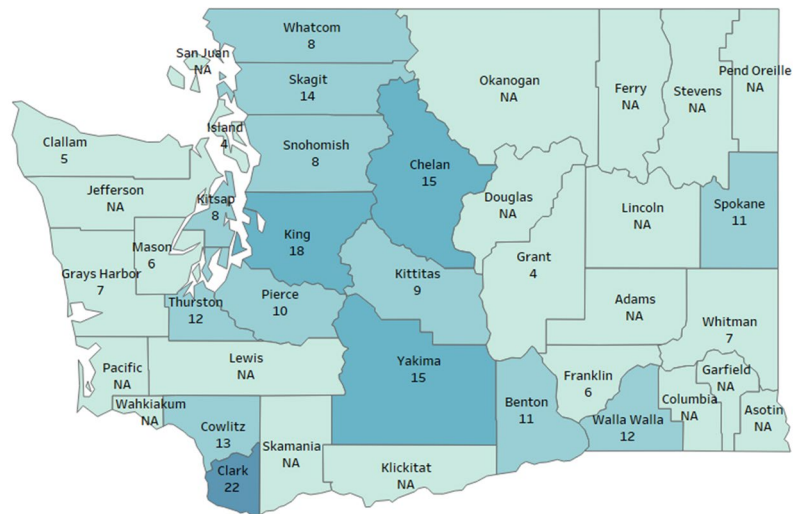
Figure C13. OB/GYN Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23
(sorted by 2023 distribution)



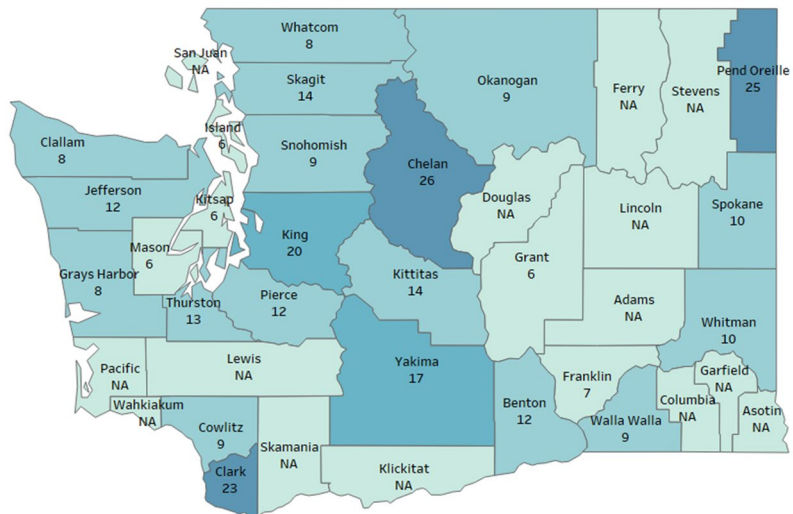
Map C37. OB/GYN Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C38. OB/GYN Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

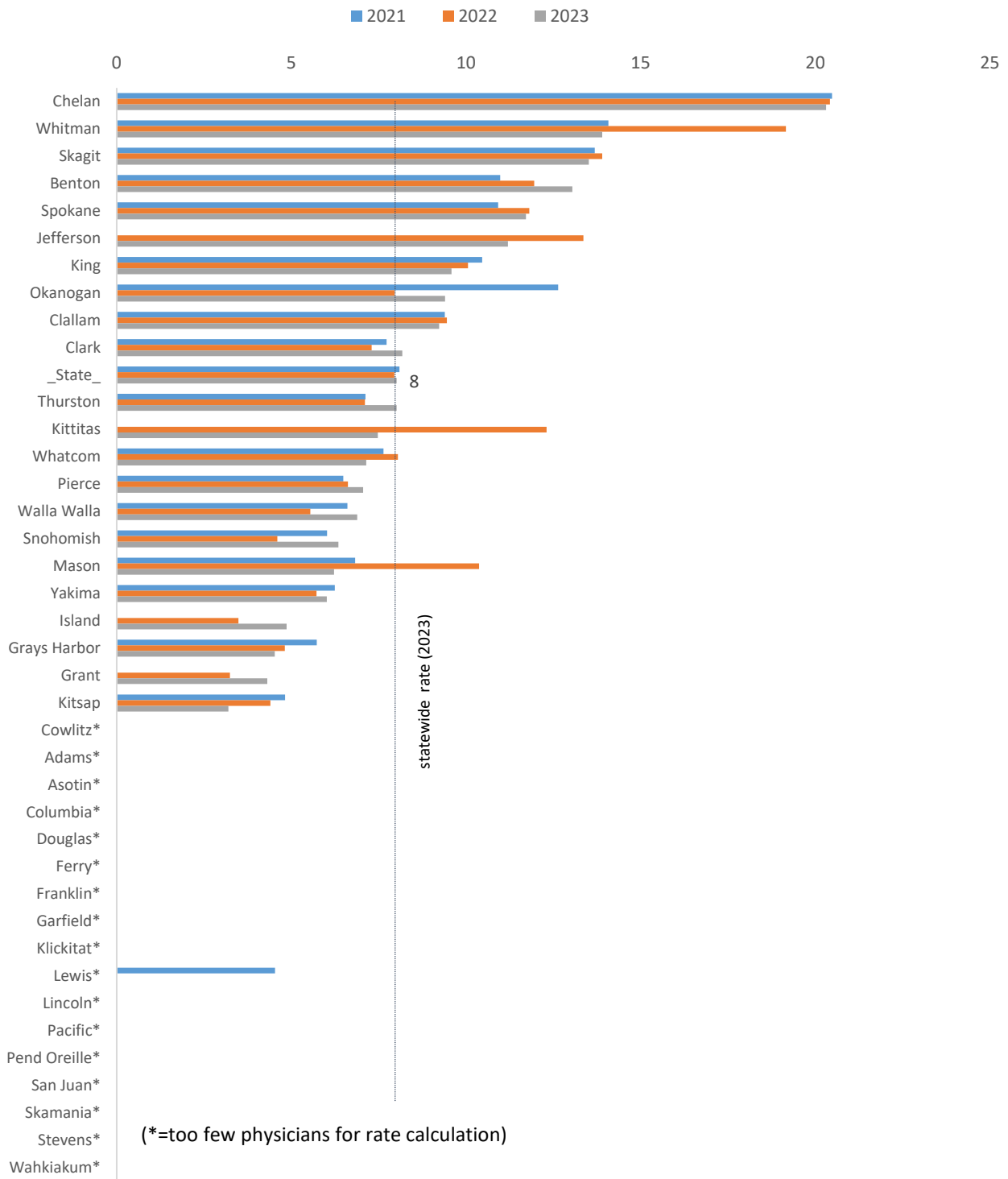


Map C39. OB/GYN Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

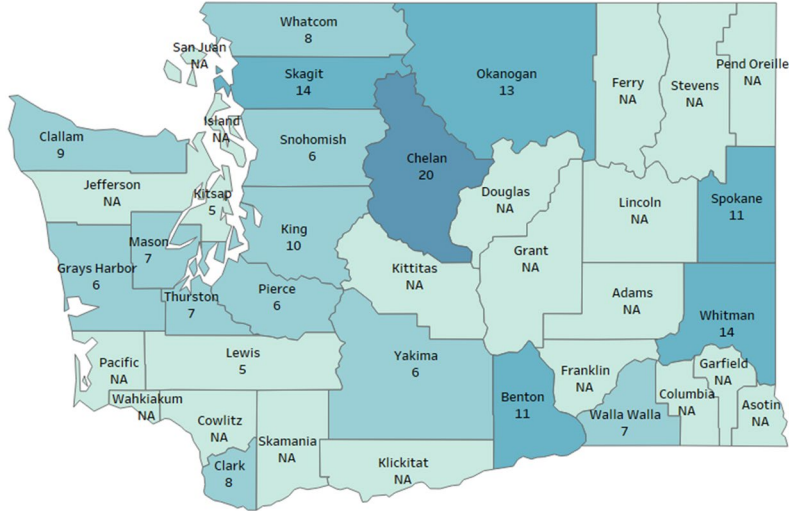


Orthopedic Surgeon Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

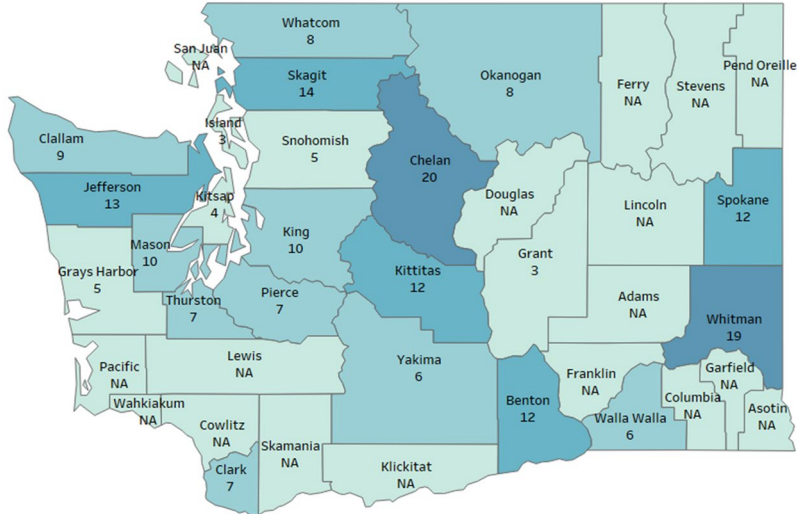
Figure C14. Orthopedic Surgeon Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

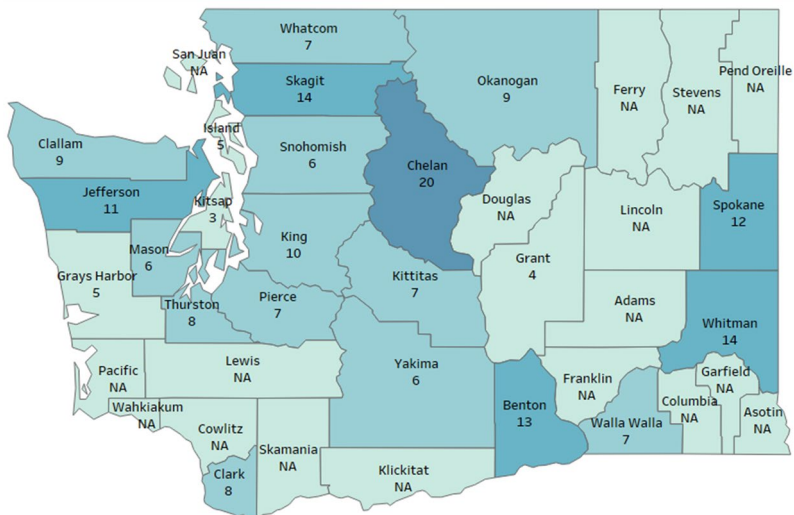
Map C40. Orthopedic Surgeon Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C41. Orthopedic Surgeon Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

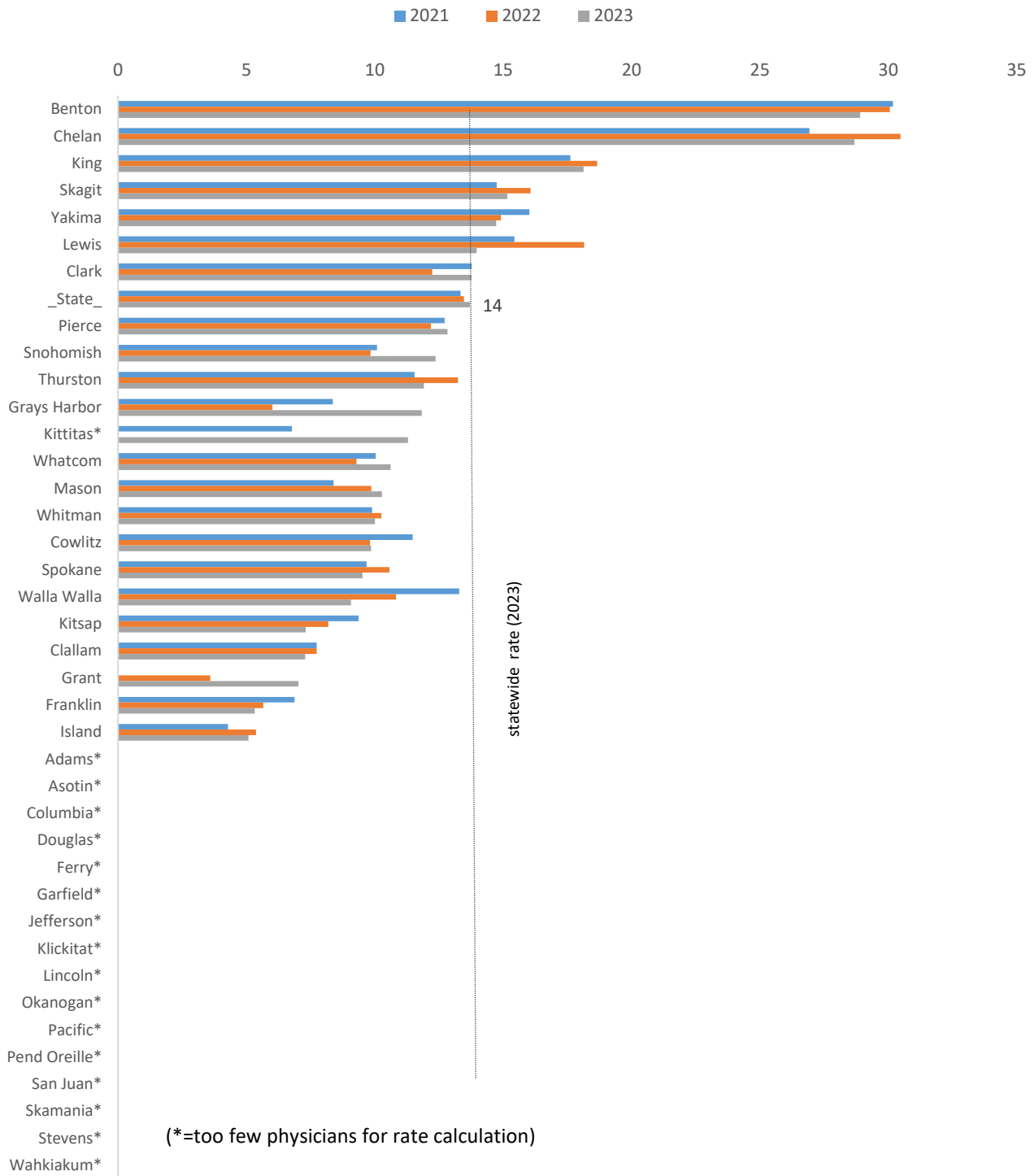


Map C42. Orthopedic Surgeon Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

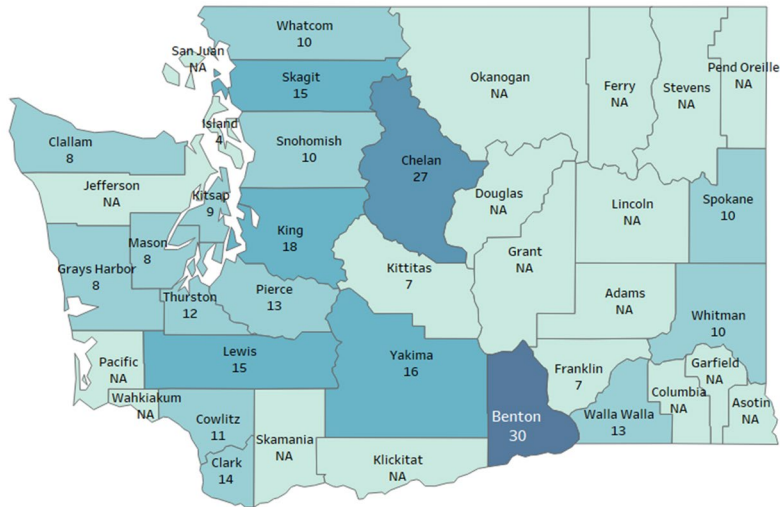


Pediatrician (General) Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

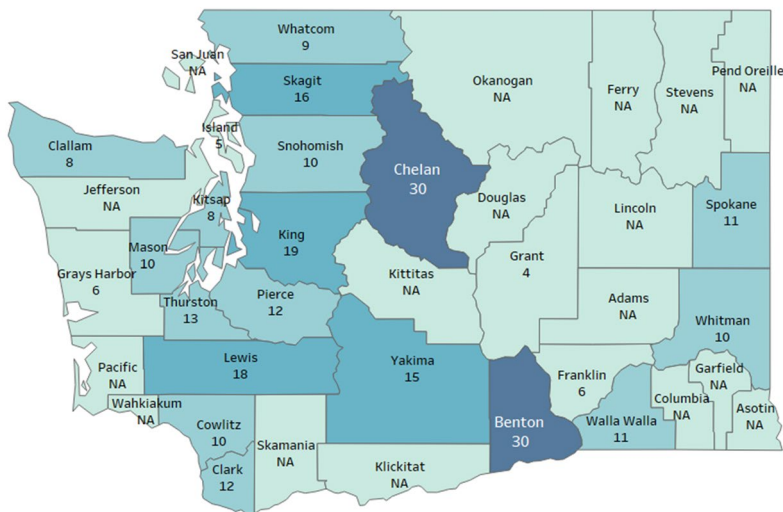
Figure C15. Pediatrician (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

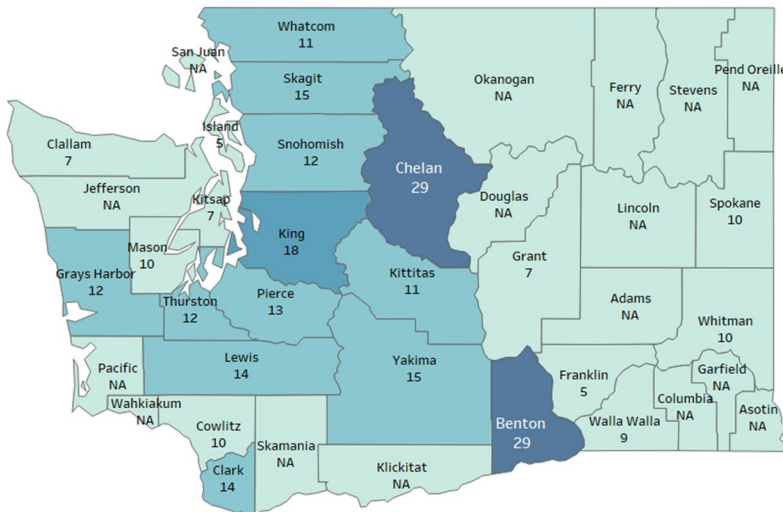
Map C43. Pediatrician (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C44. Pediatrician (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

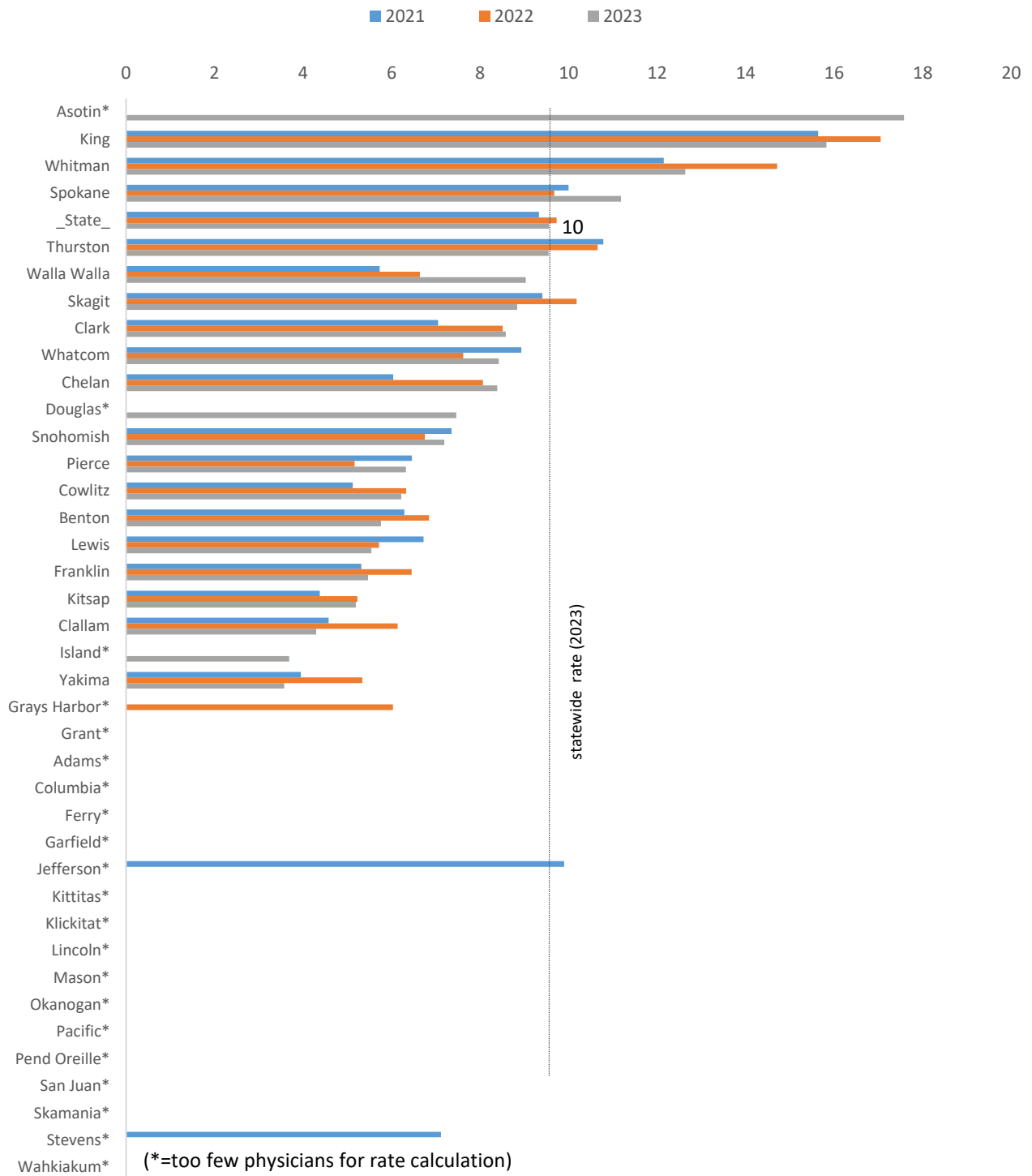


Map C45. Pediatrician (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

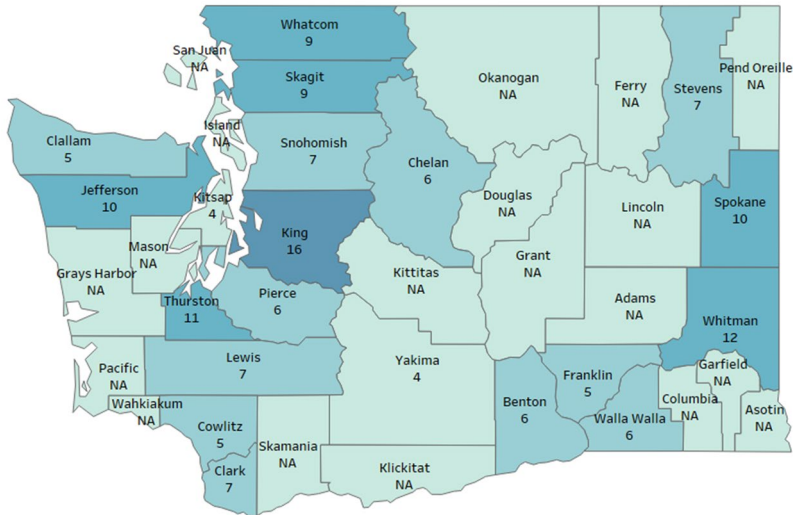


Psychiatrist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

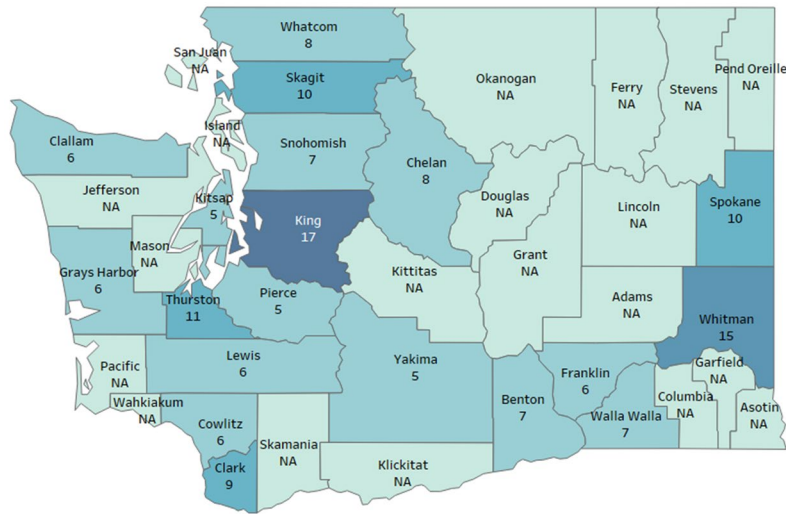
Figure C16. Psychiatrist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

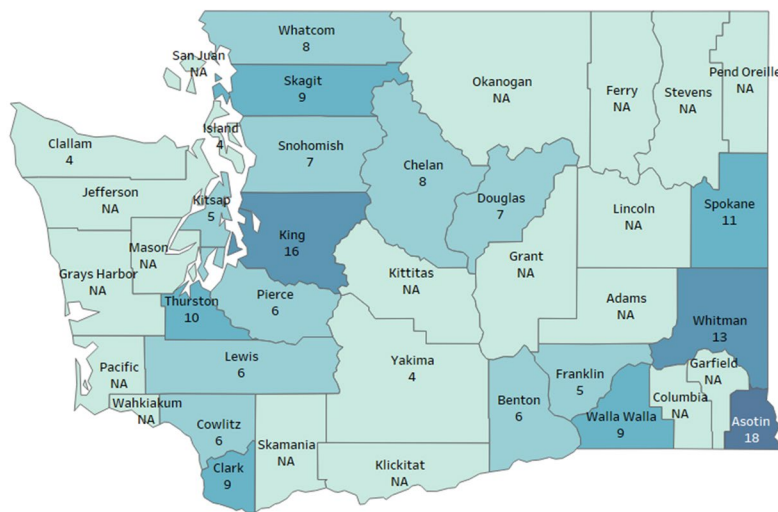
Map C46. Psychiatrist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C47. Psychiatrist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

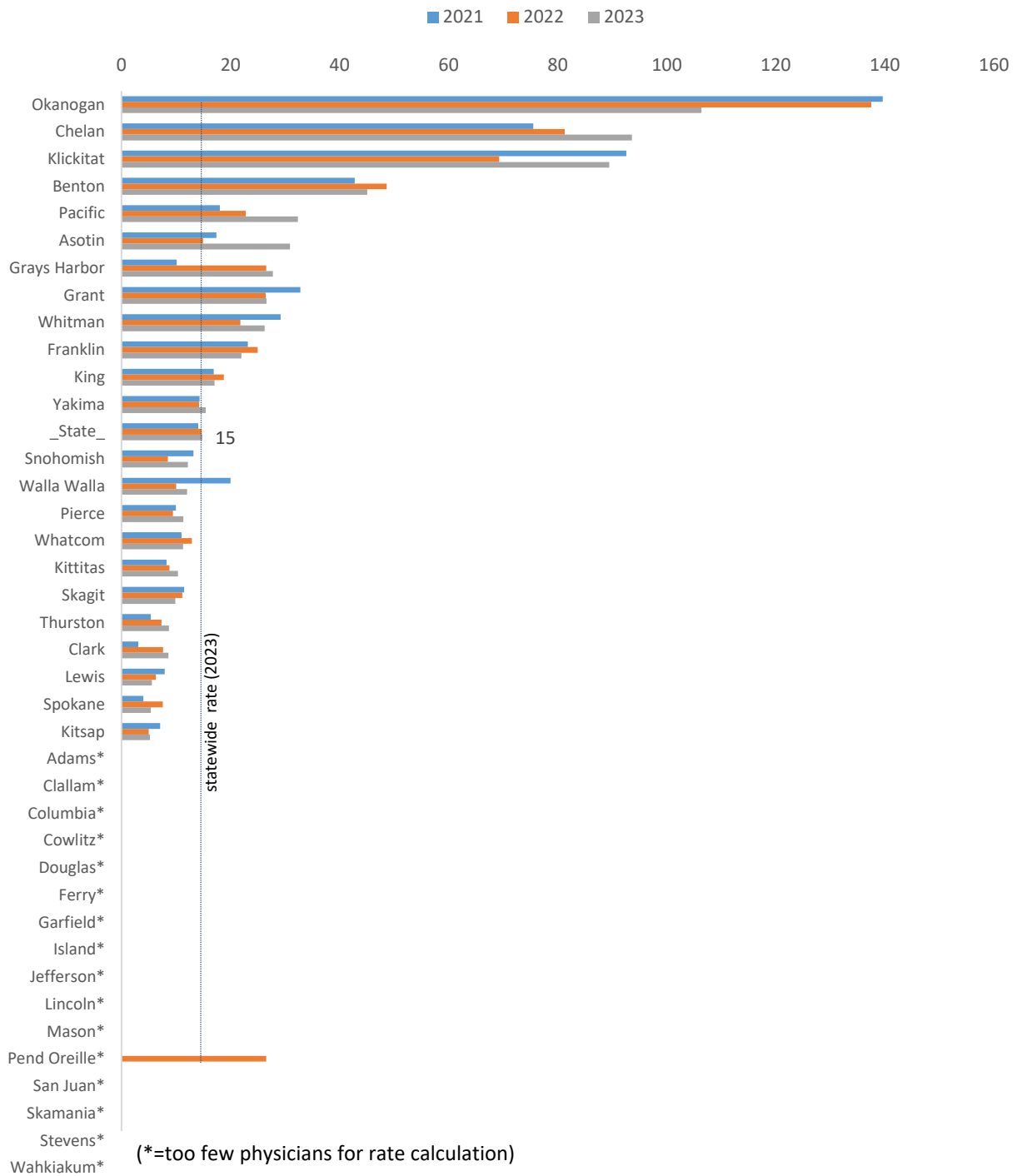


Map C48. Psychiatrist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

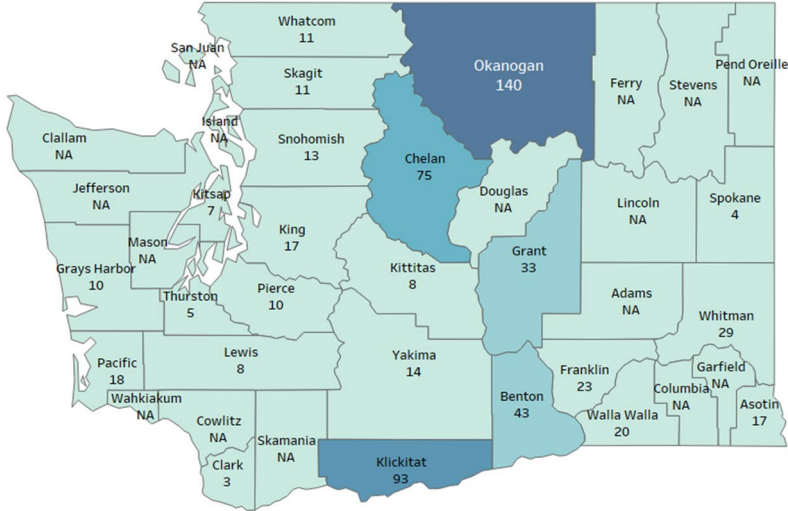


Radiologist Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

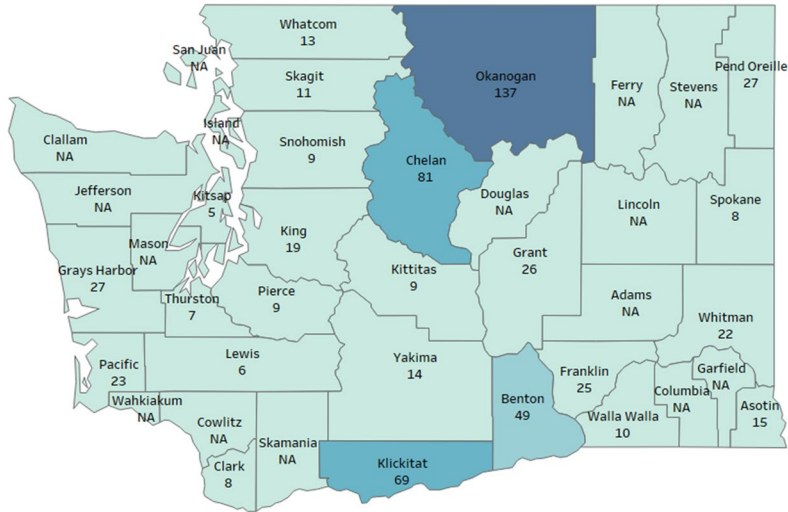
Figure C17. Radiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

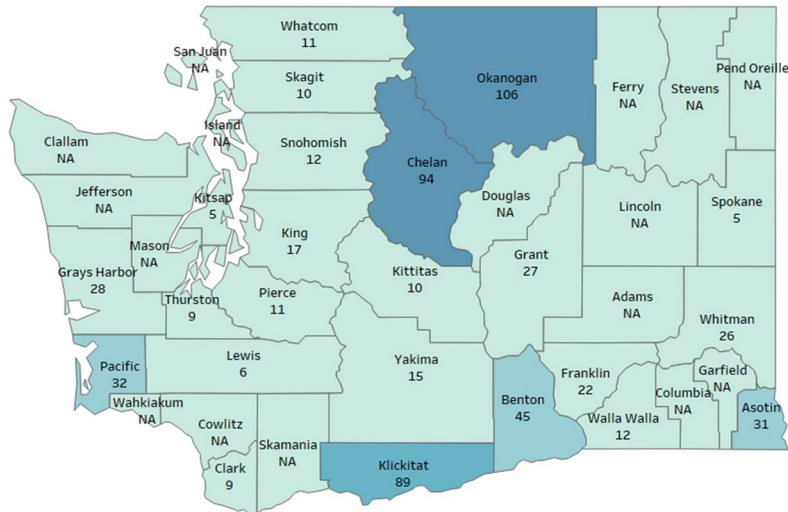
Map C49. Radiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C50. Radiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022

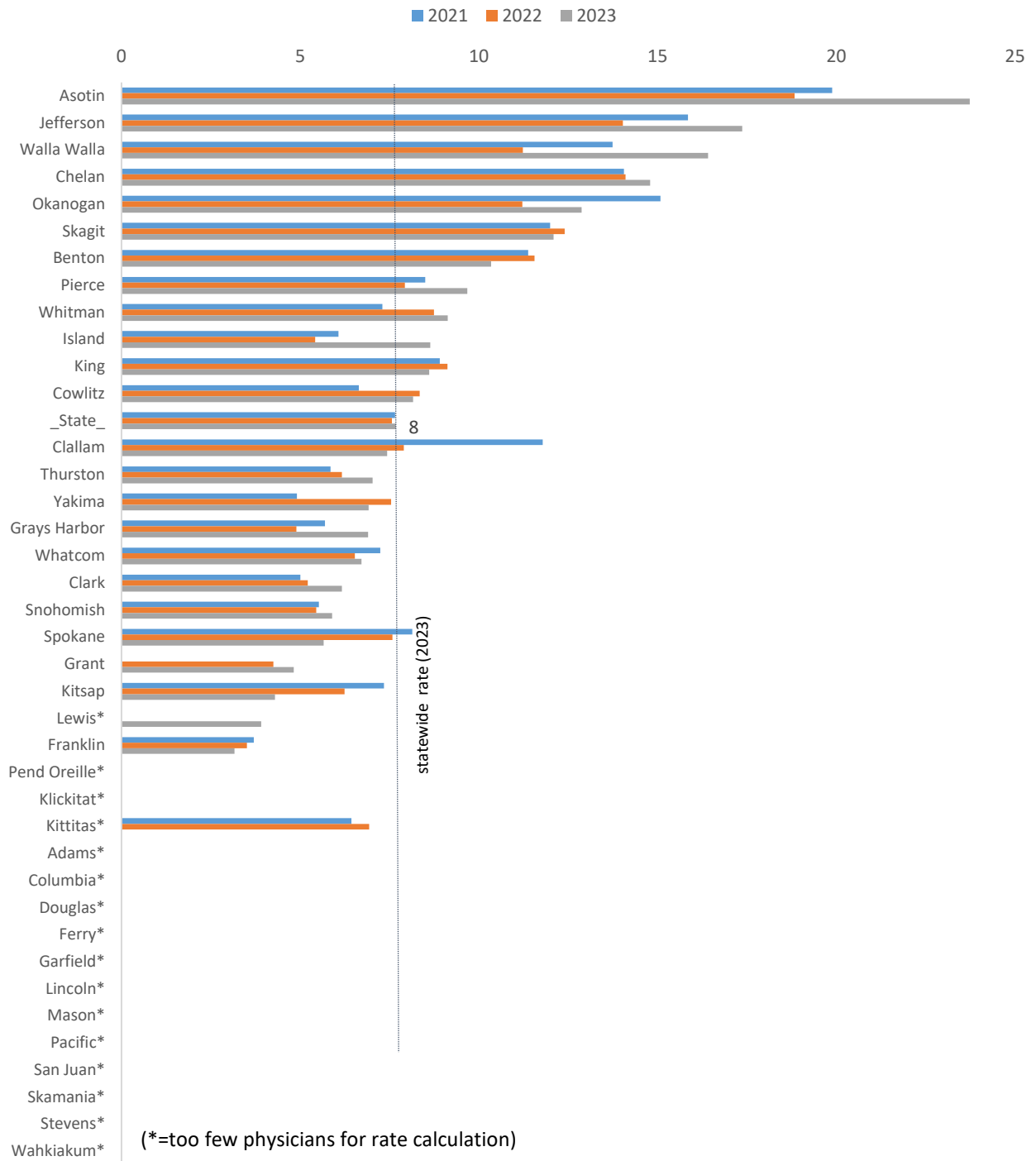


Map C51. Radiologist Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023

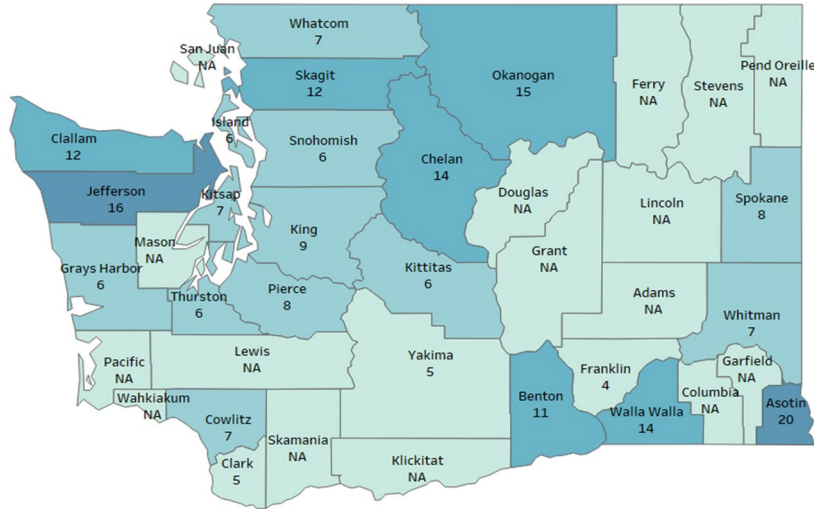


Surgeon (General) Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

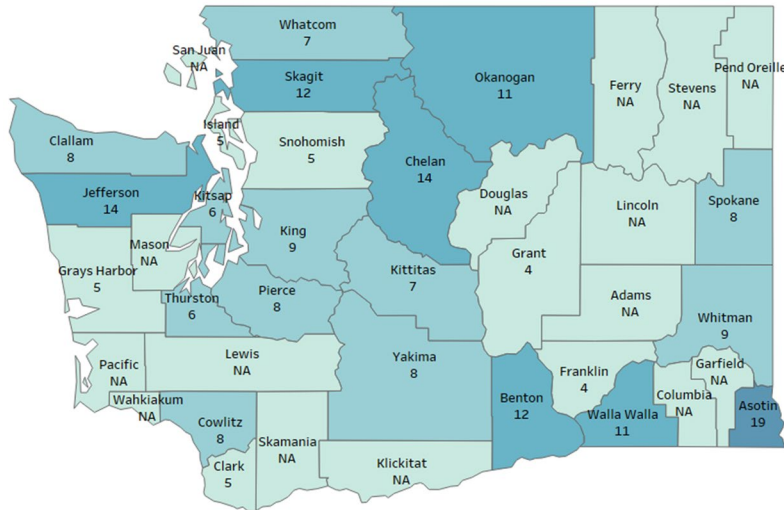
Figure C18. Surgeon (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23
(sorted by 2023 distribution)



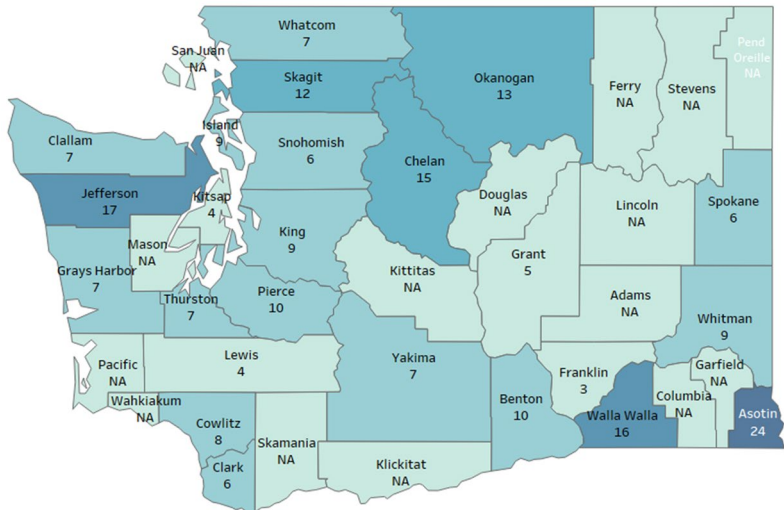
Map C52. Surgeon (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021



Map C53. Surgeon (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2022



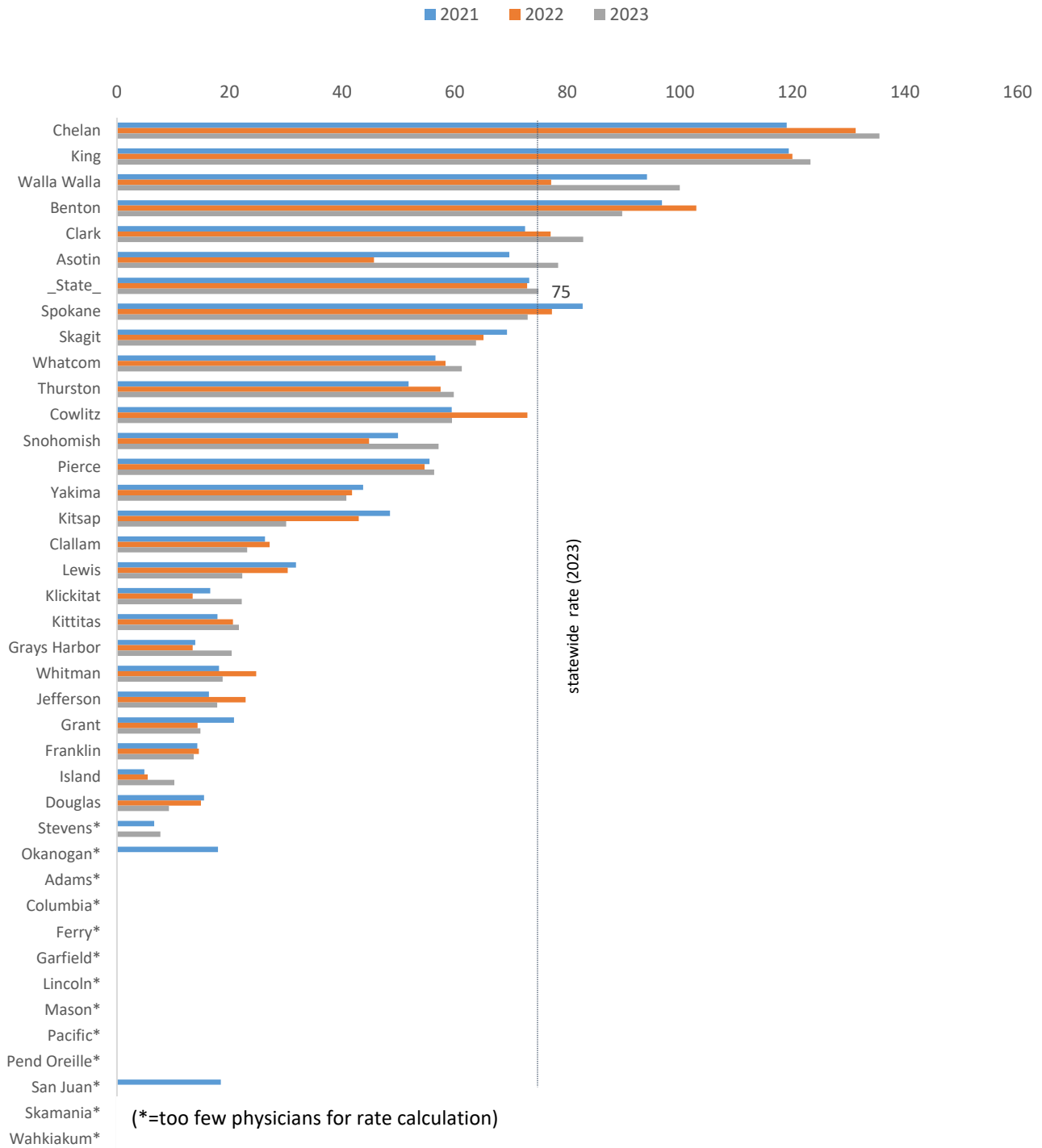
Map C54. Surgeon (General) Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2023



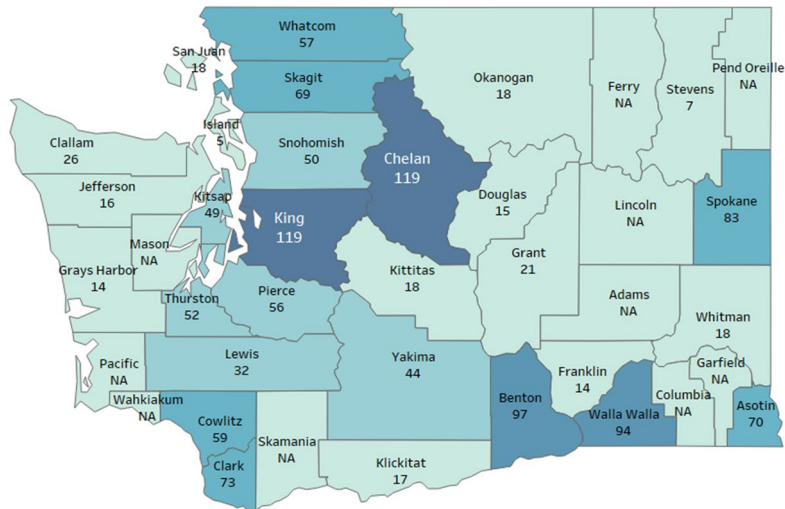
Other Specialty Physician Rates (Per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

Figure C19. Other Specialty Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021–23

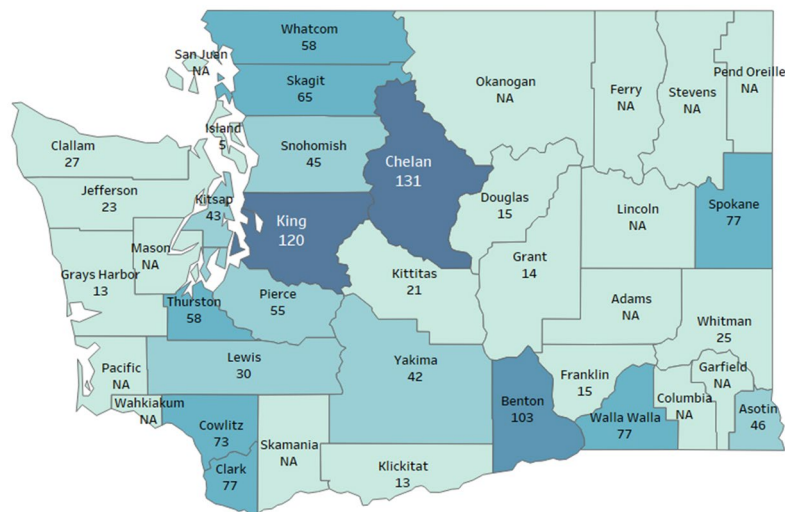

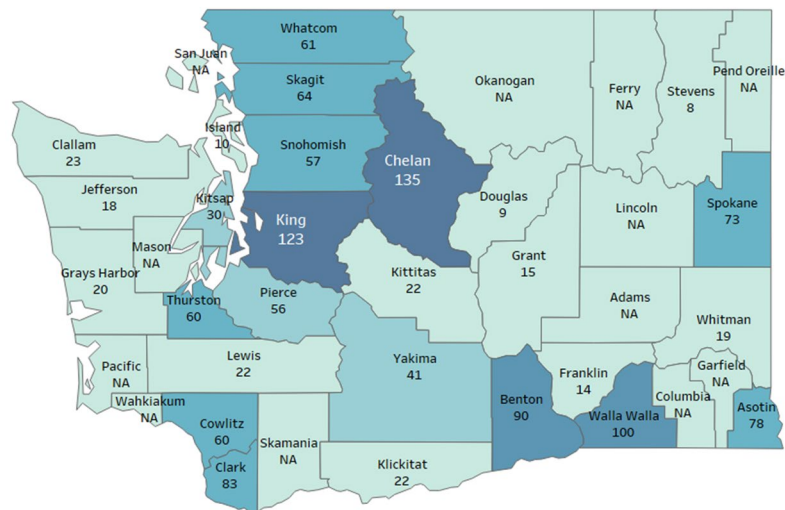
Map C55. Other Specialty Physician Rates (per 100,000) by County: 2021
