CREAMERY OPERATOR I

Abolished Effective February 10, 2006

DEFINITION

Operate creamery equipment and perform duties related to the processing of dairy products.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Positions allocated to this class are distinguished by the requirement for performing work in the manufacture of dairy products.

TYPICAL WORK

Receive, weigh, test and dump milk delivered to the creamery;

Operate pastuerizers, homogenizers, bottling machines, churns and bottle washers;

Disassemble, clean, lubricate, adjust and reassemble plant equipment;

Assist in the manufacture of ice cream, cheese, chocolate milk, and other dairy products;

Operate motor vehicle to deliver milk and other dairy products;

May direct the work of creamery assistants;

Perform related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

High School graduation or GED Certificate; possession of a valid, approved driver's license and one year full-time experience in creamery or dairy processing work.

Ability to obtain a food handler's permit and appropriate state licenses.

Additional work experience may substitute year-for-year for required education.

Equivalent education/experience will substitute for all minimum qualifications except when there are legal requirements, such as a license/certification/registration.
