# FARM EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I **Abolished Effective February 10, 2006**

#### <u>DEFINITION</u>

Operate a variety of light, medium and heavy farm equipment in agricultural operations.

#### DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Positions in this class spend a majority of their time operating farm equipment with responsibility for minor repairs and servicing of assigned equipment.

### TYPICAL WORK

Operate farm equipment such as tractors, bulldozers, back hoes, trucks, harrows, cultivators, seeders, drills, combines, mowing machines, rakes, hay bailers, forage choppers, cutters and loaders, and silo fillers;

Haul feed, hay, straw, grain, ensilage, manure, etc., in various farm equipment;

Adjust equipment in the field and perform emergency field repairs;

Assist in the overhaul and major maintenance of farm machines and equipment;

May construct and repair fences, fixtures, and other farm structures:

Occasionally perform routine farm work;

Perform related duties as required.

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

One year's full-time farm experience including the operation and maintenance of powerdriven farm implements.

Equivalent education/experience will substitute for all minimum qualifications except when there are legal requirements, such as a license/certification/registration.
