ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL TECHNICIAN II

Abolished Effective June 1, 2005

BASIC FUNCTION

Perform complex technical duties in hazardous chemical disposal, fire protection, general safety, vector control, and environmental sanitation.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Under general supervision perform complex technical duties such as independently instituting control procedures in accordance with institutional policies and governing regulations such as those related to pesticide safety and/or chemical compatibility.

TYPICAL WORK

Interpret results of field inspections;

Evaluate and recommend proper practices in compliance with appropriate standards and regulation including emergency situations;

Collect, transport, and dispose of hazardous chemical wastes; may operate heavy material handling equipment and trucks;

Perform vector control duties such as application of pesticides and insecticides;

May lead assigned personnel;

Perform duties of Environmental Control Technician I;

Perform related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

A Bachelor's Degree in science, engineering or related field; OR two years of experience as Environmental Control Technician I or equivalent.

Equivalent education/experience will substitute for all minimum qualifications except when there are legal requirements, such as a license/certification/registration.
