VENDING MACHINE MECHANIC

**Abolished Effective February 10, 2006**

DEFINITION

Repair and maintain housing and food service vending equipment; may direct the work of student assistants.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Positions allocated to this class require specialized skills in the repair, rebuilding, service, and maintenance of a variety of vending equipment such as cold drink, hot drink, milk, ice cream, hot sandwich, and money changing machines.

TYPICAL WORK

Overhaul refrigeration, electrical, plumbing, mechanical and security systems in vending machines;

Install, clean, adjust, maintain, and repair various types of vending machines (including coin-operated) on location or in the central repair shop;

Investigate vandalism and maintain a stock of spare parts for vending equipment;

Direct total vending operation in absence of supervisor during weekends and night duty;

Occasionally run a service route including the collection of coins and replenishment of products;

May lead work of student employees and/or vending service workers;

Perform related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Two years of full-time experience in vending machine repair or completion of a comprehensive vocational or technical program in vending machine repair.

Possession of a valid motor vehicle operator's license may be required.

Examination Requirements:

A job element examination (including written, E & T and oral components) scored on the basis of job related experience, training, skill, ability and other elements which are established through job analysis.
