DISHWASHER

Abolished Effective July 1, 2007

Definition: Performs simple, repetitive dishwashing duties in a camp kitchen.

Typical Work

Washes, sterilizes, dries, stacks and stores china, glassware, silverware, pots and pans, appliance casings and attachments and other kitchen utensils;

Performs other work as required.

Knowledge and Abilities

Ability to: understand and follow simple oral instructions; learn simple repetitive tasks.

Minimum Qualifications

No physical impairment to moderate lifting, continuous standing and manual dexterity. No allergy to common kitchen chemicals.
