LAUNDRY WORKER 1

Abolished Effective July 1, 2007

Definition: Performs routine laundry work in institutions.

Typical Work

Operates washing machines, extractors, mangles, and presses; prepares bleaching, starching, blueing, and sterilizing solutions; adds starches, bleaches, and disinfectants;

Washes, dries, irons, and presses institution clothing and linens;

Receives, counts, marks, sorts, folds, bundles, and ties laundry; arranges for distribution of laundry;

Escorts students, patients or inmates to and from laundry;

Oils, cleans, and makes adjustments and minor repairs to laundry equipment;

Supervises and trains students, patients or inmates in operating laundry equipment and in doing routine laundry work;

Performs other work as required.

Knowledge and Abilities

Knowledge of: use of bleaches, soaps, and starches.

Ability to: operate washing machines, mangles, extractors, and presses; supervise and train students, patients or inmates in operating laundry equipment and in doing routine laundry work; follow written and oral instructions.

Minimum Qualifications

Ability to read and write.
